Headline: US calls on Israel, Palestinians to 'make a fresh start' and rekindle peace talks

The United States on Wednesday urged Israel and the Palestinian Authority to resume direct talks in 2013 and move toward peace. "As we turn the calendar to 2013... now is the time for leaders on both sides to display real leadership, to focus on the work that's necessary to return to direct negotiations," State Department spokeswoman Victoria Nuland was quoted by *AFP* as having said. The U.S. urged "both sides to clearly demonstrate that they are serious about achieving two states living side by side in peace and security," she said, calling on both sides to halt any "counter-productive unilateral actions." Nuland stressed that with President Barack Obama starting his second White House term this month and upcoming elections in Israel, the two sides are heading into a particularly important period.

Headline: Hamas could oust Abbas from West Bank: Netanyahu

Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu said on Tuesday that Hamas could wrest the West Bank from the rule of Palestinian president Mahmoud Abbas, just as it did in the Gaza Strip in 2007.

"Everyone knows that Hamas could take over the Palestinian Authority", Netanyahu's office quoted him as telling members of a Jewish bible study circle meeting at his Jerusalem residence. "It could happen after an (Israeli-Palestinian peace) agreement, it could happen before an agreement, like it happened in Gaza," he said.

He revealed this opinion three weeks before a general election in which he will seek to boost his support amongst religious-nationalist settlers and their backers. "Therefore, as opposed to the voices that I have heard recently urging me to run forward, make concessions, withdraw, I think that the diplomatic process must be managed responsibly and sagaciously and not in undue haste," he said in an apparent retort to recent comments from dovish President Shimon Peres.

Headline: Israel completes 'almost hermetic' Egyptian border fence

Israel has reported the completion of its security barrier along the border with Egypt. Officials said the Israeli Defense Ministry oversaw the construction of 230 kilometers of an electronic fence and barrier along the Egyptian border. They said the project took two years and cost nearly \$500 million in an attempt to block insurgents and African migrants. "The last 12-kilometer section of the fence in the mountainous Eilat area is due to be completed in about three months," the Defense Ministry said. On Jan. 2, Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu attended a ceremony that marked the completion of the Egyptian border fence. Netanyahu said the fence, completed in half the time allotted, reduced the infiltration of migrants from Egypt to almost nil.

Headline: Clashes explode at West Bank outpost over farm land

Headline: Fearing a third intifada, Israel boosts targeted arrests in West Bank

Palestinian officials say undercover Israeli troops broke into a West Bank house in a failed arrest raid Thursday, igniting a violent protest and signaling that Israeli-Palestinian security coordination may be in trouble. The Israeli military says some 500 Palestinians threw stones and firebombs at troops near the town of Jenin. Palestinian officials say a Palestinian was shot in the hand by army fire and an elderly woman was bitten by an army dog. No Israeli injuries were reported. The confrontation mirrored a violent face-off between troops and Palestinians on Tuesday, when undercover troops entered the village of Tamoun to arrest an Islamic Jihad operative. In that case, hundreds of Palestinians hurled rocks and Molotov cocktails at troops, drawing teargas and rubber bullets in response.

Headline: Fatah prepares for Gaza rally

Preparations are under way for a Fatah rally in Gaza, marking the group's 48th anniversary, Palestinian officials said. It is the first Fatah rally in the Gaza Strip since the Hamas takeover in 2007. Senior Fatah official Nabil Sha'ath said the celebrations will have a positive effect on national unity, Ma'an News Agency quoted him as saying Thursday. The rally dubbed "The modern Palestinian revolution," will aid in uniting Hamas and Fatah, he said, adding "we don't want to negotiate again; there is an agreement that should be implemented," he said, referring to unity meetings in Cairo in the past year that were meant to reconcile the two factions.

Headline: Jordanian minister accuses Israel of planning to erect the third Temple

A Jordanian minister accused Israel on Wednesday of planning to partition the Al-Aqsa Mosque compound in Jerusalem and the Temple Mount plaza surrounding it in order to erect the third Temple. Islamic Endowments Minister Abdul Salam Abadi told a visiting clerical delegation from Australia that he received instructions from the “Hashemite leadership” to safeguard the Arab and Islamic identity of Jerusalem, Jordanian media reported. Abadi said Israel was planning to divide the mosque from its courtyards with a 144-dunam structure. According to the independent Jordanian daily Al-Ghad, Abadi stressed the need to support the residents of Jerusalem “in their steadfastness in the face of the repeated Israeli attacks on the holy Al-Aqsa Mosque and the Islamic holy sites in Jerusalem.”

Headline: Saudi Arabia in for Egypt-style revolution: Analyst

Saudi Arabia is on the brink of an imminent Egypt-style revolution unless Riyadh addresses people's demands, a political commentator tells Press TV. “I think the Saudis are heading into a place where

probably what has been taking place in Egypt and throughout the Middle East probably will come to Saudi Arabia,” Kamel Wazne said in an interview with Press TV on Wednesday. He described the recent spread of anti-government protests to major cities in the Persian Gulf kingdom as a “challenge” for the Al Saud dynasty and urged Riyadh to take people’s message “very seriously.”

“Any neglect for the demand of the people or disregard for their voices I think it is going to have a ramification on the stability of the country,” Wazne pointed out. As recently as Tuesday, people held demonstrations against the Al Saud regime in the holy city of Mecca and the central city of Buraidah. They called for the downfall of the royal family and demanded the release of political prisoners.

Headline: Egyptian Islamist party splits

A senior Muslim Brotherhood official has said that Israel will cease to exist within a decade, the latest in a series of inflammatory comments by figures close to Egypt’s Mohammed Morsi. Essam el-Erian, deputy head of the Brotherhood’s political arm, the Freedom and Justice Party, was trying to lay to rest a controversy over comments he made in an interview last week, in which he invited Egyptian-born Jews to return to the country. In an interview with the Saudi-backed newspaper Al-Sharq al-Awsat, Mr Erian said that the “ideology of Zionism” had ended in failure and that “Palestine’s occupiers” should leave to make way for the return of Palestinians. Meanwhile, a radical group in Egypt's conservative Islamist party has broken away and could strengthen support for Sharia law ahead of legislative elections, experts said.

Headline: UN Estimates Syria Death Toll at More than 60,000

More than 60,000 people have been killed in the Syrian conflict, the UN said on Wednesday, as dozens more died or were wounded when an air strike hit a service station near Damascus. *AFP* reported that UN High Commissioner for Human Rights Navi Pillay said in Geneva that 59,648 people had died through the end of November in the 21-month conflict, which began as a peaceful uprising in March 2011. "Given there has been no let-up in the conflict since the end of November, we can assume that more than 60,000 people have been killed by the beginning of 2013," Pillay said in a statement quoted by the news agency. "The number of casualties is much higher than we expected, and is truly shocking," she added.

Headline: Syrian rebels fight for key military airport in northern Syria

Syrian rebels on Thursday fought to capture a key military airport in the north used by President Bashar al-Assad's air force to bombard their posts, an opposition group said. The Britain-based Syrian Observatory for Human Rights reported fierce clashes in the vicinity of the Taftanaz military airport near the northern province of Idlib. Rebel fighters, mainly from the al-Nusra Front and Ahrar al-Sham Islamist groups, briefly broke into the airport and stormed its command before being repulsed by government forces, the observatory said. The airport is used by al-Assad's forces to bombard opposition strongholds in the north where rebels have made significant gains in recent months. The facility is located near a road linking the Syrian capital Damascus and Aleppo, the country's biggest city close to the border with Turkey.

However, outside observers suspect that the evacuation order may corroborate previous reports indicating that a uranium enrichment facility near Isfahan had been leaking radioactive material.



Headline: South Sudan accuses Sudan of bombing before leaders' summit

South Sudan accused Sudan of launching air strikes on the southern side of their disputed border shortly before the leaders of the oil-producing African countries were due to meet to defuse tensions. Several civilians were wounded in the attack in the southern state of Western Bahr El Ghazal on Wednesday, South Sudan's Information Minister Barnaba Marial Benjamin told journalists. Sudan's armed forces were not immediately available for comment but have regularly denied southern accusations of attacks in the past. The two countries have been at loggerheads over oil, territory and a string of other disputes since the South split away from Sudan last year under the terms of a peace deal.

Eurozone factories sank deeper into recession in December as new orders tumbled, business surveys showed on Wednesday, a sharp contrast to continuing signs of revival in China. U.S. manufacturing reports, to be released later in the day, are expected to show activity in the world's largest economy to have expanded modestly. Purchasing managers' surveys in the 17-nation eurozone showed economic decline spread further into the core members, suggesting the overall economy may have slipped deeper into recession at the end of 2012.



The number of American people initially applying for unemployment aid last week went up again after the previous week's decline, the Labor Department reported Thursday. The advance figure for seasonally adjusted initial claims for jobless benefits was 372,000 in the week ending Dec. 29, up 10,000 from the previous week's revised figure. Meanwhile, the four-week moving average, which helps smooth out week-to-week volatility, also edged up to 360,000.

Headline: Dust Bowl Wilting U.S. Wheat as Funds Turn Bearish

The worst U.S. drought since the 1930s Dust Bowl is damaging wheat crops across the world’s biggest supplier, at a time when hedge funds are the most bearish on prices in seven months. About 61 percent of the country is mired in a dry spell that the government says will last at least until March in states growing the most winter wheat. With dormant crops already in the worst condition since records began in 1985 and global inventories headed for a third annual drop, Chicago futures may rise as much as 25 percent to \$9.50 a bushel this year, the median of 32 analyst estimates compiled by Bloomberg shows. That raises the prospect of prices reversing their 20 percent drop since a July peak, a retreat that spurred hedge funds to start betting on more declines in December. The prolonged drought is increasing concern that supplies will tighten because there is also dry weather in Argentina and Australia. Heat waves in the Black Sea last year curbed cargoes until the next harvest and a lack of rain is slowing barge traffic on the Mississippi, which handles about 60 percent of U.S. grain exports.

Headline: 300 children die in measles outbreak in Pakistan

Measles cases in 2012 have surged by almost five times of that the previous year in Pakistan, leading to the deaths of hundreds of children, according to an international health body. Maryam Yunus, a spokeswoman for the World Health Organization (WHO) said on Tuesday that 306 children died in Pakistan because of the infectious disease in 2012, a dramatic surge from to the 64 children in 2011. The WHO said the jump was most pronounced in southern Sindh province, where measles killed 210 children in 2012. Twenty-eight children died there the year before. The organisation did not give a reason for the increase in deaths, but a provincial health official in Sindh said that the disease hit areas where poor families did not vaccinate their children. A provincial health minister said 100 children died in Sindh province in December alone, mostly in areas where many people were not vaccinated. He said health officials recently launched a campaign to vaccinate 2.9 million children in the affected areas of the province and urged parents to get their children vaccinated. “We are vaccinating more than 450 patients per day. We are working on vaccination since the outbreak of measles in the area,” Dr. Shahid Hafeez Shahani, a government official, said.

Headline: Patriotic Group Told to Stop Praying in Jesus’ Name

The Daughters of the American Revolution, one of the nation’s oldest patriotic organizations, has erased any mention of Jesus Christ in their official book, removed prayers and poems that reference Christian imagery, and directed members to refrain from praying in the name of Christ, an outraged group of members alleged. The dispute has been brewing for more than a year when DAR members

learned that the newly revised Ritual and Missal books – the primary guide for chaplains – were altered. They noticed that the name of Jesus Christ had been omitted. The DAR president general did not return calls seeking comment for this story. The members said DAR leadership made the changes to be politically correct and to accommodate new members of other religious beliefs. A state chaplain in the organization notified members of their concerns in a newsletter. “The newly updated Missal and Ritual was written to reflect the desire to be considerate of other belief systems,” the statement read. “The Chaplain General uses scripture from both the Old and New Testaments and prays in the name of God without reference Christ. Chapter and district chaplains need to follow the example set by the National Society.”

Headline: Congo rebels demand government sign ceasefire for talks

Congolese rebels on Thursday threatened to walk away from this week's peace talks to end their nine-month revolt unless the government signs an official ceasefire, a demand Kinshasa dismissed as unnecessary. The rebel March 23 Movement, preparing for talks on Friday in Kampala, capital of regional mediator Uganda, said government troops had reinforced positions in the east of Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and warned it would resist an offensive. "If Kinshasa continues to refuse to sign a ceasefire, M23 is going to ask its delegation to return to DRC. We will wait and when they say 'we're ready to sign (a ceasefire)' we'll go back," Jean-Marie Runiga, head of the rebels' political wing, told reporters in Bunagana, a border town under rebel control. The first attempt at peace talks to end the nine-month rebellion in Congo's volatile east failed last month amid threats and accusations.

Headline: **Central African Republic president refuses to leave power, defying rebels**

Central African Republic President Francois Bozize will refuse to leave power during talks with rebels, his spokesman said on Thursday, rejecting the insurgents' main demand and raising the prospect of a return to fighting. The Seleka rebel alliance, which has accused Bozize of reneging on a past peace deal, advanced to within striking distance of the mineral-rich nation's capital this week before bowing to international pressure to start negotiations. A week before those talks were due to start, a spokesman for Bozize's ruling KNK party said the president's departure would not be on the agenda. "The question of President Bozize leaving ... will be rejected systematically if it is proposed," Cyriac Gonda told Reuters. "For us, the solution is to form a unity government with everyone," he added, reiterating a previous offer by Bozize to give government posts to the rebels. The spokesman for the CPSK, one of the rebel groups that form Seleka, said on Thursday a peace deal would not be possible without Bozize's unconditional exit.

Headline: **Cash Strapped Red Cross Predicts Violent Riots in Europe**

The International Committee of the Red Cross said on Tuesday that the organization's staff experienced working in conflict areas will now concentrate on Europe. "We need to prepare for more violence here," ICRC Director General Yves Daccord told the Danish daily Politiken. "For the first time we see growing pressure on Europeans, where more and more people have become really poor. Secondly, European countries use less money on social welfare due to the economic crisis," Daccord said. "That creates new challenges for the Red Cross that we have not experienced previously." In Spain, the ICRC now supports about 300,000 "extremely vulnerable" people unable to fend for themselves and helps millions more who cannot make ends meet. Meanwhile, in Greece, the organization's operation is preparing to go bankrupt.

Headline: **Myanmar admits to airstrikes against rebels**

Myanmar's military has acknowledged carrying out airstrikes against ethnic Kachin rebels in the country's north, and said it has captured a hilltop post from where the insurgents launched attacks on government supply convoys. The statement broadcast on state television on Wednesday contradicted government claims two days earlier that the military was not carrying out offensive air attacks on the Kachin, raising questions about how much control the elected government of reformist President Thein Sein has over the army. The AFP news agency earlier reported that strikes were carried out as

the military, known as the "Tatmadaw", battled to regain one of its bases taken over by the armed wing of the Kachin Independence Organisation (KIO). A military owned news website stated that a key base had been seized from the rebels "with the help of air strikes in the region".

Police in the Bangladeshi capital Dhaka have arrested at least five people after an anti-government protest turned violent, local media say. Hundreds of activists from the country's opposition party, Jamaat-e-Islami, participated in the protest rally, which was held in the Rampura area of the capital on Wednesday. 
