Thursday night, Nov. 29, the UN General Assembly grants Palestine non-member observer status within 1967 borders by a majority vote. Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu has tried dismissing this upgrade as meaningless – awarding its initiator Mahmoud Abbas (Abu Mazen) nothing more than a small town sheriff's badge. But the fact remains that this status and those borders are on the books, no matter which Palestinian government is in power, Abbas's Fatah which rules the West Bank from Ramallah or the extremist Hamas in the Gaza Strip. And Israel now has a new headache, especially if the Palestinian entity seeks membership of the International War Crimes Court in The Hague. For now, the Palestinians are treading carefully. They say they won't apply as yet. However, by having Yasser Arafat's remains exhumed in a grand military ceremony, for samples to be tested for poison in Paris and Moscow, they have set a road sign pointing to The Hague.

#### Headline: UN Set to Violate Its Own Rules on 'State'

The United Nations is expected to pass a resolution on Thursday to admit the PLO as a non-member state and recognize the "right of the Palestinian people to self-determination and to independence in their State of Palestine on the Palestinian territory occupied since 1967," even though its regulations require a state to have a functioning government within borders under international agreement. The Palestinian Authority, the administrative body of the PLO, also does not satisfy U.N. requirements that it have a functioning government over the presumed borders. PA Chairman Mahmoud Abbas has ruled from the PA capital of Ramallah more than two years beyond the prescribed date for new presidential elections, and the legislature has not functioned for years following the Hamas parliamentary victory in the first and only parliamentary elections.

## Headline: Morsi's dilemma in Egypt bad news for Jordan's Islamists

As the political scene in Egypt continues to unfold, the Muslim Brotherhood movement's leaders in Jordan struggle to disassociate themselves from their Egyptian peers, advocating a narrative focused on the so-called "Moroccan option" for reform rather than the Egyptian scenario. Last week, Egyptian President Mohamed Morsi declared unilaterally that until a new constitution is decreed all presidential decisions would be immune from legal challenge, triggering a wave of protests across the country, and setting him on course for a showdown with Egypt's judges as well as other political rivals. But despite the dramatic events in Egypt, Abu Rumman said, the Muslim Brotherhood leaders in Jordan continue to reiterate their demands to apply the Moroccan scenario, where Islamist party leaders formed the government after winning a majority of parliamentary seats, rather than the Egyptian option in terms of the political reform they have been calling for.

Headline: Jordan secures financial assistance from Saudi Arabia

Violent protests that shocked Jordan this month have mostly subsided, but unprecedented chants for the "fall of the regime" suggested a deeper malaise in a kingdom so far spared the revolts reshaping the Arab world. Anger over fuel subsidy cuts undoubtedly drove the unrest, in which police shot dead one man during a confrontation at a police station. The government's planned electricity price rises starting next year may well ignite more popular fury. King Abdullah has made some constitutional reforms and his counsellors say turnout at a parliamentary poll in January will test public support for the pace of political change amid an acute financial crisis that has forced Jordan to go to the IMF. "This government is raising tension, corruption, and looting especially with the recent forged pharmaceuticals scandal, the ranks and salaries system issue, drug trafficking, irresponsibility in the power and communication sectors, and many more" Political tension has been on the rise since the announcement made by March 14 in late October to cut all ties with the government of Prime Minister Najib Miqati after the specter of political assassinations returned to Lebanon.

Headline: Egypt's opposition protest on Friday to reject constitutional declaration, draft constitution

The Islamist-dominated assembly writing a new Egyptian constitution has convened to vote on the final draft. In one of its first steps, the constituent assembly voted to keep sharia, or Islamic law, as the main source of legislation. It came after the constitutional court said it would rule on Sunday

whether to dissolve the assembly. Egypt's judiciary is in a stand-off with President Mohammed Morsi after he granted himself sweeping new powers. Mr Morsi is scheduled to address the nation on television on Thursday evening. His decree last week has sparked huge protests across the country. Liberal, left-wing and Christian members have boycotted the assembly, accusing the Islamists of trying to impose their vision.

#### Headline: Clashes block access to U.S. Embassy


The U.S. Embassy in Cairo closed Thursday after fighting between protesters and police blocked access to the building. The clashes stem from Egyptian President Mohammed Morsi's refusal to back away from a showdown over his decree granting himself near absolute power, CBS News reported. CBS said the protesters were targeting riot police, not the U.S. Embassy in the confrontations occurring near the diplomatic compound. Most embassy staff were gone, and the embassy was closed for all American citizen services, officials said.

Headline: New page in Syria war as rebel missiles hit aircraft

Syrian rebels have acquired as many as 40 shoulder-fired missile systems in recent weeks to counter assaults by Syrian military aircraft, introducing a possibly decisive new weapon into the conflict, Western and Middle Eastern intelligence officials say. The potential impact of the missiles on the 20-month-old civil war was demonstrated Tuesday with the dramatic downing of a Syrian helicopter, blasted from the sky near Aleppo by what military experts say was almost certainly a portable anti-aircraft missile. The Obama administration has steadfastly opposed arming Syrian opposition forces with such missiles, warning that the weapons could fall into the hands of terrorists and be used to shoot down commercial aircraft.

Headline: Syrian air strike kills 15 in Aleppo, activists say

The Syrian government shut down the Internet across the country and cut cellphone services in select areas on Thursday as rebels and government troops waged fierce battles near the capital's airport, forcing international airlines to suspend flights, activists said. The Internet blackout, confirmed

by two U.S-based companies that monitor online connectivity, is unprecedented in Syria's 20-monthold uprising against President Bashar Assad. Regime forces have suffered a string of tactical defeats in recent weeks, losing air bases and other strategic facilities, and the blackout may be an attempt by the government to dull any further rebel offensives by hampering communications. Members of the team will hold talks with their counterparts and partners to promote economic cooperation and trade during the one week visit to Turkey. They will visit Polytan company in Istanbul as the largest Polymer company and hold talks with the Board of Directors of Etishkan Company which produces plasters for construction projects. According to the figures released by the Turkish Statistical Institute, Iran became Turkey's third biggest business partner with a trade exchange of \$17.52bln since the beginning of the current Iranian year (started on March 20, 2012). Turkey imported \$8.94 billion in goods from Iran, and exported \$8.58 billion in goods to the Islamic Republic during this period.

## Headline: US sets March deadline for Iran to cooperate with IAEA

The United States effectively set a March deadline on Thursday for Iran to start cooperating in substance with a UN nuclear agency investigation, saying it would otherwise urge reporting the issue to the UN Security Council. The comments by US diplomat Robert Wood to the 35-nation governing board of the UN International Atomic Energy Agency signaled Washington's growing frustration at the lack of results in the IAEA's inquiry into possible military dimensions to Tehran's nuclear program. Iran denies the charge.

## Headline: Iraq bombings kill 45

Bombs mainly targeting Shiite Muslims and security forces in Iraq killed 45 people and wounded 205 others on Thursday in the deadliest day of violence to hit the country in more than two months. The attacks, the worst since 76 people were killed on September 9, included the second series of bombings against Shiites this week, after three car bombs exploded near their places of worship in Baghdad on Tuesday, killing a dozen and wounding scores more. The Thursday violence brings the number of people killed in attacks this month to at least 152 -- 16 more than in October, according to an AFP tally based on security and medical sources. That reversed a three-month trend of declining death tolls. Two roadside bombs targeted a group of Shiite pilgrims in the city of Hilla, police said. A list of victims posted at a hospital in Hilla put the toll at 33 killed and 166 wounded -- figures confirmed by Babil provincial council member Hamed Ahmed Abboud. Iraqi security forces cordoned off the

area of the blasts and set up checkpoints in the city to search cars, an AFP correspondent said, adding that shops near the site were shuttered after the attacks.

Headline: Tunisia PM refuses to resign after protests

Tunisia's army intervened Thursday in a third day of violent clashes in a northern town between police and striking residents who are demanding jobs and investment. Witnesses said 15,000 people marched through the town of Siliana, in Tunisia's economically deprived interior on the edge of the Sahara desert, demanding the governor's resignation. After two days of battles that a hospital said left more than 300 people injured, police pulled out of Siliana Wednesday night, then returned Thursday afternoon and attempted to disperse the crowd with tear gas and shotguns, sparking more violence before army units restored order, witness Mouldi Kenzizi told The Associated Press. FRANCE 24 correspondent David Thomson and his Tunisian driver Hamdi Tlili were among those injured in the clashes Wednesday, apparently after being fired on by riot police.

## Headline: Algeria anti-vote activists clash with police, "20 wounded"

Twenty people were wounded on Thursday in clashes between Algerian police and youth activists who tried to disrupt local elections, in a region southeast of Algiers, a newspaper reported on its website. The clashes broke out as the police tried to disperse protesters who were attempting to ransack a polling booth in the municipality of Takerboust, in the Bouira region, 125 kilometers (80 miles) southeast of the capital, El Watan said, citing residents. The youths, who have been demanding an inquiry into the running of the commune for the past five years, were seeking to disrupt the vote, some of them told the French-language daily. Several protesters were arrested and the incident temporarily interrupted voting.

## Headline: EU commission foresees two treaty changes to reach full integration

The EU commission Wednesday published its vision for a "genuine" economic and monetary union (EMU) under which national budgets could be vetoed and a central European budget would allow transfers for troubled countries. The process would require two rounds of treaty change – one within the next five years and another more profound exercise in the longer-term. The 52-page blueprints emphasises the need for the eurozone to be able to "integrate quicker and deeper" than the rest of the EU, with the eurozone now largely seen as paying for being established as a political project without the fundamental economic and financial structures to back it up.

#### Headline: Gold, Silver Rise on Bets Fed Will Expand U.S. Stimulus

Gold rose for the first time in four days on speculation that the Federal Reserve will buy more debt to boost the U.S. economy. Silver climbed to a seven-week high. "I will be assessing the employment and inflation outlook in order to determine whether we should continue Treasury purchases into 2013," Federal Reserve Bank of New York President William C. Dudley said in a speech in New York. Treasury Secretary Timothy F. Geithner began talks with congressional leaders on a budget accord. "Talks about more stimulus measures being introduced are bullish for gold," Bart Melek, the Toronto-based head of commodity strategy at TD Securities, said in a telephone interview. "The market is expecting some sort of resolution soon to avert the fiscal-cliff crisis" on U.S. spending and taxes, he said. Gold futures for February delivery gained 0.6 percent to settle at \$1,729.50 an ounce at 1:49 p.m. on the Comex in New York.

## Headline: Consumer Spending in U.S. Grows Less Than Forecast

Consumer spending in the U.S. grew less than forecast in the third quarter, underscoring why Federal Reserve policy makers are zeroing in on fighting unemployment to spur the world's largest economy. Household purchases climbed at a 1.4 percent rate, the smallest gain in more than a year and down from a previously reported 2 percent advance, revised figures from the Commerce Department showed today in Washington. Gains in inventories and a smaller trade deficit more than offset the slowdown to propel gross domestic product to a 2.7 percent rate, exceeding the 2 percent pace previously reported. "The economy is moving forward at a moderate pace," said Chris Rupkey, chief financial economist at Bank of Tokyo- Mitsubishi UFJ Ltd. in New York. "The pace of consumer spending was disappointing, but it seems less worrisome given that some other sectors of the economy are doing better, like housing."

#### Headline: China issues new warning

China, in its "effort to protect the South China Sea," said police in Hainan Island province will be authorized to search ships illegally entering its waters. Effective Jan. 1, Hainan police would be authorized to board and search ships that illegally enter the province's waters as part of the latest "Chinese effort to protect the South China Sea," China Daily reported. China's aggressive territorial claims to much of the sea combined with its growing military might have raised concerns among a number of other nations in the region that also have overlapping sea claims. It was on Hainan that the Chinese military last July set up a garrison in the newly created Sansha City.

North Korea has made further progress in the construction of a new atomic reactor, the U.N. nuclear chief reported on Thursday, a facility that may extend the country's capacity to produce material for nuclear bombs. Pyongyang "has continued construction of the light water reactor and largely completed work on the exterior of the main buildings," Yukiya Amano, director general of the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA), said. But, he told the IAEA's 35-nation governing board that the U.N. agency "remains unable to determine the reactor's design features or the likely date for its commissioning."

Headline: Judge rules atheist court case seeking removal of Jesus statue meant as World War II memorial near Montana ski resort can continue

A lawsuit seeking the removal of a Jesus statue near a Montana ski resort will go on after a national group of atheists and agnostics produced a local member who says he is offended by the religious symbol whenever he swooshes down the slopes. The Knights of Columbus and four individuals had asked a judge to throw out the legal challenge because the Wisconsin-based Freedom From Religion Foundation had not named anyone actually harmed by the statue on federal land next to Whitefish

Mountain Resort. Without such a person, the Knights of Columbus argued, the foundation had no right to bring the lawsuit. So the foundation found William Cox, an atheist who lives 15 miles from the northwestern Montana resort. Headline: Residents on alert, as Santiaguito volcano blows its top in Guatemala

The Santiaguito volcano, in western Guatemala, erupted today with "very strong," with the release of smoke and ash at high altitudes, so the agency has recommended Meteorology restrict air traffic in the area. So far there is no need for an evacuation of the villages closest to the volcano, which is located about 227 kilometers from Guatemala City. The director of the National Institute of Seismology, Volcanology, Meteorology and Hydrology (Insivumeh), Eddy Sanchez, reported that the activity of the volcano at 2,550 meters, and located in the department of Quetzaltenango, started at

about 5.30 local time (11.30 GMT). Sanchez added that the sand and volcanic ash is dispersed within at least a 4 kilometers radius of the volcano.

Mount Lokon volcano in North Sulawesi erupted on Wednesday, spewing ash up to 3.5 kilometers to the sky, without report of fatality and evacuation, officials said. Head of National Volcanology Surono said that the eruption took place at 10:05 local time (0205 GMT). He said that the agency had asked people living near the crater to be alert. "We issued warning to the people living 2.5 kilometers from the crater," Surono told Xinhua by phone. Spokesman of National Disaster Management and Mitigation Agency (BNPB) Sutopo Purwo Nugroho confirmed that there was no evacuation after the eruption.

The 3,085-meter Plosky Tolbachik volcano in Russia's Far Eastern Kamchatka Peninsula is erupting for the first time in 36 years, according to reports of KVERT, the he volcano monitoring body for Kamchatka. The volcano is located on the peninsula's eastern coast, 343 km from the region's capital of Petropavlovsk-Kamchatsky. A bulletin released Tuesday by the Kamchatka Volcanic Eruption Response Team (KVERT), as cited by The Voice of Russia, described a significant explosive eruption with the potential for ash explosions up to 10 km. The eruption at Plosky Tolbachik was given code orange (number three on the four-tiered USGS Volcano Alert Level), meaning it "poses limited hazards."
