

Headline: China could hold Israel-Palestinian talks if asked

The Chinese government says it is willing to set up a meeting between the Israeli prime minister and the Palestinian president when the two leaders visit Beijing next week, if the sides expressed interest in doing so. Foreign Ministry spokeswoman Hua Chunying said Friday at a regular briefing that China would be happy to facilitate a meeting between Benjamin Netanyahu and Mahmoud Abbas if they were willing to meet. Abbas will be in China from Sunday to Tuesday, overlapping with Netanyahu's Monday-Friday visit.

Headline: Hamas rejects Arab League initiative for Israeli-Palestinian peace

Hamas Prime Minister Ismail Haniyeh on Friday rejected a revised Middle East peace initiative put forward by the Arab League, saying outsiders could not decide the fate of the Palestinians. In meetings this week in Washington, Arab states appeared to soften their 2002 peace plan, acknowledging that Israelis and Palestinians may have to swap land in any eventual peace deal. The United States and the Palestinian leadership in the West Bank praised the move. But speaking to hundreds of worshippers in a Gaza mosque, Haniyeh said it was a concession that other Arabs were not authorized to make. "The so-called new Arab initiative is rejected by our people, by our nation and no one can accept it," said Haniyeh. "The initiative contains numerous dangers to our people in the occupied land of 1967, 1948 and to our people in exile."

Headline: Israel Must End Occupation, says European Parliament Delegation

A European Parliament (EP) delegation called on the European Union Foreign Policy Chief Catherine Ashton and Member States to insist that Israel ends to the illegal policies preventing a resumption of negotiations to end the occupation, said an EP press release Thursday. The delegation from EP's Delegation for Relations with the Palestinian Legislative Council conducted a six-day visit to East Jerusalem and the West Bank that started on April 27, taking in the "Freedom and Dignity" conference in Ramallah on the subject of Palestinian prisoners and people. EP passed a resolution on March 14, 2013 expressing concern about the conditions under which prisoners are being held in Israeli prisons and called for a fact-finding mission to "assess the current situation."

Headline: Israel questions Google over 'Palestine'

Internet search engine Google has taken a small but politically loaded step by changing the tagline on the homepage of its Palestinian version from "Palestinian Territories" to "Palestine." The change, introduced at the beginning of May, shows Google's logo with "Palestine" written below in Arabic and English. "We're changing the name 'Palestinian Territories' to 'Palestine' across our products. We consult a number of sources and authorities when naming countries," Google spokesman Nathan Tyler said in a statement to the BBC. "In this case, we are following the lead of the UN, Icann [the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers], ISO [International Organization for Standardization] and other international organizations," Tyler added. The United Nations General Assembly granted Palestine the status of "non-member observer state" last November, providing Palestinians a certain degree of statehood recognition.

Headline: Jordanian prisoners in Israel begin hunger strike

Jordanian prisoners in Israel began an open hunger strike on Thursday, demanding freedom and better treatment, according to Fadi Farah, spokesperson of the National Committee for Prisoners in Israel. Farah told The Jordan Times over the phone that prisoners are disgruntled with the way the Jordanian government is handling their cases, accusing it of neglecting their issue. "Prisoners are calling for their freedom and they want the government to exert serious efforts to release them," he noted. "For a long time, the government has neglected the issue of Jordanians behind Israeli bars,

and prisoners are frustrated with the continuing failure of the authorities to address their plight," the activist added. He said that the prisoners complain of the "rare" visits staff at the Jordanian embassy in Tel Aviv make to their prisons to check on them.

Headline: Ground sources say Israeli Air Force conducting flyovers in Lebanon Headline: President Suleiman condemns Israeli violations

Israeli Air Force planes conducted several sorties in Lebanese air space on Friday, according to reports from Lebanese sources. The fly-overs, according to the sources, were ongoing throughout the morning and focused from the southern sector of Marjayoun and Al Khayyam, up to the Beqaa valley in the east. According to these reports, some of the planes simulated low altitude attacks, as part of activity which started on Thursday. UNIFIL forces in southern Lebanon reported that two brigades conducted exercises in the area, including searches for unexploded bombs and weapons. Israeli sorties over Lebanon have been reported for several months now. These reports have appeared on Lebanese websites ever since the reports regarding an Israeli attack in Syria which targeted chemical weapons stockpiles, as well as following two recent incidents involving unmanned drones which originated in Lebanon.

Headline: Saudis report new fire fights with Iran-backed Shi'ite fugitives

Saudi Arabia has reported fresh battles with Iranian-backed Shi'ite insurgents. Officials said police came under fire from suspected Shi'ite fighters in the oil-rich Eastern Province in late April. They said a Shi'ite fugitive and organizer, identified as Abdullah Al Asri, was captured. "Security forces will not hesitate to pursue fugitives," Saudi Interior Ministry spokesman Maj. Gen. Mansour Al Turki said. Al Turki said Al Asri was one of a list of 23 Shi'ite fugitives linked to unrest in Awamiya, which has seen more than a dozen attacks and clashes with security forces over the last year. He said Al Asri and another suspect were shot in the leg during a battle with police. Officials said Saudi security forces have intensified their search for Iranian-backed Shi'ite insurgents. They said 12 members of the Interior Ministry's fugitive list have been captured.

Headline: Tear gas fired as Egyptian Islamists target security HQ

Egyptian security forces fired tear gas to disperse a small group of hardline Islamist protesters who were attempting to scale the walls of the state security headquarters in a Cairo suburb late Thursday night. Around 2,000 protesters from several Salafi Islamist groups had staged a protest earlier on Thursday night outside the security headquarters against what they said was a return to the force's pre-revolution methods. After security forces fired tear gas, the remaining protesters, some of whom had also attempted to break into a nearby police officers' club, left the area. The protest points to lingering suspicion harbored by the hardliners about security agencies used against them by ousted President Hosni Mubarak, and which, they say, Islamist President Mohamed Mursi has been unable to reform.



Headline: Dozens dead as Assad's forces storm coastal village

State forces and militias loyal to Syrian President Bashar al-Assad stormed the coastal village of Baida on Thursday, killing at least 50 people including women and children, the Syrian Observatory for Human Rights said. The pro-opposition monitoring group said the final death toll was likely to exceed 100. Many of those killed appeared to have been executed by shooting or stabbing, it said, and other bodies were found burned. Activist reports on the killings could not be independently verified as the Syrian government restricts access for independent media. Hours earlier, rebels had attacked a busload of pro-Assad militiamen, known as shabbiha, killing at least six and wounding 20. In response, government forces and shabbiha surrounded Baida and nearby Magreb, near the city of Banias, and pummeled them with mortar fire before raiding Baida. Assad's forces have mounted a string of attacks reaching from the capital Damascus and the central city of Homs out to the Mediterranean coast, homeland of the Alawite minority sect to which Assad himself belongs. Headline: Syria rebels rocket Damascus airport

Rebels in Syria fired two rockets at Damascus international airport on Friday, hitting an aircraft and a fuel dump and sparking a massive fire, the official SANA news agency reported. "One rocket hit a kerosene tank and the other hit a parked commercial aircraft, badly damaging it," the agency said, adding that traffic at the facility was "normal" and the fire had been extinguished. Syrian government forces have mounted a string of attacks reaching from the capital Damascus and the central city of Homs out to the Mediterranean coast, homeland of the Alawite minority sect to which Syrian President Bashar al-Assad himself belongs.

Headline: Fresh round of Iran nuclear talks in Istanbul May 15

The Pentagon has beefed up its biggest "bunker buster" bomb so it can destroy Iran's most heavily armed and protected nuclear site, U.S. officials said. The administration believes the enhanced Massive Ordnance Penetrator, the Pentagon's largest conventional bomb, will decrease the chances Israel will launch a unilateral bombing campaign against Iran, at least for this year and maybe next year too, the officials told The Wall Street Journal. This would buy more time for the Obama administration to pursue diplomacy after Iran holds elections in June. It could also give the West more influence in diplomatic efforts to persuade Iran to rein in its nuclear program. Israel and Iran had no immediate comment. Jerusalem maintains it reserves the right to attack Iran. Iran maintains its nuclear program is solely peaceful.

Headline: 16 killed, many injured in two separate attacks in Iraq Headline: Clashes kill nine police in north Iraq

At least 16 people have been killed and dozens injured in two separate terrorist attacks in Iraq, security sources say. Nine Iraqi police were killed and seven others were injured in clashes with armed militants in the northern city of Mosul on Friday. Seven people were also killed after a car bomb exploded outside a Sunni mosque in Rashidiyah, north of Baghdad, as worshippers left the mosque following the Friday Prayers. Thirteen people were also injured in the attack. Sunnis and Shias have both recently been the target of terrorist attacks in Iraq. The attacks come a day after the United Nations Assistance Mission for Iraq (UNAMI) said that April 2013 was Iraq's deadliest month since June 2008, with a total of 712 people killed and 1,633 wounded in bomb attacks and other forms of violence.

Headline: Erdogan: There's No Doubt Assad Used Chemical Weapons

Turkish Prime Minister Recep Tayyip Erdogan said on Thursday that there is no doubt that Syrian President Bashar Al-Assad has used chemical weapons against rebels. Erdogan added that he would discuss the issue with U.S. President Barack Obama during his upcoming visit to Washington. "We will discuss the use of chemical weapons during the meeting with President Obama. It is obvious that the al-Assad regime is using it," Erdogan told the Japanese daily *Nikkei* in an interview. "The opposition dominates on land, however Assad uses chemical weapons, war planes and helicopters. The only field the regime is superior in is air backed operations," he added. Erdogan predicted that "the regime is living its final moments but we don't know when it will topple. This is a situation that will happen suddenly."

Headline: Army deploys around Libya capital amid sieges

Headline: Gunmen in standoff with Libyan army at Tripoli protest

Libya's army took up positions Friday at strategic sites around the capital, where militias have besieged state institutions for the past week, an AFP journalist reported. Soldiers in pickup trucks mounted with machineguns and anti-aircraft weapons were also deployed on Martyrs Square in the heart of Tripoli where a demonstration against the militias is set to take place on Friday. "This measure is intended to secure the entrances of Tripoli, the state institutions and strategic facilities, such as the electric company or the banks," Major Hussein al-Faidi, head of the army's press center, told AFP. "It's also aimed at reassuring the people," he added. Gunmen have surrounded the foreign ministry since Sunday and the justice ministry since Tuesday to demand the General National Congress adopt a bill that would purge former officials of the ousted regime of Moamer Kadhafi. Headline: Separatists slam Morocco "repression" of protesters

The Polisario Front on Friday slammed Morocco's "systematic repression" of separatist protesters in the disputed Western Sahara and urged the UN to apply a new resolution calling for greater efforts on human rights. "The Sahrawi government vigorously denounces the systematic repression of peaceful Sahrawi protests in the occupied territories of the Western Sahara... and calls on the Security Council to ensure the application of its latest resolution," the pro-independence group said in a statement. On April 25, the Security Council passed Resolution 2099 extending the Western Sahara peacekeeping mission for another year and urged Morocco and the Polisario Front to pursue efforts to promote human rights in Western Sahara. The vote came after a bid by the United States to task the UN mission with rights monitoring was dropped. The Polisario said the resolution was "violated by the Moroccan colonizer less than 24 hours after its adoption," and denounced the "brutal treatment inflicted on around 40 Sahrawi protesters by the Moroccan police" in Laayoune on April 26.

Headline: France 'to enter recession' as eurozone growth slows

The eurozone economy will shrink more than expected this year with France sliding into recession, according to a gloomy European Commission report. The Commission forecast says euro-area growth will shrink by 0.4% this year, down from 0.3% forecast in February. France will go into recession this year with negative growth of 0.1% and unemployment rising to 10.9% in 2014 from 10.6% this year. On Thursday, the European Central Bank cut interest rates on growth worries. "Grappling with the aftermath of a profound financial and economic crisis, the EU economy is set to pick up speed only very slowly in the course of this year," the report said. It predicted that France's deficit would rise sharply from 3.9% of GDP this year to 4.2% in 2014. That prompted the EU's commissioner for economic affairs, Olli Rehn, on Friday to say it would be "reasonable" to give France two extra years to meet the EU deficit target of 3%. May 3, 2013

Headline: US: Iran, N. Korea bypassing sanctions to get material for nukes

The Pentagon says North Korea appears headed toward its announced goal, which is to be able to strike the U.S. with a nuclear-armed missile. In a report to Congress Thursday, the Pentagon made no estimate of when North Korea might achieve that capability. It said the North will move closer to its goal if it continues investing in the testing of nuclear and missile technologies. The report says the North's work on a space-launch vehicle has contributed heavily to its effort to build a missile capable of delivering a warhead to U.S. targets. That work was highlighted by the launch of a satellite into

space last December. But it adds that the North has yet to test a re-entry vehicle, without which it cannot deliver a warhead to a target.

Headline: Saudi Arabia reports 3 cases of SARS-like virus

Saudi Arabia's Health Ministry has confirmed three more cases of a new respiratory virus related to SARS, bringing to 10 the number of cases it reported this week, including five deadly ones. The ministry said Friday the three cases were part of an ongoing investigation. It said the two men and one woman were aged between 33 and 53. Their symptoms first appeared over the past week. The germ is from a family of viruses that cause the common cold, as well as SARS — the severe acute respiratory syndrome that killed some 800 people, mostly in Asia, in a 2003 epidemic. Since September 2012, WHO has been informed of 24 confirmed cases. Sixteen of the patients died. The new virus was first identified last year in the Middle East.

Headline: Rhode Island legalizes same-sex marriage

Rhode Island on Thursday became the nation's 10th state to allow gay and lesbian couples to wed, as a 16-year effort to extend marriage rights in this heavily Roman Catholic state ended with the triumphant cheers of hundreds of gays, lesbians, their families and friends. Gov. Lincoln Chafee signed the bill into law on the Statehouse steps Thursday evening following a final 56-15 vote in the House. The first weddings will take place Aug. 1, when the law takes effect. "I've been waiting 32 years for this day, and I never thought it would come in my lifetime," said Raymond Beausejour, a 66-year-old gay North Providence man who has been with his partner for 32 years. "For the first time in my life, I feel welcome in my own state." After Chafee signed the bill, the hundreds of people who gathered on the Statehouse grounds erupted into cheers as a chorus sang "Chapel of Love." May 2, 2013

Headline: Pentagon Backtracks on Evangelization Comments, Investigation Launched

Alliance Defending Freedom filed a Freedom of Information Act request Wednesday for records related to a Pentagon statement issued Tuesday that indicated members of the military could be subject to court martial for "religious proselytization." The Department of Defense spokesperson who made the comments backtracked in a new statement Thursday that explained, "Service members can share their faith (evangelize), but must not force unwanted, intrusive attempts to convert others of any faith or no faith to one's beliefs (proselytization)." "Members of our military should not be denied the very freedoms they fight to defend. Freedom of religion and speech are paramount among those freedoms," said Legal Counsel Joseph La Rue. "We appreciate the Pentagon's clarification, but little or no evidence exists of coercive proselytization in the military, so we are still troubled over what motivated the original comments."

The secretary-general of Egypt's Islamic Jihad Party said that it's OK to kill Christians because they threw the first punch. "Those who came out with weapons, their blood is allowed for us [to spill]. As a fighter, [it's] not considered dhimmi," said Mohamed Abu Samra, according to the Christian Post.

Dhimmi is an Islamic law that says those of non-Muslim faith who live in Islamic states are supposed to be protected if they pay taxes. But Christians at a recent funeral "brought the [Koran] and urinated on it," Mr. Samra said. "They also came out in demonstrations to destroy Muslim places, chanting 'We'll bring Islam down by any means possible." Mr. Samra railed against Pope Tawadros II, who was named as the head of Egypt's ancient Coptic Christian church in November, calling him more dangerous than his predecessor because he "considers using force as he is trying to establish a Coptic state. He considers the arrival of the Islamists an opportunity to declare civil war. "What Tawadros is doing is a far cry from what the Coptic people want," he said. The pope did not respond in the Post report.

Headline: Guatemala cracks down on anti-mine protests

Guatemala's government declared a state of emergency and banned public gatherings in four townships east of the capital Thursday following several days of violent clashes between police and anti-mining protesters. The confrontations, which began over the weekend, have left one policeman dead, six residents wounded by rubber bullets, and police patrols and other cars burned. Twenty-three police officers were briefly held by protesters before being freed. "The investigation has revealed that a series of criminal acts were committed, from murder to kidnapping to the destruction of government property," said President Otto Perez Molina, explaining why he declared a state of emergency for the townships in the states of Jalapa and Santa Rosa. The government sent in 500 police officers and 2,000 soldiers, some in armored personnel vehicles. It said protesters were armed with guns and explosives. Clashes have involved police, mine security guards and local protesters. May 2, 2013

A third unidentified man died from a gunshot wound, doctors said. The fourth victim of the protest-related violence was a police officer killed by demonstrators, according to authorities. Long-delayed legislative elections have been set for June 30, though opposition to the poll date has prompted a series of demonstrations in Guinea's capital.

Headline: Hundreds in Pakistan pay tribute to Osama bin Laden

Hundreds of Islamists rallied in Pakistan's southwestern city of Quetta Thursday to pay tribute to al-Qaeda chief Osama bin Laden on the second anniversary of his death. Organised by a pro-Taliban faction of Jamiat Ulema-e-Islam (JUI), headed by Maulvi Ismatullah, some 450 participants at the rally chanted: "Long live Islamic jehad and long live Mulla Omar!" an AFP reporter at the scene said. Many of them were also carrying portraits of bin Laden. The JUI's central secretary for information, Maulana Abdul Sattar Chisti, paid tributes to bin Laden. "We are observing death anniversary of an Islamic hero, who was killed by American and Pakistani agents," he said. "Bin Laden's martyrdom gave a new impetus to jehad against forces inimical to Islam," he added.

Headline: Bahrain Shiites protest to demand prisoners be freed

Hundreds of people from Bahrain's Shiite Muslim majority clashed with police on Friday as they demonstrated to demand the release of Shiite prisoners held by the kingdom's Sunni-dominated government, witnesses said. Demonstrators, who included women, shouted "Free the prisoners!" and held up photos of people being held. The protests in Shiite villages near the capital Manama were in response to a call from the radical February 14 Revolution Youth Commission. Shiites, inspired by the Arab Spring in 2011, have been pushing to be given a greater say in the small country's affairs. The kingdom was rocked by a month-long uprising, which was crushed with the help of Gulf troops led by neighbouring Saudi Arabia, but protests continue and frequently turn violent.

Headline: Muslims in Myanmar barricade village as attacks spread Headline: Indonesia radicals urge 'Myanmar jihad'

Three Muslim men peered over a bamboo fence built recently to fortify their village in central Myanmar. They gazed across dry rice paddies towards a nearby Buddhist community, looking for rising dust, a sign of an approaching mob. It was a false alarm. But a day earlier, on Wednesday, about 100 Buddhists armed with sticks had gathered outside the fence, threatening to burn the village and kill them, said the villagers of Win Kite, about a two-hour drive from Myanmar's largest city, Yangon. Police foiled that attack. But Muslims were taking no chances after four days of mob violence led by Buddhist monks in Meikhtila in March killed 44 people, mostly Muslims, and touched off a wave of unrest in central Myanmar that threatens to derail the country's nascent economic and political reforms. "We have a plan to defend ourselves if they come and attack us," said Kin So, adding that many in Win Kite had armed themselves with clubs and swords as a precaution for when troops and police patrolling the area pull out.
