Malaysian Prime Minister Najib Razak is scheduled to visit the Gaza Strip, which has been under an Israeli blockade for the past five years. An aide to the Malaysian prime minister said on Sunday that Foreign Minister Anifah Aman and other high-ranking officials will also accompany Najib on the one-day visit, AFP reported. The aide, who spoke on condition of anonymity because he was not authorized to speak to journalists, did not provide details of the visit or its purpose. However, he said that an official statement would be issued on Monday.

Headline: Israel removes Palestinian protest camp outside Jerusalem

Headline: Israel to change route of separation fence near Jerusalem to cut off Palestinians from E-1 area

Israeli security forces removed Palestinian protest tents from land adjoining a Jewish settlement in the West Bank on Monday, the second such camp to be torn down in a week. Palestinian activists had pitched tents near the village of Beit Iksa, northwest of Jerusalem, where residents face difficulty building homes due to Israeli restrictions and may be surrounded by a separation barrier Israel plans for the area. Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu, widely predicted to win a third term in an election on Tuesday, has pledged to pursue settlement building in the West Bank and in East Jerusalem, occupied land that Israel has annexed in a move not recognized internationally.

Headline: Ramallah: 18 Palestinians injured in riot

Palestinian security forces shot and injured three Palestinian youths during a riot that broke out in the al-Am'ari refugee camp in Ramallah on Sunday. The extent of their wounds wasn't immediately clear. At least 15 police officers were hurt by stones hurled by protesters while trying to clear a major road that was blocked by torched tires. The clashes broke out when a demonstration staged by young

residents of the camp got out of control. The youths rallied in show of solidarity with Palestinians imprisoned in Israel. A witness said that some of the rioters fired shots at the cops who tried to disperse the crowds. The security forces later fired warning shots in the air before turning their guns on the protesters.

Headline: Arab Campaign in Europe Calls for 'Palestinian Spring'

A Palestinian Authority Arab group calling itself “the European initiative to remove the fence and the settlements” has launched a new media campaign in Europe, entitled “Palestine without a fence and with no settlements.” Arab affairs expert Dalit Halevi reports that the group’s chairman, Amin Abu Rashid, an Arab-Dutch national known for his activism in favor of Hamas and Gaza-bound flotillas, is calling as part of the campaign to continue what he termed the “Palestinian Spring” protests against the Jewish communities in Judea and Samaria. Halevi reports that Abu Rashid is calling on PA Arabs to continue to establish facts on the ground by setting up illegal outposts in areas designated for expropriation by Israel.

Headline: Hamas and Islamic Jihad expected to join PLO

A member of the Executive Committee of the PLO, Dr. Ahmed Majdalani, told Al-Quds newspaper that he expects Hamas and Islamic Jihad to join with the PLO after National Council elections later this month, though the government will still be headed by President Mahmoud Abbas. As Elder of Zion says: “This means that terror groups who urge the ethnic cleansing of Jews in the Middle East will be accepted as part of the international community at the UN. (The UN does not distinguish between the PLO and the ‘State of Palestine.’)” This means UN sanctioning of Islamic antisemitism and the genocidal aspirations that Hamas has so often enunciated as the contemporary fulfillment and embodiment of those antisemitic teachings. It also gives the lie to the fiction, so prevalent in Washington, that the PLO and Fatah are the “moderates” who oppose the Hamas and Islamic Jihad “extremists.”

Headline: Israel Police to Deploy 20,000 Officers to Secure Polls

Voters should have no problems voting on Tuesday when they head to the polls: Israel Police plan to deploy more than 20,000 officers to make sure there are no problems at the sites. General police officers, Border Police and volunteer security personnel will be on hand to secure the 10,132 polling stations across the country, said police spokesman Mickey Rosenfeld on Monday. Vandalism by those who appear intent on intimidating potential voters into staying home will be prevented, Rosenfeld said, with police “ensuring the public can exercise its right to vote without any problems whatsoever.”

Headline: Islamist boycott clouds Jordan general election

Jordanians go the polls on Wednesday, but an Islamist boycott is expected to produce a toothless parliament that is unlikely to bring real reform, leaving the country in political uncertainty. Jordan has high hopes for the election, seeking to turn it into the pivot of a reform process aimed at fending off protests inspired by Arab Spring revolts that have toppled four regimes. But a boycott by the powerful Muslim Brotherhood and other opposition groups such as the National Reform Front of former premier and intelligence chief Ahmad Obeidat cast a long shadow over the process. "Previous parliaments have proven their incapability of introducing reform and change. The coming parliament is no exception. It could be the worst," Zaki Bani Rshaid, deputy leader of the Brotherhood, told AFP. "Many people will not vote and the political scene will be more frustrating. Any hope of establishing real political life as a foundation for parliamentary governments is illusory."

Headline: Assad fall won't mean Hezbollah disarmament: Geagea

The fall of Syria's Assad regime would not lead to the disarmament of Hezbollah, Lebanese Forces leader Samir Geagea said Sunday evening. "Hezbollah considers arms as its key power and will become more committed to it after the regime in Syria falls and will work on enhancing it further," said Geagea in an interview to Egyptian Capital Broadcast Center (CBC) television channel. According to Geagea, Syria serves only as a path for Hezbollah to reach its goals and the party will look for other channels when the Assad regime is brought down. "Syria is no more than a passageway for Hezbollah and the party has currently replaced this channel. However, postponing its project doesn't necessarily mean giving up on its arms," said Geagea.

A group of protesting Saudi Arabian women were arrested earlier this month, prompting a groundswell of outrage that may ultimately result in a sequel to the 2011 Arab Spring uprisings. In what is seen as a new phenomenon in the kingdom, a ripple of outrage has begun following the arrests that came in response to demonstrations protesting the detention of male family members. The incident, which took place in the town of Buraida, was reported by *CNN*, which quoted Saudi activists who said the kingdom has been trying to silence the women. Buraida is the provincial capital of Qassim Province, a conservative area of the country in which the detention of women is seen as a red line not to be crossed.

The police fired tear gas at the protesters to disperse them who threw rocks at the security forces. The demonstrators later raided the court and set fire to legal papers and documents inside the premises.

Egypt under the Muslim Brotherhood is continuing to get closer to Iran. According to a Sunday report in *PressTV*, Iranian President Mahmoud Ahmadinejad will soon visit Cairo in order strengthen bilateral relations between the two countries. Khalid al-Said Ibrahim Amari, identified in the report as the head of Egypt's Interest Section in Tehran, said that Iran's president would visit Egypt on February 6 and 7, at the official invitation of Egyptian President Mohammed Morsi. Ahmadinejad will attend the 12th summit of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation, according to *PressTV*. The Iranian president is also expected to hold talks with Morsi.

Headline: Syrian activists say government airstrike near Damascus kills at least 7

Syrian government troops battled rebels in several areas outside Damascus on Sunday while regime warplanes bombed opposition-held areas around the capital, including an airstrike on one village that killed at least seven people, activists said. Rebels seeking to topple President Bashar Assad have seized swaths of territory in northern Syria but have become bogged down in their push for Damascus, where government troops are still firmly in control. While the opposition fighters have established footholds in suburbs east and south of the capital, Assad's forces have kept them from advancing into the heart of the city and regularly hit them with artillery and airstrikes. Much of the fighting Sunday was focused in areas east and south of the city, the Britain-based Syrian Observatory for Human Rights said, while government jets were bombing rebel areas.

Headline: Syrian opposition fails to form 'transitional government'

Headline: Syria's Opposition Meets to Select Prime Minister

Syrian opposition leaders failed to form a "transitional government" at a meeting in the Turkish city of Istanbul amid differences between the parties involved. On Monday, the so-called Syrian National Council (SNC) said in a statement that it needs guarantees of support from Syrian militant groups as well as the countries financing and arming them. "After studying the proposals and after deliberation on the question of creating an interim government, we decided to set up a five-member committee tasked with consulting with opposition forces, the Free Syrian Army and friendly states," the SNC said. The council added that the five-member panel would also be tasked with exploring the extent to which Syrian opposition groups and their foreign supporters can help the work to be 'financially and politically feasible.'

Headline: Iraq protester sets himself ablaze in anti-government rally

An Iraqi protester set himself on fire on Sunday in the northern city of Mosul in a dramatic turn after more than three weeks of Sunni Muslim rallies that are challenging Shi'ite Prime Minister Nuri al-Maliki's government. Thousands of Sunni demonstrators have rallied since late December against a Shi'ite-led government they say has marginalized their minority sect, raising fears the OPEC country may slide again into widespread sectarian confrontation. During protests by around 2,000 people in the northern city of Mosul, one man set himself on fire before others quickly stamped out the flames with their jackets, police said. He was sent to hospital with minor burns to his face and hands.

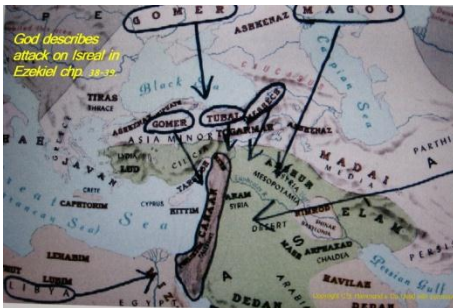

Turkish Prime Minister Recep Tayyip Erdogan has said that the Turkish Army will continue its war with Kurdistan Workers' Party (PKK) fighters until they withdraw abroad. "The terror organization (the PKK) must give an end to its actions, withdraw abroad, and lay down their arms. And we will give our best support to the process," Endogen said in southern Gaziantep province on Sunday. He added that the Turkish Army would not launch attacks against PKK fighters if they were leaving the country. Erdogan stated that the government would not allow any kind of separatist movements to work in the country.

Russia has started the largest naval exercises in the past few decades in the Mediterranean and Black Seas as a civil war in Syria continues to gain momentum. The drills involve task forces from Russia's Black Sea, Northern and Baltic fleets, strategic bombers, tactical aircraft, air defense units, paratroopers and naval infantry. An official statement by the Defense Ministry, issued on Saturday, says the exercises "are held in line with the Russian Armed Forces' 2013 combat training plan and focus on interoperability of task forces from several fleets while on a mission in a far-off maritime zone."

Headline: Coordinated Kabul suicide attack targets government building

Taliban insurgents wearing suicide vests attacked the Kabul traffic police headquarters before dawn Monday, police said, and eyewitnesses heard numerous explosions and a still-raging gun battle two hours later. Police officer Mirza Mohammad said at least one insurgent blew himself up at the entrance to the compound and a number of others wearing suicide vests entered the building. Another police officer said at least three attackers entered the building and two were killed, possibly by detonating their vests.

Headline: Death toll at Algerian gas plant rises to at least 81 as bomb squads find more bodies

The death toll from the bloody terrorist siege at a natural gas plant in the Sahara climbed to at least 81 on Sunday as Algerian forces searching the complex for explosives found dozens more bodies, many so badly disfigured they could not immediately be identified, a security official said. Algerian special forces stormed the facility on Saturday to end the four-day siege of the remote desert refinery,

and the government said then that 32 militants and 23 hostages were killed, but that the death toll was likely to rise. The militants came from six countries, were armed to cause maximum destruction and mined the Ain Amenas refinery, which the Algerian state oil company runs along with BP and Norway's Statoil, said Algerian Communications Minister Mohamed Said. The militants "had decided to succeed in the operation as planned, to blow up the gas complex and kill all the hostages," he said in a state radio interview.

Headline: China poised to play debt card – for U.S. land

Could real estate on American soil owned by China be set up as “development zones” in which the communist nation could establish Chinese-owned businesses and bring in its citizens to the U.S. to work? That’s part of an evolving proposal Beijing has been developing quietly since 2009 to convert more than \$1 trillion of U.S. debt it owns into equity. Under the plan, China would own U.S. businesses, U.S. infrastructure and U.S. high-value land, all with a U.S. government guarantee against loss. Yu Qiao, a professor of economics in the School of Public Policy and Management at Tsinghua University in Beijing, proposed in 2009 a plan for the U.S. government to guarantee foreign investments in the United States. WND has reliable information that the Bank of China, China’s central bank, has continued to advance the plan to convert China’s holdings of U.S. debt into equity owned by China in the U.S. The Obama administration, under the plan, would grant a financial

guarantee as an inducement for China to convert U.S. debt into Chinese direct equity investment. China would take ownership of successful U.S. corporations, potentially profitable infrastructure projects and high-value U.S. real estate.

Headline: Wall Street makes big gains over food price spikes

Powerful firms like Goldman Sachs have made hundreds of millions of dollars in food future trades. Critics accuse them of profiting off starvation and market manipulation, while traders claim their profits are due to increasing consumption in China. World food prices tracked by the UN Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) have more than doubled in the past 10 years. The FAO's Food Price Index, which baskets prices for five prime food commodities, peaked in 2008 and 2011, each time rising more than 50 percent from the previous year. The latest price spike was one of the key factors that triggered the series of uprisings in the Arab world resulting in the fall of several governments. The year 2013 may see another price hike, following the worst draught in the US in 50 years and poor harvests in Russia and Ukraine. The UN has warned that the world may be approaching a major hunger crisis. At the same time, the industry is bringing millions in profits to those who rushed to invest in food. Goldman Sachs made an estimated \$400 million in 2012 from investing its clients' money in a range of "soft commodities," from wheat and maize to coffee and sugar, according to an analysis by the World Development Movement (WDM).

Headline: EU officials want governments to share bank bailout pain

National governments should pay their own contribution to recapitalize ailing banks alongside funding from the eurozone's bail-out fund, according to a paper by EU officials. Eurozone finance ministers are expected to discuss the plans when they convene on Monday (21 January) for their first Eurogroup meeting of 2013. For their part, officials in the EU Council in an informal "Issues Note" leaked on Friday by the Wall Street Journal, propose that banks should be eligible for direct support only if national governments are unable to put up the cash themselves or if their failure is of systemic importance to either the member state or the eurozone as a whole. Banks would also be eligible if

they would otherwise breach rules on capital requirements requiring them to hold core capital worth at least 4.5 percent of the total value of financial instruments on their balance sheets.

Headline: Spain Recession Scars Exposed as Jobless Seen at 6 Mln

Spain's scars from the slump that overshadowed Prime Minister Mariano Rajoy's first year in office will emerge this week as data show the toll on economic output that may have kept as many as 6 million people out of work. Spanish exports fell 0.6 percent in November from the same month the previous year, when they had risen 7.4 percent, the Economy Ministry said today. House-price data tomorrow will show if the property market endured a fourth year of declines. The Bank of Spain may also release its estimate for fourth-quarter gross domestic product, and the data will culminate in jobs figures on Jan. 24, forecast by economists to show a record 26 percent of Spaniards unemployed. Officials predict the euro-area's fourth-biggest economy faces a further slump this year at a time when the government will struggle to meet its budget goals. Such a backdrop hasn't deterred investors, with the prospect of a European Central Bank backstop in the event of a bailout enabling the Treasury to fast-track higher 2013 funding needs, selling 16 billion euros (\$21 billion) at its first three auctions at lower costs.

Headline: China's Buying A Fleet Of Russian Bombers Perfect For Taking On The US Navy

Chinese websites are again reporting that Russia has agreed to sell Beijing the production line for the Tupolev Tu-22M3 bomber at a cost of \$1.5 billion. Once in service with the Chinese Naval Air Forces the Tu-22M3 will be known as the “H-10”. The deal struck with Russia includes 36 aircraft: a batch of 12 followed by a second batch of 24 additional bombers. The Tu-22 bombers will give China another tool to pursue the area denial strategy in the South China Sea and the Pacific theatre; a fast platform to launch cruise missiles, conventional or nuclear weapons in various regional war scenarios. Headline: Minnesota shivers as wind chill nears 50 below zero; New England braces for foot of snow

Icy winds and bitter cold lashed the Midwest as a powerful storm made its way eastward and left New England preparing for up to a foot of snow. Pushed by northwesterly winds, Arctic air was bringing wind chills near to minus 50 in Minnesota and western Wisconsin. Highs were expected to remain below zero into Tuesday, according to forecasters. In Detroit, about 40,000 customers were without power early Monday. Utility DTE Energy blamed high winds for knocking out power Sunday to 120,000 customers. DTE said it was receiving assistance from crews based in neighboring Ohio and Wisconsin, as well as outlying parts of Michigan. "We expect to have the vast majority of our customers restored by midnight Monday," DTE said in a statement. In Illinois, temperatures dipped into the single digits, with wind chills well below zero, NBCChicago.com reported. NBC Chicago meteorologist Cheryl Scott said wind chills could hover around 15 below zero, which would be the city's coldest weather in two years.

Headline: Floods kill 26 in Indonesia's capital

Police say floods in Indonesia's capital have killed at least 26 people and sent more than 100,000 fleeing their homes. Jakarta police spokesman Col. Rikwanto said Monday that most of the victims were electrocuted or drowned in floodwaters reaching up to two meters (6.5 feet) high in some places. About 103,000 people are living in temporary shelters. The floods reached their peak Thursday after a dike in central Jakarta collapsed. They engulfed around 30 percent of the city of 14 million, including its business district center and the presidential palace.

Headline: Mali, French Forces Take Second Town in Insurgents' Fight

Burned out vehicles and scattered bullets dotted the streets of a central Malian town after radical Islamists retreated following days of French airstrikes, according to video obtained Sunday. The Malian military announced late Saturday that the government was now controlling Diabaly, marking an important accomplishment for the French-led offensive to oust the extremists from northern and central Mali. "People are calm since the Islamists left the city of Diabaly before it was taken by the Malian and French forces yesterday," said Oumar Coulibaly, who lives in the nearby town of Niono. The Associated Press obtained video filmed Saturday by a local resident, which shows people from Diabaly inspecting the fighters' vehicles and charred weaponry destroyed by French airstrikes and Malian ground forces.

Headline: South Africa protesters burn tyres, loot shops

Thousands of South Africans burnt tyres and vehicles, barricaded streets and looted shops in the industrial town of Sasolburg near Johannesburg on Monday, the worst social unrest this year around the commercial hub of Africa's biggest economy. Three police officers were injured when a mob threw stones at them in the town, 90 km (55 miles) south of Johannesburg, Constable Peter Kareli said. In return, 50 officers fired rubber bullets and stun grenades and deployed water cannons to disperse the rioters, who went on the rampage because of a plan to move local government boundaries, he added. "These people are attacking us in groups at different locations so it is difficult for us to control them," he said.

Headline: SOLDIERS TAKE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS, STATE TV IN APPARENT COUP IN ERITREA

An author who writes about the small nation of Eritrea says soldiers took control of the country's Ministry of Information and read a statement on air saying the 1997 constitution would be applied. Léonard Vincent, author of the book "The Eritreans" and co-founder of a Paris-based Eritrean radio station, says more than 100 soldiers took control of the ministry Monday morning. Vincent said that the daughter of Eritrea's president is among ministry officials being controlled by the soldiers. Vincent stopped short of calling it a coup d'etat and said it's not yet clear if the action is a well-organized coup attempt or what he called a "kamikaze crash." Vincent said his information came from a ministry source and information gathered by Eritrean journalists working at the radio station he co-founded.

Headline: Georgian protestors demand president's resignation

Over 1,000 Georgians have staged a protest in the capital city of Tbilisi to demand the immediate resignation of President Mikhail Saakashvili. Protestors gathered outside the Georgian president's

residence on Sunday, asking him to hand over executive power to the country's parliament speaker. According to the Georgian constitution, Saakashvili's tenure will finish at the end of his five-year term on January 20, 2013. The country's next presidential elections, however, are slated for October 2013. The protest follows a petition circulated by the opposition groups and non-governmental organizations, which bears more than 1 million signatures also calling for Saakashvili's exit. About 50 NGOs and political organizations joined the petition, which says "radical measures" will be taken if the president refuses to step down.

Headline: Bosnian teachers, policemen strike against budget cuts

Public sector workers from across Bosnia's Serb Republic went on strike on Monday in the first big protest of 2013 against government spending cuts. Trade unions said teachers, policemen, judicial and tax office workers had walked off the job after the regional government went ahead with a 10 percent pay cut imposed as part of an austerity budget. The government had sought a six-month moratorium on any industrial action and promised to increase public employees' wages in the second half of the year if revenues rose. "The government proposal is unacceptable. Our aim is not to strike but to use it as a mean to protect our rights," union leader Ranka Misic told Reuters.

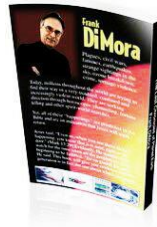
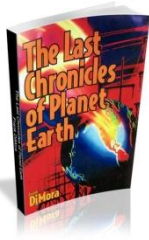

Headline: Despite Cease-Fire, Fighting Continues in Burma's Kachin State

Sporadic fighting has continued between Burma's army and ethnic Kachin rebels in Burma's north Kachin state, despite a government-declared unilateral cease-fire. An eyewitness tells VOA that Burmese soldiers appeared to use a brief lull in hostilities after the declaration to advance on rebel positions. The close proximity of combatants is complicating efforts for peace talks. President Thein Sein announced the cease-fire through state television, saying it would take effect on Saturday morning for the La Ja Yang area near the China border. But, the rebel Kachin Independence Army says Burma soldiers attacked their positions in the days that followed using heavy artillery and machine guns.

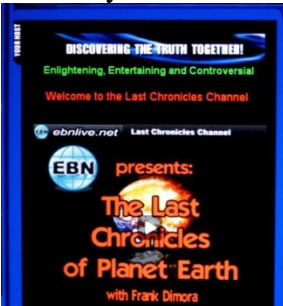

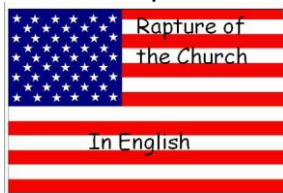
