A Palestinian prisoner serving a life sentence in Israel who had been suffering from terminal cancer died at Soroka Medical Center in Beersheba on Tuesday, setting off unrest in a number of prisons. The prisoner, 64-year-old Maisara Abu Hamdiyeh, was a Hamas member from the West Bank who was sentenced to life in prison in 2002 for attempted murder, membership in a banned organization, and illegal possession of firearms. The IPS said that after news of his death on Tuesday made it's way to the security prisoners, a number of them began slamming on their cell doors and throwing trash in a number of security blocks at prisons across the country. Prison authorities were able to gain control of the situation, however six prison guards and three prisoners were lightly injured from inhaling tear gas. Palestinians also rioted in the Hebron area at the news of Hamdiyeh's death, throwing Molotov cocktails at security forces. On the official Hamas al-Qassam Brigades twitter page, the organization called for an "urgent solidarity march for the martyr" to be held in Ramallah in the West Bank.

Headline: Hamas re-elects exiled leader Meshaal for a new term: official

Headline: Diplomat: Mashaal re-election opening for 'real engagement with West'

Hamas re-elected on Monday its longtime exiled leader Khaled Meshaal for a new term, officials in the Palestinian Islamic movement said from Cairo. “The leaders of Hamas chose Meshaal,” a high-ranking official told AFP via telephone from the Egyptian capital, requesting anonymity. Hamas officials said earlier that the movement's governing shura council was poised to renew Meshaal's leadership for another four years, with one describing his re-election as “widely known.”

Prior to Monday's vote, however, there had been speculation that the exiled leader would be forced aside by the movement's powerful leaders in the Gaza Strip, which it has controlled since 2007.

Meshaal himself had said last year that he would not seek a new term. But developments in the Middle East since the Arab Spring uprisings of 2011 “pushed Hamas to choose Meshaal...who has given the movement a national face... and has good relations in the Arab world,” one Hamas official said Monday.

Headline: Hamas Law Bans 'Zionist' Ties, Co-Education in Gaza

A law banning “normalizing ties with the Zionist occupation” as well as co-education schooling in the Gaza Strip has entered into force, the education minister for Hamas, said on Monday. The law, which was issued on February 10, was approved by the Islamist movement's legislative council and went into effect on Sunday, Osama Mazini told a news conference. Article 46 of the law, obtained by the *AFP* news agency, will “ban the mixing of students from the two sexes in educational establishments after the age of nine, and work to 'feminize' girls' schools.” Hamas has in the past moved to enforce conservative religious laws, including telling schoolgirls in Gaza to wear traditional full-length robes and headscarves. The newly approved education law also forbids the “receipt of gifts or aid aimed at normalizing (relations) with the Zionist occupation (Israel).”

Headline: Syria mortar shell strikes Golan; Defense Minister: Israel will respond to any security threats

A mortar shell fired from Syria landed in the Israeli Golan Heights on Tuesday evening, and an Israel Defense Forces patrol came under light fire in a separate area of the northern territory.

A string of bullets from the mortar shell hit an IDF jeep touring in the central Golan Heights, near Tel Fares. The jeep sustained light damage, but no casualties were reported in either the shell or light fire incident.. It is not yet clear whether the fire was shot by Syria rebels or forces loyal to President Bashar Assad, and whether it was directed at the IDF force or strayed from the fighting north of the border. The IDF did not response to the either fire. Also Tuesday, militants Gaza Strip launched two rockets at the western Negev. There were no reports of casualties in either of those strikes.

Headline: Israel destroys Syrian outpost in response to cross-border fire

Israeli troops fired tank shells at a Syrian army post Tuesday night after Syrian fighting spilled over into Israel in two separate incidents. The response came a few hours after an IDF patrol on the border came under light fire from across the border and a Syrian mortar landed in the southern Golan Heights. The attacks came shortly after Defense Minister Moshe Ya'alon vowed to continue responding to cross-border Syrian fire during a tour of the border area. The Israeli tanks destroyed an outpost at Tel Hazeka, near where the patrol came under fire. It is not known if there were casualties on the Syrian side. In the late afternoon, a shell fired from Syria slammed into Israel near Tel Fares. There were no reports of injuries or damage in either case incident. Israel has come under spillover fire from Syria's civil war from time to time, often responding by shooting missiles back into the Syrian Golan Heights, where anti-Bashar Assad rebels are waging a bloody battle for control of the country.

Headline: Jordan will face huge unrest in absence of real reforms: Analyst

A 21-year-old student on Tuesday died at Mutah University, where, over the past five days, there has been escalating violence that has caused chaos in the southern governorate of Karak and the suspension of classes at the university until further notice. Several injuries, damaged properties and riots in Faqouh — the native village of the student who died in the campus violence — were the outcome of the clashes that erupted as a result of the student union elections that took place last Wednesday, according to official and other sources. The cause of the fourth-year engineering student's death is still unknown, according to a medical source who spoke to The Jordan Times on condition of anonymity. The student was not involved in the clashes and was a mere “bystander”, according to the source and web-based reports. “He was in the crowd when police used tear gas to disperse the students who restarted the clashes,” the source told The Jordan Times. However, his family refused to allow the forensic doctors in Karak to carry out an autopsy on the body, and demanded health authorities to send doctors from Amman, the medic added.

Unknown attackers kidnapped at least eight members of Syria's Alawite community on Monday after they crossed into Lebanon by bus, a security official said. The assailants seized the group “shortly after their bus crossed the Syrian-Lebanese border via the Jisr Aqmar crossing into the Wadi Khaled area of north Lebanon,” the official told AFP on condition of anonymity. “Women and children were among the group,” the official added, without giving any further details. Two years into a spiralling war in neighboring Syria, sectarian tensions have flared up in Lebanon. Frequent sectarian clashes have

raged in the flashpoint city of Tripoli in northern Lebanon, where Alawite fighters have battled armed members of the Sunni community. Last week, a wave of tit-for-tat kidnappings hit eastern Lebanon, pitting Shiites against Sunnis.

Headline: Saudis demand release of Shia cleric Sheikh Nimr al-Nimr

Protesters have staged an anti-regime demonstration in Saudi Arabia's Eastern Province, calling for the release of senior Shia cleric Sheikh Nimr al-Nimr. The demonstrators took to the streets in the city of Awamiyah, located in the county's Qatif region, chanting anti-regime slogans despite a ban imposed by the regime on public gatherings. On March 28, a Saudi prosecutor reportedly demanded the death penalty for Sheikh Nimr al-Nimr on charges of 'aiding terrorists' and 'instigating unrest' in the kingdom. Sheikh Nimr was attacked, injured and arrested by Saudi security forces en route to his house in the Qatif region of Eastern Province on July 8, 2012.

Egypt

Headline: Egyptian students protest mass food poisoning case

Hundreds of Egyptian students angered by a mass outbreak of food poisoning at a Cairo university stormed on Tuesday the offices of the country's top Muslim cleric, who presides over the institution. The Monday outbreak at al-Azhar University forced the hospitalization of 479 students, health ministry official Khaled el-Khateib said. It occurred after a meal served at the university dormitories in Cairo's Nasr City district. The university is affiliated with Al-Azhar mosque, the world's foremost seat of Sunni Muslim learning, and awards degrees in sciences and humanities as well as in religious studies. Ahmed el-Tayeb, the Grand Imam of Al-Azhar whose offices were attacked, is the university's ultimate authority. Underlining the gravity of the incident, Egypt's top prosecutor ordered an investigation into the outbreak and Islamist President Mohammed Morsi visited one of the several Cairo hospitals to which victims were taken. In Tuesday's protest, thousands of Al-Azhar students blocked the Salah Salem road, a vital artery linking the city's south to its eastern districts. Some of them broke into el-Tayeb's offices on Salah Salem road near the university's main campus in the medieval part of Cairo. The students also protested on Monday, blocking roads outside their dormitories and chanting slogans against the university's management.

Arab news outlets reported Monday that Syrian rebel battalions have seized control of As-Safira, a suburb of Aleppo where, according to foreign reports, President Bashar Assad's largest chemical weapons cache is located. According to the reports, the rebels who took over the city are also close to area in which Syria's largest arms manufacturing factories are concentrated. Assad's forces have withdrawn into this area, the Arab news outlets said. Rebels and forces loyal to Assad have been fighting near As-Safir for months. The Syrian army is trying ward off the rebels by bombing them from the air. Members of the jihadist Jabhat al-Nusra group, which is affiliated with al-Qaeda, are also taking part in the battles in the city. A number of al-Nusra commanders spoke to Al Jazeera about the fighting, but they did not mention the chemical weapons. As clashes rage between Syrian regime troops and rebels in Damascus' suburbs, photos published online showed the regime is resorting to building fortifications to protect its headquarters, Al Arabiya reported Tuesday.

Headline: Historic Damascus synagogue looted and burned

The 2,000-year-old Jobar Synagogue in the Syrian capital of Damascus was looted and burned to the ground. The Syrian army loyal to President Bashar Assad and rebel forces are blaming each other for the destruction of the historic synagogue, according to reports on Sunday. The rebels said the Syrian government looted the synagogue before burning it to the ground, Israel Radio reported Sunday. The government said the rebels burned the synagogue and that so-called Zionist agents stole its historic religious items in an operation that had been planned for several weeks, the Arabic Al-Manar Television reported, citing the Arabic Syria Truth website. The synagogue, one of the oldest in the world, was damaged earlier this month by mortars reportedly fired by Syrian government forces. A video posted online by the Syrian opposition shows extensive damage done to the outside of the synagogue

Headline: Armed men attack Baghdad newspaper offices over story on cleric

A suicide truck bomber killed nine people at a police headquarters on Monday as data showed March was Iraq’s deadliest month since August, raising fears of a surge in violence leading up to elections. The latest attack, in Saddam Hussein’s hometown of Tikrit, comes as Iraq marks 10 years since the US-led invasion of the country that intended to oust Saddam and install a stable, democratic ally in the Middle East but instead unleashed brutal violence and endless political disputes.

The attacker detonated the tanker truck at a police headquarters in Tikrit, 160 kilometres north of Baghdad, killing nine people and wounding 28, according to Mohammed Hassan Attiya, the head of the security committee within the provincial council of Salaheddin, of which Tikrit is the capital.

Among the victims were eight policemen who died and 25 who were wounded, Attiya said.

Also north of the capital, separate attacks in Mosul, Tuz Khurmatu and near Tikrit left a policeman dead, a town mayor and his two bodyguards wounded, and a tribal chief kidnapped and his bodyguard wounded, officials said. No group immediately claimed responsibility for the Tikrit attack, but Sunni militants linked to Al Qaeda often use suicide bombers and vehicles packed with explosives to target security forces and officials in a bid to destabilise the country.

Headline: Russia Not Obligated to Notify West of War Games – Ministry

Russia was not obligated to notify Western countries beforehand of its recent snap military exercises, a top Russian Defense Ministry official said Monday. “The mechanism of checks today is such that we only need to notify Western countries when we hold planned events,” Sergei Ryzhkov, the chief of the ministry’s treaty implementation department, told journalists. “If exercises occur suddenly, we may notify them [other countries] only when the exercises begin,” Ryzhkov said. Russian President Vladimir Putin ordered snap drills on Thursday, as concerns persist over the combat readiness of the armed forces in Russia. The Black Sea exercise, which ended on Sunday, involved up to 7,000 military personnel, including rapid deployment, airborne and special task forces, more than 30 warships, about 250 armored vehicles, up to 20 pieces of artillery and 20 aircraft.

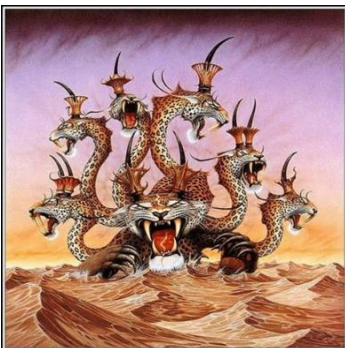

Headline: Thousands of Moroccans protest to topple Islamist-led government

Thousands of people on Sunday have taken to the streets in the Moroccan capital, Rabat, to protest against the country's high unemployment rate and cost of living. Protesters marched through the city ahead of plans by the Islamist-led government to push for social and economic reforms. Al Arabiya TV correspondent Adel Zobairi said about 30,000 protesters gathered in the kingdom's capital, calling for the downfall of Islamist Prime Minister Abdel Ilah bin Kiran. One of the slogans raised in the protest was: "People rise up against bin Kiran the dictator." "Morocco is witnessing social regression," chanted protesters, including activists from the February 20 pro-reform movement, which was born of the Arab Spring protests sweeping the region in 2011. The official Moroccan news agency, MAP, said members of opposition parties as well a human rights activists and civil society figures were also on the streets, alongside activists of the February 20 movement. MAP quoted unidentified union leaders as saying the march was "a sort of warning" to Benkirane's government.

Headline: UN adopts pact to regulate multibillion-dollar global arms trade

The U.N. General Assembly has overwhelmingly approved the first U.N. treaty regulating the multibillion-dollar international arms trade. The resolution adopting the landmark treaty was approved by a vote of 154 to 3 with 23 abstentions. The 193-member world body voted after Iran, North Korea and Syria blocked its adoption by consensus at a negotiating conference last Thursday. The three countries voted "no" on the resolution. The National Rifle Association has portrayed the draft treaty as a threat to gun ownership rights enshrined in the U.S. Constitution and has lobbied to defeat the

proposal at the U.N. The NRA last week praised the Senate's passage of an amendment to the Democratic budget proposal that would prevent the U.S. from entering into the treaty. The Obama administration, however, formally supported the U.N. treaty-- despite the warnings from Senate lawmakers that they would not ratify it.

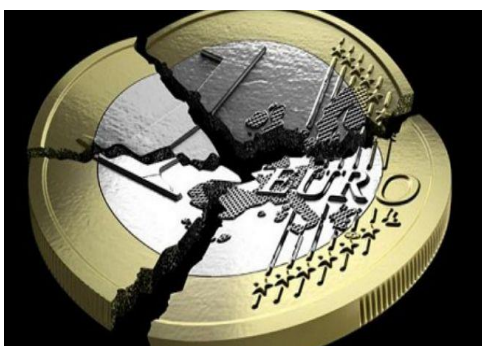
Headline: Judge: Stockton, Calif., Can File for Bankruptcy

A judge accepted the California city of Stockton's bankruptcy application on Monday, making it the most populous city in the nation to enter bankruptcy. U.S. Bankruptcy Judge Christopher Klein said the bankruptcy declaration was needed to allow the city to continue to provide basic services.

"It's apparent to me the city would not be able to perform its obligations to its citizens on fundamental public safety as well as other basic government services without the ability to have the muscle of the contract-impairing power of federal bankruptcy law," Klein said. The city of nearly 300,000 people has become emblematic of government excess and the financial calamity that resulted when the nation's housing bubble burst.

Headline: BRICS dumping euro amid simmering EU banking crisis

Brussels has been forced to eat a generous slice of humble pie: A massive sell-off of the euro is underway in the wake of a persistent financial crisis, as holdings in the European currency by emerging economies were slashed by almost 8 percent last year. Emerging economies – including Brazil, Russia, India, China and South Africa (BRICS) – are dumping the euro, having sold €45 billion of the currency in 2012, according to data gathered by the International Monetary Fund. The euro represents just 24 percent of their reserves, the lowest level since 2002 – the year when euro coins and banknotes first entered circulation – and down from a peak of 31 percent in 2009. At the same time, the euro's share of total global reserves has also fallen. This change of fortune for the euro is blamed on several factors, including sovereign debt crises and rapid growth by BRICS nations. Last week, China and Brazil agreed to a \$30-billion swap deal that would give each the ability to borrow the other's currency in the event of future turbulence in the global financial system. The move undercuts the need to use the dollar as a reserve currency; given China's increasing economic might, Beijing appears to be steadily promoting its national currency, the renminbi.

Headline: Eurozone Unemployment Rate Hits Record High

Unemployment in the euro area held steady at a record high in February, raising concerns that the ongoing recession is set to be a prolonged one as the region's debt crisis continues to weigh on economic activity, latest data showed Tuesday. The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate  was unchanged at 12 percent in February, after the January figure was revised upwards from the originally reported 11.9 percent, data from statistical office Eurostat revealed. The latest rate was the highest since euro was launched more than a decade ago. The February figure also matched economists' expectations. In February 2012, the jobless rate was 10.9 percent. The Eurozone unemployment rate for those aged below 25 dipped to 23.9 percent from 24 percent in January. However, the figure was higher than the 22.3 percent registered a year ago. The unemployment figures in the region are expected to climb further in the coming months as governments shed public sector jobs in their austerity efforts. The signs of a prolonged recession are likely to put more pressure on the European Central Bank to cut interest rates in the upcoming rate-setting session on Thursday.

The U.S. Navy is shifting a guided-missile destroyer in the Pacific to waters off the Korean peninsula in the wake of ongoing rhetoric from North Korea, U.S. defense officials said. The USS McCain is capable of intercepting and destroying a missile, should North Korea decide to fire one off, the officials said. Still, U.S. defense officials insist that there is nothing to indicate that North Korea is on the verge of another launch. The White House on Monday said the United States hasn't seen large-scale movements from North Korean military forces in the aftermath of harsh rhetoric from the reclusive government. Meanwhile, China has placed military forces on heightened alert in the northeastern part of the country as tensions mount on the Korean peninsula following recent threats by Pyongyang to attack, U.S. officials said. Reports from the region reveal the Chinese People's Liberation Army (PLA) recently increased its military posture in response to the heightened tensions, specifically North Korea's declaration of a "state of war" and threats to conduct missile attacks against the United States and South Korea.

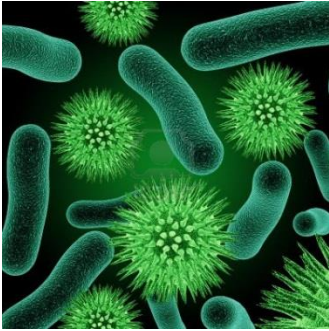
Headline: North Korea ratchets up tension: to restart nuclear reactor program, and expand nuclear arsenal

Headline: U.N. chief urges talks in North Korea crisis

North Korea said on Tuesday that it will put all its nuclear facilities — including its operational uranium-enrichment program and its reactors mothballed or under construction — to use in expanding its nuclear weapons arsenal, sharply raising the stakes in the escalating standoff with the United States and its allies. The announcement by the North's General Department of Atomic Energy came two days after the country's leader, Kim Jong-un, said his nuclear weapons were not a bargaining chip and called for expanding his country's nuclear arsenal both in "quality and quantity" during a meeting of the Central Committee of the ruling Workers' Party of Korea. The decision will affect the role of the North's uranium-enrichment plant in the North's main nuclear complex in Yongbyon, north of Pyongyang, a spokesman for the nuclear department told the Korean Central News Agency. **This marked the first time North Korea said that it would use the facility to make nuclear weapons.** Meanwhile, United Nations Secretary-General Ban Ki-moon said on Tuesday that a crisis over North Korea had gone too far and urged dialogue and negotiation to resolve the situation. "Nuclear threats are not a game. Aggressive rhetoric and military posturing only result in counter-actions, and fuel fear and instability," Ban said at a news conference in Andorra, where he was on an official visit.

Headline: China confirms 4 more cases of H7N9, urges public to remain calm

China reported today that four more people in one province were made seriously ill by a bird flu virus new to humans, while cities along the eastern seaboard stepped up public health measures to guard against a disease that has already caused two deaths. The health bureau of eastern Jiangsu province said in a notice on its website that three women, aged 45, 48 and 32, and an 83-year-old retired man, from different cities in the province, were all critically ill with the H7N9 virus, a diagnosis confirmed by the provincial disease prevention centre. These latest cases are the second batch to be confirmed after three in Anhui province and nearby Shanghai on Sunday. The H7N9 strain, so named for the combination of proteins on its surface, has previously not been a problem in humans. That compares to the more virulent H5N1 strain, which began ravaging poultry across Asia in 2003 and has since killed 360 people worldwide, mostly after close contact with infected birds. The reports of the new cases likely suggested that authorities were coming to grips with the virus. With the health agency having identified the first known infections on Sunday, authorities were likely taking a closer look at other severe flu cases.

Headline: More Bugs as Bucks Co. Bats Die Off?

Bucks County's largest bat population has met a grim fate. Scientists have confirmed that nearly all of the 10,000 bats that have hibernated in an abandoned iron ore mine in Upper Bucks for generations have died. When Pennsylvania Game Commission Biologist Greg Turner recently visited the Durham mine for the first time in two years, he found total devastation. The Durham bat mine was once the second largest known bat habitat in Pennsylvania, but this winter only 23 were found alive. Of those, half had clear signs of infection. Bucks County's bats were wiped out by a disease that has been killing bat colonies across the Northeast at an alarming rate in the last four years.

Headline: Church Walls Ordered Razed by Local Indonesian Officials

Crowds cheered as a demolition crew destroyed the newly erected walls of the Batak Protestant Church in the Bekasi district of Jakarta Thursday in yet another setback for Christians trying to survive in the planet's most populous Muslim nation. For the past 13 years the Batak congregation had been meeting in residential homes every Sunday, but when it grew to 600 members, Pastor Adven Nababan applied for a building permit and then obtained the signatures of 60 non-Christian neighbors as required by local law. However, as soon as church construction began in January, hundreds of Bekasi Muslims began to protest at the site. In March, police cordoned off the site and told church elders to demolish what they already built. When they refused, Bekasi officials declared the 60 signatures required for their building permit to be fraudulent and then sent a demolition crew to the construction site. At the construction site, about 100 members of the Batak Church were singing hymns and praying. When the demo crew arrived, the congregation reportedly locked arms and stood in front of the church as hundreds of militant Muslims from Islamist groups applauded the demo crew by shouting 'Alahu Akbar'.

Officials say flash floods blamed on climate change killed at least 11 people in the capital of the Indian Ocean island of Mauritius. Officials said most drowned in rivers of water that rose swiftly Saturday in a pedestrian underpass and an underground car park. Torrential downpours slammed Port Louis. An EU mission to train Malian soldiers is due to begin as part of efforts to help the West African country counter an Islamist insurgency. The first of four Malian battalions will train under European instructors at the Koulikoro base some 60km (37 miles) from the capital, Bamako. A French-led intervention that began in January has regained the main cities of northern Mali from Islamist groups. However, fighting continues in the north. Of the 550 troops from 22 EU nations sent to Mali, about 150 are trainers with the rest made up of mission support staff and force protection. France is the biggest contributor to the force with 207 troops, followed by Germany with 71, Spain with 54, Britain 40, the Czech Republic 34, Belgium 25 and Poland 20.

Headline: African Union Rejects New Central African Republic Leader

Central African Republic's opposition said on Monday it would not participate in a caretaker government nominated by the country's self-proclaimed president, claiming it has been stacked with rebel sympathisers. The move will complicate a planned transition back to civilian rule in the resource-rich former French colony after fighters from the Seleka rebel coalition stormed the capital on March 24 and ousted President Francois Bozize. "We are suspending our participation in this new government because we can not accept the fact that 16 posts have been handed over to Seleka allies disguised as civil society activists," said Edouard Koyambounou, a spokesman for the country's nine main opposition parties. Central African Republic's new leader, Michel Djotodia, named a cabinet of ministers on Sunday night that included eight opposition slots, 16 for civil society members, and most of the remaining 10 chosen from among Seleka's ranks. Djotodia claimed the role of Defence Minister.

Regime forces in Bahrain have attacked protesters in the capital Manama and the northwestern village of al-Diraz, Press TV reports. On Monday, security forces used shotguns and poisonous gas to disperse crowds of anti-regime protesters in the capital. In the village of al-Diraz, security forces also cracked down on the funeral procession of Abdul Ghani al-Reis who died after his son was abducted and tortured by regime forces. Al-Reis died of psychological shock after visiting a torture chamber where his son was being kept. In March 2011, the Bahraini regime launched a brutal crackdown on peaceful protests that erupted in February of the same year, and called in Saudi-led Arab forces from neighboring states to help crush the popular uprising.

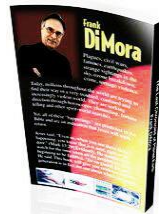
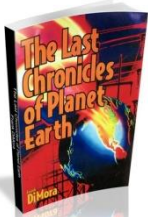
Headline: **Anti-government strike hits Bangladesh**

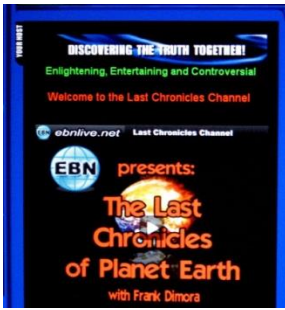
