Headline: Abbas returns home to hero's welcome, but faces fresh punishment from Israel

Headline: Israel garnishes Palestinian tax revenues

Returning to a hero's welcome Sunday after gaining limited recognition of statehood at the United Nations, Palestinian Authority President Mahmoud Abbas faced fresh punitive action by Israel, which froze the transfer of more than \$100 million in tax revenue collected for his cash-strapped government. The Israeli step was the second response to the vote last week at the U.N. General Assembly, which granted the Palestinians the status of a "non-member observer state." On Friday, Israel said it would build 3,000 homes in West Bank settlements and in East Jerusalem, and would advance controversial settlement plans near the city in an area deemed critical for the territorial contiguity of a future Palestinian state. Israeli Finance Minister Yuval Steinitz announced that he was halting the transfer of tax and customs revenues collected by Israel for the Palestinian Authority. A spokeswoman for Steinitz said that a monthly tax transfer of about \$120 million due to be made this week would not be carried out because of "the unilateral step taken by the Palestinians." The funds would be diverted to meet a debt of some \$200 million to the Israel Electric Corp., the spokeswoman said.

Headline: Hamas appeals for talks with EU diplomats

The Prime Minister of Gaza, Ismail Haniyeh, has appealed to the EU to take his political and militant group, Hamas, off its terrorist register. Speaking to a delegation of visiting MEPs and MPs from Poland, Portugal and the UK in Gaza on Sunday (2 December), he said: "It is time to remove the Palestinian resistance from the terrorist list. Hamas is a national liberation movement which operates only inside the borders of Palestine." "We would like you to send a message from under the rubble which you have seen here, that we are not terrorists," he added. His spokesman, Taher Nouno, told EUobserver: "We want a direct dialogue with European leaders so that they can hear from us, not just to hear about us."

Headline: Report: UK mulls recalling ambassador, halting trade with Israel

Israel's decision to approve 3,000 new homes on occupied territory drew sharp condemnation from European allies on Monday, with at least three governments summoning ambassadors to express their disapproval of an action they say undermines an already troubled peace process. The Israeli envoy to Paris was called to a meeting late Monday morning, according to a statement from the French foreign ministry spokesman, Philippe Lalliot. France, which was the first major European country to announce support for the Palestinian effort to win recognition at the U.N., also sent a letter to the Israeli government, calling the settlement decision "a considerable obstacle to the two-state solution." Britain and Sweden also summoned the Israeli ambassadors, and Germany said the decision would hurt Israel's ability to negotiate a long-term peace agreement. None of the European governments openly threatened any concrete measures to punish Israel.

Headline: Report: Israel requested Jordan's 'permission' to attack Syria chemical weapons sites

Israel has asked Jordan twice in the last two months for a green light to attack chemical weapons facilities in Syria, according to a report by journalist Jeffrey Goldberg of The Atlantic. Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu has sent representatives of the Mossad intelligence agency to Amman twice already, to coordinate the matter with the Jordanians and receive their "permission" for the operation,

Goldberg wrote. The Jordanians, however, responded negatively to the request and refused to grant their approval. American officials quoted in the article said the Jordanians told Israel the "time was not right" for such an action. Goldberg wrote further that while Israel could carry out an operation of the kind without Jordan's approval, they were worried about the repercussions it could spark.

Headline: Jordan urges Palestinian unity to build on UN upgrade

His Majesty King Abdullah on Sunday urged Palestinians to unify their front to build on their latest historic achievement after the UN upgraded Palestine's status to "non-member observer state". The King made the remarks during a meeting with Palestinian President Mahmoud Abbas in Amman, a Royal Court statement said. His Majesty congratulated Abbas on the UN General Assembly's vote, which upgraded Palestine's status. The resolution was adopted by a vote of 138 in favour to nine against with 41 abstentions by the 193-member assembly. The King said this was a strategically huge step to establish a sovereign Palestinian state that would enable the Palestinians to obtain their rights, praising Abbas and the Palestinian Authority for their efforts to achieve this cornerstone. The Monarch emphasised the importance of building on the resolution and investing in it to constantly promote the Palestinian cause. The two leaders agreed on continuing cooperation and discussions regarding future steps to ensure the peace process gains the momentum it deserves, and to renew negotiations to deal with all final status issues. His Majesty reiterated Jordan's position in supporting Palestine for a two-state solution within the 1967 borders.

Headline: Army ups security in north Lebanon over kidnapping threats

A young Lebanese man was injured in clashes between the Lebanese Armed Forces and Syrian gunmen near the border with Syria, the National News Agency reported on Monday. The victim, identified as 18-year-old Bashar Hassan Amoun, was admitted into Hermel Hospital after he sustained injuries in the clashes in the Beqaa Valley town of Mashari al-Qaa. On Sunday, the LAF said in a statement that one of its outposts came under fire from the Syrian side of the border in the Beqaa Valley.

Lebanon's Syrian border has experienced regular border violations, including shelling and gunfire as well as limited incursions by Syrian troops, while the country's political landscape is split between supporters of the Syrian regime represented by the March 8 alliance and Western-backed forces associated with the March 14 coalition.

Saudi Arabia

Headline: Saudi protesters stage anti-regime rally in Qatif

Protesters in Saudi Arabia have once again held a demonstration against the Al Saud regime in the country's oil-rich Eastern Province, Press TV reports. On Sunday, the demonstrators chanted anti-regime slogans in the Qatif region, situated about 418 kilometers (259 miles) east of the capital Riyadh, and called for the immediate release of senior cleric Sheikh Tawfiq al-Amer. The cleric has been behind bars since last year for criticizing the ruling Al Saud monarchy. Since February 2011, protesters have held demonstrations on an almost regular basis in Saudi Arabia, mainly in Qatif and Awamiyah in Eastern Province, primarily calling for the release of all political prisoners, freedom of expression and assembly, as well as an end to widespread discrimination.

Judges in Egypt have refused to oversee a vote on the country's new draft constitution, to be held in two weeks. The Judges' Club's decision follows a confrontation between Egypt's Supreme Constitutional Court and Islamist supporters of President Mohammed Morsi. The court said it was suspending its work after its members were prevented from ruling on the legitimacy of the body that drew up the constitution. Opposition groups called for protests against the referendum on Tuesday. They said Mr Morsi had broken a promise not to call a referendum without gaining a wide national consensus. "The National Salvation Front condemns the irresponsible act by the president of the republic in calling a referendum on an illegitimate constitution that is rejected by a large section of his people," an alliance of opposition groups said in a statement.

Headline: 'West worried by Syrian chemical site activity'

Headline: Syria moves chemical weapons, White House warns of crossing 'red line'

Western intelligence officials have noticed new worrying signs of activity at chemical weapons sites in Syria, *The New York Times* reported on Saturday. The Syrian regime is "doing some things that suggest they intend to use the weapons," one American intelligence official told the *Times*, adding, "It's not just moving stuff around. These are different kind of activities." The officials were unsure of

Syria's intentions regarding the work at the chemical sites, but said it is possible Damascus is preparing to use chemical weapons as a last-ditched effort to defeat rebels, according to the report. But the Syrians have yet to take the most crucial steps toward using their chemical weapons, or preparing them for firing in any way, the Times reported. Earlier this year, Prime Minister Binyamin Netanyahu said Israel would weigh military action if it suspects Syria's chemical weapons could fall into the hands of a terrorist organization.

Headline: Army bombards Damascus suburbs, NGO says

Headline: Air strike kills 12 in Syrian border town, activists say

The Syrian army bombarded southern districts of the capital and suburbs overnight as part of an assault aimed at driving rebels out of footholds around Damascus, a monitoring group said on Monday. The Syrian Observatory for Human Rights said artillery gunners targeted the districts of Hajar al-Aswad and Tadamun as well as the Palestinian refugee camp of Yarmuk in southern Damascus. The army also bombarded Yabrud to the north, Yalda to the south and the Eastern Ghouta towns of Douma, Harasta, Irbin and Haran al-Hawamid, in the area of the road linking Damascus to its international airport, it said. Forces loyal to President Bashar al-Assad have been trying to establish a secure perimeter around Damascus at all costs, turning the province into one of the main battlegrounds in the country's 20-month conflict.

Headline: Assad regime could fall "anytime," Arab League chief says

Headline: U.N. pulls nonessential international staff from Syria

Syrian President Bashar al-Assad's regime is in danger of collapse "anytime" as the opposition gains ground on the military and political fronts, Arab League chief Nabil al-Arabi told AFP on Monday. "That could happen anytime," the Secretary General said in an exclusive interview. "Now they are fighting in Damascus," he said, "[and after 20 months of violence], I think there will be something soon," he said. "Facts on the ground indicate very clearly now that the Syrian opposition is gaining, politically and militarily. Every day they are gaining something," Arabi said. He said a new coalition of Syrian opposition groups now based in Cairo was "moving ahead." The Arab League, which is also based in the Egyptian capital, last month recognized Syria's National Coalition as the "legitimate" representative of the Syrian opposition.

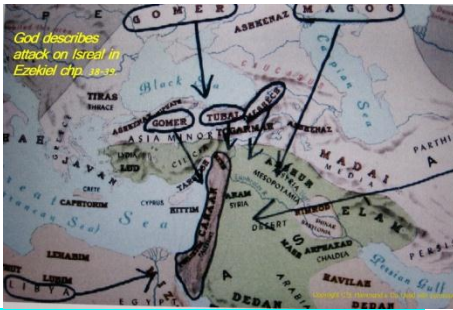

Headline: Iran hints direct talks with US are possible

Direct talks between Iran and the United States are possible, but any such breakthrough would have to be approved by the country's Supreme Leader Ayatollah Ali Khamenei, Iran's foreign minister said Monday. The comments by Ali Akbar Salehi were a first sign Tehran may seek diplomatic overtures with what it long considers a nemesis in Washington, as sanctions over Iran's contentious nuclear program stunt the country's economy. "Comprehensive political talks are within the powers of the exalted supreme leader," Salehi said in comments published by the official IRNA news agency.

Headline: Putin to discuss Syria, other issues in Turkey

Headline: Russia, Turkey agree to differ over Syria conflict

Russian President Vladimir Putin is scheduled to visit Turkey to discuss various issues including the Syrian conflict. Putin is to meet with Turkish Prime Minister Recep Tayyip Erdogan during his visit to Istanbul on Monday, amid disagreements between Moscow and Ankara over the 20-month Syrian conflict. "The negotiations are to touch upon a series of urgent international and regional issues including reconciliation in the Middle East, the situation in the Gaza Strip, the crisis in Syria, as well as cooperation," Putin's foreign policy aide Yury Ushakov said in a statement. Tensions between Turkey and Syria climaxed on October 10, when Turkish F-16 fighter jets intercepted a Syrian Airbus A320 en route from Russia to Syria over Turkish airspace and escorted it to Ankara's Esenboga Airport.

Headline: Al-Qaeda 'intensifying efforts to establish new base in Libya'

The leaders of Al-Qaeda in the Islamic Maghreb (AQIM), the North African offshoot of the mainstream organisation, are making a concerted effort to link up with Ansar al-Sharia. The CIA believes Ansar al-Sharia was behind the September 11 attack on the US consulate in which four people died, including US Ambassador Christopher Stevens. AQIM leaders are also attempting to establish ties with other Libyan Islamist groups in the hope of establishing an al-Qaeda fiefdom there similar to the one it has created in nearby Mali. Intelligence officials say that leaders of the AQIM movement have been travelling regularly to the desert town of Ghat in south-western Libya, close to the border with Niger. Their aim is to establish a foothold in Libya from which to launch attacks against Western targets, as well as gaining access to the large stockpiles of weapons – including Russian-made anti-aircraft missiles – that were looted by Libyan rebels during the fall of Colonel Muammar Gaddafi's regime at the end of last year.

Headline: Greece Offers 10 Billion-Euro Debt Buyback to Unlock Aid

Greece offered 10 billion euros (\$13 billion) to buy back bonds issued earlier this year as the bailed-out nation attempts to cut a debt load that may threaten future international aid. Greek bonds rallied after the so-called modified Dutch auction was announced today by the Athens-based Public Debt Management Agency. The prices offered for bonds maturing from 2023 to 2042 averaged 33.1 percent of face value, based on information in a statement from the debt agency today, higher than euro-area finance ministers indicated would be paid. The offer runs until 5 p.m. London time on Dec. 7. Success is crucial to releasing aid that’s been frozen since June. The offer was part of a package of measures approved by the finance ministers last week to cut the nation’s debt to 124 percent of gross domestic product in 2020 from a projected 190 percent in 2014. The 10 billion-euro buyback may enable Greece to retire about 30 billion euros of debt, Citigroup strategist Valentin Marinov wrote in a comment.

Headline: **Boehner Faces Line in the Sand in Fiscal Cliff Talks**

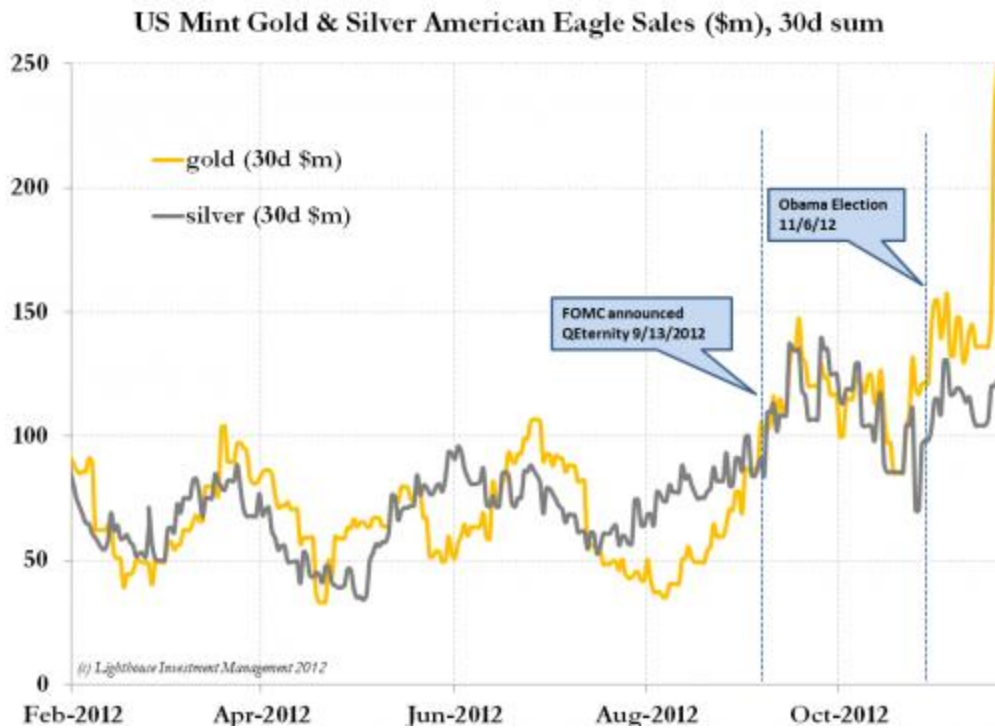
President Obama and his White House team appear to have drawn a line in the sand in talks with House Republicans on the "fiscal cliff." Tax rates on the wealthy are going up, the only question is how much? "Those rates are going to have to go up," Treasury Secretary Tim Geithner flatly stated on ABC's "This Week." "There's no responsible way we can govern this country at a time of enormous threat, and risk, and challenge ... with those low rates in place for future generations." But the president's plan, which Geithner delivered last week, has left the two sides far apart. In recounting his response today on "Fox News Sunday," House Speaker John Boehner said: "I was flabbergasted. I looked at him and said, 'You can't be serious.' "The president's idea of negotiation is: Roll over and do what I ask," Boehner added. The president has never asked for so much additional tax revenue. He wants another \$1.6 trillion over the next 10 years, including returning the tax rate on income above \$250,000 a year to 39.6 percent. Boehner is offering half that, \$800 billion.

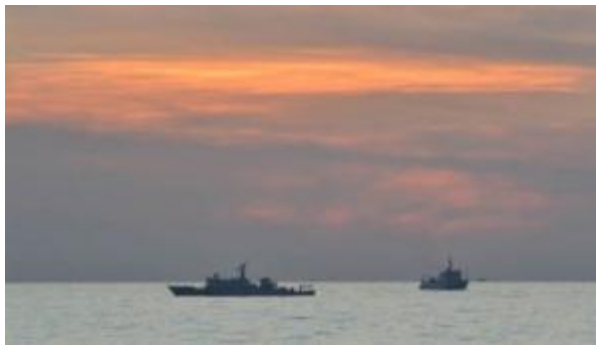

Headline: Vietnam Says China Must Avoid Trade Weapon in Maritime Spat

Vietnam said China should avoid using trade as a weapon in maritime disagreements after diplomatic tensions led to a slump in exports from Japan when Chinese consumers boycotted the goods of its Asian neighbor. “Economic force should not be applied in the case of settlement of territorial disputes,” which should be addressed through international law, Deputy Foreign Minister Pham Quang Vinh said in a Nov. 28 interview in Hanoi. He said he had “observed” Japan’s conflict with China. Japan reported last month that its exports to China tumbled 12 percent. China’s emergence as the largest export destination for markets from Japan to South Korea offers it a potential lever as frictions escalate over such claims as the Diaoyu, or Senkaku, islands in the East China Sea and the Spratlys in the South China Sea, which are estimated to hold energy reserves. Vietnamese officials plan to meet Dec. 12 with Southeast Asian counterparts to discuss ways of addressing conflicts with China.

Headline: Japan threatens to intercept North Korea's rocket

North Korea has begun installing a rocket at its Sohae launch pad ahead of a planned launch this month, South Korea's Yonhap news agency reports. The North's state news media say the launch is an attempt to put an observation satellite into space, between 10 and 22 December. It is expected to take scientists several days to assemble the three-stage rocket at the Sohae station. The US and its allies say it is a cover for long-range missile technology. Ambassadors from China, the US, Russia and Japan met South Korean officials in Seoul on Monday to discuss the situation. Korean Air is planning to reroute flights over the Yellow Sea to avoid possible collisions with rocket debris, according to the Associated Press. The airline could not be reached for comment.

Headline: Borno attacks: Nigeria 'militants' kill Christians

Suspected Islamist fighters have killed 10 Christians in an overnight machete and gun attack in Borno state in north-east Nigeria. Later, gunmen attacked government targets and churches near the border with Cameroon, killing five policemen. It is not yet clear who was behind the attacks. But the army suspects the Islamist Boko Haram group, which often targets security forces, government officials or Christians it views as infidels. Late on Saturday night, residents say a group of men went from house to house in a largely Christian area of the remote village of Chibok, before slitting the throats of 10

people. "Suspected Boko Haram came at night and set people's houses on fire before killing their victims," Nuhu Clark, a former councillor of the village who escaped the attack, told Reuters news agency. He said he counted 10 bodies.

Much tighter controls have already been introduced for anyone seeking access or photocopies of the Holy See's archives, dossiers and documents. The Papal Apartments, which include the living quarters of Pope Benedict XVI and the offices of his personal staff inside the Apostolic Palace, are totally off limits to anyone without strict authorisation. Slovenian priest, Mitja Leskovar, an anti-espionage expert nicknamed 'Monsignor 007', is in charge of implementing the new security procedures with the identity cards expected to be introduced from January 1.

Headline: Three earthquakes jolt eastern Taiwan

Three earthquakes shook Hualien in eastern Taiwan early Monday, with the strongest recorded at magnitude 5.1 on the Richter scale, but there were no reports of casualties or damage, according to the Central Weather Bureau (CWB). The magnitude 5.1 earthquake hit at 1:45 a.m., centered 7.5 kilometers southwest of the Hualien County Hall at a depth of 18.1 km, the CWB's Seismology Center said. The quake caused strong tremors but they did not last long, the center said. The Hualien County Fire Department said it has not received any reports of damage. A second earthquake, magnitude 2.8, struck at 2:14 a.m., with the epicenter 9 km west of the county hall at a depth of 11.7 km, the Seismology Center said. It was followed by a magnitude 4.7 temblor at 3:43 a.m., centered 8.5 km southwest of the county hall at a depth of 16.1 km.

Headline: M23 rebels threaten to take back Goma in DR Congo

The March 23 movement (M23) rebels have threatened to take back the Democratic Republic of Congo's eastern city of Goma, if the government does not agree to negotiate with them by Monday. "It pained us to withdraw from Goma after having lost men on the battlefield to conquer the city. But if it is the price for peace, we accept it," the Associated Press quoted Bertrand Bisimwa, the spokesman for M23's political branch, as saying on Sunday. "There was no external pressure. Friends of Congo have advised us to give negotiations a chance," Bisimwa stated, adding, "If negotiations have not started by tomorrow at 2 pm, 48 hours since our withdrawal ... we will take back the city ... We know that President Kabila is not trustworthy, but we want to give a chance for our friends to realize that too." Congolese President Joseph Kabila has not yet made it clear if his government is ready to negotiate with the M23.

The crisis in northern Mali could enter a new chapter this week. Malian officials are expected to meet with delegations from two of the armed groups in the north, while the U.N. Headline: Kuwait opposition wants dismissal of new parliament

Kuwait's opposition has said that it will keep holding anti-government protests until their demands, including the dismissal of the newly elected parliament, are met. "We will continue with our national and peaceful protests under the umbrella of the constitution to bring the downfall of the new parliament," opposition leader and former MP Faisal al-Muslim said on Sunday, AFP reported. In Saturday's election, the Kuwaiti opposition lost majority in the 50-seat parliament after it boycotted the polls, which reduced its representation from 36 to four. "We will use all peaceful and constitutional tools, including demonstrations and gatherings," said al-Muslim. The opposition has held many protests after the government announced six weeks ago that it was holding parliamentary elections on December 1, and announced that it would change the electoral law "to preserve national unity."

Headline: Police, textile workers clash in Bangladesh

Fresh clashes have erupted outside the Bangladeshi capital, Dhaka between police and garment workers protesting over the recent deaths of 121 people in the country's worst clothing factory inferno. Protests entered a second week on Monday when thousands of workers took to the streets of Ashulia, a manufacturing hub outside Dhaka, to demand better working conditions and safety in garment factories in the country. "There were around 10,000 workers. They barricaded a road at Ashulia and attacked some vehicles and factories," industrial police deputy director Moktar Ali said. He added that a false rumor about another deadly fire in a garment factory sparked the latest protests. Police used rubber bullets and tear gas to disperse the angry demonstrators.

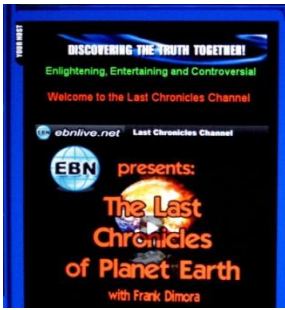

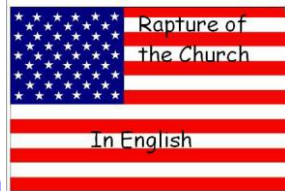
