Headline: **On the Temple Mount, a battle brews over Jewish prayer**

Headline: **Activist: Regain the Sovereignty of the Temple Mount**

On Tuesday, the struggle of Jewish women fighting to worship with prayer shawls at the Western Wall in Jerusalem received renewed attention when protesters at the holy site were joined by several new members of Knesset, spotlighting Israel's ongoing policy of imposing Orthodox practice on all worshipers at the wall. But in the coming years a different battle over Jewish prayer, one unfolding a few paces away, is likely to be of more significance — a growing debate over whether Jews should be allowed to pray on the Temple Mount itself. The desire to pray on the Mount, also the site of Islam's third-holiest shrine, has found more acceptance among mainstream rabbis in Israel over the past decade, spreading gradually from a tiny fringe to a broader religious public. The numbers of Jews actually visiting the Mount for religious reasons is still tiny — no more than several thousand a year, according to police estimates — but inching upward, and the sacred enclosure is slowly gaining in importance as an issue of religious and political meaning for religious Zionists, a group with outsize ideological and political clout in Israeli society. That could make it a flashpoint inside Israel and an inflammatory issue for local Muslims and the entire Islamic world.

Headline: Obama Meets Arab-American Leaders Ahead of Israel Trip

U.S. President Barack Obama met members of the Arab-American community at the White House on Monday, ahead of his trip to Israel, the Palestinian Authority and Jordan, a U.S. spokesman said. During the meeting, Obama reiterated that his trip to the Middle East was "not dedicated to resolving a specific policy issue, but is rather a chance to consult with Jordanian, Israeli, and Palestinian Authority officials about a broad range of issues," the spokesman said, according to *AFP*.

"(Obama) underscored that the trip is an opportunity for him to demonstrate the United States' commitment to the Palestinian people and to partnering with the Palestinian Authority as it continues building institutions that will be necessary to bring about a truly independent Palestinian state," the source said.

Headline: Violence mounts in West Bank, Gaza in lead up to Obama visit

Palestinian youth group called to reject US President Barack Obama's visit to Palestine and to demonstrate against resuming negotiations, said a press release by Palestinians For Dignity group published on Sunday. The group said Obama's visit to Palestine, which is expected between 20-22 of March, comes while the hunger striking prisoners are battling Israeli policies and arbitrary measures and the US silence. Palestinians For Dignity said that it is "naive to presume that US policy toward Israel has changed since Obama took office." Palestinians For Dignity called on all Palestinians to demonstrate against receiving Obama, who considers Israel "the closest ally in the region" and to refuse return to negotiations.

Headline: Bolton: Israel has 'very short period of time' to strike Iran. Warns Tehran will soon possess nukes beyond Jewish state's reach

Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu has a "very short period of time" to decide whether to strike Iran's nuclear infrastructure before Tehran possesses nuclear weapons, warned former United Nations Ambassador John Bolton in a radio interview last night. "Obviously in the short term Israel is focused on forming its own government," stated Bolton. "But I think assuming it's Prime Minister Netanyahu forming that government he has a very short period of time in which to determine whether Israel will use military force knowing that the United States will not or whether Israel is prepared to allow Iran to get to the point where it has nuclear weapons." Continued Bolton: "I don't know what Netanyahu's decision will be but I do think he is very limited in how much time he has because every day that goes by allows Iran to put its nuclear capabilities beyond Israel's powers to destroy."

Headline: Hamas Working on Being Removed from EU, U.S. Terror Lists

Gaza's ruling Hamas terrorist group said on Monday that the group's removal from the U.S. and European countries' lists of terrorism organizations "has become a matter of time." Ahmed Youssef, one of Hamas's leaders, told the Bethlehem-based *Ma'an* news agency, "There are contacts [being] made by the movement, with the help of Arab and Islamic countries such as Qatar, Egypt and Turkey, to convince major and European countries to take Hamas's name out of the terrorism list." Youssef claimed that the contacts received positive responses from some European countries, without naming them, saying that visits from other Western countries are also positive signs. "Despite the requirement of the international Quartet [for us] to recognize Israel in order to take Hamas off of the terrorism list, we will not do so," he said, according to *Ma'an*.

Headline: World Bank blames Israel for damaging PA economy

The World Bank charges that Israel's system of checkpoints, delays in transferring millions of dollars in tax revenue and preventing most exports from Gaza have caused lasting damage to the Palestinian economy. Tuesday's report said deteriorating water and transport infrastructure were also serious problems, particularly in Gaza. Israel officials cite security concerns for restrictions. The report said economic problems were exacerbated by shortfalls in donor aid, forcing the Palestinian Authority to borrow unsustainable amounts from local banks to stay afloat. The report said the small Palestinian economy has slowly unraveled over nearly 20 years, with exports falling from 10 percent of the economy in 1994 to just 7 percent today, one of the world's lowest levels. The report was issued ahead of a donors meeting in Brussels on March 19.

Headline: Clashes erupt in Ain al-Helweh

Clashes erupted Tuesday morning in the Ain al-Helweh Palestinian refugee camp in South Lebanon's Sidon between a Palestinian faction and an Islamist group, a day after the latter's leader was shot in the camp. Eleven people were injured in the fighting between members of the pro-Syrian regime Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine - General Command (PFLP-GC) and the Islamist Bilal Badr group, the National News Agency reported. Meanwhile, LBC television said that the clashes erupted after a grenade exploded near the PFLP-GC office in the camp's Fawqani Street. Future TV reported at noon that the clashes ended and tense calm prevailed over the Palestinian refugee camp. Afterward, camp residents held a march to call for an end to internal fighting.

Headline: Saudi preacher calls for 'joint fatwa' against Assad

An influential Saudi preacher called Monday on Muslim scholars to issue a joint fatwa against Syrian President Bashar al-Assad, whose regime – according to the United Nations – has killed more than 70,000 people since the uprising erupted two years. Sheikh Ayed al-Qarni told Al Arabiya that the Council of Senior Scholars in Saudi Arabia and Al-Azhar University in Egypt should condemn Assad and his government, adding that the killing of the Syrian president was justified. Qarni's statement came following the recent announcement by Syrian Grand Mufti Ahmad Bedreddine Hassoun that it was a "religious obligation" of Muslims to support Assad. The Saudi sheikh said that the actions of the Syrian regime go against Islamic principles, adding that Assad's government has committed crimes against women and unarmed civilians.

Headline: Jihadist groups test-fire long range rocket in central Sinai

Headline: Hamas: We'll Continue to Transfer Arms from Sinai

Salafist jihadi groups test fired a long range rocket in the Sinai Peninsula, an Egyptian military official told Egyptian state TV on Sunday. The official said the rocket launch was part of exercises being held by jihadi groups in the peninsula, and that the rocket was in fact Israeli ordnance that had been collected by Bedouin. Bedouin are known to scavenge areas where the IDF practices drills, or have been stationed in search of munitions to sell, often to terrorist groups who then deploy those arms against the IDF and Egyptian security forces. According to the military official, the rocket was fired toward an unoccupied area in central Sinai, and its explosion caused a three-meter (10-foot) deep crater.

Delivering a historic address to the European Parliament on Tuesday, President Shimon Peres called for the Arab League to intervene in the Syrian crisis, urging the nations "to stop the massacre."

"The Arab League can and should form a provisional government in Syria to stop the massacre, to prevent Syria from falling to pieces. The United Nations should support the Arab League to build an Arab force in blue helmets," Peres said, according to the *AFP* news agency.

Headline: Battle over Syria's Aleppo airport intensifies

Headline: Syrian forces kill 30 deserters in ambush: opposition

New clashes erupted Tuesday in an intensifying battle for control over Aleppo's international airport and nearby military bases in Syria's north, activists said. Rebels have tried for weeks to capture Aleppo's international airport and nearby air bases as part of their campaign to erode the regime's air supremacy in the 2-year-old conflict that the United Nations says has claimed more than 70,000 lives. Rebels have made significant strategic advances in the north in the past months, capturing military bases, two dams on the Euphrates river and the city of Raqqa in the northwest - the first urban area to fall into opposition hands since the uprising against Assad's regime began in March 2011.

The rebels also control large swathes of land outside of Aleppo. The battle for the city itself, Syria's main commercial hub, is locked in a stalemate. Rebels pushed into the city in July and captured several neighborhoods and it has been a major battleground in the civil war ever since.

Iran: Jeremiah 49:34-39

Israel’s Chief of Staff Lt. Gen. Benny Gantz rated war as a “low risk” for the foreseeable future, but credited the risk of escalation as “very high,” in a lecture he delivered Monday, March 11 at the Herzliya Interdisciplinary Institute for policy and strategy. “Almost every week, some incident occurs that could drag the region into a conflagration,” he warned. debkafile’s military sources: Gen. Gantz’s distinction between “war” and “conflagration” stems from the differentiation Israel’s senior policy-making and military circles have begun making of late to support a misconception that a full-blown war is no longer on the cards at present. They support this rationale by arguing that full-scale war can only be fought by large regular armies, while a “conflagration” or “escalation” entails smaller units and less terrain. What this kind of thinking omits to take into account is that, while the regular Arab national armies which attacked Israel in the past are indeed crumbling, the militias in their countries are mushrooming dangerously. They are bursting out of their national boundaries, nourished with arms, manpower and funding from distant sources in and beyond the Middle East.

Five suspects have been arrested for their alleged involvement in an explosion last month near Turkey’s southern border that killed 14 people, police said. The suspects said individuals connected to Syria’s intelligence agency paid them \$35,000 for their work and said commands came from Ammid Havvas, the commander of armed forces in the Syrian army.

Hundreds of UN peacekeepers have been deployed to a volatile state in South Sudan before an expected government offensive against a militant group in the country. According to an unnamed UN envoy, the UN Mission in South Sudan (UNMISS) has moved the peacekeepers to Jonglei state. The deployment comes ahead of an operation by the Sudanese government against fighters loyal to militant leader David Yau Yau. "We are expecting a military operation against David Yau Yau to happen quite soon," UNMISS chief Hilde Johnson said, adding, "If the military operations start... we will have to be present on the ground to protect civilians to the maximum extent possible."

Headline: Man sets himself on fire in central Tunisia, protesting against unemployment

A man set himself on fire Tuesday at the Tunisian capital's center, only hours before the country's lawmakers were to vote on a new government tasked with pulling Tunisia out of a deep political crisis. "This is a young man who sells cigarettes because of unemployment," shouted the man before immolating himself on Habib Bourguiba Avenue, a witness told AFP. "Allahu Akbar! (God is greatest!)" said the severely burned man who was reportedly still conscious when emergency services rushed him to the hospital, reported AFP. Police officers and firefighters refused to reveal information about the man, who is believed to be in his 20s. The number of people committing suicide or attempting to take their own lives has multiplied in Tunisia since a young street vendor set himself on fire on December 17, 2010, in a drastic act of protest against police harassment. *(the beginning of the "Arab Spring")*

Headline: Iran, Armenia Find Solidarity in Isolation

While the West seeks to isolate Iran over its disputed nuclear program, landlocked Armenia seeks to build relations with its neighbor -- without violating international sanctions. The West seeks to isolate Iran, believing its nuclear program is being used to build a nuclear bomb. Iran denies the charge. But Armenia is positioned between two historic enemies -- Turkey to the west and Azerbaijan to the east. Armenia has no trade or diplomatic ties with the two nations. Instead, it trades north with its Christian neighbor, Georgia. Now it is trying to expand trade and investment to the south, with Iran. "Armenia is the only neighbor of Iran where the regime or the government in Iran feels quite comfortable, and is actually keen to increase relations," says Richard Giragosian, director of the Regional Studies Center, a Yerevan think tank. "From the Armenian perspective, there is a shared sense of isolation, where both Iran and Armenia feel surrounded by either hostile or rival states and feel under blockade or sanctions."

Headline: New anti-euro party forms in Germany

A new party in favour of returning to the Deutsche Mark is taking shape in Germany, hoping to attract voters disillusioned by the political establishment. Unlike other European countries, Germany's firm pro-EU and pro-euro stance is deeply anchored in the public psyche, with eurosceptic rhetoric taking place only on the fringes of the political spectrum. But the new "Alternative for Germany" party is hoping to capitalise on a growing resentment about the euro-crisis and what Germans perceive as costly bailouts for profligate southern countries. Backed by Hans-Olaf Henkel, a prominent eurosceptic and former head of the German Industry Federation (BDI), the new party is expected to have its official launch on 14 April in Berlin. "I'm trying to save Europe. There is a schism in Europe, a divergence not convergence," Bernd Lucke, one of the leaders of the new party said Monday (11 March) at their first public event, which gathered around 1,200 people in Oberursel, a small town north of Frankfurt.

After two Korea-U.S. joint military drills end, American vessels equipped with nuclear weapons will stay in South Korean waters to fully guarantee the U.S. “nuclear umbrella” in case North Korea attacks. A high-ranking South Korean government official told the JoongAng Ilbo yesterday, “If North Korea makes a nuclear attack, retaliation can come from U.S. nuclear weapons stationed in Okinawa or Guam. But considering the time that might take, we need to have a nuclear weapon near the Korean Peninsula. “By not withdrawing U.S. weapons participating in the Korea-U.S. military exercises, we decided to let them stay a while and see what happens in North Korea,” he said.

Headline: China plans to survey disputed isles: Chinese officials

China is set to carry out a survey of the disputed isles claimed by both Tokyo and Beijing, Chinese officials say. According to China’s mapping agency Vice Director Li Pengde on Tuesday, Beijing planned to land a survey team on the disputed islands - known as Senkaku in Japan and Diaoyu in China - based on certain geological features. “My hope is that we can get under way under conditions where the situation is relatively good and the survey team's physical safety can be assured,” Li added in an interview with state broadcaster CCTV. Following the remarks made by Li, Japan's Foreign Ministry issued a statement saying that Beijing “has no reason to conduct a land survey because the islands are undoubtedly Japanese territory.”

Headline: Algae bloom kills record number of manatees in Florida

Florida's endangered manatees have long suffered from human activity, but this year they face an especially deadly threat hidden in the waters where they swim. An algae bloom off southwest Florida, called Florida red tide, has killed 174 manatees since January, the highest number to die from red tide in a calendar year, state wildlife officials said Monday. A red tide is a higher than normal concentration of a microscopic algae that appears in the Gulf of Mexico. At high enough concentrations, the algae can turn the water red or brown, hence the name. Red tides happen almost every year in southwest Florida and sometimes last just a few weeks, but this year the red tide has lingered and settled in an area of warm water where the manatees have migrated.

Headline: Snow disrupts Frankfurt flights and Eurostar trains

Frankfurt airport, Europe's third-busiest hub, has partially re-opened after heavy snow caused severe travel disruption in north-west Europe. One of the three runways was operating again for take-offs only, the airport operator said. Hundreds of flights via Frankfurt and Paris have been cancelled. The Eurostar high-speed train service between London, Paris and Brussels has been suspended until at least Wednesday. In south-eastern England, hundreds of people were stranded in their cars by the snow as emergency services struggled with road chaos. There were huge traffic jams in Belgium and

northern France too. Frankfurt airport had received about 12cm (5in) of snow, said Stefan Schulte, a spokesman for the airport operator, Fraport AG.

Headline: Bomb near Pakistan politician’s house wounds six according to local police

Headline: Pakistani election commissioner shot dead

A bomb exploded close to the home of a prominent provincial minister in restive northwest Pakistan on Tuesday, wounding six people including three children, police said. The blast hit in the town of Pabbi, just 60 meters from the home of Mian Iftikhar Hussain, the information minister for Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province, which is frequently hit by attacks by Islamist militants. Hussain, a member of the province’s ruling Awami National Party (ANP) whose son was killed by Taliban militants, was 25 kilometers away in Peshawar at the time of the blast, police said. “A bomb exploded near the house

of information minister Mian Iftikhar Hussain and wounded three children and three passersby,” district police chief Mohammad Hussain told AFP. Asked if the minister was the target, the police official said: “It is a terrorism incident.”

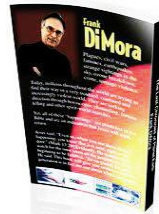
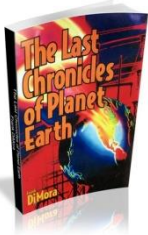

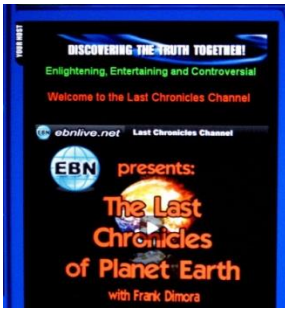
