Headline: **Missile Attack Simulation in All Israeli Schools**

The Home Front Command and Education Ministry are carrying out a simulation of a missile attack in the nation's schools this morning (Thursday). The exercise will help authorities assess the level of readiness of each educational institution in the country, including those in both the public and religious sectors. The drill, set to launch at 10:00 a.m., is expected to last till about 12:00 noon, and begins with the wail of the Color Red rocket alert siren to simulate a missile attack during recess. The siren will sound for 90 seconds, and will be heard across the country, officials said.

Headline: **UN 'Concerned' Over Hunger Striking Terrorists**

A United Nations official on Wednesday expressed concern about the well-being of Palestinian Authority Arab terrorist detainees in Israeli prisons and in particular about the condition of hunger striker Samer Issawi, *AFP* reports. A UN statement quoted in the report said that Humanitarian Coordinator James W. Rawley met in Ramallah with the PA's prisoner affairs minister, Issa Qaraqe. During the meeting, Rawley "expressed the United Nations' continued concern about Palestinian detainees in Israeli custody," according to the statement. "They discussed the situation of four Palestinian detainees currently on hunger strike and, in particular, the critical health condition of one Palestinian detainee, Samer Issawi, who has been on hunger strike for more than 200 days," it said, according to *AFP*.

Headline: **Vatican says no deal with Israel over Jerusalem Muslim shrine**

Minister of Awqaf and Islamic Affairs Abdul Salam Abbadi on Wednesday refuted claims that Israel has granted the Pope an "official seat" at a Muslim shrine believed to be the venue of Jesus' Last Supper. In a statement, Abbadi cited a phone conversation between the director of Awqaf Department in Jerusalem and the Vatican's representative in the Holy City, during which the envoy categorically denied that such a deal took place. Israeli media reported that the "historic agreement" between Israel and the Vatican was endorsed on January 29. It also include tax exemptions for Catholic institutions in Jerusalem. The Last Supper Hall is located in the upper floor of Prophet Daoud (David) Mosque, a key Muslim shrine in Jerusalem. According to the statement, the envoy told the

awqaf official, Azzam Khatib, that the issue would be discussed with the government of Jordan, which has jurisdiction over Islamic sites, under a 1994 peace treaty with Israel.

Headline: Japan hosts East Asian talks on Palestinian aid

Palestinian Prime Minister Salam Fayyad urged East Asian donors Thursday to share their wealth and knowledge for nation-building efforts in his troubled region. "We find your experience in East Asia highly inspiring," he told a Tokyo conference, citing the way countries in the region have moved away from reliance on overseas aid and become economic powers. The Conference on Cooperation among East Asian Countries for Palestinian Development (CEPAD) is jointly hosted by Japan and the Palestinian Authority. It is the first time East Asian nations have gathered in support of Palestinians, to try to improve the efficiency of development aid programmes for the region. The meeting drew ministers and senior officials from Brunei, Indonesia, Malaysia, Thailand, Singapore, South Korea, Vietnam, the United Nations, the World Bank, the UN Relief and Works Agency, the Islamic Development Bank and the Arab League.

Headline: Iranian Revolutionary Guards Commander Shot Dead In Syria

Iranian news media on Thursday were full of reports that Israeli forces have killed a senior Iranian official. According to the report, "Zionists" assassinated Commander Haj Hassan Shateri, a member of the Revolutionary Guards who was in charge of Iranian construction efforts in Lebanon. Shateri reportedly oversaw reconstruction in south Lebanon after the 2006 Israel-Hizbullah war. He had returned to Iran, but was on a visit to Lebanon this week when he was allegedly killed. According to a report on Al Jazeera, Shateri landed in Damascus this week and traveled towards Beirut. At one point, while he was still in Syrian territory, Shateri's vehicle was ambushed, and he was killed. Iran insisted that the killers were Mossad agents, either themselves Israelis or Syrian rebels "who are working on behalf of the Zionists."

Headline: Trial of al Qaeda plot suspects begins in Jordan

Eleven men went on trial on Thursday in a Jordanian military court accused of plotting to carry out suicide attacks in the capital, including on shopping malls and the U.S. Embassy, judicial sources said. The Jordanian defendants, all suspected supporters of al Qaeda, pleaded not guilty to charges of "possession of explosives and plotting to undertake terror attacks and infiltration across borders", the sources said. The prosecution said the cell had targeted major shopping malls in the capital and was planning a bombing campaign in the capital's affluent Abdoun neighborhood, where many foreign embassies are located. The indictment said the group planned to attack the embassy with mortar rounds and then blast its way inside with suicide bombs, but gave no further details.

Comment: *In neighboring Middle Eastern countries, trials of 'opposition activists' lead to protests, which has led in many cases to an uprising. Let's watch what happens*

Headline: Lebanon remembers Rafiq Hariri

Newly-appointed US Secretary of State John Kerry on Thursday reiterated Washington's support for the Special Tribunal for Lebanon probing the 2005 assassination of former Premier Rafiq Hariri and condemned the recent string of political assassination bids in the country. "Those who initiated the killing sought to undermine Lebanon's sovereignty and independence. This act of cold blooded mass murder sent shivers throughout the region," a State Department statement quoted him as saying on the 8th anniversary of the slain leader's death. "The United States reaffirms that we reject the use of assassination as a political tool by parties within or outside Lebanon," he added. "We support the work of the Special Tribunal for Lebanon to independently investigate and hold accountable those responsible for the assassination of Hariri and the others killed and injured on that tragic day."

Lebanon's Social Affairs Minister Wael Abu Faour presented the public with a dire warning regarding the repercussions that the Syrian refugee crisis could have on the country. "If the situation [does not improve], I am worried that we might be leading Lebanon toward social and economic self-destruction," Abu Faour was quoted as saying by the National News Agency on Thursday during a meeting he held with a delegation of European MPs. "The issue is no longer only about the Syrian

and Palestinian refugees, but is now concerned with Lebanon's stability, since the pressures that are being felt as a result of this crisis are beyond the national government's ability to [handle]."

Headline: Egypt government won't resign, says PM Qandil

Headline: ElBaradei investigated for 'encouraging violence at presidential palace'

Egyptian Prime Minister Hisham Qandil has quashed media reports that his government will resign and said he will push forward with his long-term goals. "Resignation at the present time of serious challenges would mean surrender," Qandil said on Wednesday during an interview with Mona El-Shazli on MBC Misr TV. Opposition groups and activists have been calling for the government's dismissal. Qandil voiced dissatisfaction with the government's performance in the areas of security and economics, which he attributed to high levels of political unrest. "I am not satisfied because I persistently seek improvement. Such dissatisfaction boils down to the high expectations the revolution created, which are higher than the ability of the state [to fulfil]," Qandil added. "The government has created 750,000 job opportunities, improved services for the poor, and integrated 3,000 informal economic institutions into the formal economy," he said. He went on to criticise the Egyptian media for "sparking off crises."

Syrian activists say rebels have captured a town and a nearby oil field after a three-day battle with regime forces in the energy-rich northeast. The director of the Britain-based activist group Syrian

Observatory for Human Rights, Rami Abdul-Rahman, said the rebels captured the town of Shadadah in the Hasaka province on Thursday. The fighters also took control of most of a nearby oil field, although there was still sporadic gunfire in the area, Abdul-Rahman said.

Headline: Fresh off of airport victory, Syrian defectors to form first 'air squadron'

Headline: Rebels shoot down two warplanes in northwest Syria

Fresh off the capture of a strategic military airport, Syrian rebels say they are set to form their first air squadron in a bid to add air power to the armed resistance's arsenal. According to rebel sources, Syrian air force defectors have agreed to return to the country to form the resistance's first "air squadron" in a bid to operate a fleet of fighter jets reportedly seized by the Free Syrian Army (FSA) on Tuesday. Some 35 former air force officers, pilots and technicians currently residing in Jordan and Turkey are set to form the squadron, defectors say, which is to operate under the umbrella of the FSA and the Higher Syrian Military Council. "We have been waiting for months to return to Syria and serve the revolution," said Abu Khaled Al Dimashqi, a 45-year-old former Syrian air force major general currently residing in Jordan. "We believe this is our chance."

Headline: New Syria peace plan circulated in UN: Saudi daily

A new peace plan for Syria, involving the creation of a senate to oversee a power transition, is currently making the rounds in the United Nations, Saudi newspaper Asharq Alawsat reported. The daily reported that it had obtained a copy of the plan aimed at ending Syria's 23-month conflict, saying that it had been drafted "under UN supervision". Members of the Syria-based opposition that is tolerated by the regime of President Bashar al-Assad took part in the drafting of the plan, the paper added. The draft does not elaborate on Assad's fate, though the West and opposition groups calling for his fall have said any talks should lead to his departure. The plan foresees the creation of a 140-member senate body tasked with leading the dialogue process between the regime and the opposition during a transitional phase, said Asharq al-Awsat.

Headline: Tehran Accuses Israel of Killing Top Iranian Official

Assailants shot dead a senior Iranian official in Syria while he was traveling by road towards the Lebanese capital overnight, the Iranian authorities said on Thursday. The Iranian embassy in Beirut said "armed terrorists" killed a man it identified as Hessam Khoshnevis, adding that he had been involved in reconstruction work in Lebanon. The Revolutionary Guards named the slain man as Hassan Shateri, a commander of the elite Iranian military unit, in a statement on its website that said he was killed while traveling from Damascus to Beirut. "Commander Hassan Shateri was martyred en route from Damascus to Beirut at the hands of Zionist regime mercenaries and backers," the force's spokesman Ramezan Sherif said in the statement.

Headline: Iran, IAEA Agree on 'Some Points' in Latest Talks

UN nuclear inspectors have seen a small number of advanced centrifuges at an uranium enrichment plant where Iran has said it will install and operate them, a diplomatic source said on Thursday. On Wednesday, Iran's atomic energy chief said it had started installing a new generation of machines for refining uranium at the Natanz plant, an announcement likely to annoy the West and complicate efforts to resolve a dispute over its nuclear work.

Headline: Arabs rap Iranian call for atomic talks to include Bahrain, Syria

Gulf Arab government dismissed as "interference" an Iranian suggestion that unrest in Syria and Bahrain be discussed at nuclear talks between world powers and Iran, accusing Tehran of constantly trying to destabilize some Arab states. The secretary general of the Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) said the bloc "categorically rejected" Iran's proposal, saying it was further evidence of Iranian meddling in the region, the Bahraini news agency BNA reported on Thursday. "This confirms Iran's clear interference in the domestic affairs of Arab countries, and its continuous efforts to destabilize the security of some of these Arab countries," Abdulatif al-Zayani was quoted as saying.

Arab popular uprisings since 2011 have kindled increased strife between Shi'ite and Sunni Muslims that Sunni-ruled Gulf states with restive Shi'ite communities blame on incitement from regional Shi'ite power Iran, which denies this.


Headline: Seven killed in fresh wave of terrorist attacks in Iraq

Seven Iraqi people have been killed in a fresh bout of terrorist attacks mostly targeting security forces, as violence once again picks up in the country. Gunmen killed two brothers on Thursday inside their home in the northern city of Mosul, in Nineveh Province. The victims were a police officer and a soldier - reportedly a bodyguard for Iraqi Parliament Speaker Osama al-Nujaifi.

In a separate incident also close to Mosul, a roadside bomb targeted a police patrol and killed two officers and wounded another. Just north of Baghdad, three people, including two anti-al-Qaeda militiamen, were killed and seven people wounded in separate shootings and bombings in Balad and Dujail. No group or individual has so far claimed responsibility for the attacks.

Headline: Russia may be drawn into resource wars in future – army chief

Russia may become drawn into military conflicts as world powers begin to vie for energy resources in the next two decades, said Valery Gerasimov, the head of the General Staff of the Russian Armed Forces. By 2030, the level of “existing and potential threats will significantly increase,” Gerasimov said during a security conference in Moscow, according to Interfax. Leading world powers will soon begin to struggle for fuel, energy and labor resources, as well as new markets in which to sell their goods; some powers will “actively use their military potential,” he explained. He also observed that the sphere of combat is moving away from traditional battlegrounds – such as land and sea – to aerospace and information. Conflict zones in North Africa and the Middle East point to such changes in the use of military force, the general said. The role of non-military instruments is also increasing, including information wars, secret operations and the use of the “protest potential of a population,” Gerasimov said, adding that such non-military means are often more effective than the use of military power.

Headline: Tunisians head abroad to perform jihad

The cradle of the Arab Spring is increasingly looking like the birthplace of jihadists. Long before Tunisia ousted its dictator and inspired the North African pro-democracy movement, the small, relatively prosperous country had the more dubious distinction of exporting Islamic militants. Now, as the country wrestles with the creation of a new government after the killing of a liberal opposition leader, experts say the flow of fighters is getting worse. The repressive measures of the old secular dictatorship fueled the anger that produced jihadi movements, but its ruthless security apparatus also kept them largely in check. The much more relaxed approach of the country's new leaders is allowing extremist groups and their networks to flourish like never before, experts say. Though no one knows for sure just how many Tunisian fighters have traveled abroad, evidence suggests it remains one of the top exporters of jihadists per capita. Tunisians have turned up on the battlefields of Iraq, Syria, Libya and now Mali. The 32-man militant strike team that seized a gas plant in Algeria and took dozens of foreign workers hostage was more than one-third Tunisian.

Headline: Greek unemployment rate hits record 27 percent as recession rolls on, poverty spreads

Unemployment in Greece rose to a record 27 percent in November as separate surveys on Thursday showed the country remains stuck in recession and predicted nearly a third of the population would be in poverty by the end of the year. The Statistics Agency said unemployment increased from a rate of 26.6 percent in October and 20.8 percent in November the previous year. More than 30,000 people lost their job in November, the agency said, with the jobless rate accelerating from earlier in the year. Worst affected are the young, with 61.7 percent of adults under the age of 24 without a job.

Greece is mired in the sixth year of a recession, and has been relying for nearly three years on international rescue loans to keep it afloat. In return for the bailout, the government has imposed major spending cuts and tax hikes which have hammered the economy, causing an increase in poverty and forcing thousands of businesses to close.

Headline: Eurozone recession deepens, as Germany posts surprising declines


The eurozone recession deepened in the final three months of 2012, official figures show.

The economy of the 17 nations in the euro shrank by 0.6% in the fourth quarter, which was worse than forecast. It is the sharpest contraction since the beginning of 2009 and marks the first time the region failed to grow in any quarter during a calendar year. It followed news that the economies of Germany, France and Italy had all shrunk by more than expected. A recession is usually defined as two consecutive quarters of contraction. In the first three months of 2012 the eurozone economy failed to grow, but then in the second quarter of the year it contracted by 0.2% and it shrank by 0.1% in the third quarter.

Headline: NASA: Alarming water loss in Middle East

An amount of freshwater almost amounting to the volume of the Dead Sea has been lost in parts of the Middle East due to poor management, increased demands for groundwater and the effects of a 2007 drought, according to a NASA study. The study, to be published Friday in *Water Resources Research*, a journal of the American Geophysical Union, examined data over seven years, starting in 2003, from a pair of gravity-measuring satellites that are part of NASA's Gravity Recovery and Climate Experiment or GRACE. Researchers found that freshwater reserves in parts of Turkey, Syria, Iraq and Iran, along the Tigris and Euphrates river basins, had lost 117 million acre feet (144 cubic kilometers) of its total stored freshwater, the second fastest loss of groundwater storage after India. About 60 percent of the loss resulted from pumping underground reservoirs for ground water, including 1,000 wells in Iraq, and another fifth was due to the impact of the 2007 drought, including declining snow packs and dried up soil. Loss of surface water from lakes and reservoirs accounted for about another 20% of the decline, the study found.

Headline: Wheat prices may rise due to supply, U.S. drought

Global wheat prices are close to bottoming out and may rise in coming months because of lingering drought in the U.S. and smaller crops in exporting countries including Australia and Russia and Argentina. Higher prices would result in costlier imports by Asian countries, higher returns to growers and switching by animal-feed millers to relatively cheaper corn instead of wheat. Benchmark wheat prices rose to a multi-year high of \$9.4725/bushel July 23 but have since eased. CBOT March wheat

settled at a seven-month low of \$7.32/bushel Tuesday in response to rain and snow slightly easing drought conditions in parts of the U.S. The Taiwan Flour Millers' Association recently purchased U.S. Western White wheat with 9% protein around \$343.77/ton, or \$9.35/bushel, FOB, up by over \$11/ton since mid-November. Some traders and analysts expect prices to test \$350/ton if the U.S. drought continues. The United Nations Food and Agriculture Organization, in forecasts released Thursday, said global wheat inventories will decline 10% in the year ending June 30.

Headline: **Japan entitled to preemptive strike if threat imminent: Defense Minister**

Japanese Defense Minister Itsunori Onodera says Tokyo is “allowed under the law” to develop the ability to launch a preemptive strike against an impending attack. “When an intention to attack Japan is evident, the threat is imminent, and there are no other options, Japan is allowed under the law to carry out strikes against enemy targets,” Onodera said on Thursday. The Japanese minister, however, stated that given Japan’s political environment as well as the peace-oriented diplomacy that the country observes, “This is not the time to make preparations (for building such capability).”

The comments came two days after North Korea carried out its latest nuclear test, which drew condemnation from several countries including Japan, South Korea and the United States.



Headline: **South Korea unveils ballistic missile it says can hit anywhere in North Korea**

South Korea unveiled a cruise missile on Thursday that it said can hit the office of North Korea’s leaders, trying to address concerns that it is technologically behind its unpredictable rival which this week conducted its third nuclear test. South Korean officials declined to say the exact range of the missile but said it could hit targets anywhere in North Korea. The Defense Ministry released video footage of the missiles being launched from destroyers and submarines striking mock targets. The weapon was previewed in April last year and officials said deployment was now complete. “The cruise missile being unveiled today is a precision-guided weapon that can identify and strike the window of the office of North Korea’s leadership” ministry spokesman Kim Min-seok told reporters.



Just in time for Valentine's Day, the U.S. Centers for Disease Control released data Wednesday revealing that 20 million new sexually transmitted infections (STIs) are diagnosed each year nationwide, costing some \$16 billion in taxpayer funds. Half of the 20 million new infections affect people ages 15 to 24 - who only make up a quarter of the population, according to the statistics. Human papillomavirus (HPV) tops the list as the most common infection followed by chlamydia, gonorrhea, syphilis, herpes, hepatitis B, HIV and trichomoniasis.

Headline: Bahrain deploys further forces in coming days to confront protests

A Bahraini teenager has been shot dead in clashes with the Manama regime forces during a demonstration in a village near the capital to mark the second anniversary of the uprising against the Al Khalifa. “The child Hussein al-Jaziri was martyred after he was wounded by shotgun fire in Dia,” Bahrain’s major opposition group, al-Wefaq, announced on Thursday. The Bahraini Interior Ministry also said, without elaborating, that, “A wounded person who was brought to Salmaniya hospital was pronounced dead and the public prosecution was informed of the incident.” Bahrain’s opposition groups have called for nationwide protest rallies and strikes on Thursday and Friday to mark the anniversary of the popular uprising against the Manama regime.

Headline: Police Targeted in Pakistan Militant Attacks

Pakistani police say a roadside bomb has hit a vehicle carrying members of an anti-Taliban militia, killing seven militiamen in the country's restive northwest. Authorities say at least nine others were wounded in Thursday's blast in the tribal region of Orakzai, bordering Afghanistan. No one has claimed responsibility for the blast. Earlier Thursday in the city of Bannu, also in the northwest, five suicide bombers attacked a police station. A police spokesman says three of the attackers died when they detonated their explosives, while police shot the other two to death. One police officer was wounded in the incident. The Taliban have claimed responsibility for the Bannu attack. A Taliban spokesman says it was meant to avenge the killings of other Taliban fighters.

Headline: 4 commit suicide in Spain over evictions as EU struggles with unemployment

A 46-year-old man has killed himself in Alicante, Spain, over the threat of being evicted from his house. It was the fourth case this week in Spain of a suicide committed over an eviction. The tenant, a transporter by profession, hanged himself, local press reported. He allegedly had not paid rent for the last five years. Police arrived to evict the tenant and found his body, after calling several times and receiving no response. A friend of the deceased told Spanish news agency Europa Press that "people who knew him expected him to do so," as the man "had warned many times" he would commit suicide if evicted. The man had two daughters and came from Barcelona, where his family currently lives. It was the fourth such case of eviction-related suicide in Spain this week alone.


