Jerusalem police detectives detained right-wing activist Noam Federman and others for questioning, Monday afternoon, and seized a lamb the activists wanted to sacrifice on the Temple Mount in Jerusalem's Old City. Police cited them for transporting an animal without a permit. Federman reacted by saying, "We demand to offer the Passover sacrifice, one of the most important commandments. The Jerusalem police are harming freedom of religion. Several Temple movement tried to make the Pesach sacrifice on the Temple Mount Monday, expecting police to block their way, as has happened in previous years. The activists planned to assemble at the promenade near the Jaffa Gate of Jerusalem's Old City at 1:30 p.m., with the goats and lambs they plan to sacrifice. At 1:45, led by Noam Federman, they were to begin advancing toward the Temple Mount, with the hope of setting up what they term a minimal kosher altar" there.

# Headline: U.S. quietly unblocks almost \$500m in frozen funds for Palestinians

U.S. Secretary of State John Kerry met with Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu in Jerusalem on Saturday after earlier talking to Palestinian President Mahmoud Abbas in Jordan in a bid to revive stalled peace talks. Kerry's back-to-back meetings followed up on President Barack Obama's visits to Israel and the Palestinian Territories this week in which he called for fresh diplomatic efforts but offered no new peace proposals of his own. Kerry, who had accompanied Obama on his trip and then stayed on in the region, met privately for two hours with Abbas in Jordan's capital of Amman, a Palestinian source told Reuters. A State Department official said earlier that Kerry planned "to continue the conversations they started with President Obama and the secretary earlier this week". March 24, 2013

# Headline: Israel to renew transfer of tax funds to Palestinian Authority

Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu announced Monday Israel will renew the normal transfer of the tax funds it collects for the Palestinian Authority. The move comes in the wake of United States President Barak Obama's visit to Israel and the West Bank and in response to requests from Washington. Israel froze the tax revenues after Palestine earned recognition as a nonmember observer state at the United Nations in November 2012 – the culmination of a bid led by PA President Mahmoud Abbas. Close to a billion shekels in Palestinian tax revenues were confiscated to offset the PA's debt to the Israel Electric Corporation and other Israeli organizations. While in the country last week, Obama and U.S. Secretary of State John Kerry asked Netanyahu to introduce a series of confidence-building measures in hopes of kick-starting negotiations between Israel and the PA, Haaretz reported Sunday.

Israeli leader Benjamin Netanyahu apologized Friday to Turkey over a 2010 commando raid on a Gaza aid flotilla that killed nine Turkish activists, the White House said, in a phone call brokered by US President Barack Obama and confirmed by Israeli and Turkish officials. "Netanyahu said that he regretted that that incident had led to a deterioration in their relations," a senior US official said of the phone call between Netanyahu and Turkish Prime Minister Recep Tayyip Erdogan, a conversation which Obama urged and in which, the White House said, he briefly took part. Meanwhile, Turkish Prime Minister Tayyip Erdogan Friday called President Mahmoud Abbas to brief him on the agreement he has reached with Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu concerning the 2010 Mavi Marmara flotilla incident. Erdogan told Abbas that all of Turkey's demands for reconciliation were met. President Abbas told the Turkish premier that he values his government's support for the Palestinian cause and the peace process and the fact that Turkish nationals gave their lives on board of the Mavi Marmara in support of the Palestinian cause and the right of Palestinians to live freely and in dignity. Abbas considered all who died on the flotilla as martyrs.

# Headline: UNHRC approves settlements report

A report that calls for boycotting West Bank settlement products and states that Israel could be brought before the International Criminal Court for Jewish building over the pre-1967 lines was approved Friday by the United Nations Human Rights Council in Geneva. Only the United States voted against the report, which was penned by a three-member fact-finding mission. Speaking before the vote the US said that it was troubled by the council's biased and disproportionate focus on Israel. Although the status quo is not sustainable and the US is committed to resolving the Israeli Palestinian conflict, it does not believe that reports such as the one completed by the fact-finding mission can help achieve that objective, the US said. Israel cut its ties with the council when it formed the factfinding mission last year. The report stated that Israel had an obligation under international law not to transfer its population into the Palestinian territories, as it had done by constructing West Bank settlements.

Headline: Syrian gunfire hits military vehicles in Israeli Golan: army Headline: Israeli defense minister vows 'immediate' answer to all fire from Syria Gunfire from Syria hit Israeli army vehicles travelling in the southern Israeli-occupied Golan Heights on Saturday, causing some damage but no casualties, the army said. "A short while ago, military vehicles travelling in the Golan Heights were lightly damaged by bullets fired from Syria," a spokeswoman told AFP. "No one was injured, and the incident is currently being reviewed." She could not say whether the shots were aimed at the Israeli army or stray bullets from fighting in Syria between rebels and army troops. Israel is closely monitoring its border with Syria and fears that jihadist elements from among the rebels fighting the regime of President Bashar al-Assad might attempt to attack the Jewish state. Israel's new Defense Minister Moshe Yaalon on Sunday vowed an "immediate" answer to all Syrian gunfire onto the Israeli occupied Golan Heights, saying the Damascus regime was responsible. "Every violation of Israeli sovereignty and shooting from the Syrian side will immediately be answered by silencing the source of fire," a statement quoted him as saying an Al Arabiya correspondent reported Israeli shells being fired at a Syrian army post. # Headline: IDF fires missile into Syria after more cross-border shooting

IDF soldiers on Sunday morning fired a Tammuz missile at a Syrian army position in Tel Fares, from which shots were fired both that day and the previous day across the border into the Israeli-controlled Golan Heights. The missile destroyed the Syrian post and reportedly wounded two gunmen there. A military spokesman said the soldiers responded with "accurate fire toward the Syrian post from which they were fired upon." He could not say whether regular Syrian forces or rebels fired. # Headline: Syrian jihadists' gains near border place Jordan on 'high alert' Headline: Jordan closes main border crossing with Syria

Military gains by Syrian jihadist and rebel forces along the Syrian-Jordanian border on Sunday placed Jordan on "high alert", military sources said, as the armed groups moved closer to the occupied Golan Heights. According to a Jordanian military source stationed in the northern region, Jordanian forces mobilised across the north early on Sunday after the Free Syrian Army (FSA) announced its seizure of a 30-kilometre stretch of the Jordanian-Syrian border, running from southwest Daraa to the occupied Golan Heights. The FSA's so-called Yarmouk Martyrs' Brigades was assisted by Al Qaeda-linked Jabhat Al Nusra, a jihadist coalition, in its "strategic victory". The gains came after an intense two-day battle with regime forces, rebel forces and security sources say, prompting fears that Islamic militants are now patrolling the Jordanian border and the edges of the disputed Golan Heights. Headline: Lebanon falls into political, security vacuum after Mikati step down Headline: Hezbollah wanted cabinet to resign, Future MP says

Lebanon's Prime Minister Najib Mikati announced his government's resignation on Friday after a cabinet dispute with Shi'ite group Hezbollah over preparations for a parliamentary election and extending the term of a senior security official. Mikati's announcement after a deadlocked ministerial meeting plunged Lebanon, already struggling to cope with a spillover of bloodshed and refugees from neighboring <u>Syria</u>, into fresh uncertainty three months before the planned election. Mikati resigned just two hours after a cabinet meeting in which Shi'ite group Hezbollah and its allies blocked the creation of a supervisory body for the parliamentary vote and opposed extending the term of a senior security official.

# **Comment**: A little background refresher will help here: Saad Hariri was the prime minister of Lebanon until 2011when he was forced to hand over Lebanon to Hezbollah candidate Mikati, the very people responsible for the assassination of his father, former prime minister Rafic Hariri.

# Headline: UN reports major increase in Israeli air activity over Lebanon

Israel has doubled its overflights in Lebanese airspace thus far in 2013, compared to the previous year. This move, according to sources in the United Nations force stationed in southern Lebanon on Monday, may point to imminent potential maneuvers against Syria. In one particularly unusual recent incident, on March 14, "some 25 Israeli jets — a mix of F-16s and F-15s in four separate flights — [flew] north up the coast of Lebanon before turning south just short of Tartus in Syria," according to a UNIFIL source quoted in a Lebanese <u>Daily Star</u> report Monday. Israel also reportedly flew seven drone missions over areas of southern Lebanon and the Bekaa Valley, where Hezbollah has a strong presence, on March 13 and 14. The unprecedented scope of the overflights "could have been a training exercise to target Syrian coastal radar and air defense systems" in what could be considered "a muscle-flexing gesture to let Damascus know that the Israeli Air Force is primed for action," the UNIFIL source said.

# Headline: Saudi official warns against fighting in Syria

The Saudi Interior Ministry spokesman has warned Saudis fighting in Syria they will be arrested when they return home. Maj. Gen. Mansour al-Turki says "involvement in the Syrian crisis is against Saudi laws." Al-Turki said Monday authorities will also crack down on those planning to travel to Syria to join the fighting there and that some Saudis who joined the Syrian conflict have already fought for al-Qaida outside the kingdom. He also commented on last week's arrest of an 18-member spying ring in the kingdom. The ministry has said the detainees included an Iranian, a Lebanese and 16 Saudis who were suspected of "gathering information about vital installations and locations."

# Headline: Muslim Brotherhood buses set on fire, 120 injured in Cairo clashes Headline: Egypt police guard Brotherhood HQ after violent night

Four buses belonging to Egypt's Muslim Brotherhood were torched and about 120 people were injured in clashes between opposition protesters and the group's loyalists near the Brotherhood headquarters in Cairo. The violence erupted after activists marched to the building guarded by police and Brotherhood members. More than 120 people were hurt as the two sides pelted each other with stones, emergency services chief Mohammed Soltan told MENA. Shots were heard as hundreds of opposition activists and the Islamists battled in the streets of the Mokattam neighborhood where the headquarters are situated, but there were no immediate reports of gunshot casualties. Police had fired tear gas at the protesters outside the headquarters before the clashes moved elsewhere in the neighborhood.

# Headline: Morsi warns of imminent response to opponents

Egyptian President Mohamed Morsi has warned his opponents saying he may take imminent unspecified measures to "protect this nation." Morsi made the remarks during a speech on Sunday at the opening session of a conference named the Initiative to support the Rights and Freedoms of the Egyptian Women in Cairo. "If I have to do what is necessary to protect this nation I will, and I am afraid that I may be close to doing so," the Egyptian president said, adding, "I will do so very, very soon. Sooner than those trying to shake the image of this nation think... Let us not be dragged into an area where I will take a harsh decision." Morsi's statement came days after supporters of his Muslim Brotherhood movement and opposition protesters fought street battles, in which nearly 200 people were injured.


rulers, jizya was a material proof of the non-Muslims' acceptance of subjection to the state and its laws.

# Headline: Syrian Jihadist Rebels Seize Jordan-Israeli Buffer Zone Headline: Syrian opposition fighters seize key military base in Deraa

Syrian rebel forces have seized a 25-kilometer (15 mile) buffer zone stretching from the Jordanian border to the Golan Heights. According to the UK-based Syrian Observatory for Human Rights watchdog agency, "Fighters loyal to Al Nusra Front, Al Yarmuk Brigade, Al Mutaz Billah Brigade and others took control of Al Rai military checkpoint" east of Sahem al-Golan, in the Dara'a province. "The fighters seized the site after regime forces retreated," the statement continued. "The 25-kilometer area located between the towns of Muzrib (near the Jordanian border) and Abdin (in the Golan Heights) is now out of regime control," AFP reported. The rebel forces referred to in the statement are part of the radical jihadist group known as the Islamic Front for the Liberation of Syria, which despises what it considers the rival Western-backed Syrian National Council, the larger opposition force.

# Headline: Damascus: Rebels Attack Area a Kilometer from Palace

Syrian opposition campaigners said on Monday Syrian President Bashar Assad's forces fired what they said were chemical weapons from multiple rocket launchers at rebels surrounding an army base in the town of Adra on the outskirts of Damascus, killing two fighters and wounding 23. "Doctors are describing the chemical weapon used as phosphorus that hits the nervous system and causes imbalance and loss of consciousness. The two fighters were very close to where the rockets exploded and they died swiftly. The rest are being treated with Atropine," said Mohammad al-Doumani, an activist in the nearby town of Douma, where the wounded were transported. There was no independent confirmation of the attack, which follows the death of 26 people in a rocket attack near the city of Aleppo last week. The authorities and rebels accused each other of firing a

missile carrying chemicals there.

# Headline: Arab League reportedly gives Syria's seat to rebels Headline: Syria slams Arab League for giving seat to rebels

The Arab League transferred the Syrian seat in its 22-member bloc to the Syrian opposition, an Arab official told AFP on Monday, ahead of a scheduled meeting in Doha on Tuesday. The move represents a blow to the regime of Syrian President Bashar Assad, whose seat has been vacant since its suspension in November 2011, several months after the unrest in the country began. The Arab League's decision is unlikely to mean much in practical terms to Assad's regime, which has already been abandoned by many Arab states that are siding with rebel forces in the two-year-long civil war. But it reflects pressure being exerted by key rebel backers — Qatar and Saudi Arabia — for a show of Arab solidarity against Assad at a two-day Arab League summit beginning Tuesday in Doha.

Iraqi authorities say a string of attacks have left at least six people dead, including a candidate in the upcoming provincial elections. Police officials say gunmen attacked two military posts in the northern city of Mosul, killing a total of five soldiers and wounding three others. Mosul is 360 kilometers (225 miles) northwest of Baghdad.In Baghdad, gunmen killed Salah Khabat, a candidate in provincial council elections, in a drive-by-shooting. Hospital officials confirmed Sunday's death toll. All of the officials spoke on condition of anonymity because they weren't authorized to release the information. March 24, 2013

# Headline: In Moscow, new Chinese leader Xi warns against meddling

Newly-elected Chinese President Xi Jinping has affirmed that China and Russia will continue to strengthen and develop their military, political and strategic relations, including cooperation between their armed forces. Xi Jinping, who is on a three-day visit to Russia – his first foreign visit since becoming Chinese president last week, met on Saturday with the Russian military leadership in the Russian Armed Forces' Operational Command Center. He is the first foreign leader ever to be allowed inside the "heart" of the Russian military establishment. "My visit to the Russian Defense Ministry is intended to confirm that military, political and strategic relations between the two countries will strengthen as will cooperation between the Armed Forces of China and Russia," the Chinese president told Russian Defense Minister Sergei Shoigu.

About 200 former rebel fighters in Libya have besieged the prime minister's office, demanding that he resign. The militia members, who did not threaten violence, want Prime Minister Ali Zidan to step down in accordance with a political isolation law banning members of the former regime from political life. He served as an ambassador under Moammar Gadhafi, who was ousted in an eight-month civil war. The law is controversial because it bans anyone who worked with Gadhafi from 1969 until he was killed in 2011. The prime minister's convoy was seen moving around the capital, Tripoli, last week with more security guards than usual — after an influx of militias from around the country. March 24, 2013

Moroccan police violently dispersed a protest by separatists in the Western Sahara, Algerian TV and rights activists reported on Monday, during a visit to the disputed territory by UN envoy Christopher Ross. The independent Ennahar TV channel broadcast images of plainclothes Moroccan police beating Sahrawi men and women in Laayoune, chasing them through the streets and dragging some of them along the ground. "The police violently dispersed Sahrawi activists who attempted to stage a protest demanding the independence of the Western Sahara," an unidentified activist was quoted as saying. Mahmoud Iguilid, the Laayoune representative of the Moroccan Association for Human Rights, confirmed the violent suppression of Sahrawi activists, which he said took place on Saturday, before a planned protest to coincide with Ross's visit. "Plainclothes police beat up the activists, many of them women, to prevent the protest. It happens every time there is a visit by a UN or human rights official," he told AFP, adding that security in the region had been heavily reinforced.

# Headline: Top three banks in Cyprus downgraded as country tries to secure bailout Headline: Russia makes Cyprus nervous as talks fail

Moody's downgraded Friday the credit ratings of Cyprus's top three banks to Caa3 as the country was considering bank account levies to secure an international bailout and avoid a collapse of its financial sector. Moody's Investors Service said the lowering of ratings for Bank of Cyprus, Cyprus Popular Bank and Hellenic Bank was due to expectations depositors would suffer losses, the risk capital controls would be imposed and uncertainty regarding their recapitalization plans. Moody's now rates the standalone credit strength of all three banks as Ca, or highly vulnerable to default. "The situation in Cyprus remains very fluid and the risk of significant losses has increased, as has the risk of a bank liquidation scenario," said Moody's. The Cypriot government is currently working on a new plan to raise some seven billion euros (\$9 billion) in order to unlock 10 billion euros in bailout assistance from the EU and IMF. There has been speculation that the government could close Popular Bank to lower the cost of recapitalizing the banks. The European Central Bank has warned it will cut of emergency assistance to Cypriot banks unless the country agrees on a bailout plan by Monday.

# Headline: Cypriot archbishop calls for euro-exit

Eurozone finance ministers have agreed a 10bn-euro bailout deal for Cyprus to prevent its banking system collapsing and keep the country in the eurozone. Laiki (Popular) Bank - the country's secondbiggest - will be wound down and deposit-holders with more than 100,000 euros (\$130,000; £85,000) will face big losses. However, all deposits under 100,000 euros will be "fully guaranteed". Officials warn the island faces a deep recession with many businesses to shut. The European Central Bank had set a deadline of Monday for the deal, which came a week after the Cypriot parliament rejected a proposed bank levy on small and large deposits. The new deal will not be put to a vote in the Cyprus parliament.

# Headline: Britain set to lose second AAA credit rating

George Osborne was served notice on Friday night that the UK's AAA credit status will be downgraded for a second time when ratings agency Fitch said Britain's lack of growth and rising debt mountain meant there was a "heightened probability of a downgrade in the near term". Delivering its verdict on this week's budget, Fitch said it was writing a report, due in April, that analysts said is almost certain to strip the UK of the second of its three AAA ratings. Fitch said the notice of a possible downgrade reflected "the latest economic and fiscal forecasts published by the Office for Budget Responsibility (OBR) that indicate that UK government debt will peak later and at a higher level than previously expected by Fitch". The government will find out in April whether the economy suffered an unprecedented triple-dip recession. In the last three months of 2012 the economy shrank 0.3%. A second straight quarter of negative growth could undermine faltering business confidence and choke off the first signs of a recovery.

# Headline: 1,000 ducks found dead in river in SW China

Up to 1,000 rotten dead ducks have been found floating in a river in Meishan city, Southwest China's Sichuan province, China Central Television (CCTV) reported on Sunday. With the joint efforts of local environmental protection, waterworks and livestock department, the dead ducks have been disinfected with lime and buried three meters underground in a designated area, said Liang Weidong, deputy director of the publicity office of Pengshan county.Liang denied it was a dumping work by local residents. Bagged in 50 to 60 plastic woven bags, the duck carcasses are believed to have been washed downward from upstream and accumulated in the Pengshan section of Nanhe river due to lack of water in dry season. The cause of their death is unknown. The incident poses no threat to drinking water, nor does it endanger residents and livestock along the river banks, said Liang. Thousands of dead pigs were retrieved from Shanghai's Huangpu River at the beginning of this month and they were thought to have been dumped in Jiaxing, Zhejiang province. March 25, 2013

# Headline: Treasury Sued to Remove 'God' from Currency

The Freedom From Religion Foundation is suing the U.S. Treasury Department to remove "In God We Trust" from all its currency. A nonprofit organization that represents atheists and agnostics, the FFRF claims the motto is "offensive" to the nonreligious. In February, the FFRF and 19 plaintiffs filed a civil suit in New York claiming the motto violates the First and Fifth Amendments of the Constitution; they also claim it forces atheists, agnostics and secular skeptics to impart a religious message they all decry whenever using U.S. currency, resulting in a false declaration of their own religious views. Dan Barker, co-president of the Wisconsin-based FFRF, also believes the motto sends a religious message to everyone who uses U.S. currency. "[In God We Trust] is indeed considered to be a religious phrase," Barker told The Christian Post. "The message belongs in churches, private institutions and can be shared by missionaries, but who is the 'we' representing, if not all of us trust in a God?" Barker said the purpose of the motto, first proposed in the 1950s, was to proselytize Christianity whenever Americans exchange currency overseas. "The idea was that 'as our money goes around the world, we are sharing our Christianity." Barker told the Post that the plaintiffs are not advocating the motto be replaced, just removed.

# Headline: Rise of Islam fuels Christian persecution

In the wake of the "Arab Spring" across northern Africa, Islam has been on the rise throughout the continent, and with it, violent persecution against Christians. Christians in Tanzania, for example, are on alert after an Assemblies of God pastor was killed while attempting to stop Muslim youth from killing two Christian meat cutters. Pastor Mathayo Kachili died on the scene from injuries sustained during the brutal beating by the Muslim teenagers. International Christian Concern says that this attack set off a two-week string of violent anti-Christian attacks in Tanzania's northwestern Geita region. Only days after the pastor was killed, Muslim militants on the island of Zanzibar killed a Father Evarist Mushi, a Catholic priest. International Christian Concern's Africa analyst William Stark told WND in an interview that the priest's murder links violence in Africa to terrorist activity throughout the region. "After a Catholic priest was shot and killed, a text message was sent out tying the attackers to Somalia, thus proving the link of radicalization between Zanzibar and Somalia. It is likely that many of the attackers have been trained in Somalia by al-Shabaab, but that is pretty hard to prove," Stark said. Stark adds that the Muslims in Tanzania are radicalizing at a rapid rate.

# Headline: Magnitude 6.1 earthquakes strike Kuril Islands and 6.0 Hits Vanuatu

A 6.1 magnitude earthquake struck off the coast of far-eastern Russia early Sunday, the US Geological Survey reported. The quake, which hit at 0418 GMT at a depth of 9.7 kilometers (six miles), was centered 269 kilometers from the eastern Russian city of Ozernovsky, on the southern tip of the Kamchatka peninsula. The USGS said an underground formation there called the Kuril-Kamchatka arc is considered one of the most seismically active regions in the world. Since 1900, seven powerful earthquakes of magnitude 8.3 or greater have occurred along the arc, the USGS said. Four hours later, a 6.0 magnitude earthquake struck near the South Pacific island enclave of Vanuatu.

The earthquake swarm continues to move the California side of Peavine Mountain near Bordertown. According UNR's seismology lab, equipment detected more than a dozen quakes Saturday and another dozen Sunday morning. They are mostly too small to feel with the largest recorded at magnitudes of 2.1. The swarm includes more than 150 of the small earthquakes and has lasted a week. # Headline: Spring dumps blizzards on United Kingdom: the coldest March in 50 years

Britain is bracing itself for more horrendous weather conditions which are believed to have claimed a first victim, closed hundreds of schools and brought travel chaos. A landslide and floodwater in Cornwall, thought to have been triggered by torrential rain, smashed through a block of flats partially collapsing the building. Emergency crews and specialist investigators found a woman's body after picking through debris at the Veronica flats in Looe. The body is believed to be that of Susan Norman, who is in her 60s and police said was unaccounted for, having not been heard from since returning to the flats on Thursday night. More than a dozen residents in Sandplace Road were evacuated after most of the building's front-facing wall crumbled away, with debris and mud crashing on to the back of the property from the road behind it. More flooding is expected in the South West as heavy rain continued while residents mopped up. Further north, snow blanketed many areas and closed several hundred schools. As forecasters warned this month could be the coldest March in 50 years, officials issued weather and travel warnings dashing any hopes of spring.

# Headline: Tornado kills 23: injures over 500 in Bangladesh, as it sweeps through 25 villages

The death toll from a tornado that swept through some 25 villages in eastern Bangladesh, rose to 23 with rescuers finding three more bodies in debris, a day after the deadly storm which also left nearly 500 people injured. The storm which hit the area on Friday, left a trail of destruction in 20 villages of Brahmanbaria sadar, Bijoynagar and Akhaura upazilas. "Three more bodies were recovered today. One of them was Yasmin, who is the mother of two young boys and was found inside the tank of a sanitary latrine," a local journalist at the site said. Television footage showed villagers under an open sky around their flattened homes awaiting relief as the storm that lasted for some 15 minutes wreaked havoc in the area. # Headline: Seven killed in Islamist attack on Malian city of Gao Headline: Al Qaeda in North Africa appoints new chief as France confirms predecessor's death

Seven people, including a soldier and two civilians, were killed in clashes Sunday between the Malian army and Islamist militants in northern Mali's largest city of Gao, military sources said. "A Malian soldier, four Islamists and two civilians were killed Sunday during exchanges of gunfire between the Malian army and Islamists," an African security source told AFP in Gao, after the Malian army earlier said it was carrying out a "clean-up" operation targeting militants who claimed an overnight attack on an army camp. Islamic extremists infiltrated and attacked the northern Malian city of Gao, the mayor and residents said late Saturday. It was the third major attack on the town since it was liberated by French forces in January. The assault indicates that the radical Islamists remain entrenched and able to attack despite the thousands of French troops who have liberated most of northern Mali's towns from control by the extremists. Meanwhile, The North African terror group al Qaeda in the Islamic Maghreb named a new operational commander in Mali over the weekend as France confirmed the death of his predecessor.

# Headline: C. Africa suspended from African Union, says official

France has sent some 350 troops to the Central African Republic to counter the Seleka fighters, who have allegedly taken control of the capital city of Bangui. According to a senior official who spoke on condition of anonymity on Sunday, some 150 French military personnel were dispatched from Libreville, the capital of Gabon, a day after 200 French troops arrived in Bangui. This comes after fighters in the Central African Republic said they had taken control of the capital city following heavy fighting. The fighters on Sunday also seized the presidential palace in the capital and forced President Francois Bozize to flee to neighboring Democratic Republic of Congo. On Saturday,

hundreds of Seleka forces entered the capital, and called on President Bozizé to leave. <u>Comment</u>: So now they're fighting in Mali AND C.A.R. 

# Headline: Buddhist-Muslim violence spreads in Myanmar

Anti-Muslim mobs rampaged through three more towns in Myanmar's predominantly Buddhist heartland over the weekend, destroying mosques and burning dozens of homes despite government efforts to stem the nation's latest outbreak of sectarian violence. President Thein Sein had declared an emergency in central Myanmar on Friday and deployed army troops to the worst-hit city, Meikhtila, where 32 people were killed and 10,000 mostly Muslim residents were displaced. But even as soldiers restored order there after several days of anarchy in which armed Buddhists torched the city's Muslim quarters, the unrest has spread south toward the capital, Naypyitaw.
