Headline: Palestinian Prime Minister Rami Hamdallah resigns after three weeks

"It's time to grapple head-on with the issues and negotiate," Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu said about the peace process with the Palestinians in a Washington Post interview published on Friday. "We should enter immediately into negotiations without preconditions," Netanyahu said. "That's been my view for the last four years, and I hope it becomes the Palestinian view." U.S. Secretary of State John Kerry will visit Israel, the Palestinian Authority and Jordan this week, marking his fifth visit to the region since February as he tries to renew Israeli-Palestinian peace talks. "If Secretary Kerry, whose efforts we support, were to pitch a tent halfway between here and Ramallah -- that's 15 minutes away driving time -- I'm in it, I'm in the tent," Netanyahu said. "And I'm committed to stay in the tent and negotiate for as long as it takes to work out a solution of peace and security between us and the Palestinians.

Headline: Gaza: Islamic Jihad Cuts Off Ties with Hamas

Headline: Islamic jihad chief dies after clash with Hamas police

The Islamic Jihad terrorist group in Gaza announced on Sunday that it was temporarily suspending ties with Hamas, which rules the region, accusing Gaza authorities of being responsible for the death of one of the group's members. According to the *Ma'an* news agency, Raed Qassim Jundeyeih, a member of Islamic Jihad's Al-Quds Brigades, died on Sunday after being shot a day earlier by Hamas police officers. Police had gone to an address in Gaza City on Saturday to deliver summons orders to a member of the Jundeyeih family, reported *Ma'an*. Upon approaching the home, members of the family opened fire at the officers and Jundeyeih was wounded in the ensuing gunfight. He died from his injuries on Sunday.

Headline: Israel prepares for major cross-border attacks

The Israeli army on Sunday launched a large-scale surprise exercise simulating three simultaneous major terrorist attacks. The conditions of the drill had Israelis soldiers dealing with hypothetical terrorist incursions from Syria and Sinai, as well as a mass hostage situation. While the exercise had been planned in advance, the date was kept secret in order to test the soldiers' response to an surprise assault on the Jewish state. Israel remains on high alert for possible attempts to drag it into Syria's ongoing civil war.

Headline: Netanyahu: Israel to continue acting against Gaza rocket fire

Headline: Lieberman: Invade Gaza for 'Thorough Clean-Up'

Prime Minister Binyamin Netanyahu on Monday warned Palestinians in the Hamas-led Gaza Strip that Israel would continue to act militarily against elements who launch missiles and rockets at the country's population centers. Netanyahu's comments came after six rockets were fired from Gaza into southern Israel overnight, prompting the Israel Air Force to respond with air strikes on multiple terror targets. The IDF Spokesman's office said that, while the Islamic Jihad was behind the rocket attacks, Israel still holds Hamas responsible for all attacks emanating from Gaza. Earlier on Monday, former foreign minister Avigdor Lieberman told Israel Radio that the government should seriously consider the reoccupation of the Gaza Strip in response to Palestinian rocket fire on the western Negev. Lieberman, who currently heads the Knesset's Foreign Affairs and Defense Committee, said that if Israel were to allow the status quo to persist, Hamas would amass a fleet of aircraft and missiles that would threaten populous coastal towns like Tel Aviv and Netanya.

Headline: Jordanian troops prepare for chemical attack

Headline: US troop buildup in Jordan after Turkey shuts US-NATO arms corridor to Syrian rebels

Jordan's prime minister says the country is hosting 900 US military personnel to bolster its defense capabilities against potential threats from the Syrian civil war. The first Jordanian public official to speak publicly of the numbers of US troops in the kingdom, Abdullah Ensour told reporters Saturday that 200 of the personnel were experts training for how to handle a chemical attack. He said the remaining 700 are manning a Patriot missile defense system and F-16 fighter jets which Washington deployed this month in case the Syrian war worsens. Jordan is concerned its larger northern neighbor would use chemical weapons against Syrian refugee camps in Jordan and other neighboring countries, or that the stockpile may fall into the hands of al-Qaeda or other militants if President Bashar Assad loses control.

Headline: Rocket strike near Beirut brings Syrian civil war closer

A rocket slammed into a suburb of Beirut on Friday, bringing the conflict in neighboring Syria closer to Lebanon's bustling capital and reviving bitter memories of the country's own devastating civil war. With skirmishes between Shiites and Sunnis on the rise around the country, religiously mixed and highly vulnerable Lebanon is increasingly buffeted by powerful forces that are dividing the Arab world along sectarian lines. There were no casualties from the rocket, which struck a Christian area southeast of Beirut overnight, but the incident raised fears that Lebanon was being sucked into a war that has already paralyzed state institutions and strained its economy with the presence of more than a half-million Syrian refugees.

Headline: Radical Salafists kill 15 Lebanese soldiers in port city of Sidon

Headline: Sunni cleric warns of uncontrolled reaction to Sidon clashes

Salafist militants have killed at least 15 Lebanese soldiers in persisting clashes in the southern city of Sidon between the supporters of the radical group and Lebanon's army. Fighting between the two sides continued into Monday morning as Lebanese security forces attempted to encircle supporters of radical Salafist cleric Sheikh Ahmed al-Assir after they waged a deadly attack against a Lebanese army checkpoint in the port city on Sunday. The armed clashes have also left dozens of people injured. According to witness accounts cited in local media reports, machine gun and rocket fire shook Sidon, about 40 kilometers (28 miles) south of Beirut, generating panic among residents. The Lebanese army, meanwhile, blamed the deadly violence on the militants loyal to the hard-line cleric, who has fervently supported the foreign-backed Takfiri militants in Syria while expressing outrage over Hezbollah's supportive role on the side of the Syrian government.

Saudi Arabia

Headline: Shootings in Saudi Shiite area end months of relative calm

Saudi police shot a man dead on Saturday night in the Shiite Muslim district of Qatif, authorities said, in the second shooting incident in two days in the fractious area after months of relative calm.

The deaths bring to at least 20 the number of people shot dead by police since early 2011, when Shiites in the Eastern Province staged protests against the involvement of Saudi forces in ending demonstrations in neighbouring Bahrain. The government said Ibrahim Al Rebah, previously described as a wanted man connected with unrest in the area, was shot dead after exchanging fire with police when he resisted arrest late on Saturday. Local police said another man, identified by activists as Ali Al Mahrous, was shot late on Friday in an exchange of fire with a suspect, but not found until Saturday morning. Saudi Arabia last year ordered the arrest of 23 Shiite Muslims in the kingdom's Eastern Province, saying they were responsible for unrest that has led to shootings and protests.

Headline: Egypt airports on high alert ahead of June 30 protests

Headline: Egyptian army 'ready to intervene to stop conflict'

Egyptian President Mohammed Mursi on Saturday renewed his calls for dialogue with the opposition in an attempt to ease deep political rifts ahead of planned protests calling for his resignation set for June 30. "I have said it before. I urge everyone to sit together to discuss what would achieve the interests of our nation," Mursi said in an interview published in the state-owned Akhbar al-Youm newspaper. The interview comes a day after tens of thousands of Mursi supporters massed in Cairo in a show of strength. Mursi and the Brotherhood have turned their organizational prowess into electoral success since the 2011 revolution that toppled Hosni Mubarak, but a diverse opposition coalition now hopes to force Mursi to resign by demonstrating en masse on the first anniversary of his inauguration on June 30. "I will continue in my pursuit for contact, and I may speed up parliamentary elections as a way of involving everyone in an agreed method to manage our differences," Mursi said.

Headline: As Egypt lurches into civil strife, local militias raise their heads

After weeks of mounting anti-government turmoil across Egypt, army chief Abdel-Fattah al-Sissi finally spoke up Sunday, June 23, to warn that the Egyptian army would "not watch the country descend into uncontrollable conflict" ahead of the planned June 30 mass opposition rallies" or allow "an attack on the will of the people." Meanwhile, Egypt lurches day by day closer to what US and Israeli intelligence diagnose as "low intensity civil war." In outlying towns, law and order is breaking down as armed gangs attack governors and burn emblems of government, while the ruling Muslim Brotherhood deploys armed men strike back at government opponents. The police are not intervening in the disorder - any more than the army has to date. debkafile's military sources note that Defense Minister al-Sissi avoided defining which side the generals regarded as representing the "will of the people" - President Mohamed Morsi who pushed them off the national stage, or the myriad opposition groups sworn to overthrow him on the first anniversary of his rise to power. They aim to replace him with a high presidential council headed by a Supreme Court judge. A number of opposition groups say they have collected 15 million signatures in support of their demand.

Headline: U.S. soldiers head to Egypt for riot control

A group of U.S. soldiers are rocked and ready to deploy to Egypt for a 9-month peacekeeping mission. More than 400 American troops will ultimately go, as part of the long-standing Multinational Force and Observers peacekeeping mission. Their assignment: To man posts and security checkpoints along the Sinai Peninsula. They're also tasked with reporting violations of the peace treaty between Egypt and Israel. Although they will be far from Cairo, where protests against the government have raised concerns in Israel, they have been trained to respond to any threats, including protests and riots, to the security of Israel or the peace agreement. Part of their training included how to respond to Molotov cocktails. The force is comprised of soldiers from 13 nations.

Headline: Container Ship Carrying Weapons for Syrian Rebels Splits in Half

'A large fleet named "Mol Comfort" carrying Arms for FSA from the U.S. has crashed in the Indian Ocean as it made its way from Singapore to Jeddah, on board were 4,500 containers loaded with arms for the Syrian rebels' 'MOL Comfort sank due to yet unclear reasons, sailing from Singapore to Jeddah and after that to North Europe, leaving behind hundreds of drifting containers and a huge aftershock hitting liner sector and all of the maritime industry. Headline: New 'Syrian' front to open in Golan

In addition to the choice of a moderate to become Iran's new president and plans to send some 4,000 troops from the Iranian Revolutionary Guard Corps to Syria, the regime, along with its Lebanese proxy, Hezbollah, intends to open a new "Syrian Front" on the Golan Heights against Israel, Iranian sources said in a report in Joseph Farah's G2 Bulletin. The United States, meantime, has announced some kind of weapons support for the Syrian rebels, which analysts believe is too little, too late.

The analysts say it won't be fast enough as Iran and Hezbollah plan their next military move to take over the strategic Syrian city of Aleppo, a move that could prove decisive in the civil war against the embattled regime of Syrian President Bashar al-Assad. Two weeks ago, the city of al-Qusayr in southern Syria, which is at the crossroads of routes for rebel supplies and manpower, was retaken by the Syrian army, with the help of Hezbollah.

Headline: Damascus under fire, US deploys hundreds of troops in Jordan

Headline: Government on offensive outside Syria's capital

Syria's army on Saturday pressed a fierce assault launched four days ago against rebel areas in northern and eastern Damascus, killing three children with mortar fire, a monitoring group said. In northern Syria, rebels said they had begun a new assault on regime-held neighborhoods of the country's second city, Aleppo. "The district of Qaboon in (northeastern) Damascus is being intensely shelled by regime forces," the Syrian Observatory for Human Rights reported. Rebels were resisting the onslaught, battling troops loyal to President Bashar al-Assad on the edges of Qaboon, it said. Afternoon shelling in Qaboon killed or wounded several people, after a bus filled with passengers was hit, the Britain-based group said. Overnight mortar fire targeting Qaboon had already killed three children from one family, it added. Nearby, as fighting raged in the flashpoint district of Barzeh, rebels fired rockets at a police academy in the neighborhood, said the watchdog. It also said two mortar rounds hit Abbasiyeen Square in the northeast of the capital, one of Damascus's main landmarks. Several people were wounded in the attack, the group said. Over the past fortnight, the army has dramatically boosted efforts to crush the anti-Assad insurgency in and around Damascus.

Headline: Syrian Rebels Attack Police Post in Northern Damascus, 7 Killed

Syrian rights activists say rebels have attacked a police post northern Damascus, triggering a battle with security forces that killed at least seven people. The Britain-based Syrian Observatory for Human Rights said three rebels and four policemen were killed in Sunday's fighting. Forces loyal to Syrian President Bashar al-Assad have intensified attacks on rebels on the outskirts of Damascus in recent days, in a bid to drive them out of his seat of power in the capital. Elsewhere, the Observatory said a car bomb killed 12 Syrian troops in the northern city of Aleppo.

Headline: New Iran president thanks 'messiah' for victory

Iran's newly elected president, Hassan Rohani, attributed his victory in the June 15 voting to the 12th Imam, Mahdi, a statement with ominous overtones in the Islamic regime's quest for nuclear weapons. The Shiites believe that at the end of times, the 12th Imam, a 9th-century prophet, will reappear with Jesus Christ at his side, kill all the infidels and raise the flag of Islam in all four corners of the world. Many analysts believe Iran is seeking nuclear capability to bring on that Armageddon. "This political [election] was due to the kindness of the last Islamic messiah [Mahdi]," Rohani said Friday. This victory and the epic saga is without a doubt due to the special kindness of the Imam Zaman (Mahdi) and the measures taken by the supreme leader, especially his guidance and words. ... Without his management then it was not clear if the people of Iran would witness such a day filled with joy," Rohani said. "I am so happy that there is a feeling of joy in our society and that the election took place in the month of Shaban [the 8th Islamic month, representative of courage and blessings], which is the month of victory," he said.

Headline: Attacks Kill at Least 11 People in Iraq

Suicide bombers and shootings in northern and central Iraq were among attacks across the country that left eleven dead on Sunday. They were the latest incidents in a wave of violence that has claimed more than 2,000 lives since the start of April. Militants, building on Sunni discontent with the Shiite-led government, appear to have grown stronger in central and northern Iraq. The commander of the army's 12th Division, Brig. Gen. Mohammed Khalaf, said the assault on the police station near the town of Hawija started with a gunman on foot opening fire on the guards. A suicide bomber with an explosives belt then blew himself up in the reception area, and a suicide car bomber rammed his vehicle into the building, Khalaf said. Three policemen were killed and five others wounded. Hawija, a former insurgent stronghold, is about 240 kilometers (150 miles) north of Baghdad. The predominantly Sunni town and surrounding areas have been tense since April, when Iraqi security forces launched a deadly crackdown on a Sunni protest there in which 23 people, including three soldiers, died.

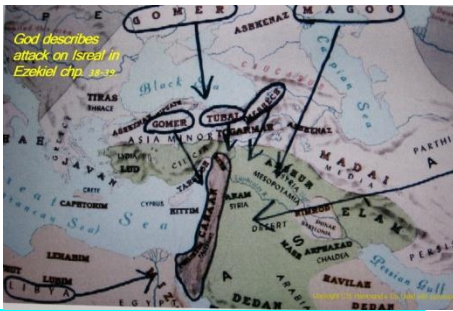

Headline: Police disperse Istanbul protesters with water cannon

Turkish police used water cannon on Saturday to disperse thousands of demonstrators who had gathered anew in Istanbul's Taksim Square, calling for the resignation of Prime Minister Recep Tayyip Erdogan. Hundreds of riot police backed up by water cannon trucks moved in on several thousand protesters chanting for Erdogan's dismissal. "This is but a start, the battle continues!" the protesters yelled, throwing red carnations. "It is by resisting that we will prevail!" The protesters had gathered a week after police evicted thousands of people from the adjacent Gezi Park, the epicenter of nationwide demonstrations that had shaken Turkey for much of June and presented Erdogan and his Islamic-rooted government with the biggest challenge of their decade-long rule. Following the eviction, the protests that had infuriated Erdogan and earned Turkey harsh criticism from the West had fizzled out as the premier claimed victory over "traitors." "The people and the AKP (ruling Justice and Development Party) government have foiled the plot... hatched by traitors and their foreign accomplices," Erdogan said on Tuesday. Confident he has weathered the storm, he warned against any resurgence of the protests.

Headline: Russia Offers Iran New Replacement for S-300 – Paper

Moscow made a new attempt to dodge a \$4-billion lawsuit from Tehran over a failed deal to supply S-300 missile systems by offering another type of air defense system to Iran, Kommersant daily said Saturday. The new offer on the table is Antei-2500, aka S-300VM, or SA-23 Gladiator in NATO nomenclature, the newspaper said, citing unnamed sources in the Russian arms trade industry. The missile defense system can simultaneously destroy up to 24 aircraft within the range a range of 200 kilometers or intercept up to 16 ballistic missiles. The deal can be formalized during the visit of outgoing Iranian President Mahmoud Ahmadinejad to Moscow on July 1, an unnamed Iranian diplomat told Kommersant.

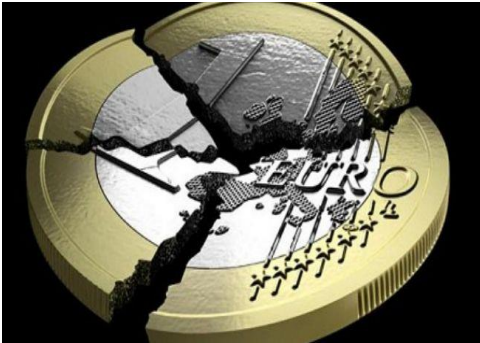

Headline: EU ministers clash over reviving Turkish talks after protests

European Union ministers clashed over whether to revive membership talks with Turkey on Monday with several countries joining Germany in arguing it would send the wrong signal to reward Ankara after a crackdown on protests. The objections of Germany, Austria, the Netherlands and others make it likely that the EU will cancel or postpone talks scheduled for Wednesday, raising new doubts about whether it will ever be admitted to the European club. The EU had planned to breathe new life into Turkey's EU ambitions on Wednesday by opening a new chapter, or policy area, in its EU membership talks - the first opened since 2010. But Germany is blocking the plan over Turkey's handling of anti-government protests that swept cities after police used teargas and water cannon to disperse a demonstration against redevelopment of an Istanbul square. Two weeks of clashes with police have left four people dead and some 7,500 injured.

Headline: Greece's unemployment to rise to 30 percent in 2014

Greece's unemployment rate will increase to more than 30 percent in 2014 while the economy contracts, a report indicates. A report by the Center of Planning and Economic Research released Friday said the jobless rate will rise to 28.5 percent in 2013 and reach 30.4 percent in 2014.

"This is a particularly negative development, but it is also inevitable given the continuing reduction in economic activity," the report said. The center predicts the economy will shrink by 4.09 percent this year, though the government forecasts a 4.5 percent reduction, ekathimerini.com reported Friday.

Headline: Central banks told to head for exit

Central banks must head for the exit and stop trying to spur a global economic recovery, the Bank for International Settlements has said following a week of market turbulence sparked by the US Federal Reserve’s signal that it would soon cut the pace of its bond buying. US Treasury markets, which saw yields hit their highest level in almost two years on Friday, face further challenges this week as they prepare to sell an extra \$99bn of debt. After last week’s global sell-off, markets in the US will also be knocked by traders winding down for the end of the second quarter. “One cannot reverse the Fed’s big bang moment,” said George Goncalves, strategist at Nomura Securities, adding that the scale of foreign demand for this week’s Treasury debt sales would be a crucial test of sentiment.

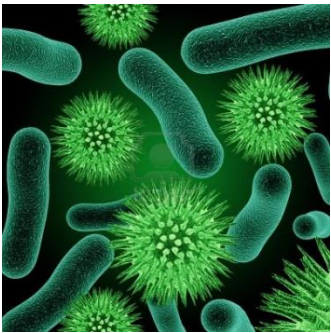
Headline: Ex-CIA chief to Obama: Strike North Korea

North Korea's UN envoy has accused the United States of using the UN forces in South Korea against the North, saying US hostility could lead to war at any time. During a rare news conference on Friday ambassador Sin Son Ho, demanded the dissolution of the United Nations Command in South Korea, accusing the US of building an Asian version of NATO to realize President Barack Obama's pivot to Asia. "The most pressing issue in northeast Asia today is the hostile relations between the DPRK (North Korea) and the US which can lead to another war at any moment," Sin said. He reiterated Pyongyang's surprise offer last Saturday of wide-ranging senior-level talks with the United States "to defuse tension on the Korean peninsula and ensure peace and security in the region." The ambassador said that the deteriorating situation on the Korean peninsula "is not caused by the DPRK (Democratic People's Republic of Korea)."

Headline: Flesh-eating ‘Aleppo boil’ disease spreads through Syrian city as parasite-spreading flies thrive on mounting waste and sewage

Rebels fighting to hold Syria's economic hub from government forces are facing an enemy their AK47's cannot target. A virulent flesh-eating disease known as 'Aleppo boil' is sweeping the city as the destruction of its infrastructure has led to a breakdown in sanitation systems. Also known as the 'Aleppo evil' or, to give it its proper name, cutaneous leishmaniasis, it causes painful lesions which can become secondarily infected, often leading to permanent disfigurement. The sandflies which spread it flourish in waste and sewage which can now be found almost everywhere in the heavily

bombarded city, where sewer systems have been blasted open by artillery shells. The World Health Organisation is monitoring the spread of the disease which, despite its gruesome symptoms, is generally not fatal, and reported 1,047 cases across Syria in May.

Headline: Latest bird flu strain 'kills more than a third' of patients, Chinese researchers say

More than a third of patients infected with a new strain of bird flu died after being admitted to the hospital earlier this year, Chinese researchers report in a new study. Since the new H7N9 bird flu first broke out in China in late March, the strain has sickened more than 130 people and killed 37. The World Health Organization has previously described H7N9 as "one of the most lethal influenza viruses" it has ever seen and said it appeared to spread faster than the last bird flu strain, H5N1, that threatened to unleash a pandemic. After making some adjustments for missing data, the Chinese scientists estimated the overall death rate to be 36 percent. The outbreak was stopped after China closed many of its live animal markets -- scientists had assumed the virus was infecting people through exposure to live birds.

Headline: Saudi Arabia declares new death from MERS virus

A Saudi man has died from the MERS virus, bringing the kingdom's death toll from the SARS-like infection to 34, the ministry of health said on Monday. The ministry said on its website that new cases had also been recorded, especially in Eastern Province where most of the infections have occurred. The ministry said it had now recorded 66 cases of infection from the coronavirus MERS in the kingdom since the disease erupted last year. It said 34 of those who contracted the disease had died. The World Health Organization said on June 17 that 64 laboratory-confirmed cases of the disease, dubbed Middle East Respiratory Syndrome (MERS), had surfaced worldwide to date, including 38 deaths.

Headline: Dengue fever kills 10 people in Angola

At least 834 cases of dengue fever have been recorded in Angola since March, with 10 patients reportedly dead of the disease. The capital city of Luanda, home to one third of the southern African country's 20 million population, was the worst hit with 831 cases found, the official news agency Angop reported on Monday. The provinces of Malanje and Kwanza Sul recorded two cases and one case respectively, Angop said, citing the Ministry of Health. There were 657 cases confirmed in laboratory tests and 214 people admitted in hospital, the ministry said, adding that health authorities are training professionals in the provinces of Malanje, Uige, Lunda Norte and Kuando Kubango to combat outbreaks. Dengue fever is an acute febrile infectious disease caused by a virus of the flaviridae family and is transmitted by aedes aegypti mosquito which were infected by the virus.

Headline: Christians Slain by Islamists in Nigeria

In the latest of a series of attacks this year in the Wase area of Plateau state, Nigeria, Fulani Muslims killed one Christian and destroyed church buildings in four villages Tuesday. "Muslim Fulani terrorists attacked some villages, including Bakin Rijiya village where Toma Vongjen was killed, and in Kumbur, Wase Tofa, Angwan Sayawa, some churches were also destroyed," the Rev. Dinfa Lamda, Church of Christ in Nations in Jos, told Morning Star News. "There are Christian villages that have been completely wiped out by these Muslim terrorists. Just last week Muslim Fulani herdsmen attacked some Christian farmers in Wase and destroyed all the crops they planted on their farms." Lamda said Muslims have attacked Plateau state Christian communities in Wase, Langtang and Shendam. "For a number of years, the attacks on Christians in these three local government areas have caused the displacement of thousands of Christians there," he said. "There is a very lamentable problem, as we are no longer able to worship God as Christians in this part of Nigeria." In the last six months, more than 100 Christian farmers have been killed or injured and almost 100 churches destroyed in attacks by armed Muslim Fulani herdsmen.

Headline: M-CLASS SOLAR FLARE

Sunspot AR1778 produced an impulsive M2-class solar flare on June 23rd at 20:56 UT. NASA's Solar Dynamics Observatory recorded the extreme ultraviolet flash: The eruption flung material away from the blast site, but the debris does not appear to be heading toward Earth. Except for the effects of the UV flash, which created a short-lived wave of ionization in Earth's upper atmosphere, this flare was not geo-effective. More flares could be in the offing. In addition to AR1778, sunspots AR1775 and AR1776 have 'beta-gamma' magnetic fields that harbor energy for significant

eruptions. NOAA forecasters estimate a 40% chance of M-flares and a 5% chance of X-flares on June 24th.

Headline: India floods: Rescue efforts intensify, as death toll rises

Efforts have intensified in northern India to rescue tens of thousands of people trapped by flash floods that have already killed nearly 600 people. The army is evacuating survivors in mountainous Uttarakhand state by helicopter and special trains are carrying people from affected areas.

More than 40,000 people are still stranded in what the government has described as a "national crisis". Officials have admitted a lack of co-ordination in the rescue effort. Forecasters are predicting more rain. Early monsoon rains in India this year are believed to be the heaviest in 60 years.

Headline: Brazil unrest continues as popular support for demos grows

Brazilians have staged fresh street protests nationwide amid growing popular support for demands for institutional reform and better public services. On Sunday, rallies were held in several cities, including a 4,000-people march on Rio de Janeiro's Copacabana beach and in the northeastern city of Fortaleza, where the final games of the group stage of the FIFA Confederations Cup were played. People have been taking to the streets during the past two weeks to express their anger at rampant government corruption and the high cost of hosting the 2014 World Cup. "We like football, after all we are Brazilians. But that doesn't mean we want to shell out billions. We pay too much tax, the prices of the new stadiums are too high," said one of the protesters.

Headline: Kenyan leader orders disarmament amid inter-ethnic clashes

Kenyan President Uhuru Kenyatta on Monday ordered disarmament in the northern region of the East African country to stop inter-tribal clashes which have so far left more than 50 people dead and dozens of others injured. Kenyatta warned of stern action against perpetrators of hostilities in Mandera and Wajir which has fueled hostilities between the Garreh and Degodia clans.

"If the hostilities do not end, we will have no other choice but to move in with full force," President Kenyatta said in Nairobi when he met political leaders from Mandera and Wajir to discuss the conflict between the Garreh and Degodia clans. He said his government will engage the Ethiopian government to ensure the peaceful co-existence of all communities along the common border, adding that the killings of innocent children, women and the elderly cannot be tolerated.

Headline: Pakistani premier: Musharraf to face treason trial

Pakistan's prime minister said Monday that the government plans to put the military ruler who ousted him in a coup over a decade ago on trial for treason, setting up a possible clash with the country's powerful army. But the government stopped short of declaring officially that it was filing charges against Pervez Musharraf, saying it would first consult with other political parties. Prime Minister Nawaz Sharif spoke in parliament as the Supreme Court held a hearing on a possible treason case against Musharraf. The former military ruler can only be tried for treason if the federal government presses charges against him. Sharif said the government agrees with the Supreme Court's decision that Musharraf committed treason under Article 6 of the constitution when he declared a state of emergency in 2007 and suspended the constitution.

Thousands of protesters turned out for the ninth day of protests in Bulgaria Sunday to rally against Prime Minister Plamen Oresharski. Protesters shouted chants of "red trash" and "resignation," criticizing the newly elected prime minister's cabinet appointments, the news website Novonite.com reported. Opponents of Oresharski, who was appointed prime minister by Parliament May 29, have called for the introduction of more transparent practices in politics, the news website said. Demonstrators held signs in the midst of a heavy summer storm in Sofia that read "this is a protest against impudence," "forgiveness, no thanks," "today we create New Bulgaria -- with new Parliament and Bulgarian politics" and "Bulgarian police worthy for respect," Focus news agency reported.
