Headline: Israel begins tapping Tamar gas field in ‘step toward energy independence’

Israel has reported the flow of natural gas from a major offshore field. The government and an energy consortium said gas from Israel’s Tamar field in the eastern Mediterranean began to flow on March 30. The government said Tamar was believed to contain 10 trillion cubic feet of gas, which could result in a drop in electricity rates. “We are taking an important step toward energy independence,” Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu said. Tamar, discovered in 2009 and located 90 kilometers from the Israeli coast, was one of two major reserves reported in the Mediterranean. Leviathan, the second field, was said to contain a larger reserve. The project has been led by the U.S. firm Noble Energy, with a 36 percent stake in Tamar.

Headline: Kerry returning to Jerusalem and Ramallah to push for renewal of peace talks

United States Secretary of State John Kerry will return to Israel and the Palestinian territories for the second time in less than two weeks, as part of the Americans’ efforts to kick-start the long-stalled peace process. According to a senior Israeli official who asked to remain anonymous, Kerry is expected to arrive in Israel on Saturday night. Kerry is also expected to visit Turkey this week as part of his trip to Western Europe and Asia, to consult allies on issues including Syria’s civil war. Kerry spoke on Tuesday with both Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu and Palestinian President Mahmoud Abbas and informed them of his plan to return to the region.

Headline: Israeli envoys heading to Turkey next week to begin process of restoring bilateral relations

Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu’s special envoy to Turkey, Joseph Ciechanover, and National Security Adviser Yaakov Amidror will be going to Ankara next Thursday (April 11) for the start of talks on restoring Israeli-Turkish relations. A source in the Prime Minister’s Office said the talks are expected to focus on arrangements for compensating the families of the nine Turkish nationals killed in the May 2010 Israel Navy raid on the Gaza flotilla, as well as Turkey’s promise to cease all legal

proceedings against Israel Defense Forces personnel involved in the incident. The Turkish negotiating team will be headed by Deputy Prime Minister Bülent Arınç. His meeting with Ciechanover and Amidror will be the first high-level meeting between Turkish and Israeli officials since the crisis between the two countries ended last month. The actual negotiations, however, will be conducted by Turkey's Undersecretary of the Foreign Ministry, Feridun Sinirlioğlu, Ankara's point man on Israel since the raid on the Mavi Marmara.

The Permanent Observer of Palestine to the United Nations, Riyad Mansour sent three letters, identical in content, to the UN's Secretary General, the Chairperson of the UN's General Assembly and the head of the UN's Security Council regarding the death of Palestinian security prisoner Maisara Abu Hamdiyeh. In his letter, Mansour wrote that Abu Hamdiyeh suffered from cancer for some months, and that Israel failed to grant him adequate treatment, causing the cancer to spread throughout his body. He also claimed Israel refused to allow family members to visit him in jail.

Meanwhile, More than 4,500 Palestinian prisoners in Israeli jails have launched a hunger strike over the death of a Palestinian inmate from cancer. The inmates sent back their food on Wednesday morning to protest the death of Maysara Abuhamdieh, 64, of esophageal cancer. Many also had sent back their meals on Tuesday afternoon in what has been declared a three-day hunger strike.

Maysara Abuhamdieh, 64, died Tuesday at Soroka Medical Center in Beersheba. Palestinian officials and Palestinian human rights organizations accused the Israel Prison Service of withholding medical treatment. A Palestinian observer is set to be present Wednesday at Abuhamdieh's autopsy; He will be buried in Hebron on Thursday

Headline: Israeli planes strike Gaza for first time since Pillar of Defense

Headline: Israel issues warning over fire from Gaza, Golan

Israeli planes carried out bombing sorties over the Gaza Strip late Tuesday night, responding to rocket attacks out of the Palestinian enclave earlier in the day. The air force bombing was the first Israeli attack on Gaza since an informal cease-fire was signed between Jerusalem and the Strip's Hamas rulers in November following an eight-day mini-war to stem rocket fire dubbed Pillar of Defense. A Hamas spokesperson said the planes struck an area in northern Gaza near Jabal al Rayes, with no injuries. Other reports from inside the Strip indicated an open field east of Gaza City was also struck. The Israel Defense Forces said it struck at least one terror target in Gaza.

The sorties are likely meant seen as a warning to the Strip not to escalate the violence.

Earlier in the day, three missiles were fired at Israel from the central Strip. Two landed inside Gaza and a third struck an open area in the Eshkol region, the IDF said. There were no injuries in the attacks.

Jordan

Headline: Jordan intends to declare north of country 'disaster area'

Jordan is intending to declare the north of the country a “disaster area,” Jordanian Prime Minister Abdullah Ensour said in remarks published on Wednesday. The prime minister voiced concerns over a wide-scale flow of Syrian refugees into Jordan as a result of possible flare-up of major armed confrontations in Syria. The number of Syrians in Jordan has exceeded one million, including 450,000 refugees and more than 600,000 citizens who came with their families before violence surged in their country. Last week, Amman said it will continue to operate an open-door policy towards Syrian refugees, despite the economic burden on Jordan, and the alleged presence of pro-regime sleeper cells in the country. Although Jordan hosts hundreds of thousands of Syrian refugees, the government says it is firmly against any intervention in Syria’s internal affairs.

Headline: Syrian truck driver wounded in Lebanon ambush: official

Gunmen ambushed a convoy of trucks travelling through north Lebanon towards the Syrian border on Wednesday, badly wounding a driver, a security official said. The early morning attack occurred in the flashpoint Bab al-Tebbaneh district north of Tripoli, where gunmen and protesters frequently try to prevent tankers from entering Syria with fuel destined for President Bashar al-Assad’s regime.

“Dozens of gunmen from the district of Bab al-Tebbaneh opened fire on a string of Syrian trucks headed towards Syria at around 2:00 am (2300 GMT Tuesday). One of them hurled an explosive at the trucks. One of the drivers was badly hurt,” the official told AFP on condition of anonymity.

“The gunmen then held up the truck drivers and prevented them from continuing their journey to the Syrian border until the army intervened and rescued the injured driver,” the official said. He added that the attackers believed the tankers were carrying fuel although they were in fact not.

Headline: Syrian Jet Fires Missile at Lebanese Town of Arsal

Headline: U.S. warns citizens against travel to Lebanon

A Syrian jet has fired a missile into Arsal, a town bordering Lebanon, damaging a house. No casualties have been reported so far, but the incident could heighten tensions between Syria and Lebanon. Local reports suggest that a helicopter belonging to the Syrian army was also seen swirling in the vicinity. People in Arsal openly criticise Syrian President Bashar al-Assad's regime. The target of the attack is not clear but the firing is believed to be related to Assad's plan to wipe out the rebels who are seeking to overthrow him. Hours ahead of the attack, Lebanese gunmen attacked a convoy travelling to Syria, injuring one person. Although Lebanon has officially distanced itself from the two-year Syrian conflict, many Lebanese officials are concerned that their country is being dragged into the crisis.

Headline: Syria military warns rebels against taking Damascus, says push into city means 'certain death'

Headline: Rebels capture military base in southern Syria

Syria's military is warning rebels against pressing an ongoing offensive into Damascus, saying the push by opposition fighters into the capital means their "certain death." Rebels fighting to topple President Bashar Assad have established strongholds in the suburbs surrounding the capital during the two-year-old-conflict. In recent weeks, they've stepped up mortar attacks on the center of the city, bringing the conflict closer to the seat of Assad's power. A military commander told the pro-government al-Watan newspaper that any advance by the rebels on Damascus means "certain death for them and their leaders." The commander, who is not named in the Wednesday report, said the bravery of government troops on the battlefield is keeping Damascus safe.

Headline: Hezbollah, Iranian troops deployed in Damascus, reports say

Al-Arabiya reported on Wednesday that a number of members from the Lebanese Shiite party Hezbollah and the Iranian Revolutionary Guard had been spotted in the Syrian capitol. The station

cited the rebel Free Syrian Army as saying that there was an “unprecedented, public deployment” of Hezbollah and Iranian troops in Damascus. Meanwhile, the Syrian anti-regime news agency SANA al-Thawra reported that the FSA apprehended Hezbollah members in the Sayyidah Zeinab neighborhood of the capital, one of whom was a commander in the Abbas Brigade. Syrian rebel officials have repeatedly accused Hezbollah of fighting alongside President Bashar al-Assad’s regime troops, which prompted a number of Lebanese opposition parties to condemn Hezbollah’s alleged involvement in the Syrian conflict. The outcry on the part of the opposition was made louder after the Free Syrian Army threatened to “retaliate” against “terrorist sites” in Lebanon. However, Hezbollah’s chief Sayyed Hassan Nasrallah has repeatedly refuted these allegations and labeled them as “unfounded rumors.”

The UN’s top nuclear official expressed concern Tuesday that Iran may be secretly continuing work on nuclear weapons while his agency is tied up in protracted negotiations with the country on restarting an investigation into past suspected research and development of such arms. The comments by International Atomic Energy Agency head Yukiya Amano are bound to resonate with Israel and Western nations, which assert Iran is seeking nuclear weapons capacity even though it insists its atomic activities are transparent and peaceful.

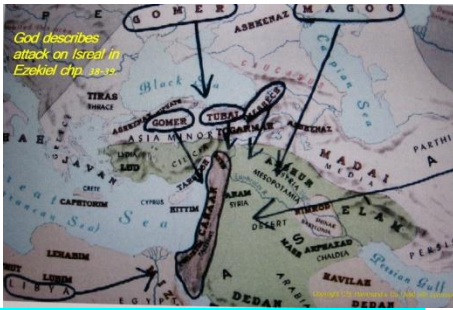

Headline: U.S. official: Iran nuclear talks depend on Tehran's response

Progress in this week's nuclear talks between Iran and six major powers in Almaty, Kazakhstan, depends on how Tehran responds to a proposal put forward by the six, a U.S. official said on Wednesday. The official, speaking on condition of anonymity, told reporters the powers - Britain, China, France, Germany, Russia and the United States - hoped "positive" Iranian rhetoric would be matched by concrete responses and actions by the Iranians.

Headline: Taliban attack Afghan courthouse, leaving 53 dead

A provincial governor says at least 53 people, including nine attackers, have been killed in a daylong gunbattle in western Afghanistan. Officials say the fighting broke out Wednesday after suicide bombers disguised as Afghan soldiers stormed a courthouse in Farah province in a failed bid to free more than a dozen Taliban. Provincial Gov. Akram Akhpewak says those killed included 34 civilians, 10 security forces and nine attackers. The assault was the latest example of the Taliban's ability to strike official institutions despite tight security measures. The persistent violence has undermined confidence in President Hamid Karzai's government as it tries to take over its own security ahead of the withdrawal of international combat forces by the end of 2014. Nine men wearing suicide vests drove into the center of the provincial capital, which has the same name, in Afghan national army vehicles that allowed them to bypass checkpoints, provincial police chief Agha Noor Kentoz said. Headline: U.S. sees highest poverty spike since the 1960s

The number of Americans living in poverty has spiked to levels not seen since the mid 1960s, classing 20 per cent of the country’s children as poor. It comes at a time when government spending cuts of \$85 billion have kicked in after feuding Democrats and Republicans failed to agree on a better plan for addressing the national deficit. The cuts will directly affect 50 million Americans living below the poverty income line and reduce their chances of finding work and a better life. The U.S. Census Bureau puts the number of Americans in poverty at levels not seen since the mid-1960s when President Lyndon B. Johnson launched the federal government's so-called War on Poverty.

As President Barack Obama began his second term in January, nearly 50 million Americans — one in six — were living below the income line that defines poverty, according to the bureau. A family of four that earns less than \$23,021 a year is listed as living in poverty. The bureau said 20 percent of the country's children are poor.

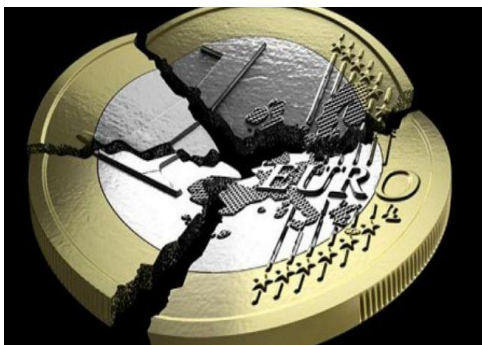

Headline: Wall Street falls on weaker data, North Korea comments

Stocks fell on Wednesday as weaker-than-expected economic data caused investors to trim positions ahead of Friday's jobs report and defense secretary expressed concern over North Korea. A report on private-sector jobs showed less-than-expected hiring in March, which some analysts saw as a discouraging sign ahead of Friday's Department of Labor report. Stocks extended losses in afternoon trading, with the S&P 500 and Nasdaq falling more than 1 percent. The Pentagon said it was sending a missile defense system to Guam in the coming weeks, while U.S. Defense Secretary Chuck Hagel cited a "real and clear" danger from North Korea. The drop put the S&P 500 on track for its biggest daily percentage loss since February 25, with energy and financial sectors leading the decline. The S&P 500 financial index <.SPSY> was down 1.7 percent.

Headline: IMF agrees to provide €1bn in Cyprus rescue plan

Headline: Cypriot finance minister resigns as crisis inquest begins

The International Monetary Fund has agreed to provide approximately €1bn to the €10bn rescue plan for cash-strapped Cyprus, managing director Christine Lagarde said on Wednesday. "This would be through a three-year 891 million Special Drawing Rights [about €1 billion] loan," Lagarde said in a statement, adding that she expects the deal to go to the IMF executive board for approval in early May. The IMF, European Commission and European Central Bank agreed with Cyprus on Tuesday the terms of a programme that will see the country drastically downsize its bloated banking sector and put state finances in order. "The Cypriot authorities have put forward an ambitious, multi-year reform programme to address the economic challenges they face," Lagarde said, describing it as "resolute." "The overarching goals are to stabilise the financial system, achieve fiscal sustainability and support the recovery of economic activity to preserve the welfare of the population."

Headline: Portuguese government defeats no confidence motion

Portugal's government defeated a no confidence motion on Wednesday, yet the move united all the opposition in parliament against austerity policies and rattled the stock market. The vote was largely symbolic as the ruling centre-right coalition holds a comfortable majority, but Prime Minister Pedro Passos Coelho said the motion gave the impression of political instability just when Lisbon needs investor confidence to regain full access to debt markets. The main opposition Socialists and the two smaller left-wing parties voted for the motion, garnering 97 votes in a 230-seat house. They accuse the government of pushing ahead "blindly" with cuts despite the worst recession since the 1970s and record unemployment. Portuguese stocks, especially banks, slumped as the vote added to concerns the government's budget plans - required under the terms of under an EU/IMF bailout - may suffer defeat in the Constitutional Court.

Headline: Chinese troop build-up continues on North Korean border

Headline: US sends missile defenses to Guam over NKorea threat

UN chief Ban Ki-moon warned Tuesday that the Korean peninsula crisis could spiral out of control, after North Korea announced it would restart a nuclear reactor to feed its atomic weapons program. "Nuclear threats are not a game," Ban said, responding to a series of aggressive statements by Pyongyang that have prompted the deployment of nuclear-capable US B-52s, B-2 stealth bombers and a US destroyer to South Korea. The North's announcement earlier Tuesday that it would reopen Yongbyon reactor -- its source of weapons-grade plutonium -- triggered international alarm. The Korean peninsula has been caught in a cycle of escalating tensions since the North's February nuclear test, which followed a long-range rocket launch in December. Subsequent UN sanctions and annual South Korea-US military exercises have been used by Pyongyang to justify a wave of increasingly dire threats against Seoul and Washington, including warnings of missile strikes and nuclear war.

Headline: North Korea approves nuclear strike on United States

North Korea dramatically escalated its warlike rhetoric on Thursday, warning that it had authorized plans for nuclear strikes on targets in the United States. "The moment of explosion is approaching fast," the North Korean military said, warning that war could break out "today or tomorrow".

Pyongyang's latest pronouncement came as Washington scrambled to reinforce its Pacific missile defenses, preparing to send ground-based interceptors to Guam and dispatching two Aegis class destroyers to the region. Tension was also high on the North's heavily-fortified border with South Korea, after Kim Jong-Un's isolated regime barred South Koreans from entering a Seoul-funded joint industrial park on its side of the frontier. In a statement published by the state KCNA news agency, the Korean People's Army general staff warned Washington that U.S. threats would be "smashed by... cutting-edge smaller, lighter and diversified nuclear strike means".

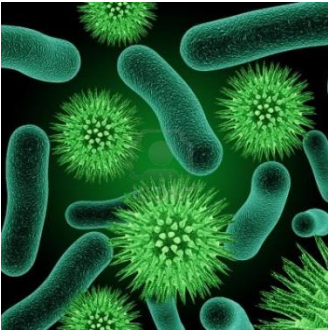
Headline: North Korea Bans South Workers from Entering Joint Site

North Korea has banned South Korean workers from entering Kaesong, a joint industrial zone, South Korean media reported Wednesday. Pyongyang is only allowing South Koreans currently at the site to leave it and return home, the Yonhap news agency reported. The entry ban is expected to further escalate tensions. Seoul's Unification Ministry said North Korea had sent it an official notification to the effect earlier in the day.

"South Korea's government deeply regrets the entry ban and urges it be lifted immediately," a ministry spokesman told reporters as quoted by Yonhap, adding that Seoul is doing everything possible to ensure the safety of South Koreans at the joint site. North Korea pledged on Tuesday to restart facilities at its Yongbyon nuclear complex, including a uranium enrichment plant and a reactor, in a move likely to further ratchet up regional tensions.

Headline: Scotland hit by second vomiting bug outbreak

Numbers of reported cases of the norovirus bug have taken another hike as the unseasonable temperatures hold on, with the double outbreak potentially being exacerbated by cross-contamination over the holiday weekend given the large numbers of people travelling to visit friends and relatives for Easter. An estimated one million Scots were struck down with the bug during the first wave of the infection, which was at its most potent between the end of October and mid-January. Now there are concerns there will be thousands of fresh cases in the community, mirroring the significant rise in infection rates among hospital patients. It is believed socialising and travelling during the spring break could have re-introduced the bug to areas where it had appeared to have peaked.

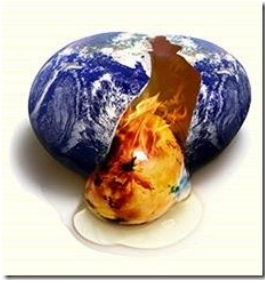

Headline: China announces 2 new bird flu cases and 1 death, as worry grows over pandemic risk

China has found two more cases of a new strain of bird flu and one of the victims has died, state media said on Wednesday, bringing the number of cases to nine. The new death comes as scientists struggle to identify the source of the virus H7N9 infection. Many who have examined the genetics of the virus believe it could actually be spread silently between birds, without them showing any signs of symptoms. However, officials do not know for sure if those infected with H7N9 actually contracted the virus from birds or any other animals. So far, the Agriculture Ministry said it had yet to find any animals infected with H7N9, but added it was possible it had been brought to China by migratory birds. If the virus is spread from birds to humans, scientists and other officials are worried about the potential for a H7N9 pandemic, as birds are difficult to contain.

The Civil Protection office of the National Commissioner in Iceland has declared a *State of Uncertainty* in North Iceland because of a series of earthquakes. The first earthquake came around one o'clock last night (GMT) and the quake was measured to be 5.5 points in magnitude. The earthquake originated East of Grimsey island. Another earthquake came shortly after, and it was measured to be 4.3 points in magnitude. The State of Uncertainty means increased surveillance with events, because at later stages the safety of people in the area might be compromised.

Headline: Mt. Etna eruptions intensifying: town covered in ash, declares state of emergency

A small tourist town in the province of Catania with 9,450 residents — was blanketed by thick black volcanic dust after the eruption. Locals said they heard the explosions and felt violent shaking. They said the air was humid, the sky went dark and there was no visibility. The town's residents are used to frequent volcanic eruptions – this is the eighth this year alone. The Italian locals now have a massive clearing job to do as roads, gardens and rooftops were covered in up to ten centimeters of ash and stones. Workers use special equipment to blow away the ash and collect solidified lava. The damage was assessed "incalculable" and the region and the neighboring municipalities have declared a state of emergency.

Headline: Argentina: flooding from torrential rains kill 41

At least 35 people were killed by flooding overnight in Argentina's Buenos Aires province, the governor said Wednesday, bringing the overall death toll from days of torrential rains to at least 41 and leaving large stretches of the provincial capital under water. Gov. Daniel Scioli said many people drowned after trying to take shelter in their cars in Tolosa, an area of the provincial capital of La Plata. Heavy rains had killed at least six people in the nation's capital of Buenos Aires the day before.

Cars were flooded to their rooftops and rainwater flowed over the windowsills into many houses in La Plata. People waded out of their neighborhoods through chest-high water, and police and neighbors teamed up using rubber motorboats to evacuate families and pets to higher ground. "Such intense rain in so little time has left many people trapped in their cars, in the streets, in some cases electrocuted. We are giving priority to rescuing people who have been stuck in trees or on the roofs of their homes," Scioli said. La Plata "has never seen anything equal" to this disaster.

Headline: African Leaders Seek Response to CAR Crisis

Regional leaders meet Wednesday to discuss how to address the situation in the Central African Republic, where rebel forces overthrew the country's president last month. Prime Minister Nicolas Tiangaye, who retained his post after the coup, is due to take part in the summit of the Economic Community of Central African States in Chad's capital, Ndjamena. A South African delegation that includes President Jacob Zuma is also participating. A spokesman for South Africa's Foreign Affairs Ministry, Clayson Monyela says that the meeting is "crucial" in plotting the way forward. "We want to preserve Africa as a zone of peace. We say no to unconstitutional change of government. We say no to people who come to power through the use of force," he said. "That's why the African Union has now taken the decision to suspend the membership of the Central African Republic as well as the decision to not recognize the rebels as a new government in the Central African Republic." Monyela says the stability of the Central African Republic and its neighbors have to be a priority, and that any decision from the summit must support the position that unlawful seizures of power will not be allowed in Africa.

The protest was staged by members of a grassroots movement, called "Wake up Cyprus". The demonstrators briefly blocked traffic in the street leading to the parliament.

Headline: Strike halts sea, train travel in Greece

Sailors and railway employees have staged a 24-hour strike across Greece in protest against the government's austerity measures. Tens of thousands of people were stranded on Wednesday after the employees began the strike to express opposition to the spending cuts that include the elimination of collective labor contracts, which preserve income levels and other benefits. Dock workers also called on the Greek government to put an end to a plan to regulate the minimum number of dock workers required in each crew, as they say the move would lead to job losses. They also asked for back-pay from ship owners and rejected employing undocumented and uninsured workers. Air traffic is expected to face disruption on Thursday as air traffic controllers would begin a 24-hour strike.

Headline: Norwegian worker unions plan to go on strike over wages

Thousands of Norwegian workers are planning to stage a general strike if talks with government over wages fail to produce results. Approximately 17,000 Norwegian private sector workers plan to go on strike on Monday, affecting oil service firms, Oslo's Gardermoen Airport and important manufacturers, said LO and YS unions on Wednesday. The unions further said that more than 170,000 workers could join the strike, potentially shutting vital industries. The unions did not specify their demands but said they want to narrow the gap between the lowest paid workers and the top earners amid the country's booming oil revenues and stable state finances.

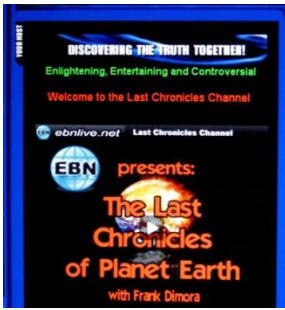
