#### Headline: UN expert wants probe of Israeli detention of Palestinians

A controversial UN rights expert called Monday for an international investigation of Israel's treatment of Palestinian prisoners, decrying arbitrary detention, torture and coerced confessions among other alleged abuses. "The treatment of thousands of Palestinians detained or imprisoned by Israel continues to be extremely worrisome," said Richard Falk, the UN's outspoken expert on the rights situation in the Palestinian territories. Presenting his annual report to the UN Human Rights Council in Geneva, Falk called for "the establishment of a commission of inquiry into the situation of Palestinians detained or imprisoned by Israel." Israel, he said, currently had nearly 5,000 Palestinians in custody and had detained some 750,000 Palestinians since its occupation of the territories began in 1967.

In his report, he said Israeli violations were happening "on a massive scale," including detention without charges, "torture and other forms of ill, inhumane and humiliating treatment," and solitary confinement, including of children.

Headline: Palestinians lay groundwork for future state

U.S. Secretary of State John Kerry, who was supposed to arrive in Israel on Tuesday, has delayed his trip, likely until next week. The delay is meant to give Palestinian Authority President Mahmoud Abbas more time to decide whether to drop his demanded preconditions for restarting peace negotiations with Israel. Abbas has said Israeli must freeze settlement construction in Judea and Samaria and accept the 1967 bordersas the basis for a two-state solution before talks can be held. Kerry had not yet officially announced his trip and therefore did not respond to reports it had been delayed. At the start of Sunday's cabinet meeting, Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu said, "We will try to advance a way to find an opening for negotiations with the Palestinians with the goal of reaching an agreement."

Headline: Abbas rejected Netanyahu offer to free 50 pre-Oslo prisoners for new talks Palestinian preconditions for peace talks make a return to negotiations impossible for Israel, Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu said on Monday. "To me the setting of preconditions is an insurmountable obstacle," Netanyahu told the foreign affairs and defense committee, a parliamentary statement said. The Palestinians say they will only return to negotiations if Israel stops building on land they want for their future state and if the Jewish state agrees to negotiate on the basis of the borders that existed before the 1967 Middle East war. Israel demands talks "without preconditions" and refuses publicly to freeze settlement building. US Secretary of State John Kerry has postponed an expected trip to Israel and Palestinian territories to attend White House talks on Syria, US officials told AFP on Monday.

Headline: Israel Cannot Depend on UN Forces For Security

Headline: Putin acts to override Israeli, UN objections to Russian troops on the Golan

Prime Minister Binyamin Netanyahu told Russia's President Vladimir Putin over the weekend that Israel will hold its fire against Syria – as long as Syria holds its fire against Israel. In a statement at the opening of the government's regular Sunday morning Cabinet meeting Netanyahu said he had discussed the situation with Putin in a phone conversation, warning him that "the situation is becoming daily more complex. "Only last week, we saw battles close to our border on the Golan Heights. Israel is not intervening in the Syrian civil war, as long as fire is not being directed at us," the prime minister said. "The crumbling of the U.N. force on the Golan heights underscores the fact that

Israel cannot depend on international forces for its security," however, he pointed out. "They can be part of the arrangements. They cannot be the basic foundation of Israel's security."

Ladsous said during a meeting with 15 members of the Security Council in New York that the IDF and Syrian army were on the verge of the most direct military clash between the neighboring countries on the Golan Heights front in the past 40 years.

## Headline: Jordan begins 'Eager Lion' military drill

Jordan announced Saturday the start of "Eager Lion" military exercises with the participation of 8,000 soldiers from 19 Arab and Western countries, said Major General Awni el-Edwan, the Jordan Armed

Forces' operations chief of staff. In a press conference held at the Jordan Special Operations Command in Amman, Edwan said the military exercise will last till June 21 and will take place in Jordan's central and southern region. Stressing that the drill is not linked to regional developments around Jordan, Edwan said the military exercise will not take place near the northern border with Syria. Dismissing speculation that the Syrian rebel army might take part in the drill, Edwan said "only nations" were invited to participate. Part of the military drill involves air exercises on how to control and reduce effects of chemical weapons on military units and civilians.

At least one person has been killed and several others injured in gunfire during an anti-Hezbollah protest outside the Iranian Embassy in Beirut. Violence broke out as activists gathered to protest the Islamist group's involvement in Syria. Men in black shirts began to scuffle with protesters as they arrived in front of the Embassy in preparation for the demonstration, Lebanese publication the Daily Star reported. The men also fired gunshots into the air to disperse the activists. Lebanese state news reported that the army quickly restored calm and cordoned off the area following the outbreak of violence.

## Headline: Roadside bomb hits Lebanon road near Syria border

A roadside bomb apparently targeting two vehicles bound for Syria detonated on Monday near Lebanon's main crossing with its war-torn neighbor, a security source told AFP. "An explosive device detonated on the side of the Taanayel road leading to Masnaa border crossing with Syria," the security official told AFP. "It targeted a van and a BMW car, but it is unclear who was inside them," the source added. The source said the two vehicles were headed to Syria and continued in that direction despite the blast. There were no immediate reports of injuries in the explosion, which an AFP correspondent said could be heard throughout the region, some 14 kilometers from the Lebanon-Syria border. The blast damaged at least one other car nearby at the time, the source said. The conflict in Syria, which began in March 2011, has increasingly spilled across into Lebanon, with tensions rising after Lebanese Shiite group Hezbollah joined the fighting. June 10, 2013

# Headline: Indonesian dies at protest in S Arabia

An Indonesian woman has died at a protest outside her country's consulate in the Saudi Arabian city of Jeddah, where thousands of frustrated workers gathered to rectify their immigration status. "Some of them lit a fire near the walls of the consulate seeking to enter by force, but leading to the death of a

woman," AFP quoted an unnamed consular source as saying on Sunday. Around 8,000 Indonesians workers gathered outside the consulate trying to resolve their immigration status as the government has asked the undocumented workers to regularize their position before July 3 or leave. The consular source said that the workers, frustrated by long waits to get exit visas, threw stones at the building. Some witnesses also said that the workers briefly clashed with security forces. Fighters from Hezbollah openly spearheaded a 17-day assault on the Syrian town of Qusayr near the Lebanese border which culminated with its recapture from the rebels last Wednesday.

## Headline: Egypt's anti-Mursi petition campaign gathers 13 million signatures

Organizers of a campaign aiming to "withdraw confidence" from Egyptian President Mohammad Mursi announced in a press conference on Sunday that they had gathered 13 million signatures since petitions were first collected on May 1. The "Tamarod" (rebellion) campaign has attracted global media attention for planning mass protests on June 30; the date marking Mursi's first anniversary in power. The campaign has announced its intention to open branches in public spaces across Egypt in order to collect more signatures for the group's anti-government petition effort, local newspaper al-Masry al-Youm reported. A campaign spokeswoman, who announced Tamarod had reached the 13 million mark, said on Sunday: "The Egyptian people are the ones who gave confidence (power) to President Mursi, and so we have the the right to withdraw it, because he has breached a contract with the people when he did not meet the demands of the revolution."



Headline: Zawahri steps into row between Syrian and Iraqi al Qaeda wings

Syrian rebel forces attacked two Iraqi military positions at the southern tip of their common border Sunday, June 9. They failed to beat the Iraqi troops back although a number of Iraqi officers and soldiers were killed. Shooting incidents flared during the day near the Al-Waleed Syrian-Iraqi crossing, but the Iraqi forces held fast. This was their first engagement with Syrian rebels in the 28-month Syrian civil war – but unlikely to be the last. The Syrian Sunni rebels were anxious to break through the Iraqi lines which were blocking their access to supplies of weapons and fighters sent over by Sunni militias in the Western Iraqi Anbar region. The failure of the rebels' first assault set back their bid to loosen the grip of loyalist Syrian troops on this strategic border crossing. debkafile's military and intelligence sources report that while all eyes have been drawn in recent days to Hizballah's proactive military involvement in Assad's war, the Iraqi role has been under-reported an treated as scattered and sporadic military actions, whereas in fact, Iraqi Prime Minister Nuri al-Maliki has even outdone Hassan Nasrallah in the generosity of his assistance for propping Assad up. Headline: 15 Yr Old Publicly Executed for Blasphemy in Aleppo

Syrian troops buoyed by victory in Qusayr were preparing Sunday to launch a northern offensive, a security source said, as the conflict came to the streets of Beirut where a demonstrator was killed. At a protest outside the Iranian embassy against the Lebanese Shiite group Hezbollah's direct involvement in the Syrian conflict, a man was shot and fatally wounded in the first such shooting in Beirut linked to the 26-month war. A Syrian security source told AFP that after its capture from rebel forces of the strategic region of Qusayr on the border with Lebanon with the support of Hezbollah fighters, the regime's next target was Aleppo province in the north. "It is likely the battle for Aleppo will start in the coming hours or days, and its aim is to reclaim the towns and villages in the province," the source told AFP on condition of anonymity. "The Syrian Arab army is ready to carry out its mission in this province." The Syrian Observatory for Human Rights has reported the regime was deploying "thousands of soldiers" in the Aleppo region, aiming to recapture rebel posts and sever supply routes from neighboring Turkey.

#### Headline: Car bombings kill 22 in eastern Iraq

More than a dozen people have been killed and nearly 40 others have been injured in three car bomb attacks at a marketplace in Iraq's eastern province of Diyala. An Iraqi provincial police source, who spoke on condition of anonymity, said the attacks were carried out during the morning rush hour at a fruit and vegetable wholesale market in the town of Judaida al-Shat on Monday. Twenty two people died and 39 others were wounded in the bombings. No group has claimed responsibility for the attacks, but the bombings bear the hallmarks of al-Qaeda-linked militants in Iraq, who are seeking to destabilize the central government. On Sunday, a total of six people were killed and 25 others wounded in shooting attacks targeting Iraqi security forces across the country. June 10, 2013

Tens of thousands of demonstrators packed the streets of Turkish cities on Saturday, challenging Prime Minister Recep Tayyip Erdogan's call to end their civil uprising with a chorus of angry chants and a shower of red flares. The government said the protests were "under control" even as the largest crowds yet packed every inch of Istanbul's Taksim Square, the epicenter of nine days of nationwide unrest. As the sun set over Taksim, which has seen no police presence since officers pulled out of the site last Saturday, fans from rival football teams Fenerbahce, Besiktas and Galatasaray united in the square. They set off red flares to loud cheers from the crowd. "I have never experienced this friendship, this solidarity among Turks before," said Fenerbahce supporter Rustu Ozmen. "We have to keep coming, we can't give up because Erdogan hasn't quite yet," the 29-year-old lawyer added. In the capital Ankara, hundreds of riot police used tear gas and water cannon late Saturday to disperse some 5,000 demonstrators from the central Kizilay Square. The police pursued the protesters who took refuge in side streets off the square, which is the nerve center of the Turkish capital. Several people were injured, television reported.

Headline: Kabul Afghanistan rocked by militant attack on NATO, ISAF headquarters near airport

Headline: Seven die in Afghanistan bomb attack

AFGHAN authorities say a battle with insurgents near Kabul's international airport has ended and all the attackers have been killed. Ministry of Interior spokesman Sediq Sediqi says two civilians were wounded in today's attack that was apparently targeting NATO's airport headquarters. The attackers had rocket-propelled grenades, assault rifles and at least one large bomb. Deputy Kabul police chief Dawood Amin says there were seven attackers. Two blew themselves up with suicide vests and five were shot and killed by police. It was unclear if the attack had damaged facilities inside the airport. The attackers had taken over a four- to five- story building under construction nearby. "We closed the Kabul airport runway so that civilian aircraft don't get hit by bullets. They are in a high building that they are shooting from," said Yaqub Rassouli, the civilian chief of Kabul airport. Taliban spokesman Zabiullah Mujahid claimed responsibility for the attack saying the insurgents were targeting NATO. June 10, 2013

Sudan's spy chief warns his country will suspend nine agreements reached earlier this year with South Sudan if it continues to support rebels fighting to topple the Khartoum government. Mohammed Atta al-Moula's comments come a day after Sudanese President Omar al-Bashir ordered the closure of pipelines exporting oil from South Sudan. Al-Moula held a rare news conference Sunday, saying that other agreements involving security and economic pacts would be suspended with South Sudan if the country does not halt its support of rebels in Sudan.

One of Libya's highest military officers resigned Sunday after clashes between protesters and a government-aligned militia he was in charge of left 31 people dead in the eastern city of Benghazi, the deadliest such violence in a country where armed factions hold sway. The violence erupted Saturday when protesters in Benghazi stormed the main camp of Libya Shield, a largely Islamist grouping of militias that are paid by the government to help maintain security. The clashes prompted Army Chief of Staff Maj. Gen. Youssef al-Mangoush to resign, citing the unusually high death toll from the violence.

#### Headline: 2 out of 3 people face hunger as Haiti woes mount

The hardship of hunger abounds amid the stone homes and teepee-like huts in the mountains along Haiti's southern coast. The hair on broomstick-thin children has turned patchy and orangish, their stomachs have ballooned to the size of their heads and many look half their age — the tell-tale signs of malnutrition. Mabriole town official Geneus Lissage fears that death is imminent for these children if Haitian authorities and humanitarian workers don't do more to stem the hunger problems. "They will be counting bodies," Lissage said, "because malnutrition is ravaging children, youngsters and babies." Three years after an earthquake killed hundreds of thousands and the U.S. promised that Haiti would "build back better," hunger is worse than ever. Despite billions of dollars from around the world pledged toward rebuilding efforts, the country's food problems underscore just how vulnerable its 10 million people remain. In 1997, some 1.2 million Haitians didn't have enough food to eat. A decade later the number had more than doubled. Today, that figure is 6.7 million, or a staggering 67 percent of the population that goes without food some days, can't afford a balanced diet or has limited access to food, according to surveys by the government's National Coordination of Food Security. As many as 1.5 million of those face malnutrition and other hunger-related problems. "This is scandalous. This should not be," said Claude Beauboeuf, a Haitian economist and sometime consultant to relief groups. "But I'm not surprised, because some of the people in the slums eat once every two days." Much of the crisis stems from too little rain, and then too much. A drought last year destroyed key crops, followed by flooding caused by the outer bands of Tropical Storm Isaac and Hurricane Sandy.

#### Headline: Kamchatka's Shiveluch volcano emits 29,500 ft ash cloud

Russia's northernmost active volcano is churning out ash to a height of up to 9,000 meters (29,500 feet) in the country's Far East, local scientists said Monday. The 3,283-meter (10,771-foot) Shiveluch volcano increased activity in May 2009 and has been periodically spewing ash from three to ten kilometers. "Video monitoring of the volcano was complicated due to poor weather conditions, but seismological stations registered over the past 24 hours almost 150 local seismic activities with the most continued one accompanied by a spew of ash up to a height of 6.9 kilometers, give or take 2.2 kilometers," a local department of the Geophysical Service with the Russian Academy of Sciences said in a statement. The Kamchatkan volcano Shiveluch has thrice emitted columns of hot volcanic ash and gas. The tallest plume reached nine kilometers above the sea level, the Kamchatkan branch of the Russian Academy of Sciences' Geophysical Service reported on Monday. A code orange alert was issued for the volcano.

Naval boats and helicopters scoured seas off Sri Lanka on Monday for dozens of missing fishermen, as the death toll from heavy monsoon rains and strong winds rose to 40, an official said. The bodies of 39 fishermen along with one victim killed on land have been recovered while another 30 fishermen caught in rough seas are missing, said a spokesman for the Disaster Management Centre (DMC). The rain and winds which pummelled the island early on Saturday have also destroyed more than 100 houses and damaged another 2,185 buildings, said the spokesman, Sarath Lal Kumara. Headline: Yemen Shiites demonstrate over protest killings

Clashes between Shiite protesters and security forces in Yemen's capital Sunday killed seven people and wounded more than 80, a Yemeni security official said. In another part of the country, a military official said an airstrike, believed to be a U.S. drone attack, killed six suspected al-Qaida militants in the eastern province of al-Jawf, bordering Saudi Arabia. The violent protest and al-Qaida's presence throughout parts of Yemen revealed how nearly a year and a half after a new government took office, the impoverished Arab country is still struggling for stability. The Shiite protesters in the capital were demanding the release of political detainees. A security official said seven Shiite Hawthis were killed after they fired at guards while trying to storm intelligence headquarters in Sanaa's historic old quarter. He said some of the detainees were arrested for smuggling weapons and drugs. He spoke on condition of anonymity according to regulations. June 9, 2013
