Headline: Mahmoud Abbas can't meet Israel's basic requirement for peace

Chairman Mahmoud Abbas of the Palestinian Authority said, Tuesday, that he is ready to meet with Prime Minister Binyamin Netanyahu, according to *Channel 10 Television*. Abbas, whose name in terror circles is Abu-Mazen, said "If Netanyahu agrees to accept the principle of two states with pre-1967 borders, I don't have a problem with meeting him anywhere." Abbas made the remarks ahead of a Tuesday departure from China, where Netanyahu is currently visiting. There was no expectation of a meeting between them before Netanyahu left Israel.

Headline: Netanyahu reportedly freezes new settlement construction

Headline: Netanyahu Orders Judea, Samaria Construction Freeze

Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu has frozen tenders for construction in West Bank settlements, amid a renewed Western push to resume peace talks between Israel and the Palestinians, Army Radio reported Tuesday. Housing and Construction Minister Uri Ariel of the pro-settler Jewish Home party was given the instruction to delay new West Bank construction projects, likely due to American pressure, in a move that would require special approval for any project, the report said. Ariel refused to comment on the report in an interview Tuesday morning, confirming only that he was set to meet with Netanyahu upon the prime minister's return from China. Asked by Army Radio about rumors that his Jewish Home party would withdraw support for the budget if a settlement freeze is implemented, Ariel said that he would stick by previous statements he had made on the issue, implying that his party would indeed undermine efforts to pass the budget.

Headline: Palestinian militants in Syria: Assad grants green light to attack Israel

A spokesman for a Palestinian militant group in Syria said Tuesday that it had received a nod from President Bashar Assad's regime to attack Israel following alleged back-to-back Israeli airstrikes over the weekend. Anwar Raja of the Damascus-based Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine-General Command said the regime has given "a green light" for the group "to attack Israeli targets" from the Syrian-controlled part of the Golan Heights. Raja did not elaborate on how the alleged approval was conveyed to PFLP-GC fighters but he stressed that there was no official government note. Most Palestinians in Syria remained on the sidelines of the 2-year-old conflict, but PFLP-GC has fought alongside government troops against the rebels trying to topple Assad. Iranian Foreign Minister Ali Akbar Salehi, also weighed into the matter, saying Tuesday during a visit to the Jordanian capital Amman that it was Syria's Arab neighbors - not Tehran - who should respond to the alleged air strikes near Damascus

Headline: Third Syrian Shell in 24 Hours Hits Golan

A mortar shell fired from Syria exploded in the Israeli Golan Heights on Tuesday, hitting an open field without causing any casualties or damage, an IDF spokeswoman said. It was the third incident of fire from the civil war in neighboring Syria straying across the ceasefire line in 24 hours and came as tensions soared after Israel carried out weekend air strikes near Damascus. On Monday, two rockets fired from Syrian territory also exploded in open fields on the Israeli side. The Golan has been tense since the beginning of the conflict in Syria more than two years ago.

Headline: UN 'Lodges Firm Protests With IDF' Over Air Strikes

The United Nations has called on Israel to halt military air patrols over Lebanon amid heightened tensions after air raids on targets in Syria, a UN spokesman said Tuesday. UN spokesman Martin Nesirky said that the UN Interim Force in Lebanon, UNIFIL, had protested after recording an increase in Israeli flights over Lebanon. UNIFIL "says that in the course of the past week it has observed a higher number of Israeli air violations over Lebanese airspace," Nesirky told a briefing, the *AFP* news agency reported. He added that the flights are a "violation of Lebanese sovereignty and of Security Council resolution 1701" which allowed for a ceasefire that ended Israel's military movement into southern Lebanon in 2006. The resolution, it should be recalled, also mandated disarmament of Hizbullah, which has increased its missile stockpile from 6000 to 60,000 since signing the resolution "We are aware of the concerns raised by the Lebanese government in this regard. The UN interim force has lodged firm protests with the Israeli Defense Force on this matter asking them to cease the overflights," Nesirky said, according to *AFP*.

Headline: U.S. democrat offers bill to arm Syrian opposition

A top U.S. Senate Democrat introduced a bill Monday that authorizes arming rebels in Syria, a step Washington has been weighing after President Barack Obama said the Damascus regime may have used chemical weapons. Senator Robert Menendez, chairman of the Senate Foreign Relations Committee, introduced the Syria Stabilization Act of 2013 that would give "increased authorization to provide lethal and non-lethal assistance to Syrian armed opposition." The bill is seen as intensifying pressure on Obama to take action in Syria after U.S. and other intelligence assessments that the regime has used chemical weapons, something Obama has warned would be a "game changer." "The Assad regime has crossed a red line that forces us to consider all options," Menendez said in a statement. "The greatest humanitarian crisis in the world is unfolding in and around Syria, and the U.S. must play a role in tipping the scales toward opposition groups and working to build a free Syria."

Headline: In first comments since alleged strikes, Assad says Syria is capable of facing Israel

In his first comments since the alleged Israeli air raids struck Syria last week, Syrian President Bashar Assad said Tuesday that Syria's army is capable of facing Israel, branding the attacks as acts of terrorism, according to a report in the Lebanon's Daily Star. "The Syrian people and its army who have made important achievements by fighting terrorist and Takfiri groups are capable of confronting Israel's ventures that represent one of the many faces of terrorism targeting Syria today," Assad was quoted as saying during a meeting with Iranian Foreign Minister Ali Akbar Salehi. The remarks were carried by Syrian TV, the Daily Star said. Assad further claimed that the strikes reveal how involved Israel is in the civil war tearing his country apart, according to the report. "The Israeli aggression on Syria reveals the extent of Israel and other regional and Western states' involvement in ongoing events in Syria," he said.

Headline: Syria rebels detain four peacekeepers in Golan Heights

Armed men detained four United Nations peacekeepers on patrol on the Golan Heights in a tense area that separates Syria and Israel, the UN said Tuesday. A rebel group claimed it was holding the peacekeepers. It was the second time in two months that unarmed UN military observers have been taken captive, and illustrated again the vulnerability of the UN peacekeeping mission amid the spillover from the war in Syria. Kieran Dwyer, spokesman for the UN peacekeeping department, said the four peacekeepers, all from the Philippines, were taken by an unidentified armed group near Jamla on Tuesday. "Efforts are underway to secure their release now," he said. A spokesman for the rebel group holding the four peacekeepers said in a phone interview with The Associated Press that at least three of the UN staffers are from the Philippines. He said the rebel unit holding them is called the Yarmouk Martyrs Brigades and the group is operating in the Golan Heights.

Headline: Iran presidency candidates to step forward

Few Iranian presidential elections have been so unpredictable but the next few days will at least narrow down who will stand in the ballot on June 14, for which candidate registration starts on Tuesday and ends on Saturday. What is certain is that Ayatollah Ali Khamenei, who has held ultimate power as Supreme Leader for 24 years, wants to avoid both the mass protests by reformists that greeted the disputed re-election of Mahmoud Ahmadinejad in 2009, and also more of the public feuding between the outgoing president's allies and fellow hardliners which has marked Ahmadinejad's second term. "The Iranian leadership is so nervous, even if it doesn't need to be. The 2009 election was an enormous loss of face for the establishment and they're very concerned about a repetition," said a Western diplomat based in Tehran. "Instead of trusting the people, they have put their trust in all sorts of security measures. Some hopefuls have already declared they will register to run in the first round in six weeks. But many with the strongest chances have been hanging back, weighing their prospects until the last minute, with an eye not only to public opinion but to the Guardian Council of clerics and jurists which can reject any candidacy until a final roster is published around May 23.

Headline: Iran FM meets Assad, says time to dissuade Israel

Headline: Iran warns against 'provocation' in Gulf anti-mine drill

Iran's Foreign Minister Ali Akbar Salehi held talks with Syrian President Bashar al-Assad on Tuesday and said it was time to dissuade Israel from carrying out attacks such as its air strikes on Syria over the past week. "The time has come to dissuade the Israeli occupier from carrying out such aggression against the peoples of the region," he said, quoted by Syrian television after his arrival in Damascus on a previously unannounced visit. "Iran stands at the side of Syria in the face of Israeli aggression, whose aim is to damage the security of the region and weaken the axis of resistance," said Salehi, whose country is a close ally of Damascus.

Headline: Turkey launches 10-day military exercise

Turkish Prime Minister Recep Tayyip Erdogan on Tuesday said the Israeli air raids on Syria were "unacceptable." "No excuse can justify this operation," Erdogan told ruling party lawmakers in parliament after Israel's weekend strikes on Syrian weapons sites, intended to prevent "game changing" weaponry from reaching Hizbullah. Erdogan said the Israeli attacks were a "golden opportunity" for his one-time ally President Bashar al-Assad to cover up massacres of opponents. "Assad is trying to cover up what happened at Baniyas by using the Israeli raids as a pretext," said the Turkish premier, referring to a crackdown by Assad's troops and militiamen in the Mediterranean city.

Headline: Kerry in Moscow to bridge gap with Russia on Syria

US Secretary of State John Kerry has held talks with Russian President Vladimir Putin in Moscow to try to bridge the divide between the two sides over the Syria conflict. Before the talks, Mr Kerry said Russia and the US shared common interests in promoting stability in the region. Moscow, which supports Syrian leader Bashar al-Assad, is refusing to back US pressure to force him to step down. The US recently said it did not rule out arming the Syrian opposition. "Arming the rebels - that's an option," said US Defence Secretary Chuck Hagel last week. Mr Kerry's visit comes days after Israel launched air strikes in southern Syria. Russia condemned the attacks - which Israeli sources said targeted missiles destined for Hezbollah in Lebanon - as a threat to regional stability. President Putin had spoken to Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu, the Kremlin said.

Headline: Protesters in Moscow demand reforms

Thousands of protesters have gathered in the Russian capital Moscow to demand reforms as well as the release of political prisoners arrested last year, Press TV reports. The protests on Monday were organized by the Russian Opposition Coordination Council. Protesters demanded the resignation of Russian President Vladimir Putin and called for fair elections. Organizers say some 30,000 protesters reportedly took part in the demonstration. On May 6, 2012, mass protests were held on the eve of Putin's controversial inauguration in Russia. The demonstrations were held at Bolotnaya Square and led to the violent arrest and prosecution of many. "Last year, the government turned the police against us. Many people suffered and were arrested and some were jailed... We should all unite against the oppressor," said Left Front Activist Irina Kalmykova. "People are waking up and joining us. We demand the release of innocent people in prison. We didn't think so many people would turn up to support the prisoners of the 6th of May," former Russian Prime Minister Mikhail Kasyanov said.

Headline: Afghans hold new anti-Pakistan rallies

Thousands of Afghans have held fresh anti-Pakistan rallies to protest against the recent border clashes between the two countries and Islamabad's support of militants in Afghanistan, Press TV reports. Chanting slogans against Pakistan in the Afghan capital, Kabul on Tuesday, the protesters blamed Islamabad for what they said supporting terrorists carrying out bombings in Afghanistan. In the provinces of Nangarhar and Kandahar, Afghans took to streets on the same day to protest against Islamabad's alleged meddling in domestic affairs of the country and the border dispute. On Monday, both countries' border guards clashed in a disputed border area near Nangarhar Province for the second time in a week. In reaction to the clashes, Afghan lawmakers called for an end to diplomatic ties with Islamabad.

Headline: **US Facing Worst Youth Employment Rates in Developed World**

The United States has gone from having the highest share of 25- to-34-year-olds in employment among large wealthy economies, to the lowest. The number of young Americans out of work has jumped over the last 12 years, Labor Department figures show. "This is still a very big puzzle," Lawrence Katz, a Harvard professor and former chief economist at the Labor Department **told The New York Times** Monday. He called the acute downturn in youth employment "the million-dollar question" for the economy. According to the data, 25-to-34-year-olds are the only age group with lower average wages in early 2013 than in 2000, **the Times reported**. The situation is worse even than in Europe, despite that continent's economic woes. In 2011 the United States had a youth unemployment rate of 26.2 percent compared to 20.5 percent in Germany, 21.6 percent in Britain and 22 percent in France. The nation also trails Canada, Japan, Australia, Russia and Sweden.

Headline: North Korea threatens 'sea of flames' retaliatory strike on South

Headline: S.Korea, US leaders seek next step on North

The North Korean army threatened late Monday of an immediate retaliatory strike if “a single shell” falls on its side of the disputed maritime border during scheduled South Korean-U.S. military drills. A statement from the southwestern command of the Korean People’s Army said that any subsequent counterstrike would trigger an escalated military reaction that would see South Korea's border islands engulfed in a "sea of flames." South Korean live-artillery exercises near the Yellow Sea border were an attempt to tip prevailing military tensions into an "actual war," said the statement carried by the official Korean Central News Agency. North Korea moved two missiles primed for imminent test firing from a launch site, American officials said Monday, as North Asia tensions eased slightly on the eve of a U.S.-South Korea summit. U.S. and South Korean officials had been worried Pyongyang would heighten a cycle of provocation, which has included threats of nuclear war, by firing the Musudan missiles, which have a range of up to 5,630 kilometers.

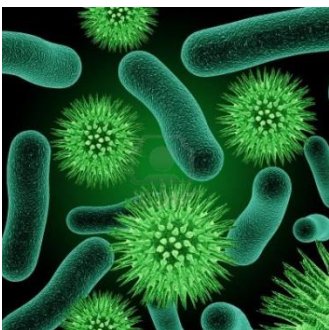
Headline: North Korea missiles moved away from launch site - U.S. officials

North Korea on Tuesday threatened the United States and South Korea over joint naval drills taking place this week in tense Yellow Sea waters ahead of a Washington summit by the allies' leaders. The warning, however, was softer than North Korea's recent highly bellicose rhetoric, and followed the North's removal of two missiles from a launch site where they had been readied for possible test firing, U.S. officials said. In the highly conditional threat, the section of the Korean People's Army responsible for operations in North Korea's southwest said it would hit back if any shells fall in its territory during the drills, which began Monday and are to end Friday. Should the allies respond to that, it said the North Korean military will strike five South Korean islands along the aquatic frontline between the countries.

Headline: H7N9 toll grows to 130 cases, 31 deaths

Health officials in China reported two new H7N9 infections, both from Fujian province, and four more deaths, boosting the outbreak's total to 130 cases, 31 of them (24%) fatal. One of the patients is a 9-year-old boy whose infection was detected during routine flu surveillance, according to official and media reports today. He has been discharged from the hospital, according to a statement Hong Kong's Centre for Health Protection (CHP). The other patient is a 69-year-old man who is hospitalized, according to a separate statement yesterday from the CHP. So far none of the man's nine close contacts have shown any symptoms. China's National Health and Family Commission today put the number of deaths at 31, an increase of four since the group's last update, Xinhua, China's state news agency, reported today. The report did not include any other details about the deaths. The report also said 42 patients have recovered from their H7N9 infections. In other developments, China's agriculture ministry yesterday announced five more poultry and market environmental samples that tested positive for H7N9, according to a report from the World Organization for Animal Health (OIE). They included three environment samples from a live-bird market in Shandong province, one chicken sample from a live-bird wholesale market in Guangdong province, and one chicken sample from a market in Jiangxi province. Guangdong is the only province to report a positive bird or market sample in the absence of confirmed human H7N9 cases. It is also the southernmost area of China to report positive H7N9 findings. The OIE report said 89,964 birds were destroyed at the Guangdong wholesale market, which is located in Dongguan.

Headline: Delaware to vote on becoming 11th state to allow gay marriage

Delaware lawmakers will take up a gay marriage bill on Tuesday in a bid to make the state the 11th to allow same-sex couples to wed. The scheduled vote in the state's Democrat-controlled Senate follows the General Assembly's passage of the bill several weeks ago. Governor Jack Markell, an outspoken supporter of gay marriage, has vowed to sign the bill into law if it clears the Senate. The vote follows a string of victories for advocates of same sex marriage. Last Friday, lawmakers in Rhode Island gave final approval to a marriage bill, which Gov. Lincoln Chafee quickly signed into law. Last November, voters in Maine, Maryland and Washington state approved ballot measures legalizing gay marriage, marking the first time voters in any state extended marriage rights to same-sex couples in a popular referendum. Meanwhile, the U.S. Supreme Court is considering a legal challenge to the Defense of Marriage Act, which bars federal recognition for same-sex couples.

Headline: Two earthquakes rattle Southeast Idaho just minutes apart

Two medium strength earthquakes rattled areas of Southeast Idaho Sunday evening just minutes apart. A 4.2 magnitude earthquake at approximately 9:13 was followed by a slightly weaker 3.6 magnitude quake at approximately 9:20. According to the U.S. Geological Survey at the University of Utah, the epicenter of the first quake was four miles East, South East of Lava Hot Springs at a depth of seven miles. The epicenter of the second quake was determined to be approximately three miles East of Lava Hot Springs. The depth of the second earthquake was set at three miles below the surface.

Headline: Magnitude 5.8 Violently Shakes Fiji Islands Region

A 5.8 magnitude earthquake violently struck the Fiji Islands within the last hour. The U.S. Geological Survey reports that 5.8 shake was 239km NNE of Ceva-i-Ra, Fiji and hit at approximately 10:10:55 UTC. According to the U.S.-based Pacific Tsunami Warning Center, a destructive tsunami was not generated, based on earthquake and historical tsunami data. This is the first quake to hit the Fiji Islands since a 5.5 tremor was recorded on April 19, 2013. Though it was a strong earthquake reports suggest it was a safe distance from Suva, Fiji. A statement from the Mineral Resources Department's Seismology Section explained that it was a medium-sized magnitude earthquake. The department said there was no felt report from the nearby places since the event source was very deep. In the past year, the Fiji Islands region has been hit with 112 earthquakes.

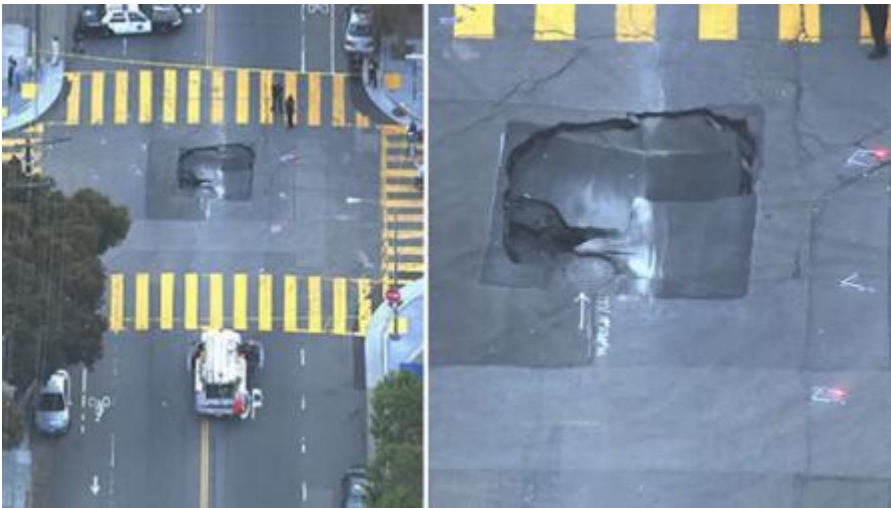

Headline: Five dead in Philippines volcano eruption

Five people are thought to have been killed when one of the Philippines' most active volcanoes erupted, throwing rocks on to a party of foreign climbers and their Filipino guides. Several members of the party were also seriously hurt following Tuesday's eruption of the Mayon volcano in Albay province. Three German climbers and a Filipino guide are among the dead, according to Albay provincial governor Joey Salceda. Salceda said eight people had been injured and everyone was accounted for apart from one foreign climber who was missing, presumed dead. A rescue operation is now under way to bring the climbing party down from the mountain. "The injured are all foreigners. They cannot walk. If you can imagine, the boulders there are as big as cars," Salceda said, speaking from provincial capital Legazpi. "We will rappel the rescue team, and we will rappel them up again."

Headline: Large sinkhole opens up in San Francisco

Monday evening a 22-foot-long sinkhole opened up in the middle of the intersection of Lake Street and 2nd Avenue in San Francisco. Headline: Authorities: 42 dead in Nigeria extremist attacks

Authorities in northeast Nigeria say at least 42 people have been killed in a coordinated attacks by Islamic extremists that also allowed 105 prisoners to escape. The violence occurred Tuesday in multiple locations in Bama, a town repeatedly hit by fighters in Nigeria's Borno state. Authorities say

extremists used multiple heavy machine guns and "anti-aircraft" weapons. Lt. Col. Sagir Musa told The Associated Press that two soldiers died in one attack, as did 14 Nigerian prison guards when the militants raided a federal prison there. Musa said 105 inmates escaped during the assault. Bama police commander Alhaji Sagiru said 22 police officers also died in the attacks, as did three children and a woman. The fighting comes amid increasingly bloody guerrilla attacks by Islamic extremists in northern Nigeria.

Headline: 3,500 European Council workers on strike against austerity

Around 3,500 employees at the Council of the European Union have staged a strike in protest against the union's austerity measures. The staff members at the council, which is one of the bloc's key institutions, stopped work Tuesday to oppose member states' attempt to curb the pay, pensions and promotions of EU civil servants. Unions say their members face a 60 percent drop in purchasing power over the next 15 years if the EU keeps its harsh austerity policies. In addition, the strikers are protesting against an increase in the retirement age from 63 to 67. The EU has proposed a seven-billion cut for its civil servants in the upcoming 2014-2020 budget.

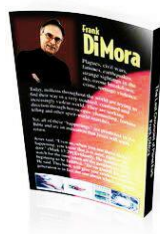
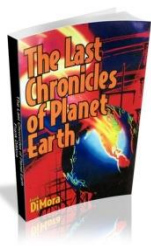

Headline: Bangladesh opposition will stage nationwide strike over recent killings

Bangladesh's main opposition party and several Islamic groups have called a two-day nationwide strike to strongly condemn the 'mass killing' of protesters in a crackdown by security forces. The strike comes as main opposition Bangladesh Nationalist Party (BNP) and its Islamic allies say hundreds of people were killed when police crushed a massive anti-blasphemy rally in Dhaka on late Sunday and early Monday. BNP spokesman Khandaker Mosharraf said the strike would begin at 6:00 am (0100 GMT) on Wednesday and end at 6:00 pm on Thursday. "We have called two days of nationwide strike to protest the mass killing of Hefajat-e-Islam workers and supporters on Sunday and Monday," Mosharraf said on Tuesday. Police sources have confirmed only 38 deaths, but the opposition is accusing authorities of concealing the dead bodies. This comes while Bangladesh's most prominent daily *Prothom Alo* put the death toll at 49.
