Headline: Abbas Warns Israel Over Al-Aqsa Mosque

The Palestinian Authority on Sunday sent a warning to Israel, over what it calls its attempts to harm the Al-Aqsa Mosque on the Temple Mount. Speaking during a meeting of the PLO's Executive Committee, PA Chairman Mahmoud Abbas that it is impossible to hold back in the wake of what he called the attacks by Israel on the Al-Aqsa Mosque and PA Arabs in Judea and Samaria, in particular by local Jewish residents. "We cannot remain silent over such actions, nor can we accept their recurrence," Abbas said. "If Israel is dreaming about establishing facts on the ground through its daily

attacks against the Al-Aqsa Mosque, then it is deluded." He added, "Eastern Jerusalem is our capital city, Al-Aqsa belongs to us, the Church of the Holy Sepulchre belongs to us, and we will not accept [the Israelis'] harassment."

Headline: Netanyahu, Putin to meet Tuesday for Syria talks

Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu is to hold talks on Tuesday with Russian President Vladimir Putin on the conflict in Syria, the Kremlin said, amid concerns Moscow plans to deliver advanced missiles to the Damascus regime. "It is expected that major attention will be paid to the current situation in the Middle East, first and foremost in Syria," the Kremlin said in a statement. It said the talks would take place in Russia, without giving further details. Last week, Russia's state RIA Novosti news agency, citing a diplomatic source, also said Netanyahu expected to call on Putin at his Black Sea residence in Sochi. According to Ynet's defense analyst Ron Ben-Yishai, Netanyahu is planning to urge Putin to back out of the arms deal with the Syrian regime. The S-300 is a Russian system made to intercept aircraft at ranges of over 100 km (60 miles) as well as ballistic missiles. It is unknown exactly which model Russia intends to sell to the Syrians or whether it has already done so. The goal of the pressing visit is to allow the two leaders to coordinate their positions regarding Syria and Hezbollah , and, more importantly, to prevent the implementation of the Russian-Syrian arms deal which the Russian have postponed, but failed to cancel.

Headline: Accepting 'Arab Initiative' is Suicide, Says Diplomat

The so-called "Arab initiative" or "Arab League peace plan" that has been gaining currency in recent months is "a recipe for Israel's suicide," according to Israel's former representative in Washington, DC, Yoram Ettinger. Ambassador Ettinger told *Arutz Sheva* that the plan is no more than "a honey trap" that misguidedly seeks to force reality to fit some people's imaginings. The Arab proposal, explained Ettinger, is based on UN Resolution 194, that favors the so called "right of return" of Arab "refugees" to Israel and would have Israel go back to indefensible 1949 Armistice lines. Ettinger noted that even the idea of going back to 1949 lines with some land swaps has been rejected by Palestinian Authority leaders Yasser Arafat and Mahmoud Abbas.

Headline: Halting Israeli settlements 'vital' for talks — Palestinian FM Headline: U.N. expert urges Israel to halt highway project in Beit Safafa

Palestinian foreign minister Riyad Al Malki said Saturday that halting Israeli settlement construction was "vital" to resume long-stalled peace talks. The Israeli government signed off on plans Thursday to build nearly 300 new settler homes near Ramallah, just days after Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu reportedly ordered a freeze on tenders for new West Bank settler homes to avoid harming US-led efforts to bring both sides back to the negotiating table. "For us, stopping settlement construction is vital, important and essential to really sit down and talk about the subject of negotiations," Malki said. "Without this, it will be difficult, if not impossible to find a Palestinian interested in sitting down and talking with the Israelis. "It is not a Palestinian condition. It is a requirement by the international community," he added.

Headline: Jordan calls for firm stand against Israel's Jerusalem violations

Jordan on Sunday called for a united Muslim-Arab stance against recent Israeli attacks in East Jerusalem against Al Aqsa Mosque. The Arab League council met at the level of permanent envoys upon two separate requests from the Jordanian and Palestinian representatives made in the immediate aftermath of Wednesday's attacks in the holy city by Israeli extremists, while a top Muslim cleric was arrested for "incitement". Addressing the urgent Arab League meeting, Jordan's permanent envoy to the league, Bisher Khasawneh, called for a unified political, moral, media and financial stand to halt the frequent Israeli attacks in the holy city. Khasawneh said Jordan monitors events in East Jerusalem with concern, especially Israeli attempts to "Judaise" the city and alter its Islamic and Arab character. He underlined the role the Kingdom plays in protecting Al Haram Al Sharif and other holy sites in Jerusalem from Israel's "provocative" measures, stressing that the attacks have recently been on the rise.

Headline: Nusra Front threatens more shelling of Hermel

The Nusra Front has threatened to shell the border area of Hermel Monday, in retaliation for Hezbollah's involvement in the Syrian war, and urged civilians in the area to take precautions. The announcement was sent via text messages to a number of Hermel residents. On Sunday, two rockets landed in the area of Al-Qasr, near the border with Syria, and injured a Lebanese and a Syrian. "As of Monday 13 May, we will continue shelling Hermel and surrounding villages with rockets and tanks to target Hezbollah locations as well as hospitals that are treating their injured fighters, schools and the government serail in Hermel in retaliation for the blood of Syrians in Qusair and its villages," the group said.

Headline: Saudis explore Iranian options for Syria & Lebanon in talks with Iran's Salehi

Saudi Arabia has decided to explore dialogue with its great regional rival Iran for ending the Syrian conflict and assuring Lebanon's political future. **debkafile's** Gulf sources report. They have given up on US policy for Syria in view of Russian and Iranian unbending support for Bashar Assad; his battlefield gains aided by Hizballah and Iranian Bassij forces; and Turkey's inaction after Saturday's terrorist bombings in the town of Reyhanli near the Syrian border which caused 46 deaths. Saudi Foreign Minister Saud al-Faisal took advantage of the Organization of Islamic Conference-OIC. in Jeddah this week on the Mali conflict for getting together Monday, May 13, with Iranian Foreign Minister Ali Akbar Salehi who was in attendance. Our sources report that Riyadh's first priority is to stabilize Lebanon through a Saudi-Iranian entente on political equilibrium in Beirut. The Saudis would next seek an accord with Tehran on the outcome of the Syrian civil conflict. The Saudi rulers have come to the conclusion, which the West and Israel have been slow to acknowledge, that since the Iranian-Hizballah-Syrian military alliance is pulling ahead in the Syrian conflict and chalking up victories, they had better look to their interests in Lebanon, which hinge heavily on the Sunni clan headed by Saad Hariri. If they wait till a victorious Hizballah comes marching home and grabs power in Beirut, protecting Lebanon's Sunni community will be that much harder. May 13, 2013

Headline: Egypt's Mursi, Abbas in fresh round of Palestinian unity talks

Egyptian President Mohammed Mursi is set to meet with Palestinian leader Mahmoud Abbas later this week to discuss a deal, involving Egypt, to propose reconciliation between Palestinian factions Fatah and Hamas. The meeting is set to begin on Wednesday with discussions on the formation of a transitional government that can be trusted by both factions, according to Fatah delegation head Azzam Al-Ahmed, as quoted by Egypt's Ahram Online. Other issues that will top the agenda include elections, security, and the reorganization of the Palestinian Liberation Organization (PLO), the report added. Earlier this year, the leaders of the rival Palestinian groups Fatah and Hamas agreed in Cairo to renew efforts to implement a two-year-old unity deal.

Headline: Egyptian lawmakers demand dismissal of Israeli ambassador

Members of the Shura Council, Egypt's upper house of parliament, requested on Monday the removal of the Israeli ambassador from Egypt and the withdrawal of his Egyptian counterpart in Tel Aviv in response to the continuing assaults against Al-Aqsa mosque in Jerusalem. Shura Council Speaker Ahmed Fahmy pointed out during a meeting that the Council does not have the authority to remove the ambassador. However, he promised he would pass the request on to the cabinet. The demand was supported by several MPs, but was initiated by MP Mohamed El-Sagheer of the Building and Development Party, the political arm of the ultra-conservative Islamist group Al-Gamaa Al-Islamiya. The Arab League held a special meeting on Sunday to denounce recent attacks by Jewish settlers on Al-Asqa mosque, and to decide on a definitive stance to take on the issue.



Headline: Palestinian-Syrian group says forming units to fight for the Golan

Syria warned that it had the right to act as it wants in the Golan Heights, and declared itself as the owner of the land, Syrian Information Minister Omran al-Zoubi was reported as saying Monday by Syrian news agency Sana. Zoubi, addressing a symposium in Damascus Sunday, reportedly blamed Israel for violating international law when it allegedly struck military sites Damascus earlier in May, and for permitting rebels to kidnap UN peacekeepers while operating inside the demilitarized zone on the Golan Heights. "Syria has the right at this time and at any other time to deal with the Golan issue in the way the owner has the right to deal with his property, because the Golan is and has always been a Syrian Arab land," Sana quoted Zoubi as saying. "Israel must understand that it can't take a promenade in the Syrian sky because the Syrian land and sky are not a promenade for anyone," he continued.

Headline: 'Israel, Hezbollah, Iran are working with Assad'

A Syrian opposition commander has accused Israel of working with Iran and Hezbollah to support Syrian President Bashar Assad in his two year effort to topple opposing forces, Turkish news network *Today's Zaman* reported on Sunday. Abdulkader Saleh, a commander in the al-Tawhid Brigade of the Free Syrian Army told *Today's Zaman* that "Assad has protected Israel's border for 40 years," and that is why "Iran and Hezbollah are cooperating with Israel to be able to support Assad" in Syria's raging civil war. Despite previous media reports that last week's airstrikes in Syria were an Israeli initiative to aid rebel forces and stop Hezbollah from helping Assad attain destructive weapons, Saleh apparently told *Zaman* that these reports were false. "The opposition was going to take over arms, so Israel attacked. There is evidence pointing to this," he reportedly said.

Headline: Syria opposition to consult allies over US-Russia initiative

Syria's main opposition bloc wants to consult its allies before deciding on joining a U.S.-Russia initiative to negotiate a peaceful transition in Syria, its leader said Monday. The U.S. and Russia called last week for an international conference to start talks that would be accompanied by a cease-fire. The two nations are on opposite sides of the Syria conflict, and this marks their first serious joint attempt at Syria diplomacy in a year. The time, venue and agenda of the conference have not been set, reflecting disagreements between the two warring sides in Syria that scuttled previous initiatives. Both have agreed in principle to attend, but the opposition Syrian National Coalition says it will not negotiate unless President Bashar Assad steps down first, while the regime has been vague about a truce. George Sabra, head of the SNC, said Monday his coalition wants to consult with its allies, including Turkey, Saudi Arabia and Qatar, before making a decision.

Headline: Syrian troops take full control of strategic town

Syrian troops have taken full control of a town near the highway linking the capital Damascus with Jordan, a new advance in the regime's campaign to drive rebels from the strategic south, an activist group said Monday. Rebels seeking to topple Syrian President Bashar Assad are trying to carve a pathway from the Jordanian border through the southern province of Daraa, in what is seen as their best shot at capturing Damascus. A few weeks ago, they scored significant gains, but have since suffered setbacks in a regime counteroffensive. In recent days, regime troops and rebel fighters battled over Khirbet Ghazaleh, a town near the Damascus-Jordan highway. Regime forces retook Khirbet Ghazaleh on Sunday and rebels withdrew from the area, said Rami Abdul-Rahman, head of the Britain-based Syrian Observatory for Human Rights. Troops reopened the highway, restoring the supply line between Damascus and the contested provincial capital of Daraa, he said. Regime forces were carrying out raids and searching homes in Khirbet Ghazaleh on Monday.

Headline: Ahmadinejad Could Face Up to 74 Lashes Over Election 'Violation'

Iranian President Mahmoud Ahmadinejad may face charges for openly endorsing the candidacy of his top adviser, Esfandiar Rahim Mashaei, and accompanying the candidate as he registered his nomination on Saturday for the June 14 presidential vote. Iran's constitution bans a seated president and his administration from campaigning for or supporting a presidential candidate. Ahmadinejad could face 74 lashes if punished to the full extent of the law. "We discussed this at a meeting of the committee that supervises elections and everyone unanimously agreed the president had committed a crime," said Abasali Kadkhodaie, a spokesman for the Guardian Council, a committee of powerful clerics that vets presidential candidates and acts as a constitutional watchdog, according to *The Wall Street Joural*. Ahmadinejad has not yet been charged and the judiciary must decide whether to follow up on the complaint.

Headline: Iran foreign minister warns of Syria breakup

Iran's Foreign Minister Ali Akbar Salehi warned on Monday of the possibility of Syria breaking up and its conflict spilling across the Middle East unless a political solution can end the bloodshed. "God forbid, if there was a void, or disintegration, in Syria, this crisis would spill over into all countries in the region," said Salehi, whose country is a close ally of Syrian President Bashar al-Assad. Instead, the Assad regime and its opponents should seek a political solution by setting up a transitional government until elections, he told reporters in Jeddah. He also rejected foreign intervention in Syria,

which is in its third year of conflict after protests against the regime in 2011 morphed into an armed rebellion. "The Syrian people should have self-determination... It is not permitted that decisions made abroad get to be imposed on an ancient country and people like Syria," he said. Salehi on Sunday held talks with his Saudi counterpart, Prince Saud al-Faisal. He acknowledged he had "different views" with his host, whose kingdom supports the Syrian opposition.

Headline: Blasts kill dozens in Turkish town Reyhanli on Syria border Headline: Turkey warns of response after Syria border town bombs Headline: Turkey bombed itself, Syrian foreign minister charges

Twin car bombs have killed at least 43 people and injured at least 100 in the Turkish town of Reyhanli, near the Syrian border. Interior Minister Muammer Guler told Turkey's NTV the bombs had gone off near the town hall and post office. Video showed injured people being carried to safety amid shattered buildings and twisted wrecks of cars. No group has said it had carried out the attack, but a senior Turkish official suggested Syrian involvement. "Our thoughts are that their Mukhabarat [the Syrian intelligence agency] and armed organisations are the usual suspects in planning and the carrying out of such devilish plans," Deputy Prime Minister Bulent Arinc said shortly after the bombings. Later on Saturday another Deputy Prime Minister, Besir Atalay, said initial investigations showed the attackers were linked to Syrian intelligence, NTV reported.

Headline: Turkish protesters urge prime minister to resign

Turkish demonstrators have taken to the streets in the southern city of Reyhanli near the Syria border, to condemn recent deadly car bombings in the city, urging Turkey's prime minister to resign. The protesters on Monday condemned the violence, noting that the outbreak of violence was due to the Prime Minister Recep Tayyip Erdogan's support for armed insurgents in Syria. Saturday's twin bombings left 46 people dead and dozens wounded in Reyhanli. A similar demonstration was held in Ankara on Saturday, in which dozens of people marched in the street and chanted slogans criticizing Erdogan and Foreign Minister Ahmet Davutoglu.

Headline: Massive blast outside hospital in Benghazi, Libya, up to 17 dead

At least 17 people, including three children, were killed and another 30 injured when a car bomb exploded in crowded area outside a hospital in Benghazi, Libya. Libya's Defense Ministry reported that 17 people died in the blast, shortly after Libyan Deputy Interior Minister Abdullah Massoud

confirmed 15 deaths. "Fifteen people have been killed and at least 30 were wounded in the explosion of a car bomb near the hospital," Deputy Interior Minister Massoud said. Libyan security official Abdel-Salam al-Barghathi said the car bomb was parked outside a bakery near the city's main hospital, AP reported. "I saw people running and some of them were collecting parts of bodies," Reuters quoted a witness as saying. No group has claimed responsibility for the Benghazi bombing, which is considered to be the cradle of the revolution that ousted longtime Libyan leader Muammar Gaddafi. Witnesses wrote on Twitter that the hospital bombing appeared different in nature from the attacks on Benghazi police stations witnessed in recent days, as the attack targeted a public place, not law enforcement. The car bombing near the hospital is the latest in a string of attacks across the country in recent weeks.

Headline: Jihadist leader threatens war against Tunisia govt

The head of a radical Salafist group in Tunisia has threatened to wage war against the government, led by moderate Islamist party Ennahda, accusing it in a message posted online of un-Islamic policies. "To the tyrants who think they are Islamists... know that the stupid things you are doing are dragging you to war," said Abu Iyadh, the fugitive leader of Ansar al-Sharia who is wanted by the police over deadly unrest last year. "Your war is not against our young people but against religion," he said, in a statement published on the jihadist group's website. Abu Iyadh, whose real name is Seif Allah Ibn Hussein, is accused of organizing numerous acts of violence and has been on the run since September, after an attack by Islamist protesters on the US embassy in September in which four of them died.

Headline: Morocco: Polisario chief warns of armed struggle

Polisario Front chief Mohamed Abdelaziz has warned that his movement could take up arms to seek independence from Morocco if the U.N. fails to resolve the Western Sahara conflict, Algeria's APS news agency reported Saturday. "We have believed in the United Nations, but if it fails to organize a referendum on self-determination in Western Sahara to allow the Sahrawi people to recover independence, then we will take up arms to liberate our territory," APS quoted Abdelaziz as saying. Morocco annexed the Western Sahara, a former Spanish colony, in 1975, a move never recognized by the international community. It has proposed broad autonomy under Moroccan sovereignty for the phosphate-rich region. But this is rejected by the Polisario, which first took up arms to fight for an independent state two years before the Spanish withdrawal, and continued its guerrilla war against Morocco until a U.N.-negotiated ceasefire in 1991. The U.N. Security Council passed a resolution last month extending the mandate of the U.N. peacekeeping mission for another year but omitting a U.S.-backed plan to task it with human rights monitoring after Morocco lobbied furiously to have the proposal dropped.

Headline: Cyprus receives EU-IMF bailout funds

Cyprus has received the first instalment of a 10bn-euro bailout package from international creditors, which was agreed earlier this year. Cyprus received 2bn euros (£1.6bn; \$2.6bn) in loans, said a statement by the European Stability Mechanism. Another 1bn euros will be transferred before 30 June, the ESM said. Eurozone finance ministers are also expected to sign off the latest tranche of Greece's bailout, as it continues to struggle to reform its economy. Another topic on the agenda at their meeting in Brussels is Slovenia, which is seen as potentially likely to follow Greece and Cyprus in seeking help from European authorities. Concerns are growing despite a plan unveiled last week by Slovenia's government, aimed at avoiding a bailout.

Spain and Portugal called on Monday for the eurozone to complete a banking union as Germany underscored legal hurdles before a central element of the plan to deal with failing banks can be introduced. "It is indispensable that we stick to the agreed calendar on banking union and that we take steps to make sure families and small companies receive credit," Spanish Prime Minister Mariano Rajoy told reporters. The World Health Organization says it appears likely that the novel coronavirus (NCoV) can be passed between people in close contact. This comes after the French health ministry confirmed a second man had contracted the virus in a possible case of human-to-human transmission. Two more people in Saudi Arabia are also reported to have died from the virus, according to health officials. NCoV is known to cause pneumonia and sometimes kidney failure. World Health Organization (WHO) officials have expressed concern over the clusters of cases of the new coronavirus strain and the potential for it to spread. Since 2012, there have been 34 confirmed cases across Europe and the Middle East, with 18 deaths, according to a recent WHO update. Headline: 3 suspected cases of SARS-like virus in France

French health officials said Friday they are investigating three suspected cases of a deadly new respiratory virus related to SARS, in people who had close contact in the hospital with France's only confirmed case. Beatrice Degrugillers, a spokeswoman for the regional health agency in France's Nord-Pas-de-Calais region, said a nurse at the hospital where the man was hospitalized in late April has herself been under watch at the hospital in Douai since Thursday night. A doctor and a former hospital roommate who had each been in contact with the first patient also remain hospitalized. Test results are expected later Friday. If confirmed, the additional cases would heighten concerns about the virus' ability to spread easily between people. Health authorities have previously said the new coronavirus has spread in limited circumstances between people in very close contact, such as relatives taking care of family members.

Headline: SARS-like virus in Saudi has killed 15: minister

Fifteen people in Saudi Arabia have died from a SARS-like virus out of 24 people who contracted it since last August, Health Minister Abdullah al-Rabia said on Sunday. "The number of people who contracted the virus in the kingdom since August/September is 24, of whom 15 have died," Rabia told a news conference in Riyadh. An earlier toll provided on Tuesday by the World Health Organisation said 11 people had died in Saudi Arabia since last year from the disease whose medical term is

NCoV-EMC, or novel coronavirus. Rabia also said three other people are suspected of having contracted the virus in Saudi Arabia, pledging to announce with "full transparency" the results of their medical tests. The WHO's assistant director general for health security and the environment, Keiji Fukuda, told a Riyadh news conference on Sunday the new virus posed an "important and major challenge" for countries affected and the world generally.

Headline: 2 new viruses could both spark global outbreaks

Two respiratory viruses in different parts of the world have captured the attention of global health officials — a novel coronavirus in the Middle East and a new bird flu spreading in China. Last week, the coronavirus related to SARS spread to France, where one patient who probably caught the disease in Dubai infected his hospital roommate. Officials are now trying to track down everyone who went on a tour group holiday to Dubai with the first patient as well as all contacts of the second patient. Since it was first spotted last year, the new coronavirus has infected 34 people, killing 18 of them. Nearly all had some connection to the Middle East. The World Health Organization, however, says there is no reason to think the virus is restricted to the Middle East and has advised health officials worldwide to closely monitor any unusual respiratory cases. At the same time, a new bird flu strain, H7N9, has been infecting people in China since at least March, causing 32 deaths out of 131 known cases. WHO, which is closely monitoring the viruses, says both have the potential to cause a pandemic — a global epidemic — if they evolve into a form easily spread between people. May 13, 2013

Headline: Lebanese man convicted of evangelism in 'Khobar Girl' case

A Saudi court convicted a Lebanese man for "evangelism" for encouraging a Saudi woman to convert to Christianity and helping her leave the country, local press reported over the weekend. A court in Khobar, in the kingdom's east, sentenced the man to six years in prison and 300 lashes, while another man convicted in the same case, a Saudi, was given two years in prison and 200 lashes. Under Saudi law, any form of proselytization is illegal, and Muslims who convert to another religion must be sentenced to death. A strong 6.5-magnitude earthquake struck off the Pacific nation of Tonga US seismologists said, but no tsunami warning was issued. The under-sea quake hit at 08:46 am (2046 GMT Saturday), 139 kilometers (86 miles) from the town of Neiafu, on the south coast of the island Vava'u, at a depth of 205 kilometers, the US Geological Survey (USGS) said. The Pacific Tsunami Warning Centre said based on the depth of the quake, no tsunami was expected. The epicenter of the tremor was 353 kilometers north of the capital Nuku'alofa. Tonga, almost 2,000 kilometers northeast of New Zealand, lies on the so-called Pacific "Ring of Fire," where continental plates collide causing frequent seismic activity

Headline: Pakistan: 6 killed in suicide attack on Balochistan IGP

Balochistan Inspector General of Police Mushtaq Sukhera narrowly escaped a suicide attack on Sunday that killed at least six people and wounded 46 others, officials said. IGP Sukhera had just entered his residence in Quetta when a suicide bomber in a vehicle laden with explosives blew themselves up outside. "At least two policemen, three paramilitary soldiers and one passerby were killed outside the inspector general's residence and 46 others were wounded," Home Secretary Akbar Durrani told AFP. A huge amount of explosives were packed into the vehicle and the blast left a deep crater, with the explosion shattering nearby windows and sending debris flying, he said. Senior police official Mobin Ahmed told AFP the police chief was safe, while another police official said the blast was so loud it was heard all over the city.

Protesters and police have clashed in Bulgaria as the preliminary results of the country's parliamentary election indicate victory for the GERB party. Partial results indicate that the leading GERB party has received 31.4 percent of the vote from the election of May 12. On Sunday, over 200

protesters threw stones and torches at police in front of the National Palace of Culture in the capital, Sofia, following the closure of the polling stations. The angry demonstrators chanted "Mafia!" against GERB, demanding an annulment of the election results. Over the past few months, Bulgarians have held a string of protests against the low living standards and high utility bills. Some 22 percent of the country's population of over seven million live under the official poverty line.

Headline: Greek government to invoke emergency powers on striking teachers Headline: Greek police, protesters clash at demo against mining project

The Greek government has threatened to use emergency powers to prevent teachers who plan to go on strike from disrupting university entrance exams. Government spokesman, Simos Kedikoglou, said on Monday that the coalition government has decided to use the emergency civil mobilization order, which is normally used at the time of disasters or natural crisis, to safeguard the May 17-31 exams. "We are dealing with a threat to the national interest. We cannot accept a situation that allows 100,000 children and their families to be held to ransom," Kedikoglou said. It came after teachers' unions called for an initial 24-hour strike for May 17 in protest to planned job cuts and two-hour increase on their weekly working hours. The Federation of Secondary Education State School Teacher (OLME) described the government's order "extreme and undemocratic," saying it would challenge the decision in court.
