Headline: Rajoub: Israel should beware, we are enemies

Jibril Rajoub, a Fatah Central Committee member who recently visited Lebanon, said in an interview with the Hezbollah affiliated television network Al Mayadeen, "We the Palestinians are the enemies of Israel." In the interview, which took place earlier this month, Rajoub emphasized that Fatah now supports popular resistance, but has not abandoned the idea of armed resistance. "As the people of the Fatah movement, we keep resistance on the agenda in all its forms," he said. "At present, we are satisfied by the popular resistance," Rajoub added, but explained, "We the Palestinians are a source of concern for Israel. We are in this country, and this country is ours. They are our enemy and our battle is against them." The interviewer of Al Mayadeen, a network associated with Iran and with the

Assad regime in Syria, criticized the policy of the Palestinian Authority, and in response Rajoub responded, "Our war is against the Israeli occupation. Our main enemy, not just as Palestinians, but Arabs and Muslims, is Israel and the Israeli occupation," he added.

Headline: Fatah, Hamas agree to form unity government within 3 months

Rival Palestinian political factions Fatah and Hamas agreed on Tuesday to form a national unity government within three months, a move that, if seen through, would end a six-year rift between the Islamist and secular parties. Representatives of the two Palestinian groups met in Cairo on Tuesday for the first time in months in a bid to mend fences and form a single government. Hamas and Fatah have been at loggerheads since the violent Hamas takeover of the Gaza Strip in June 2007 following Hamas's surprising success in national elections the year before. Senior Hamas official Moussa Abu Marzouk said following the talks in Egypt that the two groups have agreed to reconcile and form a unity government in the coming months, according to Israel Radio. Fatah official Azzam al-Ahmed said both sides agreed on a timetable that begins with creating laws to govern elections.

Headline: Palestinians mark 65th anniversary of Nakba

Headline: Nakba Day commemorations marked by violence, remembrance

Dozens of Arabs and left-wing Jewish students demonstrated at Tel Aviv University on Monday to mark the Nakba, or "the catastrophe" of Israel's inception in 1948. The students demanded that the "suffering" of the Arabs be recognized. Dozens of right-wing activists from the Im Tirzu movement held a counter rally nearby and chanted "We won't lend a hand to hypocrisy." In light of last year's clashes, police formed a human barrier between the protesters. Jihad Kial, one of the event's organizers, said the Arab student public "has an obligation to mark this day of mourning over the disaster we experienced in 1948. I wish to thank the university for cooperating and allowing us to hold the ceremony. Meanwhile, Palestinians in the West Bank, Gaza Strip, the 1948 areas and the diaspora marked the 65th anniversary of the Nakba by organizing activities in the Palestinian territories and around the world. Palestinians in occupied Jerusalem along with children of Younus village (the E1) planted saplings to remember the residents who were forced to leave their homes.

West Bank cities witnessed major processions to mark the occasion and several streets in Hebron were given new names. A major celebration was organized in Beir Zeit University where black flags signifying the right of refugees' return were installed around the campus. Families of Palestinian prisoners and hundreds of activists held a strike in front on the premises of the UN Headquarters in Ramallah. Representatives of families of prisoners handed the General Commissioner a letter signed by thousands of Palestinians urging the international community to pressure Israel to release prisoners in Israeli jails.

Headline: International Criminal Court opens initial probe into Gaza flotilla raid

The International Criminal Court's prosecutor said on Tuesday she would open a preliminary examination into the events surrounding the 2010 Israel Navy raid on a Turkish-flagged aid flotilla to the Gaza Strip. Nine Turkish citizens died during the raid on the Mavi Marmara vessel, part of a flotilla which set out from Turkey to the Gaza. The International Criminal Court is the permanent war crimes court in The Hague, Netherlands. Prosecutor Fatou Bensouda said in a statement she was obliged to

open a preliminary examination following a referral from the Indian Ocean island nation of Comoros, to which the Mavi Marmara was registered. Few preliminary examinations ever lead to a full investigation, let alone a trial. The tiny African state of Comoros, a member of the court, though Israel is not. The Mavi Marmari was registered in Comoros, an archipelago off the African coast near Madagascar with a population of around 800,000. As required by the court's rules when a member state complains, "My office will be conducting a preliminary examination in order to establish whether the criteria for opening an investigation are met," she said in response to the referral, which was transmitted by a Turkish law firm. Bensouda said she met Tuesday with lawyers from a Turkish law firm that is representing Comoros.

Headline: EU peacekeepers alarmed by redeployment of Lebanese troops toward Syria

Headline: Attacks against Lebanese Alawites deepen fears

The European Union has been mulling a withdrawal from the United Nations peacekeeping force in Lebanon. Western diplomatic sources said several EU states have been negotiating with Lebanon to bolster security for their contingents in the UN Interim Force in Lebanon. The sources said the European contingents have been alarmed by the reduction of Lebanese Army troops in the south. “We are seeing a decreasing presence of the Lebanese Army, which is being redeployed to the east and south to prevent the supply of the Sunni revolt in Syria,” a source said. On May 12, UNIFIL dismissed the prospect of a Western pullout from Lebanon. UNIFIL spokesman Milouch Struger said the contingents were serving in what he termed “calm areas” of southern Lebanon. The sources said a Lebanese Army pullout from the south would leave UNIFIL vulnerable to attacks by the Iranian-sponsored Hizbullah and Al Qaida-aligned militias. They cited bombings of UNIFIL convoys as well as repeated threats against the peace-keeping force.

Headline: Shells from Syria hit outskirts of Al-Qaa

Four shells originating in Syria struck the outskirts of the Lebanese border town Al-Qaa Tuesday, in the Bekaa Valley, marking the first time the area has been subject to attack, security sources told The Daily Star. The sources said the rockets, which fell on the foothills of Mzar al-Sayydeh, were fired in the afternoon and added that there were no reported casualties. Al-Qaa borders the Syrian village of Jousiyeh in Al-Qusayr where regime forces and rebel groups have been engaged in a fierce battle to control the area. Hezbollah has said its fighters were helping the Lebanese of al-Qusayr defend themselves against rebel attacks. This was the first time that shells fell on Mzar al-Sayydeh located some 1,500 meters away from Al-Qaa, a small town with an estimated 10,000 Lebanese Christian population.

Saudi Arabia

Headline: Al-Qaeda In Yemen Calls For Increase In Popular Protests In Saudi Arabia Demanding Release Of Prisoners – As A Prelude To Jihad Against And Overthrow Of Saudi Regime

The Yemen-based Al-Qaeda in the Arabian Peninsula (AQAP) – the umbrella organization of Al-Qaeda members in Yemen and Saudi Arabia – has recently been strongly emphasizing and encouraging the recurring protests in Saudi Arabia demanding the release of male and female jihadis from Saudi prisons. This emphasis follows the organization's realization that such protests are an effective means of stirring up popular opinion in Saudi Arabia. AQAP is also particularly underlining the demand for the release of the wives of mujahideen who were arrested after demonstrating in protest against the incarceration of their husbands and other family members, and also calling on Saudis to launch jihad against the Saudi regime, and to topple it.

Headline: Sign up for Mursi's ouster, urges Egypt 'rebellion' group

First, campaigners petitioned to send Egypt's President Mohammed Mursi into space. It was an unusual stunt which gathered pace, but remained trivial all the same. Now, another group opposing the Islamist presidency appears to be more headstrong about their cause. A petition named “Tamarod” (meaning “rebellion” in Arabic) is gathering signatures to call for Mursi's ouster.

Organizers are pushing the document with the aim of “withdrawing confidence” from the president. So far, organizers have said that the petition, which is calling for early presidential elections, has gathered over two million signatures. “We have gathered over two million signatures to withdraw confidence from the president (since May 1), which shows that people have suffered a lot from the political crises and the economic situation,” Tamarod spokesman Mahmud Badr said in a statement on Tuesday. The petition itself underlines the group’s aims: “Because security has not returned, because the poor have no place, because I have no dignity in my own country... we don’t want you anymore,” the text reads on the slip of paper being presented by “Tamarod” members petitioning across the country. “The campaign was launched because the president is no longer able to manage the country,” the text adds.

Syria

Headline: Syria wants details of U.S.-Russian proposed peace conference before deciding to go

Syria wants details on a U.S.-Russian proposed peace conference before it decides whether to attend and says the role of President Bashar Assad is a decision "only for the Syrian people and the ballot box", a minister said. Syrian Information Minister Omran Zoabi was quoted by state news agency SANA on Tuesday as saying Syria welcomed the proposal but "will not be a party at all to any ... meeting which harms, directly or indirectly, national sovereignty". Assad's departure has been a demand of the opposition since the revolt started two years ago and previous peace efforts have ground to a halt over failure to specify Assad's future role. Zoabi's comments, which are in line with Syria's longstanding policy, will pour more cold water over a conference proposal that is yet to be agreed on by either warring side.

Headline: New Syrian opposition group formed

A group of prominent Syrian activists who favor a civil, democratic state have formed a new opposition group, a member said Tuesday, in a further fragmentation of President Bashar al-Assad’s opponents. The new grouping, called the Union of Syrian Democrats, includes heavyweight activists

such as Michel Kilo, a Christian writer and human rights activist. It appears to be an attempt to counterbalance the influence of the Syrian Muslim Brotherhood inside the National Coalition, the country's main opposition bloc. The 250 "members of the group, who come from different political streams, are united on the principal of democracy," one of its members, Kamal Labwani, told AFP. He declined to say directly that the group intended to challenge the Brotherhood's influence, but said it would focus on creating a civil state. "If the Muslim Brotherhood are opposed to the construction of a civil state, this group is directed against them. If they support this project, they are our allies," he said. "Our problem with the Muslim Brotherhood is that they say one thing and do another... they say they want a civil state, but in practice, they don't."

Headline: U.S. objects to Iran chairing U.N. disarmament conference

Iran will preside over the United Nations arms control forum this month, despite the fact that it is under U.N. sanctions for illicit nuclear activities and routinely supplies arms to the terrorist organization Hezbollah in violation of international law. The U.N.'s annual Conference on Disarmament, which Iran is slated to lead from May 27 to June 23, is the organization's primary multilateral forum for negotiating arms control agreements. The forum has given way to major international treaties on nuclear non-proliferation, prohibitions on chemical weapons, and bans on nuclear tests. UN Watch, a Geneva-based watchdog group, blasted the decision to allow Iran to chair the conference.

Headline: First Kurdish rebels reach Iraq under Turkish peace plan

Headline: Gunmen open fire on liquor stores in Iraq, 11 dead

Weary and caked in mud, the first group of Kurdish militants to leave Turkey under a peace plan to end three decades of war descended a mountain into Iraq on Tuesday to be met with embraces from PKK comrades. Kurdistan Workers Party (PKK) fighters began leaving their positions in southeast Turkey last week following a March ceasefire declared by jailed leader Abdullah Ocalan to end a conflict that has killed 40,000 people, ravaged the region's economy and tarnished Turkey's human rights record. The 15 men and women dressed in baggy green fatigues walked single file into a valley at Heror near Metina mountain. They carried Kalashnikov rifles and rucksacks with rolled-up sleeping mats on their backs. "For seven days we were on the road and the conditions were very tough. There was snow, it didn't stop raining and the road was muddy," said one of the newly arrived guerrillas called Sorkhwein, a hand grenade visible inside her jacket. The PKK is deemed a terrorist group by the United States and European Union as well as Turkey.

Headline: Erdogan rejects joint investigation with Syria into Turkey bombing

Headline: 13 detained in Turkish bombings, death toll to 51

Turkey's Prime Minister Recep Tayyip Erdogan will push U.S. President Barack Obama for more assertive action on Syria during a visit to Washington this week, days after car bombs tore through a Turkish border town in the deadliest spillover of violence yet. The bombings in Reyhanli, which killed at least 50 people on Saturday, and activists' reports of a massacre of Sunni Muslims in a Syrian coastal town have incensed Tayyip Erdogan, already critical of the slow international response to the conflict. The risk of Syria's chaos spreading will top the agenda in Erdogan's talks with Obama on Thursday, but the wide-ranging meeting with one of Washington's Middle Eastern allies is also expected to cover Turkey's nascent reconciliation with Israel and its deepening energy ties with Iraqi Kurdistan.

Headline: Putin Warns against Moves that Could 'Shake' Syria

Russian President Vladimir Putin on Tuesday warned against any moves that would further destabilize the situation in Syria, speaking after talks with visiting Israeli Prime Minister Binyamin Netanyahu. "In this crucial period it is especially important to avoid any moves that can shake the situation," Putin was quoted as saying by news agencies, days after Israeli forces launched air strikes against regime targets in Syria. Netanyahu had been expected to warn Putin against delivering advanced S-300 missiles to Syria which would severely complicate any future air attacks against the

regime of Syrian President Bashar al-Assad. Netanyahu in his public comments did not indicate whether he succeeded in convincing Putin to halt arms supplies to Syria or whether the two leaders reached any firm agreements. Speaking to reporters, Netanyahu stressed that his country's task was to "defend its citizens." "Together we are trying to find ways to strengthen stability and security, we have a remarkable opportunity to directly speak with each other," the Israeli premier was quoted as saying by Russian news agencies. Russia has refused to halt arms supplies to the Damascus regime, saying it has to honor contracts it concluded before the war.

Headline: Powerful bomb blast kills four US-led soldiers in south Afghanistan

Headline: Bomb attacks kill at least 6 in Helmand

Headline: Taliban threats close 40 schools in south Afghanistan: Officials

A powerful bomb explosion has killed at least four US-led soldiers and injured several others in the troubled southern Afghanistan, NATO sources say. The fatalities come after an improvised explosive device (IED) ripped through the soldiers' vehicle in Kandahar province - one of the most dangerous regions for foreign forces in the war-ravaged country. The Western military alliance has not yet released further details regarding the soldiers' nationality or the exact location of the incident. The latest deaths bring the number of US-led soldiers killed in Afghanistan this year to at least 63. The number of casualties among foreign troops peaks at this time of year, known as the Taliban spring offensive, as the militants step up their attacks on US-led forces during this period.

Headline: U.S. moves 'assets and personnel' near Libya in case they are 'called upon'

The United States has reported the preparation of troops to intervene in Libya. The Defense Department said the U.S. military has sent troops near the coast of the North African state over the last seven months. The Pentagon said the troops were on alert for any attack on U.S. diplomatic facilities or staffers in Libya. "We are prepared to respond if necessary, if conditions deteriorate or if we were called upon," Pentagon spokesman George Little said. "Obviously, we have moved assets and personnel." In a briefing on May 13, Little said U.S. troops were equipped with aircraft that could rapidly reach Libya from bases in the Mediterranean. He said a force of 500 Marines could fly to Libya on the new V-22 Osprey air transport.

Headline: Morocco street vendor dies after setting himself on fire

A Moroccan street vendor in the southern city of Marrakesh died in hospital after setting himself on fire in protest at having his goods confiscated by the authorities, various sources said on Tuesday. Mbarek el-Karassi, 32, died on Monday evening from severe burns to the face, hands and stomach, said Mohammed Ghalloussi, a local representative of the Moroccan Association for Human Rights. He had been held in intensive care at the Ibn Tofail hospital after dousing himself in petrol and igniting the fuel on Saturday in the poor Marrakesh neighborhood of Essaada. Karassi's brother-in-law, Abdelali Idrissi, said the young man had started by selling fruit and vegetables in the street, and then began selling old furniture, until a local official confiscated his goods. "He begged the authorities to give him back what they had taken but they refused, so he felt deeply aggrieved and set himself on fire," Idrissi told AFP.

Headline: S.Korea leader wants talks with North on industrial park

South Korean President Park Geun-Hye said on Tuesday she wants talks with North Korea on removing raw materials and finished products from a joint industrial complex closed by military tensions. In a cabinet meeting, Park instructed the Unification Ministry to offer Pyongyang discussions on the Kaesong complex, which lies 10 kilometres (six miles) inside the North Korean side of the joint border. Established in 2004 as a rare symbol of inter-Korean cooperation, Kaesong was the most high-profile casualty of two months of elevated tensions that followed the North's nuclear test in February. Pyongyang barred South Korean access to the zone and pulled out all its 53,000 workers early last month. Seoul withdrew the last of its nationals 10 days ago.

Headline: N. Korea takes issues with naval exercise

North Korea's official media, blaming the U.S.-South Korean naval exercise, said Tuesday tensions on the Korean Peninsula have not eased as assumed. The Rodong Sinmun, the Worker's Party of Korea newspaper regarded as reflecting the state policy, said in an article monitored in South Korea that the naval exercise in the East Sea are making conditions on the peninsula precarious, Yonhap News reported. North Korea under its unpredictable new leader Kim Jong Un had waged a relentless campaign of threats and issuing provocative statements against South Korea and the United States after the United Nations Security Council tightened sanctions over the North's Feb. 12 nuclear test. The threats even included preemptive nuclear strikes. However, those threats have eased lately after

warnings that any provocative act would invite a firm response. "The state of tension on the Korean Peninsula have not lessened in the slightest," the North Korean newspaper said.

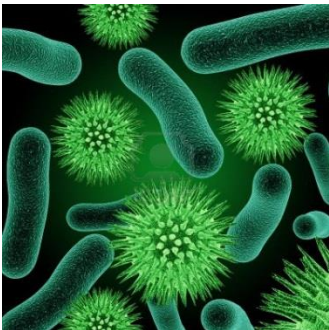
Headline: Japanese Envoy Makes Unannounced Visit to N. Korea

Japanese prime minister says foreign submarines could face a military response if they enter his country's territorial waters while underwater, as Japan and China's dispute over a group of islands in the East China Sea continues. Shinzo Abe issued the warning on Tuesday after the Japanese Defense Ministry said an underwater vessel was detected in the contiguous waters - a 12 nautical mile strip outside territorial waters - close to one of Japan's Okinawa islands, from late Sunday to early Monday. "These are serious acts. If (submarines) enter our territorial waters while underwater, we would have to implement maritime security action," Abe told Japan's parliament on Tuesday. Based on international laws, vessels are allowed to pass freely through the outer ring of waters, providing their intention is peaceable.

Headline: Saudi Arabia confirms four new cases of deadly SARS-like virus

Saudi Arabia has confirmed four new cases of the SARS-like novel coronavirus in its Eastern Province, state media reported late on Monday, citing the health ministry. The health ministry said one of the four new cases had been treated and the patient had been released from hospital, while the three other new cases were still being treated, the Saudi Press Agency reported. On Sunday, Saudi Arabia said it had had a total of 24 confirmed cases since the disease was identified last year, of whom 15 had died. In its latest outbreak in its Eastern Province, it said it had had 15 confirmed cases, of whom nine had died. World Health Organisation officials visiting Saudi Arabia to consult with the authorities on the outbreak said on Sunday it seemed likely the new virus could be passed between humans, but only after prolonged, close contact.

Headline: Three more deaths from bird flu in China as toll reaches 35

THREE more people have died in China from the new strain of H7N9 bird flu virus, raising the death toll to 35 while the total number of infections rose to 130, state media said today. Without giving details of the deaths, Xinhua news agency said a new case of the H7N9, described by the World Health Organisation as one of the most lethal flu viruses around, was found in China's east Jiangxi province. There has so far been no evidence of human-to-human transmission of the virus, a point reiterated by Xinhua on Monday, citing health authorities. It noted that 57 of those infected have recovered. Chinese scientists say the virus has been transmitted to humans from chickens, though the World Health Organisation says 40 percent of people infected with H7N9 had no contact with poultry. Since it was first detected in March, the H7N9 virus has raised alarm and pummelled Chinese demand for poultry as well as prices for livestock.

Headline: Oklahoma School District Removes Ten Commandments

Residents of a small Oklahoma town are heartbroken after the school district, under threat of a lawsuit, decided to remove Ten Commandments plaques that had been placed in nearly every classroom. “We are pleased the school administration has removed the Ten Commandments, in compliance with the Constitution,” said Freedom From Religion Foundation co-president Annie Laurie Gaylor in a statement. “We hope the Board will ‘Honor thy constitution,’ and heed the advice of its attorney rather than to acquiesce to pressure from a religious mob.” Ron Flanagan, the superintendent of Muldrow Public Schools, told Fox News they had no choice but to comply with the demands of the Freedom From Religion Foundation. “It is kind of sad in a way,” Flanagan said. “It’s been a part of our school system for a long time. It was a tough thing to deal with.”

Hundreds of Christians across the community had drawn a line in the sand and vowed to fight back against the national association of atheists and agnostics. Students rallied the faithful through social networking websites. Churches distributed Ten Commandments t-shirts. Other residents launched a petition drive. But on Monday night a standing-room only crowd heard the disappointing news – the Ten Commandments plaques had to be removed. “We took them down,” Flanagan said. “We understood some did not agree with that decision. As a school district we have an obligation to demonstrate respect and adherence to the law.” Flanagan said they consulted with the school district’s attorney and they were advised that it was a lawsuit they could not win.

Headline: 7.0 magnitude earthquake rattles north Mariana Islands

A deep 7.0-magnitude earthquake struck near the Northern Mariana Islands in the western Pacific on Tuesday, the US Geological Survey said, but no tsunami warning was issued. The quake hit 42 kilometres (26 miles) west of Agrihan and 395 kilometres north of the main island Saipan, but it was at a depth of 603 kilometres and seismologists said it was too deep to cause any impact. "Obviously people may get a small shake but there's hardly any population around there," Geoscience Australia seismologist David Jepson told AFP. "There's definitely no tsunami and it was too deep and too far away from anywhere to have caused any damage." A self-governing commonwealth of the United States since 1976, the Northern Marianas consists of 15 islands, with more than 90 percent of the population of 54,000 living on Saipan. Only four other islands are populated.

Headline: Cyclone kills 7 in Sri Lanka; thousands displaced

A cyclone caused by a tropical depression in the Bay of Bengal killed at least seven people in Sri Lanka, government officials said on Tuesday. Cyclone Mahasen, which brought heavy rains and landslides to Sri Lanka, was expected to hit Bangladesh and Myanmar later this week.

"Seven people have died and 10 people have got injured. There are 7,399 people from 1,947 families affected," Lal Sarath Kumara, the spokesman at Sri Lanka's Disaster Management Center, told Reuters. The Center said 3,881 people had been displaced due to the cyclone. Three people were missing due to heavy rains and landslides. Officials at Sri Lanka's Department of Meteorology have said the centre of Cyclone Mahasen is located 900 km off the island nation's eastern coastal town of Pottuvil.

Headline: State of emergency declared in Nigeria

Admitting Islamic extremists now control some of his nation's villages and towns, Nigeria's president declared a state of emergency Tuesday across the nation's troubled northeast, promising to send more troops to fight what he said is now an open rebellion. President Goodluck Jonathan, speaking live across state radio and television networks, also warned that any building suspected to house Islamic extremists would be taken over in what he described as the "war" now facing Africa's most populous nation. However, it remains unclear what the emergency powers will do to halt the violence, as a similar effort failed to stop the bloodshed. "It would appear that there is a systematic effort by insurgents and terrorists to destabilize the Nigerian state and test our collective resolve," Jonathan said.

Headline: Kenyan police fire teargas at protest over MPs' pay

Kenyan police fired teargas and water cannon outside parliament on Tuesday to disperse about 200 people demonstrating against lawmakers' demands for a salary 130 times the legal minimum wage. Civil rights groups organized the protest to express widespread anger that politicians are demanding a pay rise so soon after a broadly peaceful election on March 4. Protesters fed pigs' blood to live pigs at the gates of parliament in the capital Nairobi to symbolize a political class widely regarded as greedy and corrupt. Uhuru Kenyatta, Kenya's new president and its richest man, said last week that holding down the state wage bill was key to directing public funds into economic development.

Headline: Greek workers walk out to protest ban on teachers' strike

Greek public sector workers walked off the job on Tuesday to protest against a government decision to ban a strike by high-school teachers, shutting down several schools and reducing staff at hospitals to a minimum. But turnout at a planned rally and march to parliament was poor, hit by rain and a growing sense of resignation among Greeks inured to frequent strikes against austerity measures. Invoking emergency legislation, Prime Minister Antonis Samaras has threatened teachers with arrest and dismissal if they go ahead with a planned walkout on Friday that would disrupt university entrance exams, as he tries to show Greece's foreign lenders that Athens is sticking to unpopular reforms. The action on Tuesday was the latest in a string of anti-austerity strikes since 2010, when Greece adopted severe budget and wage cut measures as part of its international bailout.
