Headline: Bulgaria asks 3 Hamas lawmakers to leave the country

Bulgaria has asked three lawmakers from the Palestinian Hamas party to leave the country, after they arrived at the invitation of an NGO. Interior Minister Tsvetan Tsvetanov said on Friday that the lawmakers had entered the country with regular visas "issued, however, on different motives from what they have demonstrated here." He said they had already left the country. In an earlier statement, Bulgaria's Foreign Ministry said this was an "unannounced visit of a group related to Hamas," and added that they "will not be received by any Bulgarian institutions." The director of the Center for Middle East Studies, Mohd Abuasi, said he had invited the three Palestinians to show that Bulgaria "is not a completely pro-Israeli country."

Headline: Israeli Security Delegation Arrives for Talks in Cairo

A four-man Israeli security delegation arrived in Cairo on Thursday afternoon, the Jordanian-based *Al Bawaba* website reported. According to the report, the delegation will take part in talks about the peace process between Israel and the Palestinian Authority. The members of the delegation, who flew in using Israeli military aircraft, were received by members of the Egyptian General Intelligence Service, according to *Al Bawaba*, which cited a report in the Egyptian *Al Masreyoon* website. Official sources who spoke to *Al Masreyoon* said the visit by the Israelis would last no more than a few hours. The talks will be chaired by the Egyptian intelligence chief, Mohamed Raafat Shehata, the report indicated, and will include discussions of the alleged recent Israeli airstrike in Syria and the deteriorating security situation in the Sinai Peninsula. A Syrian news website identified with the opposition in the country contended that a senior Iranian official, Gen. Hassan Shateri, was killed two weeks ago when, according to media reports, Israeli aircraft bombed a convoy in Syria that had been on its way to Lebanon. According to the website, which based its report on "special sources," Shateri had been one of the officials overseeing dealing

with the passage of the convoy and the delay in announcing his death was the result of the fact that his death is further proof of Iran's involvement in events in Syria and Lebanon. The website does not attribute its information to any Lebanese, Syrian or Iranian source, and the absence of any official reaction casts some doubt on the reliability of the report.

Headline: Health Crisis Building in Jordan Due to Syrian Refugees

Jordan's health system is beginning to crack under the strain of caring for 340,000 Syrian refugees. Amman is seeking help with the effort. "The pressure is beyond the health sector's strength to

continue providing services for the refugees," Jordanian Health Minister Abdul Latif Wreikat said bluntly on Thursday, according to *Bernama*, the Malaysian national news agency.

Chronic diseases have been discovered among a large number of the Syrians who fled across the border to safety in Jordan as well, Wreikat said. This has led to a drop in supplies of medicines in some of the hospitals and health care centers, he warned. "We welcome any assistance to help enhance our capability to provide services to the Syrian refugees," Wreikat said. Feb. 15, 2013

Headline: Hariri vows electoral battle

Future Movement leader MP Saad Hariri on Thursday vowed to fight an electoral battle for Lebanon's future as fellow March 14 figures stressed the bloc's unity. Meanwhile, the parliamentary committee on the electoral law is set to meet again Friday. "We will run in the parliamentary elections alongside our March 14 allies and the Lebanese who believe in a civil state," he said in an address to the March 14 rally commemorating the 8th anniversary of his father, Rafiq Hariri's, death. "I will be at your side for the upcoming electoral battle no matter what law is adopted," Hariri, who currently resides in France due to security threats, declared. "I promise to achieve the principles of the Cedar Revolution."

Headline: Egyptian security forces go on strike, protest Muslim Brothehood agenda Headline: Egypt police face mutiny threat amid worsening crisis

Egypt's security forces have launched a strike as part of their demand for the resignation of the interior minister. Security sources said thousands of officers of the Central Security Forces have accused Interior Minister Mohammed Ibrahim of failing to protect their interests. They said Ibrahim was using security forces to protect the ruling Muslim Brotherhood while failing to provide weapons for self-defense. "Ibrahim represents Brotherhood interests, and this has made us hated in the eyes of many if not most Egyptians," a security source said. On Feb. 13, anti-riot police were said to have refused orders to deploy around Cairo amid nationwide unrest. At the same time, security officers held protests against efforts by President Mohammed Morsi to install Brotherhood members in key security positions. "The people demand the reform of the Interior Ministry," officers chanted in a demonstration in Alexandria on Feb. 12.



Headline: UN: 40,000 flee Syrian town in three days of heavy fighting

An estimated 40,000 people have fled a town in eastern Syria after three days of heavy fighting between government troops and rebels, the United Nations food agency said. Rebels seized al-Shaddadeh in Syria's oil-producing east on Thursday after the clashes which killed 30 of their fighters and 100 Syrian government troops, a violence monitoring group told Reuters. "A WFP (World Food Program) team visited the area and estimated that around 40,000 people have fled al-Shaddadeh to al-Hasakah city (the regional capital)," the UN agency told journalists in Geneva on Friday. Northeastern Syria was hit by four years of drought before the revolt against President Bashar al-Assad started nearly two years ago, resulting in high rates of malnutrition among children, WFP spokeswoman Elisabeth Byrs said. "The fighting and displacement only aggravates the misery of these people," she said, adding the agency had sent extra rations to the area this week. Taking Shaddadeh brings the rebels closer to the provincial capital Hasakah, 45 km (30 miles) to the north in the surrounding Hasakah province.

Headline: Activists: 150 killed in clashes for Syria airport

Activists say some 150 rebels and government troops have been killed in fierce fighting for control of the international airport in the northern city of Aleppo and a major military air base nearby. Rebels claim they have captured most of the "Brigade 80" force that is in charge of protecting the area. The director of the Britain-based Syrian Observatory for Human Rights says that death toll is from fighting on Wednesday and Thursday and is almost evenly divided between opposition fighters and regime soldiers.

Headline: Iran could use U.N. talks as cover to build bomb, Ban Ki-moon says

The United Nations must be decisive and swift in judging whether diplomacy can resolve world concerns about Iran's nuclear program, U.N. Secretary General Ban Ki-moon said Thursday, or invite the risk that Iran, like North Korea, will use talks as a cover to build a bomb. In an interview with The Washington Post, Ban said he wants to accelerate diplomatic talks with Iran and give them new urgency. World powers will hold another meeting with Iran later this month, the latest in a series of thus-far ineffective efforts to resolve questions about the scope and intent of Iran's nuclear development. "We should not give much more time to the Iranians, and we should not waste time," Ban said. "We have seen what happened with the DPRK." The Democratic People's Republic of Korea, the formal name for North Korea, exploded a third nuclear test device this week. The North exploited a decade of fitful diplomatic efforts to make progress toward a weapon. "It ended up that they [were] secretly, quietly, without any obligations, without any pressure, making progress," Ban said.

Headline: Sunnis gather in Iraqi cities in mass protests Headline: Thousands demand fall of Iraq government

Tens of thousands of Sunni Muslims have gathered in several Iraqi cities to protest against what they describe as unfair treatment by the country's Shiite-led government. In the western cities of Fallujah and Ramadi, former insurgent strongholds, demonstrators blocked the main highway to Jordan and Syria to perform Friday noon prayers. Others gathered in main squares in the northern cities of Samarra and Mosul, and outside a prominent Sunni mosque in the Baghdad. In the capital, security forces blocked roads leading from Sunni-dominated provinces and sealed off all Sunni neighborhoods.

Headline: Turkey fires back after Syrian shell hits: report

Turkish artillery struck back on Friday after a shell fired from neighboring Syria ploughed into Turkish territory without causing any casualties, the state-run news agency reported. The shell fell near the town of Yayladag in Hatay province near the border with Syria and Turkish forces retaliated immediately, Anatolia said. Since Syrian fire killed five Turks on October 3, Turkey has systematically retaliated to every cross-border shelling. Headline: Pro-autonomy leaders in east Libya urge calm on revolt anniversary

Pro-autonomy leaders in eastern Libya urged followers to cancel planned rallies against central authorities on Friday for fear they could ignite violence as the country marks two years since the start

of its revolution. Various opposition and interest groups in Benghazi, fount of the 2011 uprising that ousted dictator Muammar Gaddafi, have prepared mass demonstrations later in the day to demand better security and investment for Libya's second biggest city. "Everyone is carrying weapons in Benghazi and there is still general chaos and confusion," activist Zeid el-Ragas said. "As activists it's our responsibility to minimize harm in our city, so we will stay home on February 15." While Sunday will be the actual two-year anniversary of the start of the anti-Gaddafi revolt, celebrations were to begin later on Friday in remembrance of the arrest of a human rights lawyer in Benghazi that kindled unrest.

Headline: Tunisia jihadists on patrol as tensions simmer

Tunisian jihadist groups, taking advantage of a political crisis after last week's assassination of a vocal critic of the Islamist-led government, have set up patrols to police towns and keep the peace, witnesses said. Wearing orange vests and armed with clubs, the militants patrol by night on foot, motorcycles or by car "to protect people and property," the jihadist Ansar al-Sharia group said on its official Facebook page. They have been seen in Tunisia's second city Sfax in the southeast, in Kef and Mateur in the north, in a half a dozen Tunis neighborhoods and in the central city of Sidi Bouzid, said witnesses and the Facebook page. On Wednesday their commanders ordered them, however, to get off the streets "because of the threats of the so-called" Interior Minister Ali Larayedh, a member of the Islamist ruling Ennahda party and bete noire of the jihadists. But the orders posted on Facebook urged the jihadists to continue nevertheless to protect their homes and "stay vigilant" amid accusations by the group that the police are hunting down its militants. Headline: Euro crisis 'not solved,' German bank supervisor says

Headline: Eurozone still mired in recession

Cheap loans from the European Central Bank (ECB) might have calmed the euro crisis, but the fundamental problems are still there: governments have too much debt and no strategy to get out of it, Raimund Roeseler, executive director for banking supervision in Germany's Federal Financial Supervisory Authority (BaFin), has said. "The sovereign debt crisis is certainly not solved. The ECB pumped more money into the system, but that doesn't make states automatically more solvent," Roeseler told EUobserver in an interview in his office in Bonn, the former German capital. The €1-trillion-worth of cheap loans handed out by the ECB last year created "a lot of liquidity" on the banking market, but banks still prefer to park their money overnight in the ECB rather than lend it to each other due to lingering mistrust, he noted.

Italy's unemployment crisis has reached an alarming rate, with experts warning about the possible collapse of family-based support in the European country. About three million Italians are registered as unemployed, a figure that has increased by almost two percent in one year, marking a new record for Italy in December 2012. The number of young people who depend on their parents for day-to-day living has also risen considerably. "We survive for a month on what is in this bag. I'm very keen to find what there is for my baby boy," said the unemployed 56-year-old Salvatore, referring to the charity handout on which he depends to feed his family.

Headline: Moody's says U.S. rating hangs on debt outlook

Moody's Investors Service on Thursday said that future changes to the U.S. sovereign credit rating will turn on the expected debt trajectory, with more budget measures needed to shrink key debt ratios. If the United States does not see high growth rates, the debt-to-GDP ratio could suffer, Moody's said in a statement. "Therefore, further fiscal policy actions in coming months would be needed to ensure a decline in the debt ratios," the statement added. "Any rating action in coming months will be predicated on the expected debt trajectory, which in turn will result from fiscal policy and the expected path of economic growth." The statement laid out a series of budget milestones facing the United States in coming weeks, including the sequester, a package of automatic spending cuts set to kick in at the start of March, and the May 19 reinstatement of the country's debt limit. Headline: Central Banks Buy the Most Gold Since 1964

Worldwide gold demand in 2012 was another record high of \$236.4 billion in the World Gold Council's latest report. This was up 6% in value terms in the fourth quarter to \$66.2 billion, the highest fourth quarter on record. Global gold demand in the fourth quarter of 2012 was up 4% to 1,195.9 tonnes. Central bank buying for 2012 rose by 17% over 2011 to some 534.6 tonnes. As far as central bank gold buying, this was the highest level since 1964. Central bank purchases stood at 145 tonnes in the fourth quarter. That is up 9% from the fourth quarter of 2011, and the eighth consecutive quarter in which central banks were net purchasers of gold. The World Gold Council said: Central banks' move from net sellers of gold, to net buyers that we have seen in recent years, has continued apace. The official sector purchases across the world are now at their highest level for almost half a century. Feb. 14, 2013

Headline: N Korea: Thousands gather in support of nuclear test

Headline: N. Korea Tells China of Preparations for More Nuclear Tests

North Korea appears to be upgrading one of its two rocket launch sites, US experts say, perhaps in a move to test bigger rockets. "Important progress" had been made at Tonghae Satellite Launching Ground since October 2012, the analysis from the 38 North website said. Activities around the new launch pad also revealed possible evidence of assistance from Iran, it said. Pyongyang used a three-stage rocket to put a satellite into space last year. That launch - condemned by the UN as a banned test of missile technology - took place at the Sohae launch site. But previous unsuccessful attempts in 2006 and 2009 took place at the Tonghae site, which is also known as Musudan-ri. Meanwhile, North Korea has told its key ally, China, that it is prepared to stage one or even two more nuclear tests this year in an effort to force the United States into diplomatic talks with Pyongyang, said a source with direct knowledge of the message. Further tests could also be accompanied this year by another rocket launch, said the source who has direct access to the top levels of government in both Beijing and Pyongyang.

Headline: Christian Pastor Beheaded By Muslim Mob in Tanzania

A PASTOR with the Tanzania Assemblies of God (TAG) Church at Buseresere has been beheaded during religious-linked conflicts at Buseresere town, in Geita Region. A spokesperson for the Geita Regional Police Commander's Office, Mr Denis Stephano, identified the deceased pastor as Mathayo Kachili.

He said conflicts had been boiling for quite a while now in the area where a section of what are believed to be Muslim leaders had demanded immediate closure of butcheries owned by Christians. He said that a group of youths believed to be Muslims assaulted several Christians using sticks and machetes and attacked a butchery owner at Buseresere town. During the confrontations pastor Kachili was beheaded. According to Mr Stephano, several people are believed to have been injured, some in critical condition and were admitted to Buseresere hospital to receive treatment. He said the Chato District Commissioner (DC), Mr Rodrick Mpogolo, visited the scene and called for calm and religious tolerance among believers of the two faiths.

A huge fireball fell from the skies over Russia's Chelyabinsk region early Friday, resulting in a powerful blast that reportedly injured about 400 people. Reports from Russia suggested that the fireball was caused by a meteorite. "Preliminary indications are that it was a meteorite [shower]," the RIA-Novosti news agency quoted an emergency official as saying. "We have information about a blast at 10,000-meter (32,800-foot) altitude. It is being verified." The Associated Press quoted a spokesman for the Russian Interior Ministry, Vadim Kolesnikov, as saying that the fireball caused an explosion and sonic boom that broke windows. City authorities in Chelyabinsk, 930 miles east of Moscow, said about 400 people sought medical help, mainly for light injuries caused by flying glass, Reuters reported. Tatiana Bordovitsina, an astronomy professor at Tomsk State University in western Siberia, told RIA Novosti that the meteor, "could have been debris preceding the asteroid." Feb. 15. 2013

Headline: NASA to Chronicle Close Earth Flyby of Asteroid

Talk about too close for comfort. In a rare cosmic encounter, an asteroid will buzz Earth next week, missing our planet by a mere 17,200 miles (27,700 kilometers). Designated 2012 DA14, the space rock is approximately 150 feet (45 meters) across, and astronomers are certain it will zip harmlessly past our planet on February 15—but not before making history. It will pass within the orbits of many communications satellites, making it the closest flyby on record. (Read about one of the largest asteroids to fly by Earth.) "This is indeed a remarkably close approach for an asteroid this size," said Paul Chodas, a research scientist at NASA's Jet Propulsion Laboratory Near Earth Object (NEO) program office in Pasadena, California. "We estimate that an asteroid of this size passes this close to the Earth only once every few decades."

Greek pensioners have demonstrated in Athens to protest against the government's harsh austerity measures and highlight the consequences of the program on their life. Headline: Two die of injuries sustained during recent protests in Bangladesh, police say

Two Bangladeshis have died of injuries sustained during protest rallies that erupted after the arrest of the leaders of the country's Jamaat-e-Islami party, police say. On Thursday, a lift operator of a bank succumbed to his injuries after being beaten by angry protesters a day earlier. A village guard also died of his wounds sustained in another violent protest that was staged near the port city of Chittagong, located 216 kilometers (135 miles) southeast of the capital Dhaka, on Tuesday. On Wednesday, Bangladeshi demonstrators demanding the release of jailed leaders of the party clashed with police forces in Dhaka. Protesters gathered near Motijheel -- the city's principal business district -- reportedly throwing stones at security forces. In response, police fired tear gas to disperse the demonstrators.
