Headline: 'Nothing can save Israel from destruction'

A senior member of Iran's parliament on Saturday vowed that no amount of offensive or defensive capabilities will save Israel from destruction at the hands of its Muslim neighbors. Speaking to Iranian media, MP Abbasali Mansouri Arani scoffed at efforts to bolster Israel's northern defenses with Iron Dome and American-made Patriot anti-missile batteries. "The US seeks, in every possible manner, to prevent the destruction of the cancerous tumor it has created in the region in order to fulfill its own ominous interests," said Arani, who serves on the Iranian parliament's National Security and Foreign Policy Committee. The lawmaker stated that the Muslim nations of the Middle East remain resolved to destroy the Jewish state, and will eventually succeed.

Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu said on Monday that new centrifuges Iran was installing for its uranium enrichment program could cut by a third the time needed to create a nuclear bomb. As Iran and world powers prepare to resume talks aimed at easing a dispute that has raised fears of a new Middle East war, Tehran announced late last month it planned to install the new machines at its main enrichment plant. The move underlined Iran's defiance of international demands to scale back the uranium enrichment which Tehran says is for civilian purposes but which could also potentially be used to make material for atomic bombs.

Headline: Netanyahu stands by 2-state solution

Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu on Monday reaffirmed his commitment to the two-state solution ahead of US President Barack Obama's visit in Israel. Addressing the Conference of Presidents of Major American Jewish Organizations in Jerusalem's Inbal Hotel, Netanyahu said he still stands by his 2009 Bar-Ilan speech where he backed the concept of two states for two peoples. "I believe that a framework to peace (with the Palestinians) is what I outlined in my speech in Bar-Ilan University – two states for two peoples: A demilitarized Palestinian state that recognizes the Jewish state." He nevertheless stressed that there should be no pre-conditions to negotiations and called for a

resumption of talks. "To reach this solution means to negotiate in good faith. That means you don't place preconditions. For the past four years the Palestinians regrettably place preconditions, time after time. My hope is that they leave them aside and get to the negotiating table," he said. Feb. 11, 2013

Headline: US Secy of State Fights for \$700 Million in Aid to PA

U.S. Secretary of State John Kerry is fighting to send the Palestinian Authority nearly \$700 million in aid, despite major budget cuts and a fierce debate over where existing money should go. "The Secretary feels extremely strongly that it is time now to get this support to the Palestinian Authority," said State Department spokeswoman Victoria Nuland. Most of the funds – some \$495.7 million – were already set aside for the PA in fiscal 2012, which ended on October 1. However, a request for an additional \$200 million, appropriated for fiscal 2013, was sent to the Congress last week, Nuland said.

Headline: Clashes break out in Syrian refugee camp in Jordan Headline: Six Jordanian 'jihadists' killed in Syria

Jordanian security forces have fired teargas to disperse Syrian refugees protesting poor living and health conditions at a camp in northern Jordan. The Jordanian police claimed that seven aid workers were injured when they were attacked by dozens of angry refugees with sticks and stones while distributing bread for breakfast in the Zaatari camp on Tuesday. The police further claimed that the clashes started after the Syrian refugees, who were frustrated because cold winds had swept away their tents and torrential rains had flooded muddy streets, tried to attack the storehouse of a charity center, which was distributing aid. Meanwhile, six Jordanian nationals have been killed while fighting alongside jihadist forces in Syria, Islamist sources say, as a growing number of Jordanians take up arms to wage a "holy war" against the Damascus regime.

Senior Israeli officials have warned of an impending conflict in closed-door meetings in Washington, D.C., sources said.

Egyptians protest on second anniversary of toppling of Mubarak's regime Clashes Break Out Outside Presidential Palace in Cairo Egypt: Hundreds of police stage rare protests Headline:

Security forces sprayed protesters with water hoses and tear gas outside the presidential palace as Egyptians marked the second anniversary of the fall of autocrat Hosni Mubarak with angry demonstrations against his elected successor. The forces were trying to disperse a small crowd of protesters on Monday evening, after some of them attempted to cross a barbed wire barrier meant to block them from the palace gate. Some protesters chanted: "The people want to bring down the regime." Others threw stones. Graffiti scribbled on the palace walls read: "Erhal" or "Leave," the chant that echoed through Cairo's central Tahrir Square during the 18-day uprising that ended with Mubarak stepping down on Feb. 11, 2011. Earlier, masked men briefly blocked trains at a central Cairo subway station and a dozen other protesters blocked traffic with burning tires on a main overpass in Cairo. Hundreds rallied outside the office of the country's chief prosecutor, demanding justice and retribution for protesters killed in clashes with security forces after Islamist President Mohammed Morsi took office last summer.



Headline: U.N. chief urges Assad to accept peace talks, Assad vows to fight on

U.N. Secretary General Ban Ki-moon urged the government of Syrian President Bashar al-Assad to accept an opposition offer of peace talks, hours after Assad himself vowed to fight on. Ban referred to an offer for talks by National Coalition leader Ahmed Moaz al-Khatib as "an opportunity we should not miss -- a chance to switch from a devastating military logic to a promising political approach." "This was a courageous offer by Mr. al-Khatib," he said in a speech Monday at the Council on Foreign Relations, urging both the Syrian government and the Security Council to "respond positively." Earlier Monday, however, Assad said he would not bow to mounting pressure and "plots, "state news agency SANA reported." Syria will remain the beating heart of the Arab world and will not give up its principles despite the intensifying pressure and diversifying plots not only targeting Syria, but all Arabs," Assad said.

Headline: Syrian opposition prepares for push on eastern city of Deir al-Zor Headline: Syria crisis: Rebels 'seize northern air base'

Syrian opposition fighters are launching a major operation to take control of the strategic eastern city of Deir al-Zor after pushing out government forces from oil-producing areas around it, a rebel commander told Reuters. If they seize the city, the rebels will control a whole province for the first time in the 22-month-old Syrian uprising against President Bashar al-Assad.

Ibrahim Abu Baker, leader of the powerful Al-Qadisiyah Brigade, said his rebel force, along with Islamists from Jabhat al-Nusra and Arab fighters, had surrounded Deir al-Zor on four sides in the build-uptotheoperation. "The countryside is liberated, what is left of the province (of Deir al-Zor) is the city itself," he told Reuters from the province via Skype. "All brigades are taking part in this... We are in charge of the eastern side of the city." Meanwhile, Syrian rebels have captured a military air base near the northern city of Aleppo, activists say. Fighters took control of al-Jarrah base after days of clashes there with security forces, reports said. The reported capture comes a day after rebels in the north-east overran Syria biggest hydro-electric dam, delivering a strategic blow to the government. Feb. 12, 2013

Headline: Turkish jets bomb PKK bases in northern Iraq

Turkish fighter jets bombed targets of the outlawed Kurdish Workers' Party (PKK) in northern Iraq on Tuesday, private Dogan news agency reported. Eight Turkish F-16 jets took off from Diyarbakir airbase in southeastern Turkey at around 11:00 a.m. local time (0800 GMT), and struck the PKK targets in Qandil, Zap and Basyan regions in Iraq over initial intelligence gathered by unarmed aerial observation flights. Turkish military determined that PKK members had tried to flee the regions, which were once bombed by Turkish jets. The air operation took two hours, during which several hideouts, training bases and antiaircraft weapons were destroyed, the report said. The Turkish jets have safely returned to their bases after completing the mission, according to the report. Feb. 12, 2013

Headline: The coming struggle for Iraq in the ongoing Iran-Saudi regional war

A suicide car bomber and unidentified gunmen killed at least 12 people in the Iraqi city of Mosul on Monday, police and hospital sources said, as sectarian and ethnic tensions build ahead of elections in April. The bomber drove a vehicle packed with explosives up to a military checkpoint in Mosul, 390 km (240 miles) north of Baghdad, and detonated it, killing eight people and wounding 18, among them soldiers. "The blast destroyed everything. It looks like there was nothing here before the explosion," said a policeman at the scene who declined to be identified because he was not authorized to speak to the media. In a separate incident in Mosul, gunmen using silenced weapons killed the bodyguard of a Kurdish member of the city's provincial council and three others, police said. Feb. 11, 2013

Ezekiel (Yechezk'el) War Headline: South Sudan accuses Sudan of troops build-up on border

South Sudan on Tuesday accused Sudan of building up forces along their border, in a sign that efforts to set up a buffer zone between the neighbors and resume the oil exports vital to both economies have made no progress. The two countries came close to war last April in the worst border clashes since South Sudan seceded in 2011 under a peace agreement that ended one of Africa's longest civil wars. The African Union brokered a deal in September to defuse hostilities. But the nations have failed set up a demilitarized border zone and resume oil exports from the landlocked South Sudan through Sudanese pipelines, as agreed in Addis Ababa. Such a buffer zone is a precondition for Sudan to allow oil exports to restart. Juba shut down its output of 350,000 barrels a day a year ago in a row with Khartoum over pipeline fees. "The last two months have seen an unusual build-up of forces along our common border with the Republic of Sudan," South Sudan's deputy defense minister Majak D'Agoot told reporters in the capital Juba on Tuesday, without giving any numbers.

Headline: Libya to close borders during revolt anniversary

Libya will close its borders with Egypt and Tunisia for four days from Thursday as it marks the second anniversary of the start of the revolution that ousted dictator Moamer Kadhafi, officials said. Prime Minister Ali Zeidan said international flights will also be suspended at all airports except for those of the capital Tripoli and second city Benghazi in the east, the official Lana news agency reported on Tuesday. The "preventive" measures were decided after repeated calls for protests to be held nationwide, including some who have demanded a "second revolution" in protest at what they say is the new Libyan rulers' failure to push for reforms.

Headline: Tunisia: Crisis Deepens as President's Party Rejects Government Plan

The Tunisian Congress for the Republic (CPR) party, led by President Moncef Marzouki has decided to stay in the ruling coalition for another week, but maintained its call for key Islamist ministers to resign. Marzouki's secular party had threatened to pull out of the Islamist-led government, which would have plunged the country deeper into political crisis. However, in a press conference yesterday party chief Mohamed Abbou told reporters "We have decided to freeze our decision to withdraw our ministers from the government, but if in one week we don't see any changes, we will quit the government." The CPR wants the resignation of the justice and foreign ministers from Prime Minister Hamadi Jebali's Islamist party Ennahda, amid soaring political tension after the killing leftist opposition figure Chokri Belaid. Headline: Deal near on eurozone economic governance laws, says Rehn

MEPs and ministers are on the verge of agreement on far-reaching economic governance proposals for eurozone states, according to EU economic commissioner Olli Rehn. The proposals give the commission more powers to scrutinise national budgets and demand changes to national debt and deficit reduction programmes. Speaking with reporters after a meeting of euro finance ministers on Monday (11 February), Rehn said that "a positive conclusion ... is within reach." He added that the files are "important in their own right, but also because they are an essential foundation for further progress in rebuilding our economic and monetary union."



Headline: Gas prices hit a historic high: What's driving them up?

A combination of high crude prices, refinery shutdowns, and early speculation has sent gas prices soaring to seasonal highs earlier than usual this year, with no signs of prices at the pump falling until spring, according to recent estimates. Gas prices have climbed every day for the past 25 days, reaching a national average of \$3.59 per gallon Monday, the most expensive national average ever for Feb. 11, according to AAA. During just the past two weeks, average prices have climbed almost 25 cents, the biggest jump in gas prices in almost a year. "This is a very early rise," says Tom Kloza, chief oil analyst at the Oil Price Information Service. "January has tended to be a quiet month through the years, but the rally really began in earnest around Jan. 15."

Headline: Job Openings in U.S. Dropped in December From Four-Year High

Here's a stat you rarely (if ever) hear about: The three-month delayed figure regarding food stamp and disability enrollment. Why do you suppose this number goes largely unreported? Could it have anything to do with the fact that it may reflect poorly on Washington? Headline: Ratings agency Moody's lowers Egypt bond rating on civil unrest

International credit ratings agency Moody's downgraded Egypt's government bond ratings from B2 to B3 on Tuesday. The downgrade was due to the recent escalation of civil unrest in the country, highlighted by violent clashes between protesters and security forces in recent weeks resulting in many deaths, the agency said in a statement. The deterioration in the security situation in Egypt pushed President Mohamed Morsi to declare a temporary state of emergency in three Egyptian Suez Canal governorates on 27 January. The global firm also linked the rating cut to the continuing weakening of Egypt's net international reserves

North Korea declared Tuesday that it had carried out a test of a nuclear bomb after the detonation was detected by the U.S. Geological Survey. The explosion was registered as a 5.1-magnitude seismic event by the USGS at 9:57 p.m. ET Monday. The U.S. Office of the Director of National Intelligence said in a statement that the "intelligence community" was aware of "a seismic event with explosive characteristics in North Korea and we are evaluating all relevant information." In a statement, President Barack Obama described the test as a "highly provocative act." He said that -- following a "ballistic missile launch" by North Korea on Dec. 12 -- the test "undermines regional stability, violates North Korea's obligations under numerous United Nations Security Council resolutions, contravenes its [international] commitments ... and increases the risk of proliferation." Headline: Doctors Struggling to Fight 'Totally Drug-Resistant' Tuberculosis in South Africa

Headline: World could face outbreak of 'virtually untreatable' TB after deadly strain is discovered in South Africa

A new paper published earlier this week in the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's *Emerging Infectious Diseases* journal warns that the first cases of "totally drug-resistant" tuberculosis have been found in South Africa and that the disease is "virtually untreatable." Like many bacterial diseases, tuberculosis has been evolving to fend off many effective antibiotics, making it more difficult to treat. But even treatable forms of the disease are particularly tricky to cure; drug sensitive strains must be treated with a six-month course of antibiotics. Tougher cases require long-term hospitalization and a regimen of harsh drugs that can last years.

The patients were identified as a 21-year-old woman and a 31-year-old man, who developed symptoms Feb. 2 and Feb 3, respectively. "They are in critical condition and medical workers are carrying out emergency treatment," the ministry said in a statement. "No epidemiological connections have been found between the two cases." The ministry said an investigation found o evidence the two had contact with fowl before they fell ill. The human-infected highly pathogenic avian influenza is an acute respiratory infectious disease that frequently results in death. The main symptoms are high fever and pneumonia.

Headline: Pentagon extends benefits to same-sex couples

The Pentagon has officially extended some military benefits to same-sex partners, but said provisions such as medical coverage would not be offered to gay troops' spouses due to legal barriers. US Defence Secretary Leon Panetta, who is due to retire this month, said the decision stemmed from the repeal 17 months ago of a ban on openly gay recruits serving in the military. "It is a matter of fundamental equity that we provide similar benefits to all of those men and women in uniform who serve their country," Panetta said in a statement. "Today, I am pleased to announce that after a thorough and deliberate review, the department will extend additional benefits to same-sex partners of service members." The move, which defence officials had signaled last week, will provide same-sex partners with military identity cards, hospital visitation rights, access to youth and education

programmes and financial compensation in the event their military spouse dies, a Pentagon memo said. Panetta acknowledged that federal law, which defines marriage as between a man and a woman, remained an obstacle to extending the full array of military benefits. Feb. 12, 2013

France's lower house of parliament has approved a sweeping bill to legalize gay marriage and allow same-sex couples to adopt children. The Yemen-based offshoot of AI Qaeda urged Muslims to sacrifice themselves and their money to help fend off what it called the "Crusader war" in Mali, according to a statement posted online on Tuesday. France intervened in Mali last month to combat Islamist forces who seized control of the north of the country that followed a military coup in March 2012. AI Qaeda in the Arabian Peninsula (AQAP) compared the French intervention to what it called the "Zionist occupation of Palestine". 
