




Headline: Muslims Riot, Jews Banned from Temple Mount

Jews have been barred from the Temple Mount in Jerusalem until Sunday, the last day of Hannukah. The Temple Mount is the holiest site on earth according to Jewish tradition. The ban is aimed at preventing a Muslim riot at the site. Riots are thought to be particularly likely following Friday prayers. It follows riots and terror attacks in Judea and Samaria. Tensions were particularly high following two incidents in which soldiers shot Arab attackers in Hevron. Jewish organizations dedicated to Temple Mount activism expressed upset at the police ban. "The police treat the Temple Mount like a Muslim site, and open it to others only when necessary for tourism, at times and on days that suit tourists," activists accused.

Headline: Thousands of Palestinians march on Hebron checkpoint

Headline: Thousands rally in Ramallah, Tulkarem

Some 3,000 Palestinian protesters marched from the city hall of the West Bank city of Hebron toward an Israeli checkpoint on Friday, as part of demonstrations throughout the territory marking the 25th anniversary of the Hamas terrorist organization. IDF and Border Police forces stationed near the checkpoint, which guards the city's Jewish neighborhoods, fired tear gas canisters to disperse the protesters after they began throwing rocks at one of the Jewish-owned homes. In other parts of the West Bank, Palestinian demonstrators attacked Israeli targets. No injuries were reported. In Qalandiya, north of Jerusalem, and in the village of Bil'in, known for its peaceful weekly protests, Palestinians threw stones at Israeli security forces. In Kufr Qaddoum, dozens of protesters threw stones and set tires alight. And in Maaleh Shomron, a West Bank settlement about 10 kilometers east of Kfar Saba, and outside Ramallah, Israeli vehicles were pelted with rocks.

Headline: Palestinians to decide soon which UN bodies to join

The Palestinians will shortly decide which international organizations to join in the wake of their new-found UN status, including courts likely to act against Israel, negotiator Mohammed Shtayeh said. "We have put together a legal team to study to which organization we shall apply first and what are the procedures of accession and what are the benefits and the consequences of accession into any

of these," he said, giving as examples the World Trade Organization, the International Monetary Fund and the World Bank. "In two weeks' time we will be in a position to decide where and when we shall apply to this or that organization." On November 29, the Palestinians won recognition as a non-member state at the United Nations, a historic move which could potentially allow them to take grievances against Israeli occupation to the International Criminal Court or the International Court of Justice.

Headline: Abbas mulls forming confederation with Jordan

Palestinian Authority officials confirmed Thursday that they were studying the possibility of establishing a confederation with Jordan, but stressed that this would take place only after the creation of an independent Palestinian state within the pre-1967 lines. The officials were commenting on a report in the London-based *Al-Quds al- Arabi* newspaper that claimed that PA President Mahmoud Abbas had asked senior Fatah leaders to prepare for the formation of a confederation between a Palestinian state and Jordan. The newspaper said that Abbas has instructed his advisors to provide him with "detailed strategic reports about the best way to conduct negotiations with Jordan about reviving the confederation plan."

Headline: Muslim Brotherhood seen fueling unrest against Jordan's king

The West expects increasing Islamist unrest in Jordan. A leading Western consultant has warned that parliamentary elections in Jordan could be marred by Islamist unrest. Maplecroft said the Muslim Brotherhood was expected to use the elections to mobilize massive protests against King Abdullah. "It is likely that Jordan's Islamist opposition will move to exploit the unrest generated by the fuel subsidy cuts, further undermining the authority of the authorities," Maplecroft said. The British risk analyst discounted the prospect that Jordan would quell the protests against the removal of fuel

subsidies. Maplecroft said the opposition was becoming bolder and could galvanize the reform movement. "Direct criticism of King Abdullah, strike actions and violence indicates potential for widespread unrest in coming weeks," Maplecroft said.

Lebanon

Headline: Lebanon judiciary decides legality of Syria warrants

Lebanon's interior minister said that the country's judiciary, and not its security forces, had the competency to rule whether the arrest warrants issued by the Syrian authorities against Lebanese MPs were legal or not. "The extent of the legality of the arrest warrant is not the responsibility of the security forces... The judiciary ultimately decides whether they are legal or not," Marwan Charbel said in an interview with NOW. "We do not study the case of lifting the parliamentary immunity off MPs, but it is rather the judiciary that does." Meanwhile, Future bloc MP Samir al-Jisr told NOW said that the Syrian authorities' decision was a reaction to the request made by a Lebanese judge for two Syrian security officials to be questioned in Lebanon. "Everybody knows that this is a reaction to the arrest warrants issued by the military public prosecution in the case of Mamluk-Samaha."

Egypt

Headline: Rival protests held as Egypt referendum due

Rival sides in Egypt's political crisis are staging rallies in Cairo a day before the first round of voting begins on a contentious draft constitution. The National Salvation Front of opposition groups has organised demonstrations at the presidential palace and in Cairo's Tahrir Square on Friday, after deciding to call on followers to vote "no" in the referendum scheduled for December 15 and 22. Al Jazeera's Rory Challands, reporting from Cairo, said the opposition fears the constitution "gives too much emphasis on Islamic law ... They would like to see more emphasis given on rights and freedoms". In particular, those planning to vote against the draft constitution want additional rights for workers and women. The Coalition of Islamist Forces is describing a vote in favour of the draft as "yes" for Islam and has staged its own rally at Nasr City in the capital following mid-day prayers. Rallies were also held in other cities, and in Alexandria, Egypt's second city, those demonstratons turned violent, resulting in clashes between the two sides.

Headline: Bomb attack kills 8 in Jdaidet Artouz, near Damascus

At least eight people, mostly women and children, have been killed in a bomb attack near the Syrian capital city of Damascus, the state media report. The bombing was carried out in the town of Jdaidet

Artouz on Thursday. Reports said nearly two dozen civilians were killed in two separate explosions carried out by the foreign-sponsored militants near Damascus on the same day. Another deadly car bombing rocked the city of Qatana, about 26 kilometers (16 miles) southwest of Damascus, killing at least 16 people, including seven children, and injuring scores of others.

Headline: EU: All options are on the table to support Syrian opposition

All options are on the table to support the Syrian opposition fighting President Bashar Assad, European Union leaders said on Friday, raising the possibility that non-lethal military equipment or even arms could eventually be supplied. In their strongest statement of support for the Syrian opposition since the uprising began more than 20 months ago, EU leaders instructed their foreign ministers to assess all possibilities to increase the pressure on Assad. Britain's David Cameron pushed for an early review of the arms embargo against Syria to potentially open the way to supply equipment to the rebels in the coming months, but Germany and others were more reluctant and blocked any quick move. There was widespread agreement, however, that whatever action can be taken under current legislation should be pursued, and the arms embargo would still be reviewed at a later stage.

Headline: China calls for new talks between Iran, G6

The lead inspector of the U.N. nuclear watchdog agency said Friday a deal with Iran on its nuclear program likely will be struck in January. The agreement would grant inspectors access to a military facility where testing of nuclear material is suspected, CNN reported. "We have agreed to meet again on 16 January next year where we expect to finalize the structured approach and start implementing it then shortly after that," International Atomic Energy Agency lead inspector Herman Nackaerts said in Vienna, where the IAEA is based. The announcement came after the IAEA ended one-day talks in Iran on the country's nuclear program, suspected by the United States and other Western nations of developing nuclear weapons, a charge Iran repeatedly denies.

Headline: Pentagon to send Patriot missiles, 400 troops to Turkey to defend against Syria

Headline: U.S. troops to be deployed to Turkey


The U.S. will send two batteries of Patriot missiles and 400 troops to Turkey as part of a NATO force meant to protect Turkish territory from potential Syrian missile attack, the Pentagon said Friday.

Defense Secretary Leon Panetta signed a deployment order en route to Turkey from Afghanistan. It calls for 400 U.S. soldiers to operate two batteries of Patriots at undisclosed locations in Turkey, Pentagon press secretary George Little told reporters flying with Panetta. NATO foreign ministers endorsed Turkey's request for the Patriots on Nov. 30. Germany and the Netherlands have already agreed to provide two batteries of the U.S.-built defense systems and send up to 400 German and 360 Dutch troops to man them, bringing the total number of Patriot batteries to be sent to Turkey to six. The German Parliament is expected to formally agree to the deployment on Friday.

Headline: [Russia backtracks on statement about Assad's fall](#)

Russia issued a clumsy denial Friday of a statement from its point man on Syria, who said a day earlier that Syrian President Bashar Assad is losing control of the country. The Foreign Ministry insisted it is not changing its stance on the embattled Syrian regime. Russia's explanation - that the official was characterizing the opinion of the Syrian opposition rather than stating Russia's position - did not jibe with the words of Deputy Foreign Minister Mikhail Bogdanov, who was quoted by all three leading Russian news agencies as saying Thursday: "there is a trend for the government to progressively lose control over an increasing part of the territory," and adding that "an opposition victory can't be excluded." The Foreign Ministry insisted in a statement Friday that Bogdanov was referring only to the claims of the "Syrian opposition and its foreign sponsors forecasting their quick victory over the regime in Damascus."




Headline: US and UK refuse to sign UN's communications treaty

The US, Canada, Australia and UK have refused to sign an international communications treaty at a conference in Dubai. The countries had objected to calls for all states to have equal rights to the governance of the internet. But the breaking point was the addition of text relating to "human rights". It marks a setback for the UN's International Telecommunication Union (ITU) which had said it was sure it could deliver consensus.

EU leaders meeting Thursday (13 December) in Brussels have agreed to take further steps toward banking union including the political and legal minefield of common rules on winding up ailing banks while making sure the tax payer does not foot the bill. Text agreed after the lengthy meeting says the European Commission should "in the course of 2013" make a proposal for a single resolution mechanism for all member states that are part of the newly-agreed bank supervisory system. It also proposes a tight timetable for agreement suggesting that MEPs and member states treat the matter as a "priority" with the "intention of adopting it during the current parliamentary cycle." Parliament breaks up for the European elections in Spring 2014.

Headline: Eurozone faces deeper recession in fourth quarter of 2012

The Italian central bank says the country's public debt has risen to an all-time high of over two trillion euros as the eurozone struggles to overcome a deepening financial crisis. According to a report issued by the bank on Friday, Italy's public debt in October rose to 2.015 trillion euros (USD 2.64 trillion) from 1.995 trillion euros in September. The figure shows a 3.7 percent rise compared to January this year. There are also growing concerns that the high public debt could lead to more unemployment in a country already mired in recession.

Headline: China Defends Flight Over Disputed Islands

Headline: China submits oceanic claims to United Nations

China has defended the flight of a government plane in disputed airspace near contested islands in the East China Sea, an incident that provoked a diplomatic dispute with Japan. Chinese Foreign Ministry spokesman Hong Lei said Friday Japanese aircraft and ships have entered waters around the islands since September. "The Foreign Ministry has demanded many times that the Japanese side cease their illegal activities in territorial aerospace and waters of the Diaoyu Islands, including withdrawing their aircraft," Hong Lei stated. "The Japanese have not responded. China's maritime surveillance plane protecting China's territorial sovereignty is totally normal." On Thursday, a Chinese surveillance plane was spotted near the disputed islands, prompting Japan to dispatch eight F-15 fighter jets to the area. Japan also lodged an official protest and summoned China's ambassador in Tokyo.

Headline: North Korea stages rally to celebrate young leader's rocket launch

A triumphant North Korea staged a mass rally of soldiers and civilians Friday to glorify the country's young ruler, who took a big gamble this week in sending a satellite into orbit in defiance of international warnings. Wednesday's rocket launch came just eight months after a similar attempt ended in an embarrassing public failure, and just under a year after Kim Jong Un inherited power following his father's death. The surprising success of the launch may have earned Kim global condemnation, but at home, the gamble paid off, at least in the short term. To his people, it made the 20-something Kim appear powerful, capable and determined in the face of foreign adversaries.

Headline: Russia developing new long range ballistic missile

Russia is developing a new intercontinental ballistic missile, the military announced on Friday, in an apparent attempt to remind the United States of Moscow's rocket capacities. Revealing the existence of the project for the first time, rocket forces commander General Sergei Karakayev said that several

test launches of prototypes had already taken place and the work was on the "right path", Russian state media said.

Headline: Multiple deaths reported in shooting at Conn. school

Multiple people have been killed in a shooting at Sandy Hook Elementary School, according to The Hartford Courant, including the gunman. Some of the shooting victims are children, but it is still unclear if they are among the dead. An official who spoke on condition of anonymity because the investigation is still under way told the Associated Press the gunman apparently had two guns. The school district remains on lockdown as police investigate the shootings. There are unconfirmed reports of two shooters, according to the paper. Some students were reportedly being treated for trauma. A dispatcher at the Newtown Volunteer Ambulance Corps said a teacher has been shot in the foot and taken to Danbury Hospital, but it's unclear if that's the only injury. One child was carried from the school by a police officer, according to The Newtown Bee, apparently seriously wounded. The school superintendent's office says the district has locked down schools as a preventive measure to ensure the safety of students and staff. State police spokesman Lt. Paul Vance says they have a number of personnel on the scene to assist. The Courant reported that police said a shooter was in the main office of the school shortly after 9:40 a.m.

A knife-wielding man slashed 22 children and an adult at an elementary school in central China on Friday, state media reported, the latest in a series of attacks on schoolchildren in the country. The man attacked the children at the gate of a school in Chempeng village in Henan province, the Xinhua news agency reported. Police arrested a 36-year-old man, identified as villager Min Yingjun, Xinhua said. It did not give further details of the extent of the injuries.

Headline: 6.3 earthquake strikes off Southern California coast

A series of earthquakes, the largest being a magnitude 6.3, struck off the Southern California coast early Friday morning. The quake, with a preliminary magnitude of 6.4, was recorded at 2:36 a.m. (1036 GMT) Friday, 163 miles (262 kilometers) south southwest of the California city of Avalon and 167 miles west southwest of Rosarito, Mexico. The USGS later revised the earthquake as a 6.3 magnitude.

Fort Worth experienced another tremor today. The U.S. Geological Survey confirms a 2.6 magnitude earthquake shook the ground near Burleson, Texas at about 8:23 p.m. Wednesday night. The earthquake reached a depth of 8.1 miles and was located about three miles away from Burleson. No damage was reported. Burleson is a southern suburb of Fort Worth.

Headline: Category 3 Cyclone Evan leaves trail of death in Samoa and heads to Fiji

Category 3 Tropical Cyclone Evan is finally done pounding Samoa and American Samoa, after spending two days meandering over the islands. Evan made landfall on the north shore of Samoa near the capital of Apia on Thursday as a Category 1 cyclone with 90 mph winds, and intensified into a Category 3 storm with 115 mph winds after the eye wandered back offshore late Thursday. Media reports indicate that Evan has killed four and brought heavy damage to Samoa. "Power is off for the whole country... Tanugamanono power plant is completely destroyed and we might not have power for at least two weeks," the Disaster Management Office (DMO) said in a statement. Satellite loops show a well-organized storm with plenty of intense heavy thunderstorm activity. The storm will be a region with light wind shear of 10 – 15 knots and very warm ocean waters that extend to great depth, and could intensify into a Category 4 cyclone by Saturday, as it passes through the Wallis and Futuna Islands.

Headline: **Car bomb kills three in Somali capital: police**

A car bomb in the Somali capital killed three people and wounded several others in the latest attack in war-ravaged Mogadishu, police said Friday. "The car exploded while the driver was moving in it... three people were killed," said police officer Aden Mohammed, adding it was not clear if the driver had been targeted. "We are still investigating the blast." No group immediately claimed responsibility for the explosion, but the Al-Qaeda linked Shebab insurgents have conducted a series of guerrilla

style attacks in the capital since pulling out of fixed positions there last year. The insurgents have vowed to topple President Hassan Sheikh Mohamud, who took office in September after being chosen by the country's new parliament, bringing an end to eight years of transitional rule.

Tens of thousands of people in Bahrain have staged a pro-reform demonstration in the capital city, Manama, despite a ban imposed by the Al Khalifa regime on protests. The demonstrators took to the streets on Friday, chanting slogans and demanding freedom and reforms. There have been no reports yet on possible scuffles between protesters and police forces. However, similar rallies have turned violent in the past, with police using force to disperse protesters. Opposition rallies have continued in Bahrain in defiance of a government ban on public gatherings. The government's harsh crackdown on demonstrations has also failed to keep protesters off the streets.




