Headline: **Analysis: Israel airstrike may foreshadow Iran attack**

It's hard to get a handle on it – few Israelis are willing to talk about it on the record – but there's been a palpable shift in thinking in Israel about launching an airstrike on Iran. Nowhere more than in the counter-terrorism community itself. Even among the more reasoned – and moderate – voices there, the tone has moved from cautious optimism that an Israeli strike on Iran's uranium enrichment facilities could be avoided to gloomy inevitability. "It's no longer a question of if but when," replied one Israeli analyst when asked if Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu would respond militarily if Iran crossed his "red lines" and acquired a nuclear bomb.

Headline: **Report: Region's Armies All on High Alert**

The armies of Syria, Lebanon and Jordan are all on high alert, a report in a Lebanese newspaper said Sunday. The report in *Ad-Diar* said that the alerts were due to Israel's attack on a Syrian missile transport and, according to Syrian claims, an attack on a sensitive Syrian military installation. The report said that the Syrian army has instructed its units to break up into smaller groups, “similar to what Hizbullah has done in south Lebanon.” The strategy is designed to protect troops in the wake of another possible Israeli attack, the report said. The report added that Syrian troops had joined Hizbullah terrorists in several areas of south Lebanon. According to the report, the Syrian and Hizbullah forces were stationed very close to the Israeli border, in the area of Har Dov (also known as “Sheba Farms”). The Lebanese and Jordanian armies are also on high alert over the possibility of a clash between Israel and Syria in the area. Unconfirmed Lebanese reports said that Israeli warplanes had been seen over Lebanon earlier Sunday.

Headline: **Assad set on arms transfers to Lebanon. Israel responds with no-fly zone**

Syrian ruler Bashar Assad has ordered the resumption of weapons transfers to the Lebanese Hizbullah, debkafile's exclusive military and intelligence sources report. This was agreed with Iran's National Security Director Saeed Jalilee, who arrived in Damascus after Israel's reported air strike last Wednesday, Jan. 30, inter alia, on Syrian trucks preparing to ferry to Lebanon for Hizbullah the sophisticated Iran-supplied arms stored at the Jamraya military complex north of Damascus.

The Syrian ruler assured the Iranian official that he would not be deterred by what he called acts of "aggression." It was up to Syria and Iran to put their heads together to find a safe method of getting the hardware across to Hizballah without exposing it to Israeli attack in truck convoys on the open road. Jalilee is still in Damascus. He arrived Saturday to discuss with Syrian and Hizballah how to activate against Israel the secret mutual defense pact binding Iran, Syria, Hizballah and Hamas.

Headline: Erekat says Israel must stop settlements

Palestinians will not return to peace talks until Israel halts all of its construction in settlements, Palestinian negotiator Saeb Erekat said. Palestinians will not "repeat the lunacy of returning to the negotiations while Israel is not fulfilling its obligations," The Jerusalem Post quoted Erekat as saying Sunday. Expansion of Israeli settlements in the West Bank and East Jerusalem are a major issue in efforts to resume peace talks. "These are not Palestinian conditions but obligations that Israel is required to fulfill," Erekat said when asked to comment on Prime Minister Binyamin Netanyahu's call Saturday for a return to negotiations without preconditions.

Headline: East Asian nations to meet on Palestinian aid: report

Reconciliation talks between Fatah and Hamas will resume on Wednesday in Cairo under Egyptian supervision, head of the Fatah team to the talks, Azzam Ahmad, said Monday. He said the meeting will discuss what has been achieved so far in the reconciliation process since the last meeting and what remains to be implemented. He also said the two sides will prepare the ground for a meeting scheduled for Friday in Cairo for the committee looking into revitalizing and restructuring the Palestine Liberation Organization. Ahmad said consultations regarding forming the new government of technocrats, which will be headed by President Mahmoud Abbas, will start next Monday when the elections commission is supposed to start actual registration of voters in the West Bank and Gaza Strip in preparation for presidential and legislative elections.

Headline: Hundreds of Syrians flee to Jordan as border battle wages

Hundreds of Syrians fled to Jordan on Sunday as regime and rebel forces battled for control of the main Jordanian-Syrian border crossing point. According to Jordanian security sources, heavy shelling and mortar rocket fire erupted along the Jordanian-Syrian border Sunday after rebel forces attempted to storm the Nasib/Jaber crossing point in Mafrqa, around 80 kilometres northeast of Amman. Security sources say Damascus deployed warplanes and tanks to repel the assault, which officials are calling the largest battle to have broken out along the border since the onset of the 23-month-old conflict. Rebel forces are billing the daring operation as a "decisive battle" for the Nasib crossing, which lies some 10 kilometres west of Daraa and serves as Syria's main conduit to Jordan. Despite reportedly controlling up to 70 per cent of the 370-kilometre-long border, rebel forces have repeatedly failed to capture the heavily fortified border crossing. "We will not back down until we have liberated the southern border once and for all," said Abu Hani Al Darawi, a Free Syrian Army coordinator located in the border region.

Headline: Lebanese FM calls for boycott of Israel

Headline: Report: Tyre explosion meant to destroy Israeli recon device

Lebanese Foreign Minister Adnan Mansour said Sunday that last week's airstrike in Syria "is aggression against Lebanon." He further added, "Israel deserves harsh responses and a tough boycott on the economic, political and diplomatic levels." Speaking before travelling to Cairo to attend a conference of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation Mansour said, "Israeli jets continue to invade Lebanon's airspace every day. We must stand up against the Israeli attacks but not just with calls, statements and condemnation." Meanwhile, Sky News Arabia reported of **a blast in eastern Tyre** in Lebanon. According to the report, Israeli warplanes circled in the sky at the time of the blast. Al-Nahar TV said that the target was an electronic facility in the Hezbollah-controlled area. However, Hezbollah TV denied the report claiming the blast was caused by a stun grenade. Lebanon's state news agency also said the explosion involved a grenade.

Headline: Lebanon: 'Any Hand That Aggresses Against Army Will Be Cut Off'

A top Lebanese official has warned that its military will "pursue" anyone who attacks it, after two troops were killed in a clash with Islamists in the country's east. "Any hand that aggresses against the army will be cut off," army commander Jean Kahwaji told newspaper *Al-Safir* on Monday. "We will

pursue the attackers wherever they are, and whatever party they are loyal to," Kahwaji added. The army chief said on Sunday that Friday's attack on an army patrol in the east Lebanon area of Aarsal, near the Syrian border, was "premeditated" and that the soldiers were killed in a "barbaric way". "Methods were used that are against our Christian and Muslim beliefs," he said of the attack, in which two Lebanese soldiers, one a captain, were killed. Security officials have identified the attackers as Islamic terrorists.

Headline: Report shows Hezbollah, Iran join forces

The head of the Washington Institute's Stein Program on Counterterrorism and Intelligence, Dr. Matthew Levitt, on Wednesday issued a report detailing the intensified and reorganized collaboration between Hezbollah and Iran's Quds Force to commit terror acts against Western countries and Israel. According to the report, "the Hezbollah-Quds Force threat has sometimes eclipsed that of al-Qaida." The 17-page study notes that "Iranian decision-makers settled on a campaign of violence based on a three-tiered threat stream targeting the following: Israeli tourists, government figures (diplomats, retired officials), and targets broadly representative of Israel or the Jewish community (community leaders, prominent Israeli companies)." Levitt wrote that Iran's leaders "assigned the task of targeting Israeli tourists – a soft target – to Hezbollah, and maintained for the Quds Force operations targeting Israeli, American, British, or Gulf States' interests. The latter would be carried out by a new special external operations unit known as Unit 400."

Saudi protesters have taken to the streets in the capital, Riyadh, to express solidarity with political prisoners and those arrested in demonstrations against the ruling Al Saud regime, Press TV reports. On Sunday, the demonstrators called on Saudi authorities to release all jailed opposition activists and prisoners of conscience. Saudis staged a similar protest rally in Riyadh on January 29, calling for the release of prisoners detained during the anti-regime demonstrations. The demonstrators chanted slogans against the excessive use of force by Saudi forces in quelling the anti-regime protests and condemned the Al Saud regime's suppressive actions against dissidents.

Headline: Egypt Receives First Batch of F-16s from the U.S.

Several clashes have erupted between Egyptian anti-government demonstrators and security forces outside the presidential palace in Cairo. There were no immediate reports of casualties from the sporadic clashes, which, witnesses said, on Sunday broke out overnight, AFP reported.

Several hundred demonstrators gathered outside the palace late on Saturday and threw stones and petrol bombs at its walls after clashes between protesters and security forces killed one person and wounded dozens on Friday. Medics say the 23-year-old died of a gunshot wound in Cairo after police fired birdshot at the protesters, who are seeking to overthrow Egyptian President Mohamed Morsi.

Headline: Islamic summit in Cairo

Leaders of Organisation of Islamic Cooperation states are to meet in Cairo on Wednesday to tackle crises ranging from the French-led battle against Islamist militants in Mali to the Syrian civil war. Foreign ministers will begin a two-day meeting in the Egyptian capital on Monday to prepare for the summit, which will include leaders of 26 of the OIC's 57 states. Egypt's first Islamist president, Mohamed Morsi, will assume the OIC's rotating presidency. The summit had been scheduled to take place in 2011 but was postponed due to the regional uprisings that overthrew four Arab dictators, including Egypt's President Hosni Mubarak, the OIC's secretary general Ekmeleddin Ihsanoglu said. The summit "will discuss the major conflicts in the Islamic world," the former Turkish diplomat told sources.

Headline: No need for us to retaliate for airstrike, says Syria

Syria's defense minister said Sunday his country had no need to respond militarily to last Wednesday's reported Israeli airstrike on his country, since the Israeli attack was itself a retaliation. Israel, he claimed, was hitting back against the regime for its successes in the ongoing battle against what he said were Israel-backed Syrian rebels. "It was the Israeli enemy that was retaliating" by carrying out the strike, said Defense Minister Fahd Jassem al-Frej in an interview on Syrian state TV. "It was retaliating for our military operations against the armed gangs." The rebels, fighting to oust Syria's President Bashar Assad, were acting on Israel's behalf, he said. Assad and his officials have frequently asserted that Israel and other foreign powers are to blame for the two-year-old civil war in Syria, in which some 60,000 people are estimated to have been killed, mostly by Assad regime forces.

Headline: Syrian opposition chief renews dialogue offer

Syrian warplanes launched a deadly raid Monday on the outskirts of the rebel-held town of Douma northeast of Damascus, killing seven civilians, among them six children, a monitoring group said.

"Seven civilians, among them six children, were killed in an air raid on the Shifuniyeh area near Douma," said the Syrian Observatory for Human Rights. At least 13 insurgents were also killed in fierce battles that raged in other areas of Damascus province, said the watchdog which relies on a broad network of doctors, activists and lawyers to compile its reports. Fighter jets also blasted the rebel-held town of Talbisseh in the central province of Homs, as well as Kafraya southwest of the provincial capital, the Observatory said.

Headline: Iran pledges to aid Syria if it retaliates against Israel

Speaking during a visit to Damascus, the Syrian capital, Mr Jalili, head of Iran's Supreme National Security Council, said: "Just like it regretted all its wars ... the Zionist entity will regret its aggression against Syria. "The Syrian people and government are serious about this, and the Muslim world supports Syria. "Syria is at the forefront of the Muslim world's confrontation with the Zionist entity," he added, in reference to Israel. In Munich on Sunday, Ehud Barak, the Israeli defense minister, implicitly confirmed that the Jewish state had staged an air strike on Syria, following reports of an air raid which Damascus said targeted a military complex near the capital.

Headline: Iran could build nuclear bomb in 4-6 months, expert says

Iran has what it needs to to build a nuclear bomb in a matter of four to six months, Amos Yadlin, the head of the Institute for National Security Studies, said Monday. "Iran has completed in the last two years two components that... give it all of the necessary means to manufacture a nuclear weapons as soon as it chooses to do so," Yadlin, a former Israeli army intelligence chief, told journalists at a presentation of the INSS annual report on Israel's strategic status. Yadlin noted, however, that despite the narrow window of opportunity to thwart Iran before it breaks out toward a weaponized nuclear capability, there was still time for diplomatic and/or military action. An Israeli attack on Tehran's nuclear facilities, he assessed, would elicit an Iranian response, but not of a magnitude that would precipitate a regional war.

Headline: Iraq violence: 'Many dead' in Kirkuk police HQ attack

Headline: Bomb explosion kills 22 people north of Baghdad

At least 16 people have been killed as suicide bombers and gunmen attacked a police HQ in the northern Iraqi city of Kirkuk, medical sources say. Officials said militants had tried to seize the compound after a bomb exploded at the gates, but were unsuccessful. A police chief was hurt. No group has said it carried out the attack. The attack took place at around 09:15 local time (06:15 GMT) in the centre of Kirkuk. "I saw a vehicle stop at the checkpoint at the main entrance, and the police started checking it," eyewitness Kosrat Hassan Karim told the AFP news agency. "Suddenly, a loud explosion happened, it was terrifying." Two militants reportedly dressed in police uniforms and armed with guns, grenades and suicide vests rushed the main gate of the headquarters after the bomb was detonated.

Headline: Erodgan: Israel Waging 'State Terrorism' in Syria

Turkish Prime Minister Recep Tayyip Erdogan has condemned the recent Israeli airstrike on a research center near the Syrian capital of Damascus. "Those who have been treating Israel like a spoilt child should expect anything from them, at any time," Erdogan said at a press conference in Istanbul on Sunday. "As I say time and again, Israel has a mentality of waging terrorism. Right now, there is no telling what it might do and where it might do it." "We cannot regard a violation of air space as acceptable. What Israel does is completely against international law... it is beyond condemnation," Erdogan said. "I am worried that in a situation like this, any scenario can play out in the future."

Headline: South Sudan fails to withdraw troops from Sudan border

Headline: South Sudan accuses Sudan of deadly attack

South Sudan is not withdrawing troops from the border with Sudan to set up a buffer zone as it pledged it was last month, South Sudan's army said on Monday, in a setback to efforts to resume the oil exports vital to both economies. The two countries came close to war last April in the worst border clashes since South Sudan seceded in 2011 under a peace deal that ended one of Africa's longest

civil wars. The African Union managed to broker a deal in September to defuse hostilities. But the nations have failed set up a buffer border zone and resume oil exports from the landlocked South Sudan through Sudanese pipelines as agreed in Addis Ababa. Meanwhile, The South Sudanese army on Sunday accused Sudan of launching a deadly air assault along their volatile border, but Khartoum promptly denied the claims. A spokesman for the South Sudanese army (SPLA) said the attack occurred on its soil along the border in Upper Nile state. He said Sudan ground troops launched the attack, soon followed by air support, in the latest incident between the two foes.

Headline: Spanish, Italian Bonds Slide Amid Signs of Political Risk

Spain’s Labor Ministry says the country’s unemployment rate rose by 2.7 percent in January, indicating that about five million people are jobless in the country. According to statistics released by the Spanish ministry on Monday, the number of Spaniards registered as unemployed surged by 132,055 in January to 4.98 million. Figures from the National Statistics Institute showed last month a jobless rate of 26 percent in the fourth quarter of 2012 with 5.97 million out of work. Battered by the global financial downturn, the Spanish economy collapsed into recession in the second half of 2008, taking with it millions of jobs.

Two Japanese F-15s scramble as a Chinese plane nears the disputed islands: one in the lead, the other providing cover. They issue radio warnings to leave the area, but are ignored. Visual wing-tipping signals go unheeded. The Japanese pilots consider their last option: firing warning shots - a step Beijing could consider an act of war. That hypothetical scenario, described by a former Japanese air force pilot, shows how the risky game being played near a chain of rocky, uninhabited isles at the heart of a row between China and Japan could quickly escalate to the danger point.

Headline: North Korea 'preparing for two nuclear tests'

Analysis of recent satellite images has shown new activity on the southern edge of the Punggye-ri nuclear test site, while preparations at a second tunnel to the west were apparently completed earlier, a South Korean government source told the Chosun Ilbo newspaper. The paper quoted a military official as saying, "There is a chance that the southern tunnel is a decoy, but we are not ruling out that the regime will conduct nuclear tests simultaneously at both tunnels." North Korea is preparing to carry out two nuclear tests, either simultaneously or in rapid succession, to demonstrate to the world the advances it has made in its weapons programme, according to intelligence reports.

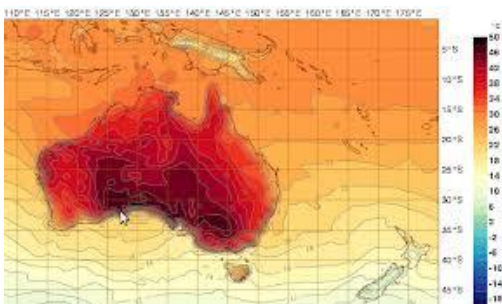

On Monday a group of 42 religious groups will publish a half-page ad in USA Today calling on the Scouts to resist political and economic pressures to lift the ban. The group is taking out a major advertising buy tomorrow denouncing the Scouts' decision to consider changing their longstanding policy prohibiting openly gay Scout leaders or Scouts. "To the Boy Scouts of America: Show courage," the advertisement read. "Stand firm for timeless values." The Supreme Court upheld the Boy Scouts' rights to determine their own membership standards – but that hasn't stopped opponents from putting fierce pressure on the group. Feb. 3, 2013

Headline: **Australia's Bureau of Meteorology says January 2013, was hottest on record**

The Bureau of Meteorology said both the average mean temperature of 29.68 degrees Celsius (85.42 degrees Fahrenheit) and the average mean maximum temperature of 36.92 Celsius surpassed previous records set in January 1932. The nation's central outback sweltered under a "dome" of heat for much of the month, with the Northern Territory posting its hottest mean temperature on record for January of 31.93 Celsius, the bureau said. "The heat-wave in the first half of January was exceptional in its extent and duration," it said in a statement released Friday. "The national average maximum temperature on 7 January was the highest on record. Numerous stations set records for the most days in succession above 40 degrees Celsius, including Alice Springs (17 days) and Birdsville (31 days)." The bureau said a large number of weather stations set all-time record high temperatures during the heat-wave, including Sydney (45.8 Celsius on January 18) and Hobart (41.8 Celsius on January 4). The highest temperature recorded during the heat-wave was at Moomba in South Australia, which hit a scorching 49.6 Celsius on 12 January.

Headline: 6.9 Earthquake Strikes Japan

An earthquake of preliminary magnitude 6.9 struck the northern island of Hokkaido, Japan today, according to the U.S. Geological Survey (USGS). As of this writing, there were no reports of significant damage and no tsunami was expected. The temblor's epicenter was 68 miles (109 km) from Kushiro and 525 miles (844 km) North-Northeast of Tokyo. It originated deep within the Earth's crust, the USGS reports. Earlier reports had put the quake at magnitude 6.4. The USGS frequently updates the magnitude of an event after more data is analyzed.

Headline: Earthquake jolts Baguio City

Classes in some elementary schools here were cut short on Monday afternoon after a magnitude 4.5 earthquake shook the city at 3:16 p.m. Reports from the Office of Civil Defense (OCD) in the Cordillera said information relayed by the Philippine Institute of Volcanology and Seismology (Phivolcs) showed that the earthquake's epicenter was located 13 kilometers southeast of Baguio. The OCD said the earthquake was felt at Intensity 5 in Baguio City. It was also felt at Intensity 2 in La Union. Electric wires in Baguio swayed as the ground shook for at least five seconds. The OCD had not received any report of earthquake-related casualty or damage at 3:30 p.m.

Headline: Indonesia's Paluweh volcano ejects a 43,000 ft ash cloud

A large ash plume rising to 43,000 ft (about 13 km) altitude and extending 175 nautical miles to the south was spotted last night by VAAC Darwin. The likely cause is either a major dome collapse triggering a large pyroclastic flow or a vulcanian explosion of the lava dome. According to the first local press reports, an explosion occurred at the volcano last night at 23:36 local time. People from the north coast of Flores (17 km distance to the south) reported having heard rumbling and detonation sounds and seen incandescent lava ejections. A cloud of ash drifted over Flores and deposited about half a millimeter of fine ash in areas of the north coast. People were advised to stay home and wear dust masks. No reports were found about the situation on Palueh Island itself. The aviation alert level of the volcano was raised to Red.

The Bahraini uprising against the Al Khalifa rule in the Persian Gulf island began in February 2011. The regime promptly

launched a brutal crackdown on peaceful protests and called in Saudi-led Arab forces from neighboring states.

Headline: **Chilling Video: Thousands of Neo-Nazis March Through Athens**

Tens of thousands of neo-Nazis rallied in Athens in support of Greece's far-right Golden Dawn party, in the movement's largest demonstration of support since its rise to power in last June's general election. Men dressed in military uniforms, holding torches, donning swastikas and chanting anti-immigrant slogans, marched through central Athens in what was reportedly a memorial event paying tribute to the party's "fallen soldiers," *The International Business Times* reported. "This is a day of remembrance. It's a day to remember that Golden Dawn is here to stay. And so long as it does, there will be hope for the country," Golden Dawn spokesman Ilias Kassidiaris told supporters. Hundreds of riot police and security officials were deployed to the scene of the march, which took place near the prime minister's office and the Turkish embassy in Athens, according to *The Times*.

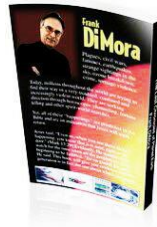
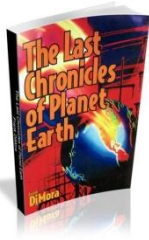
Headline: **Bangladeshis hold demo to demand release of jailed leaders**

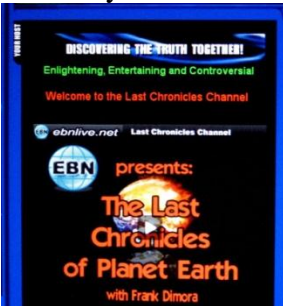
