Headline: Israel nixes UNESCO Jerusalem visit, alleging Palestinians tried to make it political

Israel has canceled a visit by a delegation of inspectors from UNESCO, the United Nations cultural agency, which was supposed to begin an inspection Monday of historical sites in the Old City of Jerusalem. "The visit has been postponed, since the Palestinians have violated the understandings that were obtained and have tried to make it into a political event," said a senior official at the Foreign Ministry in Jerusalem. On April 23, Israel, the Palestinians and the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization reached an agreement whereby five anti-Israel resolutions would be removed from the agency's agenda. In return, Israel gave its consent for the UNESCO delegation to visit the Old City and examine a number of sites that are undergoing restoration and preservation processes. All sides agreed the delegation would not visit the Temple Mount or deal with the issue of the Mughrabi Gate Bridge from the Western Wall Plaza to the mount. The Foreign Ministry recently received information indicating that the Palestinian Authority, which is now considered a full member of UNESCO, was trying to change the nature of the visit and give it a policy and political dimension. Officials at the ministry were already angry about a statement Thursday by Palestinian Foreign Minister Rivad al-Malaki that the UNESCO delegation is actually "an investigative committee examining the occupation's attempts to Judaize Jerusalem." Headline: Israeli seeks interim deal with Palestinians Headline: Interim deal on road to statehood

Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu's senior coalition partner says that reaching a final peace agreement with the Palestinians is unrealistic at the current time and the sides should instead pursue an interim arrangement. Finance Minister Yair Lapid's assessment, delivered in a published interview Sunday just days before the arrival of U.S. Secretary of State John Kerry, throws a contentious idea into the mix as the U.S. searches for ways to restart peace talks. It remains unclear whether the idea of a temporary arrangement will be raised during Kerry's visit later this week. In March, American officials confirmed that an interim arrangement, while not their preference, was one of the ideas being explored. With the gaps between Israel and the Palestinians on many key issues seemingly unbridgeable, pursuing a Palestinian state with temporary borders has emerged as an option in recent months, particularly among Israelis searching for a way out of the status quo. The Palestinians have repeatedly rejected this option, fearing an interim deal that falls short of their hopes will become permanent. In order to allay Palestinian concerns, Lapid told the Yediot Ahronot daily that President Barack Obama should set a three-year timeline for determining the final borders of a Palestinian state. As a gesture to the Israelis, he also called on Obama to endorse the position laid out by President George W. Bush in 2004, allowing Israel to keep some of the Jewish settlements it has built on occupied lands.

Headline: Qatar: Arab Spring makes Israeli-Palestinian peace more pressing

Qatar's emir, who has thrown his state's riches behind Arab uprisings, said on Monday that the emergence of 'people power' had put Arabs in direct confrontation with Israel and made a resolution of the Israeli-Palestinian conflict more pressing. "We heard in the past that reform (in the Arab world) must wait until a peaceful settlement with Israel is achieved, but everybody should realize that such belief is now unfounded after the Arab Spring revolts," Sheikh Hamad bin Khalifa al-Thani told a conference in the Qatari capital. "The reason is that the Arab Spring has today put Israel in direct confrontation with the Arab people, not only with their rulers. These people will no longer accept that negotiations are the goal in themselves." He added: "Our region will not see peace unless we see a resolution to the Palestinian issue."

Headline: Syria gunfire hits Israel-occupied Golan 'near military patrol'

Overnight gunfire from Syria hit the central Israeli-occupied Golan Heights near an Israeli military patrol, an AI Arabiya correspondent reported on Monday. An Israeli military spokeswoman confirmed that shots were fired, but it was not clear whether the gunfire was intentional. The shots were "most likely were stray bullets, we don't know if it was intentional," the spokeswoman told AFP news agency, adding that the Israeli army had not fired back and that Israel had submitted a complaint to the United Nations force in the region. Israel seized 1,200 square kilometers (460 square miles) of the strategic Golan Heights during the 1967 Six-Day War, which it later annexed, a move never recognized by the international community. The Golan Heights have been tense since the beginning of the conflict in Syria more than two years ago. However, there have been only minor flare-ups in the region to date, with Syrian shells crashing in the occupied Golan and Israel firing in retaliation. In recent weeks there were four incidents of fire coming from Syria and straying across the ceasefire line.

Headline: Deadly clashes rock Lebanon's Tripoli

Clashes erupted Sunday afternoon in the rival Tripoli neighborhoods of Jabal Mohsen and Bab al-Tebbaneh, leaving one person dead and 22 injured. Gunfire and the explosions of rocket-propelled grenades could be heard throughout the evening and into the night as the injury toll in the troubled northern Lebanese city continued to rise. Lebanon's state news agency reported that sniper activity targeted the international highway linking Tripoli to Akkar. Snipers took aim at several vehicles driving on that road, one of which was a passenger bus. Al-Jadeed television later added that the Lebanese Armed Forces took aim at the source of the gunfire in both Jabal Mohsen and Bab al-Tebbaneh, and took measures to block the international highway.

Headline: Saudi Arabia vies to avoid Afghan-style blowback from Syria

A Saudi Arabian vegetable seller, who set himself on fire in the capital Riyadh on Thursday to express discontent over social and economic injustices in the kingdom, has died. Saudi media reported on Sunday that the man set himself ablaze after police seized his goods for standing in an unauthorized area. The man, who was identified only by the family name of Sureihi, passed away in hospital on Friday night. On Saturday, Sureihi's family members gathered outside the hospital and demanded answers about why police confiscated his goods, and that what forced him to douse himself in gasoline and set himself alight. Saudi officials did not comment over the self-immolation, and refused to reveal the man's name or age. There have been several acts of self-immolation across Arab countries since self-immolation of Tunisia's Mohamed Bouazizi in December 2010, which provoked an anti-regime uprising in the North African country.

Headline: Egypt 'sends military reinforcements' to Sinai after kidnapping Headline: Gunmen storm Egyptian security post in Sinai Peninsula

Egypt has sent dozens of armored vehicles and personnel carriers across the Suez Canal into Sinai, where Islamist gunmen kidnapped seven soldiers and policemen last week, state daily al-Ahram said on Monday. Gunmen demanding the release of jailed Islamist militants seized the hostages on the road between the Sinai towns of el-Arish and Rafah on Thursday. The military reinforcements indicate that force could be used to rescue the hostages, according to al-Ahram, citing an Egyptian security official. The abductions in Sinai prompted angry police to protest and shut down border crossings with Gaza and Israel, piling the pressure on Mursi to help free their colleagues. Egypt's President Mohammed Mursi on Sunday barred negotiations with the kidnappers of the three policemen and four soldiers who appeared to plead for their release in an online video. "There are no negotiations with criminals and the awe of the state will be preserved," Mursi was cited as saying by the official MENA news agency. Meanwhile, Gunmen stormed an Egyptian security forces base in the Sinai Peninsula at dawn on Monday and exchanged gunfire with forces inside the base before retreating, security sources said. The gunmen attacked the base in the Al-Ahrash area in North Sinai from a truck and

fired automatic weapons, but the attack did not result in any casualties. The identity of the attackers was not immediately clear, but security sources said they were likely to be Islamist militants. May 20, 2013



Headline: Kerry to Mideast for Syria Talks

U.S. Secretary of State John Kerry travels Monday to the Middle East for talks on holding a Syrian peace conference. Syrian President Bashar al-Assad has said he doubts the U.S./Russian initiative can stop the fighting. The latest effort to end Syrian violence aims to bring together for the first time envoys from President Assad's government and its opponents. Though Washington and Moscow back different sides in the conflict, Secretary of State Kerry said they are united in getting to a transitional government for Syria. "Russia and the United States share a belief that it is extremely constructive and positive that we are working together, cooperatively, in an effort to try to implement a peaceful resolution," said Kerry.

Headline: Watchdog: Syrian opposition chief kidnapped Headline: Syrian opposition meets in Madrid over conflict

An opposition leader, rights activist and long-time dissident in Syria's rebel-held city of Raqa has been abducted, a watchdog said on Monday. "The Syrian Observatory for Human Rights has learnt of the abduction by an armed group of lawyer, human rights activist and head of Raqa city's (opposition) local council Abdullah al-Khalil," the Britain-based group said. It condemned the kidnapping and demanded "his immediate release". Khalil was abducted as he left the local council's headquarters in Raqa on Sunday morning, added the watchdog, which relies on a broad network of activists, doctors and lawyers for its reports. Syrian regime troops have not been inside the city since March this year, when Raqa became the first and only provincial capital to fall to rebels since the uprising against President Bashar al-Assad broke out more than two years ago.

Syria's President Bashar Assad emerged from the shadows to announce in a publicly televised interview that he's not stepping down, and he's not caving to "terrorists" who were tearing apart his country. It's his first interview since the international community has pressed for a peace conference to put a halt to the violence, BBC reported. Mr. Assad said the West would be better served by

slowing the tide of weapons into the hands of "terrorists" who were responsible for the ongoing attacks, BBC said. Mr. Assad's forces have been receiving assistance from Hezbollah fighters, BBC said. Their latest target: The rebel stronghold of Qusair. The BBC reported that government fighters have also just started receiving help from Shia militants who have been crossing the borders from Iraq.

Headline: Assad, Hezbollah forces launch massive assault on key rebel town Headline: Syrian-Hizballah's capture of Qusayr opens direct weapons route to Lebanon

Syrian troops on Sunday launched a major assault on rebel forces in Qusair, a strategic town near the Lebanese border. According to opposition sources, the Syrian army soldiers, tanks and planes, supported by hundreds of Hezbollah fighters, pounded the rebel-held city, inflicting significant civilian casualties. According to the Syrian Observatory for Human Rights, the bombardment had killed 30 people by Sunday evening, including 16 rebel fighters. The Local Coordination Committees of Syria reported that 77 were killed across the country on Sunday, including 41 in Homs province, "most of them in Qusair." Syrian President Bashar Assad's forces have besieged Qusair since November 2011. In recent weeks, a government offensive along the Lebanese border has attempted to regain control of the strategic area.

Headline: Maliki plans overhaul of Iraq's security strategy as violence rages Headline: At least 43 dead, dozens wounded as string of bombings hits Iraq

Prime Minister Nuri al-Maliki said Monday he will overhaul Iraq's security strategy as a two-day wave of violence killed 72 people including 24 police, bringing the month's death toll from unrest to 349. "We are about to make changes in the high and middle positions of those responsible for security, and the security strategy," AFP reported Maliki as saying at a news conference in Baghdad. "We will discuss this matter in the cabinet session tomorrow (Tuesday) to take decisions," Maliki said, without providing further details. "I assure the Iraqi people that they (militants) will not be able to return us to the sectarian conflict" that killed tens of thousands of people in Iraq in past years, he added. At least 43 people were killed in car bomb explosions targeting Shiite Muslims in the Iraqi capital and the southern oil hub of Basra on Monday, police and medics told Reuters news agency. About 150 people have been killed in sectarian violence over the past week and tensions between Shiites and minority Sunni Muslims have reached their highest level since U.S. troops pulled out in December 2011. Headline: 'At least eight killed' in southern Russia car bombs

At least eight people were killed and more than a dozen injured on Monday in twin car blasts outside a court building in the southern Russian city of Makhachkala in the restless region of Dagestan. The local investigative committee said that "within the space of a few minutes, two cars blew up. At least eight people died. The number of people injured is being checked." Officials added that at least two dozen cars were damaged by shrapnel. Dagestan's police department said the second bomb went off after law enforcement officials had arrived on the scene to investigate the first explosion. The blasts happened within 15 minutes of each other outside a building used by court bailiffs. ITAR-TASS quoted one police source as saying that this may have been an assassination attempt against a senior bailiff's office representative. Reports said that two law enforcement officials and a bailiff's office employee had died.

Headline: Afghan suicide attack kills 14, including politician

A suicide bomber struck outside government buildings in northern Afghanistan on Monday, killing 14 people including a local politician in the latest attack to target provincial officials. Emergency services rushed to the scene and took the wounded to hospital after the bomber, who was wearing police uniform, blew himself up next to Rasoul Mohseni, the head of Baghlan's provincial council. Also among the dead were seven police guards and several other people waiting to speak to Mohseni, who was walking into the government offices in Pul-e-Khumri city when he was killed. "I collected information from different hospitals and the death toll is 14. Another nine people are wounded," Zubair Akbary, the provincial public health director, said. Taliban insurgents said they had deliberately targeted Mohseni, who was head of the provincial council -- an elected body in each of Afghanistan's 34 provinces that liaises between residents and the local government. Headline: 51 killed in South Sudan clashes: Officials

Fifty one people have lost their lives in two separate clashes in eastern and northeastern regions of South Sudan, government officials say. In a battle between South Sudan's military and militants led by David Yau Yau in the eastern state of Jonglei, South Sudan's largest state, on Sunday, 24 people, including 20 militants and four government troops, were killed, said South Sudanese military commander, Colonel Philip Aguer. The army recaptured the town of Boma, near the border with Ethiopia, from the militants who had seized the town earlier this month, the military official noted. South Sudan's military "restored law and order to Boma and chased away the rebels to the hills outside town," Aguer said. Elsewhere in the northeastern state of Upper Nile, cattle raiders suspected to be from Jonglei state killed 27 people early on Saturday, local officials said. May 20, 2013

Headline: 'Rule of tyrant should fall': Salafi protesters and police clash violently in Tunisia

Headline: Tunisian Salafists Threaten Jihad, Say They'll 'Force America To Bow Down Before Them' And 'Raise The Black Standard' Over The White House

A young protester has died and at least 15 policemen injured, after Tunisian security forces clashed with Salafis. Police fired teargas and shots into the air to disperse the stone-throwing crowd, which gathered despite a ban. Some 200 people have been arrested in the weekend clashes, Prime Minister Ali Larayedh said in remarks published on Monday. Violence broke out in the central city of Kairouan and in the capital, Tunis. Clashes in the Tunis suburb of Ettadhamen erupted between nearly 500 supporters of Ansar al-Sharia and law enforcement as protesters started throwing stones. The Salafis were chanting, *"The rule of the tyrant should fall,"* according to Reuters. Teargas was also reportedly used in Kairouan, as Salafis threw stones at the police from behind the wall of a mosque. May 19, 2013

Headline: Subsidy reform dispute imperils Morocco's ruling coalition

Morocco's junior government party is threatening to quit the coalition unless Islamist prime minister Abdelilah Benkirane moderates plans for sweeping cuts to subsidies on food and energy. Increased subsidies have been part of Morocco's strategy to prevent popular discontent welling up into an uprising of the kind that has toppled rulers across north Africa, but the moderate Islamist PJD argues, along with the IMF, that they have become unsustainable. State subsidies on food and energy shot up to 57 billion dirhams (\$6.6 billion) in 2012 - 15 percent of total public spending - from 48.8 billion in 2011 and 29.8 billion in 2010. Nevertheless, the conservative Istiqlal party, in a move that analysts said was likely to have the backing of the palace, the ultimate power in Morocco, said the PJD's reform plans were too radical.

Headline: North Korea fires sixth missile in three days

Headline: S. Korea slams N. Korea's 'provocative' missile launches

North Korea fired two short-range missiles on Monday, making six launches in three days, and it condemned South Korea for criticizing what it said were its legitimate military drills. South Korea's Defense Ministry said North Korea had fired one missile on Monday morning and a second one in the afternoon. Both were fired into the sea off North Korea's east coast, a ministry official said. The launches come hard on the heels of more than two months of threats from North Korea that it would wage a nuclear war against South Korea and the United States if it were attacked. The North condemned joint U.S. and South Korean military exercises, that ended in late April, as a rehearsal for an attack on its territory. "We are conducting intense military exercises to strengthen our defense capacity," North Korea's KCNA news agency quoted the Committee for the Peaceful Reunification of Korea, the body that handles inter-Korean issues, as saying on Monday. "Our military is conducting these exercises in order to cope with the mounting war measures from the U.S. and South Korea, which is the legitimate right of any sovereign country."

And power was given to them over a fourth of the earth, to kill with sword, with hunger, with death (Thanatos in Greek meaning the death of the body whether natural or violent), and by the beasts of the earth" (Revelation)

Headline: H7N9 case has drug- and non-resistant strains

The only H7N9 patient so far in Taiwan was carrying two strains of the same virus, with one being drug resistant and the other not, making it tricky to treat to him, doctors said. Huang Li-min, a doctor from National Taiwan University Hospital (NTUH), explained that it was possible the avian flu virus was not drug resistant when the patient was first infected, but mutated later to become resistant to Tamiflu. With Tamiflu failing, NTUH later switched to another intravenous drug, Huang said. Because of the presence of the two strains simultaneously, it was difficult for doctors to determine how much the virus' drug resistance had undermined the therapy. Chou Chi-hao, deputy director-general of the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), said it is natural for viruses to mutate, saying the H1N1 flu strain mutated after infecting human beings. But Huang said H7N9 has limited chances of human-to-human transmission through respiratory secretions because the virus has difficulty surviving the environments of human upper respiratory systems. Patients do not have symptoms of a runny nose or sneezing.

AvianFluTalk.com, an online discussion forum created in 2005 to track the potential threat of an avian flu pandemic, has been the venue for a serious discussion regarding the new SARS-like coronavirus infecting patients at a New York Hospital leaving several in critical condition and resulting in 3 deaths. The new SARS-like coronavirus recently emerged in the Middle East infecting 41 total worldwide resulting in 20 deaths and is primarily spread by limited human-to-human transmission. Experts fear that the virus' early ability to transmit among humans could spark a global pandemic should the virus mutate further and achieve sustained human transmission. Nurses working at a St. Luke's hospital in New York have claimed that there are several cases of the new SARS-like virus in the hospital's ICU, which have gone misdiagnosed and that are in fact the new deadly virus.

Headline: High court to weigh in on legislative prayers

The Supreme Court said Monday it will hear a new case on the intersection of religion and government in a dispute over prayers used to open public meetings. The justices said they will review an appeals court ruling that held that the upstate New York town of Greece, a Rochester suburb, violated the Constitution by opening nearly every meeting over an 11-year span with prayers that stressed Christianity. The 2nd U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals said the town should have made a greater effort to invite people from other faiths to open its monthly board meetings. The town says the high court already has upheld prayers at the start of legislative meetings and that private citizens offered invocations of their own choosing. The town said in court papers that the opening prayers should be found to be constitutional, "so long as the government does not act with improper motive in selecting prayer-givers." Two town residents who are not Christian complained that they felt marginalized by the steady stream of Christian prayers and challenged the practice. They are represented by Americans United for Separation of Church and State.

Headline: Moon explosion visible from Earth

A meteoroid struck the surface of the moon recently, causing an explosion that was visible on Earth without the aid of a telescope, NASA reported Friday. But don't be alarmed if you didn't see it; it only lasted about a second. "It exploded in a flash nearly 10 times as bright as anything we've ever seen before," said Bill Cooke, of NASA's Meteoroid Environment Office. NASA astronomers have been monitoring the moon for the past eight years, looking for explosions caused by meteoroids hitting the lunar surface. It's part of a program to find new fields of space debris that could hit Earth. NASA says it sees hundreds of detectable lunar meteoroid impacts a year.

Headline: 6.5 earthquake strikes off Chile, USGS says

The U.S. Geological Survey says a magnitude-6.5 earthquake has struck off the coast of Chile. The quake was recorded at 5:49 a.m. local time (EDT; 0949 GMT) Monday, at a shallow depth of 6.2 miles, some 370 miles from the city of Puerto Quellon. No tsunami warning was issued. Chile's naval seismology office says it was not felt on land. U.S. seismologists originally estimated the magnitude at 6.8. Chile is one of the world's most earthquake-prone countries. A magnitude-8.8 quake and the tsunami it unleashed in 2010 killed 551 people and destroyed 220,000 homes. A 5.5-magnitude earthquake has struck northern Algeria, causing damage to some buildings and injuring at least five people, national news agency APS has reported. Headline: Japan hit by an earthquake of 6.1 magnitude

A strong 6.1-magnitude earthquake struck off the northern coast of Japan's main Honshu island today, seismologists said, but no tsunami warning was issued and there were no immediate reports of damage. The quake hit at 2:48 pm (0548 GMT) in the Pacific some 50 kilometres from Namie town near the tsunami-ravaged Fukushima Daiichi plant, the United States Geological Survey said. Japan's meteorological agency estimated it as 5.9 magnitude at a depth of 50 kilometres. Fukushima operator Tokyo Electric Power Co. said there were no immediate reports of any impact on the plant, Jiji Press said. "We have received no reports of damage so far," an official at Fukushima prefecture told AFP. Neighbouring Miyagi prefecture also had no reports of damage, a Miyagi official said. May 18, 2013

Headline: New tornado strikes Missouri as rash of central U.S. twisters kills 1

Tornadoes touched down in three states on Sunday, ripping roofs off homes and turning trees to matchsticks, as severe weather swept the region. A large "violent and extremely dangerous" tornado was spotted on the southwest side of Wichita, Kansas, the National Weather Service said. A second

confirmed tornado was seen near Edmond, Oklahoma, said the weather service. Another tornado was spotted in nearby Luther, Oklahoma, but it was not immediately clear whether that was the same twister. A third tornado touched down near Wellston, Oklahoma, taking out power lines and damaging several homes, according to video from CNN affiliate KFOR. The affiliate's helicopter pilot estimated the funnel cloud to be about a half-mile wide. "It's tearing up everything," the pilot said. "Just ripping everything up in its sight." Aerial video from KFOR and CNN affiliate KOCO showed severe damage near Wellston and near Carney, Oklahoma.

Headline: After Crushing Mali Islamists, France Pushes Deal with Tuaregs

After winning adulation across Mali for a five month military offensive that crushed al-Qaida fighters, France is now frustrating some of its allies by pushing for a political settlement with a separate group of Tuareg rebels. A standoff over how to restore Malian government authority to Kidal, the last town in the desert north yet to be brought under central control, is sowing resentment with Paris and could delay planned elections to restore democracy after a coup. Mali's army has moved troops towards Kidal, a stronghold of the MNLA Tuareg separatists, but missed a self-imposed deadline this week to retake the Saharan town. France, which has its own forces camped outside, does not want Malian troops to march on the town, fearing ethnic bloodshed if it is taken by force. "Paris blocks army at the gates of Kidal," read a headline in *Le Matin*, a weekly in Mali's capital Bamako. Elections are planned for July in Mali to finally restore normalcy after a chaotic 18 months that saw Tuaregs launch a revolt, the military carry out a coup, al-Qaida-linked Islamists seize the north and 4,000 French troops arrive to dislodge them.

Headline: 100 cars burned in riots sparked by police shooting in Sweden

Swedish youths have rioted in the capital, Stockholm, setting cars on fire and throwing rocks at police, apparently in protest against a fatal police shooting of a local resident. Stockholm police officer Lars Bystrom said about 50 to 60 young people on Sunday set fire to a number of cars as well as a garage, causing around 50 residents to be evacuated from their homes in the northwestern suburb of Husby. In addition, the local shopping strip was vandalized and three police officers were injured. According to a press photographer, about 100 vehicles were reportedly set on fire.
