Headline: Palestinian police struggling to contain violent demonstrations in Hebron

Palestinian mobs took to the streets Thursday after a female Israeli soldier shot and killed a young Palestinian man who had threatened one of her subordinates with what turned out to be a fake gun. The incident occurred on Wednesday night in the Judean town of Hebron. The Palestinian man came to the Israeli army checkpoint outside the Cave of the Patriarchs, and handed over his ID card as requested. The female officer at the center of the scandal went inside to run a background check, and after returning found the Arab choking one of her soldiers and holding a hand gun to his head. Acting instinctively, the officer said she looked for a clean shot that would avoid hitting the other soldier. When such a shot presented itself, she took it. Only in the ensuing investigation of the scene did army officials discover that the gun used by the Arab man was not a real firearm. Political and army officials defended the officer's actions, insisting that she could not have known the assailant's gun was fake, and certainly should not be expected to risk both her and the other soldier's lives to find out. Palestinian Authority Arabs rioted Thursday in Hevron, where they hurled rocks and bottles at Israeli soldiers. IDF troops responded with mob control methods that included the use of tear gas. There were no reports of serious injuries, according to local sources, who said that nearly a hundred protesters had attempted to storm the IDF troops. A damaging video of Israeli soldiers fleeing from rock-throwing terrorists has inspired an IDF review of the limitations being placed on the nation's troops. Several Israeli soldiers have charged that officers' concerns about media photos have recently forced them to retreat in the face of PA Arab mob attacks.

Headline: Mahmoud Abbas' duplicitous recognition of Israel Headline: Abbas slams Mashaal for not recognizing Israel'

Palestinian leader Mahmoud Abbas this week insisted that his government had already fulfilled its obligation to recognize Israel back in 1993. But a few problems with Abbas' position were immediately noted. Following meetings with the Turkish government in Ankara on Thursday, Abbas told reporters

(in English) that he does not agree with recent remarks by Hamas leader Khaled Mashaal rejecting recognition of Israel, "because we, in fact, recognized it in 1993." Abbas' went on to note that Mashaal and Hamas recognize Israel's existence, too, as they have signed on to Palestinian government documents that acknowledge a two-state solution. The Palestinian leader's words were meant to counteract harsh criticism from Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu over his failure earlier in the week to condemn the anti-Israel rhetoric coming from Hamas. But the duplicitous nature of Abbas' words was not lost on Israelis. First, Abbas cleverly continued to refuse to recognize Israel's right to exist, and especially its right to exist as a national homeland for the Jewish people in their ancient land. Without that level of recognition, Israel's leadership rightly argues that the stage remains set for future conflict.

Headline: Abbas: Hamas Seeks Peace, Even if its Boss Says Otherwise

In a speech given by Hamas top terrorist Khaled Mashaal in Gaza over the weekend, Mashaal said that Hamas would not rest until it had destroyed Israel completely, taking over all the land between "the river and the sea" and destroying the Jewish communities of Israel. Masha'al said that Hamas "would never recognize the state of Israel," and would continue to use terrorism until Israel was destroyed. Abbas said that technically, Mashaal had already recognized Israel. "I do not agree with Masha'al about not recognizing Israel, because we have already done so in 1993." Hamas and Fatah, he said, had already agreed to accept Oslo, "and this agreement was ratified by Mashaal. "There are a number of agreements between Hamas and Fatah which talk about the two-state solution," Abbas added. "Mashaal stands behind these agreements," despite his very clear comments in Gaza that Hamas intended to continue its terror campaign until Israel was destroyed.

Headline: Look who's urging Obama to talk with Hamas

The Egyptian government is leading diplomacy with the U.S. and European Union aimed at opening official Western dialogue with Hamas, according to informed Middle Eastern security officials. The officials said Muslim Brotherhood-dominated Egypt is pushing for the continued flow of international aid in the event of a future Hamas-led Palestinian government. Hamas, an offshoot of the Muslim Brotherhood, is expected to do well in any upcoming Palestinian elections. There is also a drive by Egypt, Turkey and Qatar to wean Hamas entirely off of Iranian money to help rid the Gaza Strip of Shiite Islamic influence, the officials said. Hamas believes distancing itself more from Iran could prompt a crisis with the Iranian-backed Islamic Jihad group in Gaza, added the officials.

In sign of strengthening ties, Iranian representatives to visit Gaza Headline:

An Iranian delegation will make an official visit to Gaza later this month, in a sign of the strong ties between Tehran and the Palestinian enclave. The visit will come a little over a month after the end of Gaza's eight-day mini war with Israel, in which the Hamas-ruled strip used Iranian supplied weapons and technology to fire 1,500 rockets at Israel's south and heartland. The Iranian representatives will tour the Strip and distribute food and medical supplies to locals who were injured during operation Pillar of Defense. According to Palestinian News Agency Ma'an, the delegation is expected to arrive at the el-Arish port in the Sinai Peninsula by boat and will enter Gaza via the Rafah Border Crossing. Egyptian security officials confirmed Wednesday that they have authorized the visit.

Headline: King discusses Mideast, Syria with UK officials, lawmakers Headline: Jordan-EU discussions on free movement launched

His Majesty King Abdullah on Wednesday said the Arab Spring presented an opportunity for Jordan to press ahead with reforms and develop various sectors, according to a Royal Court statement. During a meeting with representatives of the Houses of Commons and Lords at the British parliament in London, the King said the steps taken by the Kingdom pave the way for the development of political and partisan life, in addition to engaging the people in the decision-making process. His Majesty stressed the importance of the youths' role in the reform process, and engaging them in political action and the upcoming parliamentary elections, slated for January 23. The King said that he envisions institutionalised partisan work, so that it is based on clear programmes and processes that address daily life issues and challenges faced by the people, including education, health and unemployment. Discussions also covered the Middle East peace process, and prospects of reaching a lasting and just peace based on the two-state solution. The King said Jordan will continue to work with the UK, the US and other international and regional powers to bring both the Israelis and the Palestinians back to the negotiating table.

Headline: Egypt Islamist Coalition to hold pro-Morsi, pro-constitution Friday demo

Egypt's Islamist Coalition on Thursday announced plans to stage a million-man rally at the Rabaa Al-Adawiya Mosque in Cairo's Madinet Nasr district on Friday in support of President Mohamed Morsi's "democratic legitimacy" and Egypt's draft constitution. In a Thursday statement, Gamaa Islamiya, one of the coalition's member groups, declared that it would participate in the rally, both to voice support for President Morsi and call for a 'yes' vote in an upcoming constitutional referendum. According to Muslim Brotherhood Secretary-General Mahmoud Hussein, Friday's rally will begin at 10am in the public square outside the landmark mosque. Egypt is currently divided between Islamist parties and groups that support the draft constitution and liberal, leftist and nationalist parties and movements that are calling for a 'no' vote in Saturday's poll.



Headline: Triple blasts target Syria's Interior Ministry, casualties reported

Sixteen people were killed and more that 25 wounded, including women and children, in a car bomb in Qatana, a town 25 kilometres (15 miles) southwest of Damascus, Lebanon's al-Manar television channel said on Thursday. Qatana is part of a string of outlying suburbs and towns where President Bashar al-Assad's forces have been trying to push back rebels. The attack follows three bombs which exploded at the Interior Ministry on Wednesday evening, killing five.

Headline: Assad fires Scuds to stop Al Qaeda arm seizing chemical arms at Al Safira By the blacklisting Tuesday, Dec. 11, of the Jabhat al-Nusra group fighting in Syrian rebel ranks as "a foreign terrorist organization" and affiliate of al Qaeda in Iraq, Washington faces four quandaries:

- 1. The 10,000 fighters of this al Qaeda affiliate are the best-trained and most professional component of the Syrian rebel front;.
- 2. Jabhat al-Nusra fields 3,000 fighters out of the mostly Free Syrian Army's 14,000 rebels fighting in and around Aleppo. They also constitute the assault force's spearhead.
- 3. The Islamists are at the sharp front edge of the rebel force battling for control of the Syrian army's biggest chemical weapons store at Al Safira, near Aleppo. Thursday morning, Dec. 12, they were just a kilometer from the base's northwestern perimeter fence and advancing fast. By week's end, Jabhat al-Nusra jihadis may have smashed into the base and seized control of the chemical stocks and Scud D planes standing there armed with chemical warheads. The imminence of this peril forced Bashar Assad's hand into sending Scud jets against rebel-held areas in an effort to stop their advance on the base.
- 4. This al Qaeda affiliate is also better armed and equipped than any other Syrian rebel force, thanks to the generous financial and logistical aid laid on by Persian Gulf sources, especially in Saudi Arabia, Qatar and Kuwait.

The difficulty here is that those three Gulf Arab stats are also American allies in the war against Assad and the most important contributors to the US-sponsored Friends of Syria, a forum which met in Marrakesh Wednesday and formally recognized the umbrella Syrian opposition coalition of exiled groups as the legitimate government of Syria.

The Cuban foreign minister has reaffirmed Havana's determination to support Tehran's nuclear energy program and strengthen mutual cooperation to counter Western embargos. At a meeting with Ali Asghar Khaji, the Iranian deputy foreign minister for Europe and Americas, in the Cuban capital city of Havana on Thursday, Bruno Eduardo Rodriguez Parrilla, hailed Iran-Cuba ties as "strategic" and voiced his country's support for the Islamic Republic's nuclear energy program. He expressed Havana's preparedness to enhance bilateral ties with Tehran in high technology and exchange experience to counter the effects of the "plots and sanctions [imposed on both countries] by the common enemy."

Headline: Iraq: Baghdad, Kurds agree to ease tensions

Iraq's president says the central government and Kurdish leaders have reached a deal to ease a military standoff that began last month. A statement issued by President Jalal Talabani's office Thursday says the accord between leaders in Baghdad and the self-rule Kurdish region would eventually lead to the withdrawal of both sides' military forces from disputed northern areas. Under the plan, local residents would oversee their own security. The deal appears to firm up a preliminary agreement announced by Iraqi Prime Minister Nouri al-Maliki last week. Talabani gave no timetable for the deal to be implemented. Tensions between Baghdad and the Kurds spiked following a decision by al-Maliki to form a new military command to oversee security forces bordering the self-ruled Kurdish region. Headline: Turkish President Gül calls on US to recognize Palestine

President Abdullah Gül has called on countries who opposed the upgrade of Palestine's status at the U.N. General Assembly to review their positions, in an explicit reference to the United States, one of nine countries who voted against Palestine's non-member state position during the U.N. vote. Gül's call came as Palestinian President Mahmoud Abbas paid his first visit abroad to Turkey following the historic U.N. vote. "We hope that those who abstained will change their current positions in a short time and lend their support to Palestine. I have no doubt that those countries who voted against [upgrading Palestine's status] will review their decisions and understand that they cannot maintain their position continuously," Gül told reporters during a joint press conference with Palestinian President Mahmoud Abbas. He particularly stressed the large majority that had voted to upgrade Palestine's status at the U.N. from "observer entity" to "non-member state."

Headline: Thousands protest as mass Turkey coup plot trial nears end

Thousands of people protested Thursday outside a Turkish prison complex where the mass trial of almost 300 people accused of plotting to overthrow the Islamist-rooted government of Prime Minister Recep Tayyip Erdogan entered its closing stages. Police used tear gas to prevent large crowds from bursting into the heavily-guarded Silivri compound near Istanbul where 275 defendants including former Military Chief Ilker Basbug have been on trial for four years in the so-called Ergenekon case. "We are the soldiers of Ataturk!" the protesters chanted, referring to the founder of secular Turkey, Mustafa Kemal Ataturk, whose legacy has been fiercely defended by the staunchly secular army in the NATO member state.

Headline: Russia preparing for possible defeat of Assad government

Headline: Syrian regime 'approaching collapse': NATO head

Syrian rebels are gaining ground and might win, Russia's deputy foreign minister said on Thursday, in the starkest such admission from a major ally of President Bashar al-Assad. "One must look the facts in the face," Russia's state-run RIA quoted Mikhail Bogdanov as saying. "Unfortunately, the victory of the Syrian opposition cannot be ruled out." Bogdanov, who is Kremlin's special envoy for Middle East affairs, said the Syrian government was "losing control of more and more territory" and that Moscow was preparing plans to evacuate Russian citizens if necessary. Advancing rebels now hold an almost continuous arc of territory from the east to the southeast of Damascus, despite fierce army bombardments designed to drive them back.

Headline: Russian opposition refused permission to protest in Moscow

Russia refused on Thursday to register a demonstration against President Vladimir Putin planned for Saturday and said some earlier protests were orchestrated by Georgia. State TV channel Rossiya 24 aired what it said were recordings of talks between Georgian politician Givi Targamadze and Russian opposition activists that the federal Investigative Committee said proved Targamadze was involved in past protests. "This material contains evidence confirming not only the financing of the Russian opposition by Givi Targamadze but also his clear role in the organization of mass riots," said Vladimir Markin, spokesman for the committee that answers only to Putin. Russia often accuses the opposition of taking help from abroad and activists say the latest allegations are part of a crackdown against criticism of Putin, who started his third presidential term in May. Headline: Sudan warns of fresh conflict with South Sudan over Abyei status

Sudanese officials suspect Israel of using GPS-tagged vultures as spy drones, according to the Egyptian media. Cairo daily El Balad reported on Monday, in a story followed up by Israeli news site Haaretz and UK daily The Telegraph, that Sudan's military had "captured" one such vulture at the beginning of December in the country's Darfur region. The bird was equipped with a solar-powered GPS device that could reportedly transmit images by satellite. Sudanese officials, according to El Balad, suspect the scavenging bird of being an Israeli spy. The vital clue was a leg band marked "Israel Nature Service" and "Hebrew University, Jerusalem." "This means the equipment installed on the vulture was mounted on it in its home country," according to El Balad.

Headline: Meanwhile in Africa: A secret nuclear facility in Algeria and a looming jihadist threat in Mali

The Army's arrest and forced resignation of Malian Prime Minister Cheikh Modibo Diarra (announced in a 4.00 a.m. televised broadcast from Bamako on Tuesday, Dec. 11) and the appointment by President Amadou Toumani Touré of a new prime minister — former Administrator of the Presidential Palace Django Sissoko — did nothing to allay fears that the Republic of Mali was slipping further into dysfunction, without addressing the growing consolidation of control by jihadist groups in the country's

north. But regional actors are also inhibiting a resolution of the situation under the guidance of the United Nations or the African Union. The Algerian government, in particular, was quietly — and seemingly successfully — pressuring the U.S. to avoid a significant military intervention into the dispute, ostensibly to avoid a costly war in the region. The primary reason for Algiers' strenuous efforts to play down the crisis, however, according to very senior GIS/Defense & Foreign Affairs sources in Algiers, was that the Government of President Abdelaziz Bouteflika wanted to avoid any prospect of foreign interest in Algeria's secret nuclear weapons program, which is located near Algeria's southern border with Mali.

Headline: Four Libyan policemen injured in Benghazi attack

A bomb explosion near a police station in the eastern Libyan city of Benghazi has wounded four policemen, security sources say. "The blast coincided with a traffic police vehicle passing in front of Al-Fwayhat station," police officer Adel Jibril said on Wednesday, adding that two of the injured were in critical condition. The blast was caused by a suitcase laden with explosives, according to preliminary investigations carried out by the police. "We still do not know if the bomb was placed in front of the station or in the car," Jibril said. Security forces have been sent to the site of the bombing to scan the area for any other explosives.

Headline: Morocco protest movement activists "not sacred," PM says

Moroccan Prime Minister Abdelilah Benkirane said on Thursday that activists belonging to the 20 February protest movement, more than 70 of whom have been jailed according to rights groups, were "not sacred." At a news conference with French Prime Minister Jean-Marc Ayrault, Benkirane was asked about police arresting members of the movement, who held mass protests last year calling for wide-ranging reform, as Arab Spring revolts shook the region. "The February 20 movement, do you remember how many young people took to the streets? Did we arrest all of them? No. The February 20 youths are not going to become sacred people," the Moroccan premiere said. Protesters have continued this year, albeit on a smaller scale, with police sometimes employing violence to disperse them and international rights groups raising concerns about the detention and imprisonment of activists.

EU finance ministers have agreed a landmark deal establishing the European Central Bank (ECB) as the single supervisor of the European banking sector, beginning in 2014. The agreement reached in the early hours of Thursday morning (13 December) is a significant breakthrough as the EU bids to break the link between indebted banks and sovereign bonds nearly five years after the start of the

financial crisis. It also makes good on an EU leaders' promise to agree on the supervisory framework before the end of 2012. Ministers will now switch their attention in 2013 to harmonising a deposit guarantee scheme and a resolution mechanism to wind up banks. Speaking at a press conference following the end of the talks, internal market commissioner Michel Barnier told reporters that ministers had taken "a big first step for banking union," adding that "the ECB will play the pivotal role, there's no ambiguity about that."

A five-year joint U.S.-Philippine military exercise plan would be approved this week, he added. The size of the increase in the U.S. military assets in the Philippines, a former U.S. colony, was unclear.

The Army's arrest and forced resignation of Malian Prime Minister Cheikh Modibo Diarra (announced in a 4.00 a.m. televised broadcast from Bamako on Tuesday, Dec. 11) and the appointment by President Amadou Toumani Touré of a new prime minister — former Administrator of the Presidential Palace Django Sissoko — did nothing to allay fears that the Republic of Mali was slipping further into dysfunction, without addressing the growing consolidation of control by jihadist groups in the country's north. The Algerian government, in particular, was quietly — and seemingly successfully — pressuring the U.S. to avoid a significant military intervention into the dispute, ostensibly to avoid a costly war in the region. The primary reason for Algiers' strenuous efforts to play down the crisis, however, according to very senior GIS/Defense & Foreign Affairs sources in Algiers, was that the Government of President Abdelaziz Bouteflika wanted to avoid any prospect of foreign interest in Algeria's secret nuclear weapons program, which is located near Algeria's southern border with Mali.




