Headline: Israel, once energy-dependent, is new big gas producer

The huge reservoirs of natural gas discovered off the coast of Israel now flowing toward shore have the potential to transform the energy-challenged country into a lean, green manufacturing machine — capable of supplying cheap, clean energy to its people, factories and vehicles for a generation. Long bereft of the petroleum bonanza that created the modern Middle East, Israel suddenly finds itself a major player in the Mediterranean, and perhaps even the European, natural gas market. The deep-water gas fields, discovered in 2009 and 2010, will soon turn Israel into an energy exporter, putting the Jewish state in the enviable but tricky position of trying to sell billions of dollars in surplus

gas to neighbors that range from cool to downright hostile. The questions are: To whom will it sell? And how? Some Israeli leaders have suggested a "gas for peace" strategy whereby Israel provides gas at competitive rates to neighbors that want to buy. But they also acknowledge that some Arab countries might refuse gas — at any price — from Israel. For years, many oil-rich Arab nations have declined to directly supply Israel with oil. "There is an interesting cocktail of possibilities," said Pinhas Avivi, political director of multilateral, global and strategic affairs at the Israeli Foreign Ministry. "The trick is to use the gas to solve problems, not create new problems." The Israeli leadership will soon announce how much future production it will allow companies to export. At the same time, politicians have begun to think about what to do with the billions of dollars that the state will take in royalties and taxes.

Headline: Chinese president urges Israeli, Palestinian leaders to 'build trust'

Headline: Obama and Netanyahu Speak About Security and Peace

Chinese President Xi Jinping on Thursday urged Israeli and Palestinian leaders to "build mutual trust" and resume dialogue, saying China wanted to promote peace in the Middle East. "We hope Israel and Palestine can work together, take feasible measures, gradually build mutual trust, restart the peace talks as soon as possible and make substantial progress," the Chinese Foreign Ministry quoted Xi as telling Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu. "China will keep its objective and just stance, actively promote talks and [...] contribute to maintaining peace and stability in the Middle East," Xi said. Palestinian President Mahmoud Abbas left Beijing on Tuesday after talks on Monday with Xi, who told Abbas China backed Palestinian statehood based on the 1967 boundaries. Netanyahu arrived in Beijing on Wednesday after visiting Shanghai from Monday.

Headline: Israel asks Russia to block Syria arms sale

Israel has asked Russia not to sell Syria an advanced air defense system which would help President Bashar Assad fend off foreign military intervention as he battles a more than two-year-old rebellion, Israeli officials said on Thursday. Israel told Washington that Syria had already begun payments for a 900 million Euro purchase of the S-300, and an initial delivery was due within three months. U.S. Secretary of State John Kerry, meanwhile, said Thursday that the transfer of advanced missile defense systems from Russia to Syria would be a "destabilizing" factor for Israel's security.

Kerry says the U.S. has expressed concerns about what the S-300 batteries in Syria would mean for Israel's security. He wouldn't address what the missiles might mean for Syria's civil war

Headline: Islamic cleric in Gaza, rejects Israel's existence

Headline: Radical Egyptian Cleric Visits Gaza

A prominent Islamic scholar who is making a landmark visit to the Gaza Strip has declared that Israel has no right to exist. Yusuf al-Qaradawi said Thursday that "this land has never once been a Jewish land. Palestine is for the Arab Islamic nation." The Qatar-based cleric was made famous by his popular TV show and is widely respected in the Muslim world. Al-Qaradawi, who arrived in Gaza accompanied by dozens of clerics, was welcomed by Hamas officials including Prime Minister Ismail Haniyeh in a ceremonial reception. During the ceremony he was granted Palestinian citizenship and a diplomatic passport. He is slated to visit the house of former Hamas spiritual leader Ahmed Yassin as part of his two-day visit.

Headline: Israel approves 296 West Bank settler homes

Israel has given the go-ahead to build nearly 300 homes in the settlement of Beit El near Ramallah, a spokesman said, in a move likely to spark tensions as Washington seeks to rekindle peace talks.

"The Civil Administration has given the green light for 296 housing units at Beit El, but this is only the first stage of a process before actual construction can begin," he said, speaking on behalf of a unit within the defence ministry which administers the West Bank. He explained that the construction plans were part of a compensatory measure for settlers who were evicted last year from Ulpana, an unauthorised outpost on the outskirts of Beit El which was evacuated following a High Court ruling. The announcement came just two days after a report said Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu had quietly ordered a freeze on tenders for new settler homes in a bid to give a chance to US-led efforts to revive moribund peace talks with the Palestinians.

Headline: UN Report: Israeli Policies Hindered Development in East Jerusalem

According to the report titled "The Palestinian Economy in East Jerusalem: Enduring Annexation, Isolation and Disintegration," the deterioration in the socioeconomic conditions in East Jerusalem has had a significant impact on its Palestinian residents in their standards of living, housing, health care and education. "The weight of the economy of East Jerusalem has been steadily diminishing relative to that of the rest of occupied Palestinian territories since the signing of the 1993 Declaration of Principles on Interim Self-Government Arrangements, known as the Oslo Accords, and related Israeli-Palestinian agreements," said the report in its executive summary. "This decline, in large part, has been the result of an array of Israeli policies that have hindered development of the East Jerusalem economy as an integral part of the larger Palestinian economy and labor market. The deterioration in socioeconomic conditions has had a significant impact on Palestinian Jerusalemites in their standards of living, housing, health care and education," it said.

Headline: Dozens of Jordanians rally outside Israeli embassy in Amman following Temple Mount riots

Headline: Jordan: Situation in Syria more complicated after Israeli strike

An angry horde of several dozen Jordanian civilians demonstrated outside the Israeli embassy in Amman Wednesday night, following Jordan's public condemnation of Israel's role in the Jerusalem Day riots on the Temple Mount. Demonstrators scaled the fences around the outer wall of the embassy Wednesday night but were prevented by police from nearing the compound, according to reports. The embassy building is guarded by Jordanian security forces most days of the year. The crowd in Amman gathered hours after a tumultuous session of the Jordanian parliament in which legislators voted unanimously to expel Israeli Ambassador Daniel Nevo from Amman and to recall the Jordanian ambassador from Tel Aviv. The parliament was protesting what it said was Israel's responsibility for the violent riots on the Temple Mount on Tuesday. The clashes in Jerusalem had erupted Tuesday after Israel Police allowed some 200 Jews to enter the Temple Mount to pray in honor of Jerusalem Day. Security forces meanwhile prevented several dozen Muslims, whom police said were members of extremist groups, from entering the holy site. Jordanian Prime Minister Abdullah Ensour has condemned Israel's conduct Tuesday, including the attempts to enter the Al-Aqsa Mosque compound, which is under Jordanian patronage, and the supposed arrest of the mufti. Headline: Jordanian House unanimously calls for expelling Israeli envoy

Headline: U.S. Calls for 'Restraint' Over Temple Mount

President Shimon Peres sent a calming message to Jordan on Wednesday, after the Jordanian parliament unanimously demanded the government expel Israeli Ambassador Daniel Nevo over an incident at the Temple Mount. Jordan's official news agency, *Petra*, reported that the country's Interior Minister Hussein Majali, the acting foreign minister, had summoned Nevo over the arrest of the Mufti of Jerusalem. "These Israeli actions violate international law and obstruct peace efforts. As an occupying force, Israel is responsible for preventing such provocations. Jerusalem and Al-Aqsa are a red line," Majali said, according to *Petra*. Majali asked Nevo "to convey this message to his

government in a very clear way," the news agency reported. Meanwhile, at a speech at the state ceremony to mark the unification of Jerusalem and in memory of the soldiers who fell in the battle for the city, President Peres stressed Israel's commitment to the agreements with Jordan.

Headline: Nasrallah's deputy: Israeli strikes disgrace Syrian rebels

Headline: Assad: We'll give everything to Hezbollah

Hezbollah chief Sheikh Hassan Nasrallah said Thursday that Syria would supply his organization with 'game-changing weapons' in response to recent air raids near Damascus, which foreign news sources said were carried out by the Israel Air Force. According to the Daily Star, Nasrallah said Israel sought to achieve two objectives through the strikes: neutralize Syria in terms of the Israeli-Arab conflict, and prevent Hezbollah from building up its arsenal. In response to alleged Israeli strikes, Nasrallah added, Damascus would provide the Lebanese resistance group with sophisticated weapons that it has not received in the past. He also said Hezbollah would support any group seeking to target Israel in the occupied Golan Heights. The Hezbollah leader emphasized that his forces would support any Syrian effort to recapture the Israeli-occupied Golan Heights.

Four Syrian rockets struck Thursday the Bekaa Valley city of Hermel, east Lebanon, security sources told The Daily Star, adding that there were no casualties. Headline: With Increase Of Sunni-Shi'ite Tension In Lebanon, Saudi Arabia Renews Involvement In Country

On March 23, 2013, as the Sunni-Shi'ite struggle in Lebanon reached a peak, Lebanese Prime Minister Najib Mikati announced his resignation and brought down the Hizbullah-dominated government that had been formed in June 2011 under the sponsorship of this organization. Two weeks later, on April 6, 2013, Lebanese President Michel Suleiman assigned the task of forming a new government to Tammam Salam, an MP from the Al-Mustaqbal faction, which heads the March 14 Forces. This new government, yet to be established, is to serve until elections are held this June. The appointment of Tammam Salam had the overwhelming support of 124 out of 128 parliament members, including the MPs from the Hizbullah-headed March 8 Forces (the remaining four MPs abstained). This surprising consensus was achieved largely thanks to the mediation of Saudi Arabia, which has renewed its involvement in Lebanon. Acting with the approval of Iran and perhaps also of Syria, this country took steps to calm the situation in Lebanon while remaining open to all sides, including the March 8 Forces. Its intervention was apparently motivated by a joint Saudi-Iranian desire to prevent Lebanon from sliding into Sunni-Shi'ite war and thus creating a new hotspot of conflict in the region, in addition to Syria. The Saudi intervention sheds light on the struggle between Saudi Arabia and Qatar for influence over Lebanon's Sunni sector and for hegemony in the Arab world at large. It also reflects Saudi Arabia's fear that sectarian tensions in Lebanon might exacerbate Sunni-Shi'ite tensions in the kingdom itself and in other Gulf states, especially Bahrain. This report reviews the moves that preceded the political developments in Lebanon, focusing on Saudi Arabia's return to the Lebanese arena and the reasons that motivated it, as well as Iran's part in these moves.

Egypt

Headline: Egypt's Muslim Brotherhood now in full control with ouster of Mubarak holdovers

The ruling Muslim Brotherhood has completed its takeover of Egypt's government. President Mohammed Morsi ordered a Cabinet reshuffle that replaced holdovers from the former regime of President Hosni Mubarak. On May 7, Prime Minister Hashim Kandil replaced nine of 11 Cabinet ministers not deemed members of the Brotherhood. "The changes will only deepen the political crisis and state of polarization, and block the way to any genuine national dialogue," Hussein Abdul Ghani, a spokesman for the opposition National Salvation Front, said. The reshuffle did not affect most major ministries, including the Defense Ministry and Interior Ministry, both of which were headed by Brotherhood supporters. Two Brotherhood operatives, Yehya Hamed and Amr Deraj, were named investment minister and planning minister, respectively. Hamed was spokesman for Morsi's presidential campaign in 2012. Another Brotherhood supporter to receive a ministry was Hatem Begato, a spokesman for the Presidential Election Commission. In June 2012, the commission declared Morsi the winner in a close race with the candidate of the military. Begato has now been named parliamentary affairs minister. The Brotherhood was also said to have taken over the Finance Ministry, Justice Ministry and Petroleum Ministry. This marked the third reshuffle of the Kandil government since August 2012.

Headline: Syria will 'Respond Immediately' to More Israeli Strikes

Syria will "respond immediately" to any new Israeli attack against its territory, its deputy foreign minister told *AFP* on Thursday, after two reported Israeli strikes on military targets last week.

"The instruction has been made to respond immediately to any new Israeli attack without (additional) instruction from any higher leadership, and our retaliation will be strong and will be painful against Israel," Faisal Muqdad said. He spoke in an interview with *AFP* in the Syrian capital. Senior Israeli sources said the strikes targeted weapons bound for the powerful Lebanese Shiite group Hizbullah, an Iranian proxy that is a close ally of Damascus. Muqdad denied that. "They absolutely did not achieve their objective and they lied when they said they are targeting Hizbullah," he said.

There is "no way Syria will allow this to happen again," he added.

Headline: Syria opposition torn regarding sentiments on Israeli strike

Syrian opposition figures fighting to unseat the regime of President Bashar Assad reacted with a mixture of cautious optimism and anger to the massive Israeli missile strike against Syrian military facilities over the weekend. For many Syrians whose calls for Western military assistance have fallen on deaf ears over the past 26 months, the intervention from an historic Arab foe presents an awkward convergence of interests. The strikes Sunday came from a key ally of the United States, which has been at the forefront of calls for Assad to step down. This poses a conundrum for opposition groups seeking to establish their post-Assad credentials in a country traditionally suspicious of the West's agenda in the region and deeply hostile to Israel. But while some welcomed the move as a brief strategic victory in a bitter stalemate, the strike drew wide condemnation from most Arab leaders and opposition groups.

Headline: Syrian rebels claim UN peacekeepers free to go

The leader of the jihadist rebel force al-Nusra Front was wounded by an army bombing near the Syrian capital on Wednesday, a watchdog said, according to *AFP*. Abu Mohammed al-Jawlani was wounded with other members of his group in southern Damascus province, the Syrian Observatory for Human Rights said. Observatory director Rami Abdel Rahman told *AFP* that Jawlani had been hit in the foot. The head of the al-Nusra Front pledged allegiance to Al-Qaeda chief Ayman al-Zawahiri in April, but distanced his group from claims it had merged with al-Qaeda in Iraq. The announcement followed a message from Zawahiri, urging rebels to fight to establish an Islamic state in Syria, and was received with caution by the mainstream rebel Free Syrian Army. Meanwhile, The four UN peacekeepers kidnapped near the Israeli border are to be released and are awaiting pickup by the

United Nations, a spokesperson for the Syrian rebel group detaining the Filipino soldiers near the Israeli border told The Times of Israel Wednesday. According to the Yarmouk Martyrs Brigade spokesman, the UN negotiated safe passage with Syrian Army forces in the area, and the UNDOF peacekeeping troops were released and were waiting for the Red Cross to collect them.

Headline: Proposed UN resolution backs transition in Syria

Headline: Syria backs US-Russian plan for peace confab

Headline: Israeli- and Hizballah-controlled enclaves take shape inside Syria

An Arab-backed resolution calling for a political transition in Syria and strongly condemning the regime's escalating use of heavy weapons and "gross violations" of human rights was circulated Thursday to the 193-member U.N. General Assembly. The Arab group decided to seek approval of a wide-ranging resolution on Syria in the assembly, where there are no vetoes, to reflect international dismay at the increasing death toll, now more than 70,000, and the failure to end the more than two-year-old conflict. A General Assembly resolution would also counter the paralysis of the deeply divided U.N. Security Council, where Syrian allies Russia and China have vetoed three Western-backed resolutions aimed at pressuring President Bashar Assad to end the violence. Unlike Security Council resolutions, which are legally binding, General Assembly resolutions cannot be enforced. But if they are approved, especially by a large majority, they do reflect world opinion and can carry moral weight.

Headline: Assad's forces defeat rebels at key stronghold near Jordan border

Headline: Syrian warplanes pound rebel positions in north

The Syrian Army has been rolling through Sunni rebel strongholds in the south. On May 8, the Syrian Army advanced deep into the south near the border with Jordan. Army units captured a southern town held by the rebels and located on the main highway to Jordan. "This allows regime forces to gain complete access to the Jordanian border," a Western diplomat said. The regime capture of Khirbat Ghazaleh capped a two-month Army offensive against the Free Syrian Army. The offensive included the siege of Khirbat, located in the Hauran Plain near Dera, as well as nightly shelling. At least 35 fighters were killed in the artillery attacks. Opposition sources said FSA units, which comprised 1,000 fighters, withdrew from Khirbat amid a shortage of weapons. They said Khirbat marked a major rebel stronghold that allowed FSA to maintain positions around Dera, a key target of the Syrian Army.

Headline: 14 Killed, 68 Injured In Attacks In Iraq

Fourteen people were killed and 68 others wounded in shootings and bombings, including suicide bombings against Kurdish security forces, in Iraq on Wednesday, Xinhua news agency reported the police and medics as saying. The deadliest attacks occurred in the morning in and near the city of Kirkuk, some 250 km north of the Iraqi capital of Baghdad, when two suicide bombers and a car bomb detonated and left a total of four killed and 53 wounded. In one of the attacks, a suicide bomber blew up his explosive- laden car at the entrance of the office of the Patriotic Union of Kurdistan, a Kurdish party headed by Iraqi President Jalal Talabani, in central Kirkuk, a local police source told Xinhua on condition of anonymity. The blast killed one of the Kurdish security guards and wounded 40 people -- most of whom were Kurdish security members, known as Peshmerga, the source said, adding that the blast destroyed part of the office building. Meanwhile, a car bomb detonated near a Kurdish security patrol in southwestern Kirkuk, leaving one security member killed and six others wounded, he said. Another suicide car bomber struck a checkpoint at the entrance of a Kurdish security base near the town of Daquq, some 50 km south of Kirkuk, killing two Peshmerga members and wounding seven others and a civilian, the source added.

Headline: Iran, Sudan agree to boost naval cooperation

Iranian Navy Commander Rear Admiral Habibollah Sayyari said Thursday that Iran and Sudan have agreed to boost naval cooperation, official IRNA news agency reported. Headline: **Libya crisis deepens as rebel groups expand demands**

Libya's political crisis deepened on Wednesday as armed groups surrounding two ministries in the capital said they had formed an alliance to present an expanded list of six demands that included the resignation of Prime Minister Ali Zeidan. Zeidan, for his part, promised the government would stick to plans to bar anyone who held a senior position under late dictator Muammar Gaddafi and said some ministers would have to be replaced under legislation passed on Sunday. In fact, the prime minister himself could be unseated as he served as a diplomat under Gaddafi before defecting to the exiled opposition in 1980. The armed groups initially demanded that parliament pass the "political isolation law" banning senior Gaddafi officials from office, and members had hoped the vote would be enough to dislodge the gunmen from their positions at the government ministries. Instead, the groups have settled in and expanded their list of demands, which they presented to Reuters on a printed notice late on Wednesday. The additional demands included Zeidan's resignation, the freezing of a recently released state budget and the right to form a committee to take charge of the Foreign Ministry.

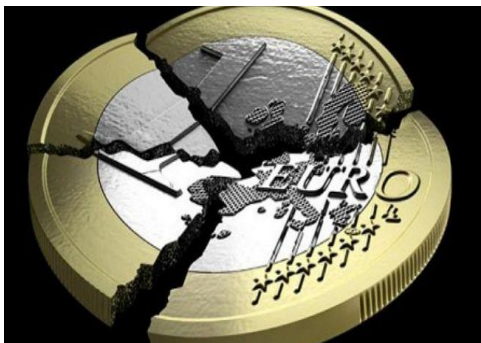

Headline: Portuguese unemployment hits record 17.7%

PORTUGAL'S unemployment rate rose sharply in the first quarter of 2013 to a record high 17.7 per cent from 16.9 per cent in the fourth quarter of last year, data from the national statistics institute INE shows. For the whole of 2013 the government has forecast a rate of 18.2 per cent and 18.5 per cent for next year as the effects of recession and austerity measures take hold. The record high comes as a new government spending package, announced by the centre-right government last week, foresees the slashing of 30,000 public sector jobs out of a total 700,000. Civil servants are also to work 40 hours per week, compared with 35 at present and are to be eligible for full retirement at the age of 66, one year later than now. The new terms are aimed at ensuring continued aid payments from a package worth 78 billion euros (\$101.71 billion) granted by the European Union and International Monetary Fund in May 2011. According to the INE data, 4.4 million people currently hold jobs in Portugal out of a total population of about 10.5 million. In 2012, the economy contracted by 3.2 per cent and is forecast to shrink another 2.3 per cent in 2013.

Headline: Greek jobless rate rises to 27 percent in February

The rate of unemployment in Greece has climbed to 27 percent in February, with youth unemployment the highest among all age groups, data show. The Greek state statistics agency said on Thursday that the number of unemployed people in the debt-stricken country rose to 1.3 million in February. The agency also said the youth aged 15-24 years were hit the hardest with an unemployment rate of 64.2 percent compared to 59.3 percent in January. In February 2012, the unemployment rate had been 21.9 percent, the agency added. The Greek economy is in its sixth year of recession due to tax rises and spending cuts initiated by the European Union (EU) and International Monetary Fund (IMF).

Headline: Slovenia announces anti-bailout measures

Slovenia's government announced Thursday an austerity plan designed to raise 540 million euros (\$707 million) in new taxes as part of an effort to balance the budget and avoid seeking an international bailout. The small Alpine country, once a model of socialist economy, is racing to convince investors it has a credible strategy for raising the funds to stay solvent and avoid becoming the fifth euro country after Cyprus to ask for financial aid. In addition to the hike in the country's sales tax from 20 percent to 22 percent, the government said it will partly privatize 15 state-run companies including the country's second-largest bank, Nova Kreditna Banka Maribor (NKBM); communications operator Telekom Slovenija; airline Adria Airways; Ljubljana airport and Elan ski manufacturer. The austerity plan has to be approved by Slovenia's parliament and will be handed to the European Union's executive arm, the Commission, which is expected to discuss it this month.

Headline: S&P downgrades Egypt credit rating

Ratings agency Standard and Poor's on Thursday downgraded Egypt's long- and short-term credit rating over the government's failure to meet the country's fiscal needs. Egypt's long-term rating was lowered to 'CCC+' from 'B-', while its short-term rating dropped to 'C' from 'B', the agency said in a statement. "The downgrade reflects our view that the Egyptian authorities have yet to put forward -- either to the Egyptian population or the international donor community -- a sustainable medium-term strategy to manage the country's fiscal and external financing needs," it said. "The likelihood of the Egyptian authorities meeting their fiscal targets, easing external pressures, and strengthening the social contract has deteriorated," Standard and Poor's said. Egypt's economy has been battered by political turmoil and unrest since the 2011 uprising that toppled Hosni Mubarak.

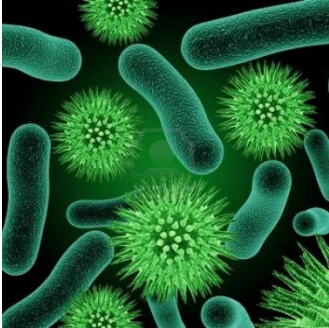
Headline: South Korea's Park urges North Korea to choose new path

South Korean President Park Geun-hye called on North Korea on Wednesday to end a "vicious circle" in which it raises and reduces tensions to win diplomatic rewards and buy time to build up its nuclear arms program. In an address to a joint session of the U.S. Congress, Park said she wanted to

break the pattern in which North Korea "provokes a crisis" that draws sanctions from the international community, which later tries concessions to calm things down. "Meanwhile, Pyongyang uses that time to advance its nuclear capabilities, and uncertainty prevails," she said. "It is time to put an end to this vicious circle," Park said in English to loud applause in a packed U.S. Capitol.

Headline: Another death in China raises H7N9 fatalities to 32

Another patient in China has died from an H7N9 influenza infection, raising the number of fatal illnesses to 32, though no new cases were reported today, holding the overall case total to 131. The World Health Organization (WHO) reported the death today in an update based on information from China's National Health and Family Planning Commission. The report did not contain any details about the patient who died or his or her location, though the WHO said on its Twitter feed that the death was a retrospective one. The WHO's update on H7N9 cases today also acknowledged the infection of a 79-year-old woman from Jianxi province whose case was first announced by Chinese officials yesterday. The WHO said she started having symptoms on May 3. Yesterday Hong Kong's Centre for Health Protection (CHP) said the woman is in stable condition. In addition, the European Centre for Disease Prevention and Control (ECDC) today published the second update of its rapid risk assessment on H7N9 influenza but said the overall risk to Europe from the disease hasn't changed. So far nearly all of the cases are sporadic, it said, with no obvious epidemiologic links.

Headline: US invokes emergency act to keep H7N9 flu at bay

THE US government has declared that H7N9 bird flu "poses a significant potential for a public health emergency", and has given "emergency use authorisation" for diagnostic kits for the virus. This means tests can be used that haven't gone through the usual lengthy approval process by the US Food and Drug Administration. They are right to be concerned. H7N9 could be a tough adversary: *New Scientist* has learned that it provokes a weaker immune response than most flu, making vaccines hard to produce. Although H7N9 is not, so far, transmissible between humans, it does cause severe disease in people, is easier to catch than other bird flu strains, and may need only a few mutations to go pandemic. The UK has already given doctors instructions on when to test people for H7N9, and how to manage any with the virus.

Headline: **Bosnian capital hit by plague of flies**

Headline: **Locust plague ravages Madagascar**

Sarajevo's fire brigade was inundated with calls after a massive swarm of flies struck the Bosnian capital. Some people reportedly fled the city to escape the aerial invasion, according to local media. Bosnian fire brigade officials said that could do little to combat the flies but advised people to shut doors and windows in order to keep the swarming insects at bay. Likened to blizzards and leaving surfaces covered with a thick layer of crawling insects, the swarms have already struck a number of towns across the Balkans. Serbian press said that the insects cleared streets and squares of people in just a few minutes after they descended on the central town of Kraljevo on Monday night. Experts said rare climatic conditions with temperatures rising rapidly after a period of damp weather have created the perfect conditions for fly hatching. "We've had three or four generations hatching at once, and the predators such as birds and bats have not been able to respond by eating them all," said Miodrag Rajkovic, an insect specialist at a Serb veterinary institute. "The best solution is to let nature take its course," he added, but also said that if the flies keep on coming then the local authorities would have to resort to chemical pesticides. He also recommended that towns attacked by the flies should turn off street lighting, which acts as a lure for the insects. Elderly local residents told local press that they have never experienced anything like the swarms in their lifetimes.

Headline: **Cyclonic storms kill seven in India**

Cyclonic storms, lightning, rain and landslides, responsible for killing seven people, wreaked havoc for a fifth day Thursday in India, officials said. The Met Office in Agartala said the storms would continue for the next two days in Tripura state. A large landslide in western Tripura killed at least two people Wednesday night. "Sixty-year-old Ramani Debbarma and her 17-year-old-son Utpal died when huge landslides buried their home at Simna in western Tripura Wednesday night," a government official said. "A team of officials and workers under supervision of Sub-Divisional Magistrate Dhiraj Debbarma were still on the job to clear the huge mudslide and to recover the bodies." Meanwhile, two women in northern Tripura died when the storm uprooted trees and electrical poles, the Indo-Asian News Service reported. Monday night, Parendra Debbarma, 55, died in western Tripura when a wall in his house collapsed, the news service said. "Thousands of trees, telephone and electric poles were uprooted, badly affecting electricity supply, telecommunication services, and movement of vehicles," the official said. Information about the two other deaths was not reported. At least 20 people have been injured since the storm began Sunday, the Indo-Asian News Service reported.

Tens of thousands of students in Chile have staged demonstrations in major cities demanding free education. Authorities said 37,000 students took to streets in the capital, Santiago, on Wednesday to call for an end to for-profit education in the country. The organizers, however, said there were 80,000 protesters in Santiago. The demonstration was largely peaceful, with protesters chanting slogans and waving flags. Reports say clashes erupted between police and protesters in some parts of the capital and police used tear gas and water cannons to disperse the crowd. Gunmen from a shadowy Nigerian cult have killed at least 23 police officers who were attempting to arrest the group's leader. Officials in Nigeria's Nassarawa state say the officers were ambushed as they approached a shrine of the cult, known as Ombatse. Nigerian newspapers report even higher casualties, saying up to 55 police and more than 90 people in all were killed in the gunbattle that erupted Tuesday in the village of Alakyo. Local officials say the cult was forcefully recruiting people in the area. The newspapers report that 11 trucks of security personnel were sent to the village, but only two returned. Nassarawa is located in central Nigeria, in the area where the mostly Muslim north meets the mostly Christian south.

Nearly 20 people have been injured in a powerful bomb explosion in Pakistan's southern port city of Karachi, just days before the country's parliamentary elections. Locals say a number of shops and vehicles near the Sitara Bakery were also damaged as a result of the blast. On May 7, a similar number of people were killed in separate bombing attacks targeting three candidates participating in the elections. Meanwhile, the death toll from attacks ahead of Pakistan's elections has surpassed 100.

Headline: Show of police force after China migrant protest

Hundreds of police lined the streets of a Beijing shopping district on Thursday after a rare protest over a woman's death in the Chinese capital, highlighting tensions between authorities and migrant workers. More than 15 police vans holding dozens of officers were visible outside the Jingwen clothing market in the capital's south, after hours-long demonstrations on Wednesday which locals said saw hundreds take to the streets. Staff at the mall and surrounding shops said the protests were fuelled by police mishandling of the alleged suicide of a 22-year-old migrant worker from the poverty-stricken eastern province of Anhui. Online commentators claimed that she had been gang-raped and thrown from the building to her death, but police say she jumped from the building and their initial investigations ruled out sexual assault and murder. Migrants have flocked to the capital for decades in search of higher incomes, but are denied the same access to health and housing services as Beijing residents and sometimes report discrimination from police.
