Palestinian protests, mainly over the issue of Palestinians imprisoned in Israel, are expected to resume on Friday with both organized and spontaneous marches throughout the West Bank and Jerusalem. In Jerusalem, demonstrations in support of the prisoners are slated to take place Friday morning at the Old City's Damascus Gate and the Al-Aqsa Mosque compound on the Temple Mount. On Thursday, messages went sent to Palestinians' cell phones urging all of them, and especially young people, to participate in the protests. In the West Bank, the main focus of activity will be the weekly march in Bili'in. Hundreds of people are also expected to demonstrate near the village of Salfit. Confrontations with Israeli soldiers may erupt at checkpoints, especially the Qalandiyah checkpoint near Jerusalem and the checkpoint near the Ofer army base. A demonstration is also planned in Hebron to commemorate the anniversary of Baruch Goldstein's massacre of 29 Muslim worshippers at the Cave of the Patriarchs in 1994. The demonstration was organized by the Committee to Protect Hebron, the Popular Campaign Against the Fence and the city's left-wing politicians. The Palestinians will be joined by Jewish and Arab activists from the left-wing group Hithabrut-Tarabut.

Clashes were also reported at the Beitunia Checkpoint.

Headline: Palestinian premier says civil resistance way to statehood

Palestinian premier Salam Fayyad said at a protest in the West Bank on Friday that the ongoing civil resistance to Israeli occupation was the right way to achieve statehood. Fayyad was taking part along with other Palestinian leaders in a weekly demonstration near the village Bilin, which marked the eighth year of such protests by villagers against the encroachment of the Israeli barrier on their lands. Protesters clashed with Israeli soldiers who fired tear gas, and Fayyad was forced to breathe through a cloth. "Today we are celebrating the renewal of hope," Fayyad said in a speech, calling what the people of Bilin had achieved in raising awareness of their struggle "a miracle." "Our people will not take the wrong route, they know very well by instinct and experience what brings success and what brings failure, and they will not err on the way to a Palestinian state," he added.

Headline: Gaza Terrorists Open Fire at Southern Israel

For the first since the end of the IDF's Pillar of Defense counterterrorism operation, Gaza-based terrorists opened fire on Friday afternoon towards the Shaar Hanegev region in southern Israel. No one was hurt but a military vehicle belonging to a commander of the IDF's Gaza Division sustained damage. While Friday's incident was the first time since November that shots were fired from Gaza towards Israel, it marks the second time in less than a week that Gaza terrorists have violated the Egyptian-brokered ceasefire agreement with Israel that was reached at the end of Operation Pillar of Defense. On Tuesday morning, Gaza terrorists fired rockets towards southern Israel. One rocket hit the city of Ashkelon, but did not cause injury. A second rocket apparently hit an open field near the city. Residents said they had no warning of the impending strike. The Al-Aqsa Martyrs Brigades, which is affiliated with Palestinian Authority Chairman Mahmoud Abbas's Fatah movement, claimed responsibility for the attack. The rocket fired was an upgraded M-75.

Iran's permanent envoy to the United Nations has expressed concern over Israel's illegal imprisonment of Palestinians, urging the UN to address the plight of Palestinian prisoners in Israeli jails. In a letter to UN Secretary General Ban Ki-moon, Mohammad Khazaei called on the world body to pay attention to the harsh conditions of Palestinians kept in Israeli prisons. The United Nations should announce that the Israeli regime must be held accountable for violation of 'international rights,' Khazaei said. The Non-Aligned Movement (NAM) calls for immediate attention to the critical conditions of the prisoners, Khazaei stated, adding that any solution to the plight of Palestinians must be in accordance with international regulations. The Iranian envoy, who also serves as head of the NAM countries at the UN, said the movement asks for the release of all Palestinian prisoners. March 1, 2013

Headline: Tripoli protests erupt following Begaa clash report

Islamist protests inspired by Sunni cleric Ahmad al-Assir erupted across the country following Friday's noon Muslim prayers in a show of force Lebanon's chief of police called "coordinated," with the centerpiece rally occurring in the flashpoint Abra area of Sidon. Assir's supporters gathered in the Bilal Bin Rabbah Mosque of the southern town amid a heavy security presence following the Sheikh's provocative call for a march toward "Hezbollah apartments" near the building, days after Hezbollah chief Sayyed Hassan Nasrallah warned against inciting action in the city. Last week, Assir and a number of his armed supporters deployed around his mosque "in self-defense against Hezbollah members who were trying to break in," setting the stage for today's events. "The army surrounded the mosque from all [sides] and searched [all those] entering," Assir spokesperson Mohammad al-Qawwam told NOW correspondent Karen Boulos on Friday. "Sidon has not seen such a security presence since the days of the Israeli occupation."

Headline: Saudi forces arrest over 300 protesters in Buraidah

Saudi security forces have arrested over 300 people in the central province of Qassim after hundreds of Saudis staged a protest sit-in to demand the release of political prisoners. The protest gathering was held outside the investigation and prosecution bureau in the town of Buraidah on Friday. Fifteen women are reported to be among those detained. They demanded the release of female political activists recently arrested in the province. According to state news agency, SPA, the protest sit-in lasted for more than 12 hours. Saudi activists say there are more than 30,000 political prisoners, mostly prisoners of conscience, in jails across the Kingdom. According to the activists, most of the detained political thinkers are being held by the government without trial or legitimate charges and have been arrested for merely looking suspicious.

Headline: Egypt's military issues second warning to Morsi regime Headline: Hundreds call for resumption of military rule in Egypt

Egypt's General Staff has been monitoring the Islamist regime of President Mohammed Morsi. The military said it was following the Morsi crackdown on protests throughout Egypt and that it was prepared to intervene to stop abuse of civilians. It keeps an eye on what goes on in the nation," Egyptian Chief of Staff Gen. Sidki Sobhi said. "If the Egyptian people ever needs the armed forces, they will be on the streets in less than a second." Western diplomats said the statement by Sobhi, appointed by Morsi in August 2012, marked the starkest warning by the U.S.-financed military. They said the military brass has been dismayed by the policies of Morsi and the ruling Muslim Brotherhood. This marked the second warning by the military amid rising unrest. In January, Defense Minister Abdul Fatah Sisi, also a Morsi appointee, warned of the collapse of Egypt and offered to mediate between the Islamist regime and protesters. In February, Sisi pledged not to allow the Brotherhood to dominate the military. Since then, Brotherhood elements have raised the prospect that Sisi would be replaced. The military then leaked a warning through the Egyptian media that any purge of senior commanders would spark a backlash. Feb. 28, 2013

Headline: Heavy fighting over police academy in north Syria

Syrian government forces fought fierce clashes with rebels attacking a police academy near the northern city of Aleppo on Friday, while the bodies of 10 men - most of them shot in the head - were found dumped along the side of a road outside Damascus, activists said. Rebels backed by captured tanks have been trying to storm the police academy outside Aleppo since launching a new offensive on the facility last week. The school, which activists say has been turned into a military base used to

shell rebel-held neighborhoods in the city and the surrounding countryside, has become a key front in the wider fight for Aleppo. The Syrian state news agency said Friday that government troops defending the school had killed dozens of opposition fighters and destroyed five rebel vehicles. The Britain-based Syrian Observatory for Human Rights activist group also reported heavy fighting Friday around the school, and said there were several rebel casualties without providing an exact figure.

Headline: Syrian rebel chief pleads for weapons

Western powers pledged aid for Syrian rebels on Thursday but stopped short of offering them weapons, disappointing opponents of President Bashar al-Assad clamoring for more arms. More than 70,000 Syrians have been killed in a fierce conflict that began with peaceful anti-Assad protests nearly two years ago. Washington has given \$385 million in humanitarian aid for Syria but U.S. President Barack Obama has so far refused to give arms, arguing it is difficult to prevent them from falling into the hands of militants who could use them on Western targets. The United States said it would for the first time give non-lethal aid to the rebels and would more than double its support to Syria's civilian opposition, casting it as a way to bolster the rebels' popular support. The help will include medical supplies, food for rebel fighters and \$60 million to help the civil opposition provide basic services like security, education and sanitation. U.S. Secretary of State John Kerry announced the new steps after a meeting of 11 mostly European and Arab nations within the "Friends of Syria" group.

Headline: War leading to dissolution of Syria: Ban Ki-moon

U.N. Secretary-General Ban Ki-moon warned Friday that the bloody violence in Syria is threatening to break the country apart as the opposition chief pleaded for weapons. "The military solution in Syria is leading to the dissolution of Syria," the U.N. chief said in Geneva, asking: "What atrocity must occur to finally stir the world to act?" With the brutal, sectarian-tinged conflict between the regime of Syrian President Bashar al-Assad and rebels poised to enter its third year next month, Ban called for a renewed drive to halt the strife. "For two years now, we have seen suppression of people's aspiration for change, the flight of ever-greater numbers of people from their homes, and the daily escalation of killing, war crimes and crimes against humanity," he said. "The United Nations and our humanitarian partners are doing all we can to provide assistance. But in Syria and anywhere else, we must never use humanitarianism to avoid the tougher choices," he insisted. Ban said it was down to all sides in Syria to come to the negotiating table, but urged the international community not to lose focus on the conflict there.

Headline: Syria scud hits Iraq

A Syrian missile on Friday landed on Iraqi territory, a local mayor in the Nineveh province told Reuters on Friday. "A Russian-made Scud landed near the village of Yoush Tapa, 3 kilometers from the Iraqi-Syrian border between Telafar and Baaj," Telafar mayor Abdul Aal Abbas told the news agency. "There were no casualties or damage, but it created fear among the Turkuman population of that village and they fled their houses." A spokesperson for the governorate told Reuters that security

forces confirmed that it was a Russian-made missile. Syria's opposition and activists have accused the regime's army of firing the deadly missiles. The Syrian regime has denied firing Scud missiles at armed rebels, including in Aleppo where a watchdog says 58 people were killed when missiles hit the northern city, a Russian broadcaster quoted a Syrian minister as saying on Monday. Headline: Series of explosions in Iraq kills at least 19

A series of bombings struck Baghdad and a livestock market south of the Iraqi capital on Thursday, killing at least 19 and wounding dozens in areas that are home to mostly Muslim Shiites — the latest evidence of rising sectarian discord in Iraq. The deadly attack occurred around sunset when a pair of bombs exploded nearly simultaneously in Shula in northwestern Baghdad. One was a car bomb that was detonated outside a fast food restaurant and the other blast occurred near a football field. The double-bombing killed 15 people and left at least 40 wounded, officials said. There was no immediate claim of responsibility, but car bombings in Shiite areas are a favourite tactic of Sunni extremists such as Al Qaeda's local affiliate. The group, known as the Islamic State of Iraq, considers Shiites to be heretics and accuses them of being too closely aligned with neighbouring Shiite powerhouse Iran. Earlier in the day, a car bomb tore through the crowded livestock market in the town of Aziziyah, 55 kilometres southeast of Baghdad. That attack killed three people and wounded eight. A few hours later, a roadside bomb missed a passing police patrol in western Baghdad but killed a bystander and wounded eight people. Police and hospital officials provided details of the attacks and the casualty figures. They spoke on condition of anonymity because they were not authorised to talk to the media. Feb. 28, 2013

Headline: Iraq's Sunni Finance Minister Quits as Protests Grow

Iraq's Sunni finance minister announced his resignation Friday at a large protest demonstration in the mostly Sunni town of Samara. Twin bombings also hit a cattle market in a mostly Shi'ite town south of Baghdad, killing at least five. The crowd of several thousand protesters cheered the announcement by Sunni Finance Minister Rafaie al-Esawi that he was resigning from the embattled government of Prime Minister Nouri al-Maliki. He says that he's not keen to serve an Iraqi government that does not respect the people of Iraq, their future, their unity, or their tribes. He says that he is with the people and will not be part of a government that has the blood of the Iraqi people on its hands. But Iraqi state TV reported during its afternoon newscast that Prime Minister Maliki "would not accept, Rafaie al-Esawi, resignation until the investigation into his financial and administrative 'crimes' had been investigated."

Headline: Erdogan calls Zionism a 'crime against humanity'

Turkish Prime Minister Recep Tayyip Erdogan on Wednesday described Zionism as a "crime against humanity" on par with anti-Semitism and fascism. Speaking in Vienna at a United Nations event devoted to dialogue between the West and Islam, Erdogan decried rising racism in Europe and the fact that many Muslims "who live in countries other than their own" often face harsh discrimination. "We should be striving to better understand the culture and beliefs of others, but instead we see that people act based on prejudice and exclude others and despise them," Erdogan said, according to a simultaneous translation provided by the UN. "And that is why it is necessary that we must consider — just like Zionism or anti-Semitism or fascism — Islamophobia as a crime against humanity." The Turkish leader's comments, made at the official opening of the fifth UN Alliance of Civilizations Global Forum, drew harsh criticism from UN Watch, a Geneva-based watchdog group monitoring anti-Israel bias and human rights abuses at the organization. Headline: Putin Calls for Upgrade of Russian Army to Counter US, NATO Headline: Russia Plans to Keep 10 Warships in Mediterranean

Russian President Vladimir Putin told the country's top brass on Wednesday to drastically upgrade the armed forces in the next few years as part of a response to attempts by the United States and NATO to "tip the strategic balance" in the world. In his address to Russia's defense ministry and top military officials, Putin said Russia is witnessing "insistent attempts" to change that balance and complained about U.S. plans to create a new missile defense system in Europe and the potential expansion of NATO to former Soviet republics. "Geopolitical developments call for our response to be well-calculated and quick," Putin said, according to a transcript of his speech on the Kremlin's website. "The Russian armed forces must move to a dramatically new level of capabilities as soon as in the next three to five years." The stated goal of the multibillion-dollar missile defense system planned for Europe is to protect the United States from Iranian missiles. But Russia has repeatedly criticized the plan, claiming it really is intended to counter its own missiles. Meanwhile, A proposed Russian permanent naval task force in the Mediterranean Sea may consist of up to 10 combat and auxiliary ships, a high-ranking military source said. "A command headquarters responsible for the deployment of a permanent naval task force must be set up at the Black Sea Fleet," the source told RIA Novosti on Thursday.

Headline: Russia Takes Over UN Security Council Presidency

Russia will assume on Friday rotating presidency of the UN Security Council for the month of March, giving priority during its term to the development of the situation in Afghanistan, the Russian Foreign Ministry said. The role of president of the Security Council involves setting the agenda, presiding at its meetings and overseeing any crisis. The presidency rotates monthly in alphabetical order of the Security Council member nations' names in English. "The situation in Afghanistan will be a priority of Russia's presidency as that country is entering a very responsible stage of its development, which

requires new efforts from the people of Afghanistan and consolidated support from the entire international community," the ministry said in a statement on Thursday. Russian Foreign Minister Sergei Lavrov will chair on March 19 a UN Security Council meeting on Afghanistan. A resolution extending the mandate of the United Nations Assistance Mission in Afghanistan (UNAMA) will be adopted at the meeting. The agenda of the Russian presidency will also address the Middle East issues, the settlement of the situation in Kosovo, and the Libyan sanctions regime, among other issues. The Council has 15 members, including five permanent members - China, France, Russia, the United Kingdom and the United States - and 10 non-permanent members elected by the UN General Assembly for two-year terms.

Headline: Tunisia renews state of emergency amid crisis

Headline: Hundreds of Salafists protest in Tunisia's Sidi Bouzid

Tunisian President Moncef Marzouki extended by three months on Friday a state of emergency in force since the 2011 revolution, as the country faces its worst crisis since the uprising. The decision, taken after consultations with caretaker prime minister Hamadi Jebali and National Constituent Assembly chief Mustapha Ben Jaafar, extends the state of emergency until June 3, Marzouki's office said. The state of emergency has been in effect across the north African country since January 14, 2011, in the wake of the uprising that ousted veteran strongman Zine El Abidine Ben Ali. Since then, the measure has been renewed regularly, either on a month-to-month basis or for three months at a time. Tunisia is facing a grave political crisis after the February assassination of leftist politician Chokri Belaid, a vocal critic of the Islamist-led government. The killing sparked clashes between protesters and police and prompted the largest anti-government demonstrations since the revolution. On Thursday, the president testified in the murder probe of Belaid, as a judicial source named the Salafist suspected of the assassination that plunged the country into turmoil. March 1, 2013

Here is something that links together a great number of seemingly unrelated issues, and confusion in the news. When this map got my attention, it was featured in Gary Kahs book Enroute to Global Occupation (released 1992). The book chronicled Kahs insider discovery of plans by globalist powers to carve the world into ten economic, and political administrative regions. I encountered the book in 1993, and at the time there was nothing to distinguish it from all of the other unproven speculation of the day, much of which centered around the first years of the Clinton administration. Official figures Friday showed that unemployment in the country in January rose to 11.7 percent from the previous month's 11.3 percent. January's figure was the highest since the current way of measuring unemployment was introduced in 1992. The unexpectedly large monthly spike was one of the key backdrops to the election results earlier this week that reignited concerns over Europe's dormant debt crisis. No party, or coalition of parties, emerged with enough votes to govern alone, triggering uncertainty in the markets about the future course of Italian economic policy.

The risk that Britain is entering its third recession in four years grew on Friday with figures showing that manufacturing shrank unexpectedly last month and mortgage approvals for home buyers dropped in January Gross domestic product fell at the end of last year, bringing Britain within sight of another recession and the latest data suggested the central bank may need to do yet more to revive the economy. The pound sank to its lowest level against the dollar in more than 2-1/2 years, while prices of British government bonds - which the Bank of England could resume buying - rose after the releases. The Markit/CIPS Manufacturing Purchasing Managers' Index (PMI) fell to 47.9 from a downwardly revised 50.5 in January, confounding forecasts for a rise to 51.0. It was the first reading

below the 50 line that separates growth from contraction since November. A separate release showed that mortgage approvals fell unexpectedly despite the authorities' efforts to boost lending. March 1, 2013

Headline: Portugal Socialists say enough austerity, government sticks to adjustment Portugal would be left "rudderless in a storm of risks" if it does not complete budget adjustments under a bailout, its finance minister said, as the main opposition hardened its anti-austerity stance. With the worst economic recession since the 1970s making tough budget goals harder to reach, the center-right government is under growing pressure to ease austerity measures imposed under the 2011 rescue programme. The government says it is likely to request an extra year to meet budget goals under the bailout, but political opponents and some business leaders say much more time is needed. Meanwhile, inspectors from Lisbon's EU/IMF lenders this week started a bailout review,

Headline: Cash-strapped Egypt considers offering pyramids, other monuments for rent

Egypt's finance ministry sent a proposal to the country's antiquities ministry to consider offering key monuments, including the pyramids, to international tourism firm as a quick solution to generate funds needed to overcome the financial crisis, an official has said. Rumors about the proposal, which some described as preposterous, have circulated online for weeks. But on Wednesday, Adel Abdel Sattar, the secretary general of the Supreme Council of Antiquities, in an interview with Egypt's ONTV channel confirmed the existence of a proposal to offer Egypt's monuments, including the pyramids in Giza, the Sphinx, the Abu Simbel Temple and the temples of Luxor, to international tourism firm. There have been reports that the rich Gulf state of Qatar, which strongly supported efforts to oust former president Hosni Mubarak from power, is interested in a deal to exploit Egypt's most precious historical assets for a period of five years. The return for Egypt would be a substantial amount of money, estimated at \$200 billion, enough to pay the country's national debt and heal its economic

woes for years if not decades to come. Abdel Sattar confirmed the proposal to rent out Egypt's monuments but denied that Qatar or any Gulf state was involved.

President Obama placed blame squarely on Republican lawmakers at a Friday press conference for failing to stop automatic spending cuts that were to begin kicking in later in the day, calling the cuts "dumb, arbitrary." Republicans, for their part, said the fault was his, for insisting that increased taxes be part of the resolution The president said the impact of the cuts won't immediately be felt, but middle class families will begin to "have their lives disrupted in significant ways." Headline: US, South Korea launch major joint exercises

A series of territorial disputes with its neighbors will ensure China boosts defense spending when it reveals this year's military budget ahead of the annual parliamentary sitting next week, security experts say. After almost three decades of sharply increased military outlays, an increasingly assertive China now has the firepower to challenge rivals claiming strategically important and resource-rich territory in the East China and South China seas. The Chinese navy, now second in size only to the U.S. fleet in terms of raw numbers, has become a genuine blue-water force and is conducting almost continuous patrols and exercises in these contested waters. Over the past six months, China's stand-off with Japan over a series of rocky islands in the East China Sea known as the Senkaku in Japan and Diaoyu in China has become more acrimonious. Beijing is also in dispute with the Philippines and Vietnam, as well as Taiwan, Brunei and Malaysia, over territory in the South China Sea. Meanwhile, Protesters have demonstrated on South Korea's Independence Movement Day against Japan's claims to sovereignty over a chain of disputed islands. Demonstrators gathered outside the Japanese Embassy in Seoul on Friday, demanding Japan expresses regret for what happened in the past as "a nation of war criminals."

Headline: Heavy die-off of fish around Presque Isle Bay

If you have seen thousands of dead fish washed up across the shorelines of Presque Isle Bay, you're not alone. Biologists and other officials with the Department of Environmental Protection began spotting the gizzard shad about two weeks ago. The fish kill is a natural occurrence, and is unrelated to pollution, officials with DEP's northwest regional office said. "We're talking about upward of a million fish," said Jim Grazio, DEP's Great Lakes biologist in Erie. Grazio called the fish kill a "very heavy die-off" that officials haven't seen locally in 10 to 15 years. "The die-off is ongoing. It's not done," the biologist added. "You can see fish struggling at the surface of the water." Gizzard shad, especially young ones, are particularly sensitive to cold temperatures. "They likely began dying under the ice several weeks ago," said Gary Clark, a DEP community relations coordinator based in Meadville. "Warmer temperatures melted the ice and exposed them." Grazio said he doesn't know why our region is seeing such a heavy die-off of gizzard shad this year.

Headline: Christian-Muslim Tension Flares in Southern Egypt

Dozens of Muslim residents threw firebombs and rocks at police on Friday as they tried to storm a church in southern Egypt in search of a woman suspected of converting to Christianity, security officials said. Clashes between Copts and Muslims usually are sparked by disputes over rumors of conversion, Muslim-Christian love affairs and the construction of churches. Violence between Egypt's Christians and Muslims has risen in the past two years in the wake of the country's uprising that ousted longtime President Hosni Mubarak, but also weakened security across the nation.

Officials said 11 policemen were wounded in the clashes in the town of Kom Ombo, which is near Aswan High Dam, about 980 kilometers (608 miles) south of Cairo. Coptic Christian activist Ibrahim Louis said 12 Christians also were wounded, including one man who was in serious condition. The fighting erupted late Thursday night when hundreds of Muslim residents tried to get inside the church. Police used tear gas to keep the crowd from storming the church as some of the residents burnt tires along a major highway and cut off traffic. The clashes erupted again Friday afternoon when dozens of residents again threw firebombs and rocks at police. In anticipation of renewed clashes, police had set up checkpoints and increased their presence around the church. March 1, 2013

Headline: Dozens of Egypt Christians held in Libya's Benghazi

Around 50 Egyptian Christians suspected of trying to convert Muslims have been arrested in the eastern city of Benghazi on illegal immigration charges, a Libyan security official said on Friday. "Forty-eight Egyptian traders who worked in the Benghazi municipal market have been arrested based on reports of suspect activities," the source told AFP on condition of anonymity. He said they were found in possession of a quantity of Bibles, texts encouraging conversion to Christianity, and images of Christ and the late Pope Shenuda of Egypt's Coptic Christians, none of which were for "personal use." But the main charge was illegal entry into Libya, he said. A video posted on the Internet shows dozens of men with shaved heads squatted on the floor in a tiny room as a bearded Libyan recounts how they had been arrested on charges of proselytising.

Headline: Obama urges court to overturn gay marriage ban

In a historic argument for gay rights, President Barack Obama on Thursday urged the Supreme Court to overturn California's same-sex marriage ban and turn a skeptical eye on similar prohibitions across the country. The Obama administration's friend-of-the-court brief marked the first time a U.S. president has urged the high court to expand the right of gays and lesbians to wed. The brief marks the president's most expansive view of gay marriage and signals that he is moving away from his previous assertion that states should determine their own marriage laws. Obama, a former constitutional law professor, signed off on the administration's legal argument last week following lengthy discussions with Attorney General Eric Holder and Solicitor General Donald Verrilli. In a statement following the filing, Holder said "the government seeks to vindicate the defining constitutional ideal of equal treatment under the law."

<u>Luke 21:9</u> and <u>Matthew 24:7</u> speak of nation against nation and kingdom against kingdom in the end times. <u>Revelation 6:3-4</u> speaks of the fiery red horse given power to <u>make men slay one another</u> and <u>Revelation 6:8</u> speaks again of this red horse in conjunction with the pale horse of Death and Hades, as the one that has the power to kill by sword. I like to call this "The Arab Spring in Prophecy" because for us it is easy to identify- that's what the world calls it.

<u>Luke 21:9</u>: wars & commotions; the Greek word here is Akatastasia, meaning instability, a state of disorder, disturbance, confusion (revolutions)

Matthew 24:7: the Greek word for <u>nation</u> is Ethnos & refers to various <u>ethnic groups fighting</u> among themselves, where the next sentence in the verse refers to <u>kingdoms</u> (basileiva) fighting one another (not to be confused with an actual kingdom but rather <u>the right or authority to rule over a kingdom</u>) I have tried to separate it into areas that sweep EAST from the point of North America.

Headline: French troops to stay in Mali until July: Officials

Headline: Chadian troops killed al Qaeda commander in Mali

French officials say the country's forces will remain in Mali until at least July amid reports of a serious humanitarian crisis in the northern areas of the country caused by the French-led war in the West

African nation. The officials, speaking on condition of anonymity, made the announcement on Thursday, the Associated Press reported. Earlier this week, an unnamed French diplomat also said that it is unlikely that "the French presence will be over in six months." French Foreign Minister Laurent Fabius said on February 6 that the country would begin the withdrawal of its troops from Mali in March. "We will continue to act in the north... I think that from March, if everything goes according to plan, the number of French troops should decrease," Fabius said.

Headline: Diibouti police battle crowds protesting election result

Riot police in Djibouti city fought street battles on Friday with protesters alleging fraud in last week's parliamentary election and demanding the release of detained opposition activists. The unrest follows clashes earlier this week and raises the specter of mounting instability in a Red Sea state that is an important ally of the United States in its fight against militant Islam. Some protesters threw petrol bombs and security forces fired tear gas and rubber bullets to disperse crowds chanting "freedom" and "free our leaders", a reference to the detention of several moderate Islamists from the opposition. "We won't stop until their release," Mahdi Ali told Reuters in the run-down suburb of Balbala, an opposition stronghold. The opposition rejects the result of last Friday's election and says the vote was rigged. President Ismail Omar Guelleh's Union for the Presidential Majority (UMP) declared victory in Friday's vote, claiming 49 of the National Assembly's 65 seats. Djibouti has been ruled since 1999 by Guelleh, effectively as a one-party state. Last week's vote was the first time the opposition had won a single seat in the assembly.



Headline: At Least 44 Dead in Bangladesh Clashes

At least 44 people have been killed in Bangladesh in a wave of violence sparked by a special tribunal's decision to sentence a top Islamist opposition leader to death. Reports Friday said the latest deaths took place in Gainbandha district, after two days of clashes between protesters and police. The protests were expected to continue after Friday prayers. Many of the victims were shot Thursday in clashes between security forces and supporters of Delwar Hossain Sayedee. He was found guilty of crimes, including mass killings and rape, committed during the 1971 war against Pakistan for Bangladesh's independence. Thursday's violence occurred during a nationwide shutdown called by Sayedee's party, Jamaat-e-Islami, to protest his trial and demand he be freed. A VOA reporter in Dhaka, Zahurul Alam, said two police officers were among the dead, and more than 200 people were wounded. He said Jamaat-e-Islami has called for another nationwide shutdown starting early Sunday. March 1, 2013
