Obama 'wants to host Netanyahu-Abbas meeting during visit' **Headline**:

Abbas welcomes Obama visit, looks to new U.S. policy in the region **Headline**:

President Barack Obama is to visit Israel, the Palestinian territories and Jordan in the next few weeks, at the heart of a wider tour of the Middle East. Israeli television broke news of the trip on Tuesday night, and said the White House had confirmed it would take place next month or in April, and that the details were agreed by Obama and Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu in a January 28 phone call. Meanwhile. US President Barack Obama wants to host a summit between Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu and Palestinian Authority President Mahmoud Abbas during his visit here this spring, Deputy Foreign Minister Danny Ayalon said Wednesday. Ayalon said he was "certain" that efforts to arrange such a meeting were already under way. Interviewed on Army Radio, Ayalon said that Obama plainly would not be visiting Israel unless it was already clear that the visit would mark some kind of substantive agreement. A three-way Obama-Netanyahu-Abbas meeting would presumably mark a resumption of peace negotiations.

White House: Obama will not bring a new peace plan with him to Israel Headline:

The White House said on Wednesday that U.S. President Barack Obama, who will be visiting Israel next month, does not plan on bringing a new peace initiative with him to the region. Obama will be making his first trip to Israel since taking the office in 2009. White House spokesman Jay Carney said in a briefing to reporters on Wednesday that Obama's trip is not connected to any restarting of Middle East peace talks between Israel and the Palestinians. During the briefing, Carney was asked whether Obama, during his trip, would press Israel to halt settlement construction. Carney did not answer the question, saying only that the U.S. president expects to discuss with Israeli leaders the issues of a nuclear Iran and the situation in Syria, adding that at this stage, it was too early to know exactly what would happen at the meeting, which would take place in a few weeks.

The Syrian army said on January 30 that two people were killed and five others injured in an Israeli airstrike on a research center in Jamraya, near the capital, Damascus. The speakers condemned the airstrike during telephone conversations with Iran's Majlis Speaker Ali Larijani.

Headline: Obama to visit Jordan in Spring

US President Barack Obama plans to visit Jordan and the West Bank as part of an upcoming trip the region that will take him to Israel, White House spokesman Jay Carney told reporters on Tuesday. Earlier, Carney confirmed Obama would travel to Israel in the spring, his first trip to Israel since taking office. While the White House gave no exact dates for the trip, Israel's Channel 10 television station cited unnamed sources in Washington saying Obama would start his visit to Israel on March 20. The choice of Israel, a close US ally, for Obama's first foreign travel since his January 21 inauguration will give the president and Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu a chance to try to repair their notoriously fractious relationship.

The U.S. State Department has told Egypt it is "extremely disturbed" by the video of Egyptian police brutally beating and dragging a naked activist near the presidential palace as the Muslim Brotherhood makes the Obama administration's enthusiastic welcome of the regime more problematic. While the State Dept, omitted any terms such as "outrage" or "barbaric" in order not to offend Cairo, Egyptian media reported there have been at least two death-by-torture incidents. Many others are "missing." The State. Dept. was "extremely disturbed" only after a video was shown of the beating of the naked activist, Hamda Saber, but there has been no lack of evidence of previous brutality, similar if not worse than that imposed by Mubarak's police force. More than 60 people were killed in clashes against the Morsi regime the past several weeks. Feb. 5, 2013



Headline: Syrian opposition leader demands women prisoners' release

Arab League chief Nabil al-Arabi on Tuesday backed a call by the leader of Syria's main opposition group for talks with the Damascus regime aimed at ending nearly 23 months of bloodshed in the country, *AFP* reported. Arabi also offered to play a role in any negotiations for a democratic transition in Syria, where tens of thousands of people have been killed in the fighting between rebels and President Bashar al-Assad's forces. According to *AFP*, he expressed hope that "the Syrian government would respond positively to the proposal" made by Ahmed Moaz al-Khatib, saying it would "take advantage of every opportunity to break the cycle of violence and to end the bloodshed." Headline: Iran's Ahmadinejad seeks strategic axis with Egypt Headline: Iran says ready to lend Egypt much-needed funds

With Iranian President Mahmoud Ahmadinejad making an ice-breaking visit to Egypt after 34 years of estrangement, the two-day meeting is focusing on how to stop bloodshed in Syria, where Tehran is one of President Bashar al-Assad's last allies. Mursi embraced Ahmadinejad and gave him a red-carpet airport welcome on the Iranian leader's arrival on Tuesday, but his foreign minister hastened to assure Gulf Arab states that Egypt would not sacrifice their security in opening to Tehran. Diplomats and analysts doubt that full diplomatic relations, broken after Iran's 1979 Islamic Revolution and Egypt's peace treaty with Israel in the same year, will be restored soon. Underlying tensions between the majority Sunni Muslims and the minority Shi'ites burst into the open on Tuesday when Ahmadinejad met Egypt's leading Muslim scholar and received a public scolding over Iran's approach to Sunni Arab nations.

Headline: Four dead in attacks on Iraq security forces

Attacks targeting security forces across Iraq left three policemen and an army officer dead on Wednesday, officials said, amid a spike in unrest as the country grapples with a political crisis. Two policemen were shot dead and three others were wounded by gunmen at a checkpoint in the town of Mussayib, south of Baghdad, while one police officer was killed and another hurt by gunfire in the main northern city of Mosul. North of Baghdad in the town of Tuz Khurmatu, an army lieutenant colonel was killed and another officer was wounded by a roadside bomb while on patrol, officials said. And in the capital, four people, including one policeman, were wounded by a roadside bomb targeting a police patrol.

Headline: Russia Starts Kuril Islands Exercises

Russia has started large-scale military exercises in the disputed Kuril Islands in the country's far east, a military official said on Tuesday. The Kuril Islands, known to neighboring Japan as the Northern Territories, are a contentious issue in Russian-Japanese relations. The exercises are taking place just

two days before Japan marks its Northern Territories Day on February 7. The exercises have included cooperation between Russian Pacific Fleet ships, tactical fighter aviation and artillery as well as border guard personnel based in the islands area, eastern military district spokesman Alexander Gordeyev told reporters on Tuesday. "In particular, the exercises will practice a special operation aimed at helping a vessel in distress in Russian waters," Gordeyev said. He did not specifiy which of the islands was involved in the exercises.

A Tunisian opposition leader critical of the Islamist-led government was gunned down as he left home Wednesday in the first assassination in post-revolutionary Tunisia, setting off anti-government riots that left downtown Tunis choked with tear gas and patrolled by armored vehicles. Police used tear gas to disperse thousands of protesters who assembled in front of the Interior Ministry in the center of the capital to accuse the government of allowing the assassination to happen. At one point, an ambulance carrying Belaid's body drove in front of the ministry accompanied by protesters before they, too, were forced away.

Headline: Netherlands AAA Outlook Cut as Fitch Cites Shocks to Economy

The Netherlands had the outlook on its top credit rating cut to negative by Fitch Ratings as the Dutch economy suffers from a deepening housing slump and persistent bank system woes. The ratings company maintained the country's grade at AAA while removing its designation as stable, according to a statement released yesterday in London. As reasons for the move, it cited the level of public debt, problems at some Dutch banks and a property-market slump which may shave a total of 25 percent off values from their peak. "The outlook revision to negative from stable reflects Fitch's view that the leveraged Dutch economy has suffered a number of shocks," it said. Investors often ignore ratings, evidenced by the rally in Treasuries after the U.S. lost its top grade at S&P in 2011. The action by Fitch comes days after the country took control of its fourth-biggest lender, SNS Reaal NV, for 3.7 billion euros (\$5 billion). While that alone isn't enough to trigger a downgrade, Fitch said the move will add 1.6 percentage points to public debt this year, reaching a total of 74.4 percent of gross domestic product.

The number of American workers collecting federal disability payments climbed to yet another record high of 8,830,026 in January, up from 8,827,795 in December, according to newly released data from the Social Security Administration. This is the 192nd straight month that the number of American workers collecting federal disability payments has increased. The last time the number of Americans collecting disability decreased was in January 1997. That month the number of workers taking disability dropped by 249 people—from 4,385,623 in December 1996 to 4,385,374 in January 1997. Feb. 5, 2013

Headline: By This Fall You Won't Be Getting Your Saturday Mail Anymore

The U.S. Postal Service will stop delivering mail on Saturdays but continue to deliver packages six days a week under a plan aimed at saving about \$2 billion, the financially struggling agency says. In an announcement scheduled for later Wednesday, the service is expected to say the Saturday mail cutback would begin in August. It was not immediately clear how the service could eliminate Saturday mail without congressional approval. But the agency clearly thinks it has a majority of the American public on its side regarding the change.

Headline: Virginia advances bill pushing for state to establish its own currency

Virginia is one step closer to breaking ties with the country's monetary system. A proposal to study whether the state should adopt its own currency is gaining traction in the state legislature from a number of lawmakers as well as conservative economists. The state House voted 65-32 earlier this week to approve the measure, and it will now go to the Senate. While it's unlikely that Virginia will be printing its own money any time soon, the move sheds light on the growing distrust surrounding the nation's central bank. Four other states are considering similar proposals. In 2011, Utah passed a law that recognizes gold and silver coins issued by the federal government as tender and requires a study on adopting other forms of legal currency.

Headline: North Korea Releases 'US Nuclear Attack' Video

North Korea has threatened to go beyond carrying out its promised third nuclear test, KCNA state news agency reported. "The DPRK (Democratic Peoples Republic of Korea, or North Korea) has drawn a final conclusion that it will have to take a measure stronger than a nuclear test to cope with the hostile forces' nuclear war moves that have become ever more undisguised," the media agency said. Pyongyang did not spell out which actions it would take. It comes after sanctions were placed on North Korea by the UN Security Council, following a December long-range rocket launch. The launch was in violation of UN resolutions which banned the country from developing missile or nuclear technology after nuclear tests in 2006 and 2009. Feb. 5, 2013

Japan's prime minister has called the decision by a Chinese frigate to put a radar lock on a Japanese navy ship a "dangerous act". Shinzo Abe told parliament the move could have led to an "unpredictable situation" and called for Chinese "self-restraint". The incident happened near disputed East China Sea islands last week. The Chinese foreign ministry said it was not aware of the details, but said Japan should stop "illegal" activities. "In recent days, Japan has on many occasions deployed aircraft and ships and illegally entered Chinese waters around the Diaoyu Islands," spokeswoman Hua Chunying said.

Headline: Welfare, food stamp recipients could soon be required to get microchipped with RFID tags

For at least the past 15 years, the U.S. *Department of Agriculture* (USDA) has been actively trying to develop new ways to decrease fraud in the federal food stamp program, which currently covers nearly 50 million Americans and adds more than 10,000 new enrollees to its ranks every single day, according to reports. But one disconcerting method the agency appears to be considering involves the potential use of radio frequency identification (RFID) chips to track and identify food stamp recipients at the national level. Two separate reports quietly issued by the USDA's Food and Nutrition Service program back in 1999 reveal that the agency's ultimate goal is to develop new tracking protocols that will supposedly improve the integrity of the food stamp program, also known as the Supplemental Assistance Nutrition Program (SNAP). In both of these reports, the USDA explains how novel biometric identification technologies can help better verify the identities of food stamp recipients, and thus decrease fraud and "double-dipping."

The slowly-unfolding explosion also hurled two CMEs into space. The clouds are not heading directly for Earth, but they could deliver glancing blows to our planet's magnetic field on Feb. 9-10. Headline: Pakistan rain and storms kill dozens

At least 32 people have been killed and dozens more injured after three days of heavy rain and storms in Pakistan, officials say. Most of the deaths were in the north of the country, where roofs caved in and houses collapsed, killing several children. Six members of one family are reported to have been swept away by floodwaters. In places more rain fell in three days than would normally fall in the entire month of February. At least 25 people were killed in the north-western Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province. There were reports of three soldiers missing in an avalanche in the district of Lower Dir. Officials say more bad weather is expected in the middle of the month, but it is not likely to be as destructive as the storms this week.

Headline: France wants U.N. peacekeeping force for Mali by April

Hundreds of al-Qaeda-linked fighters have been killed since the beginning of French military operation in northern Mali, France's defence minister has said. Jean-Yves Le Drian, the defence minister, said on wednesday that the 26-day military intervention had killed "several hundred" rebel fighters as its air and ground forces chased them from their northern strongholds into remote mountainous terrain in the far northeast, near the Algerian border. The defence ministry said the fighters died in French air strikes on vehicles transporting fighters and equipment, and in "direct combat in Konna and Gao", key central and northern towns. France's sole fatality so far has been a helicopter pilot who was killed at the start of the military operation. Mali said 11 of its troops were killed and 60 wounded after the battle at Konna last month but has not since released a new death toll.



Headline: Protests hit Bangladesh after war crimes verdict

Police and protesters clashed for the second day Wednesday after the conviction of a powerful politician in connection with killings during the country's 1971 independence war. More than two dozen small homemade bombs also exploded in the country's north, but there were no reports of injuries. Local news reports said at least 10 people were hurt Wednesday in clashes outside Dhaka, a day after the latest verdict was announced in a series of controversial war crimes trials. Street battles across the country Tuesday killed as many as four people and injured dozens more. The clashes came after Bangladesh's largest Islamic party, Jamaat-e-Islami, ordered a nationwide general strike, shutting down schools and shops, to protest the conviction and life sentence given its leader, Abdul Quader Mollah.
