# Headline: Israel OKs building plans in E.Jerusalem

Hours before U.S. Secretary of State John Kerry's arrival in Israel, Jerusalem approved building 69 new homes in an East Jerusalem neighborhood, officials said. Kerry was due to arrive in Israel Thursday for the fifth time since taking office Feb. 1 in ongoing efforts to jump start peace talks between Israel and the Palestinians. The Jerusalem Municipality Wednesday said it had approved the construction of 69 new homes in the Jewish neighborhood of Har Homa in East Jerusalem, Israel Radio and The Jerusalem Post reported. The 69 housing units are part of a project approved in August 2011 to construct 1,000 housing units in the neighborhood. Tenders were issued in April 2012, Peace Now, an organization that monitors settlement building in East Jerusalem and the West Bank said. The contractor who won the bid for the 69 units already had submitted plans to the Jerusalem Municipality Local Planning Committee and was given the go-ahead to start building Wednesday, The Jerusalem Post said. Headline: Likud minister: Netanyahu ready to compromise, withdraw from over 90% of West Bank if security concerns met

Headline: Peres, Netanyahu reject idea of bi-national state
Headline: Abbas: We will only negotiate based on 1967 lines

Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu would be willing to withdraw from most of the West Bank and evacuate numerous settlements as part of an agreement with the Palestinians, as long as his security demands were satisfied, a senior cabinet minister from Netanyahu's Likud party told Haaretz on Wednesday. The senior minister, who requested anonymity due to the sensitivity of the issue, said Netanyahu knows very well that if negotiations with the Palestinians resume under U.S. Secretary of State John Kerry's auspices, he will have to hold serious discussions on the borders of a Palestinian state. "Netanyahu understands that for a peace agreement, it will be necessary to withdraw from more than 90 percent of the West Bank and evacuate more than a few settlements," he said. "He knows this is one of the things that will be discussed." The minister said the issue of security arrangements is Netanyahu's main concern, and this will be his main demand in the negotiations. If his security demands are met, he is prepared to make significant territorial concessions, the minister

added. Meanwhile, Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu and President Shimon Peres on Thursday rejected the idea of a bi-national state during a memorial for Theodore Herzl in Jerusalem.

"We do not want a bin-national state," said Netanyahu, adding "but let's not delude ourselves, even if we sign an agreement with the Palestinians it won't end the wild defamatory accusations against the Jewish state."

#### Headline: Hamas and Islamic Jihad Resume Communications

The Islamic Jihad and Hamas terror movements in Gaza on Wednesday resumed communications, three days after Jihad severed ties with Hamas, following the death of one of its members at the hands of police officers. Jihad spokesman Daoud Shihab told the Bethlehem-based *Ma'an* news agency that full contact between both groups was resumed after a Hamas delegation visited the home of Jihad leader Muhammad Harazein to apologize for an alleged assault during the funeral of a slain Jihad member.

#### Headline: UN Council backs machine guns for Golan peacekeepers

The UN Security Council on Thursday backed UN peacekeepers in the Golan Heights carrying machine guns, as fallout from the Syria war increases in the ceasefire zone. The 15-member council passed a resolution to extend the mandate of the force, which monitors a three-decade-old ceasefire between Syria and Israel, but which called on Syrian government and opposition fighters to stay out of the zone. The council strongly condemned three abductions of UN peacekeepers in the Golan since March and expressed "grave concern" at violations of the 1974 ceasefire accord. June 27, 2013

#### Headline: Israel demands UN condemn Gaza rocket fire

Israel called on the United Nations to categorically denounce rockets fired by terrorists in Gaza at the country's southern cities and civilian population and said that the typical UN response calling for both sides to stay calm was inadequate. "Unequivocally condemn the rocket fire," Israeli envoy to the UN Ron Proser urged in a letter this week to United Nations Secretary-General Ban Ki-moon and the Security Council. "The usual statements calling for mutual restraint are not enough. This is not a matter of two sides, but one side and one side only that continues to repeatedly to impose terror on innocent civilians." Prosor went on to decry the notion that the exchange of fire between Israel and Palestinian terror groups in Gaza was morally balanced. "There is no place to equate between a terror group that makes civilians its target and a state that wants to protect its residents," the envoy wrote in the missive, sent Monday after a barrage of rockets from the Hamas-controlled coastal enclave slammed into southern Israel. The attack is widely believed to have been carried out by Islamic Jihad in violation of Hamas instructions to refrain from such activity.

# Headline: Jordan MPs urge efforts to end Israel inmates' hunger strike

Parliament called on Thursday for international efforts to help end a 57-day hunger strike by five Jordanian inmates in Israel who are protesting prison conditions. "We hold Israel responsible for the safety and life of the Jordanian prisoners holding an open-ended hunger strike," MPs said in a statement. "We support their legitimate demands to have decent prison conditions and treatment, including the chance to see their families." The lower house of parliament urged "international organizations, rights groups and the Red Cross to help end the suffering of the prisoners and push for meeting their demands." "We hail the courage of all prisoners in Israeli jails for their legendary resistance of the Israel's arrogance and racism."

# Headline: US looks to send training teams to Lebanon, Iraq

U.S. military commanders have been told to explore ways to increase security assistance to Lebanon and Iraq, the chairman of the Joint Chiefs said Wednesday, as the violence in Syria spills across the borders and the Iraqis face growing threats from the local al-Qaida offshoot. Gen. Martin Dempsey said the assistance is aimed at improving the two nations' military capabilities and could include sending in U.S. training teams and accelerating foreign military sales of weapons and equipment to Iraq and Lebanon. Dempsey made the recommendation to U.S. Central Command in recent weeks, according to Air Force Col. Ed Thomas, a spokesman for the Army general. There have been no U.S. military trainers in Iraq since troops left at the end of 2011, as the war there ended. But the U.S. has provided military training and assistance to Lebanon for a number of years. June 27, 2013

Headline: Hezbollah using LAF to further its own ends

In Sidon earlier this week, followers of Salafi leader Ahmad al-Assir challenged the Lebanese Armed Forces (LAF), compelling the Army to put down the Assir movement once and for all. Or at least, that was the accepted narrative for the first day or so, until it started to become apparent that there was another element in the battle as well. The fact is the LAF was not acting alone. On Monday, the Hezbollah-owned Al-Manar TV showed live footage of what appeared to be uniformed soldiers taking into custody fighters from Assir's group. As the captured Sunni militiamen were being marched away, the uniformed soldiers, as identified by the station's correspondent, could be heard shouting "Ya Zaynab" — a Shiite religious cry referencing Imam Ali's daughter. This video was but one item among several which threw into sharp relief the real dynamic of what went down in Sidon. The version describing the episode as a clash between the LAF and the Assir group is as inaccurate as it is incomplete. In reality, there was a third protagonist: Hezbollah. In fact, the operation in Sidon was a preemptive power play by the Party of God. Using the LAF as cover, Hezbollah moved to eliminate what it considered a potential threat.

Headline: Saudis hold massive funeral for activists killed by regime forces
Headline: Thousands of Shi'ites denounce Saudi rulers at funeral

Tens of thousands of people in Saudi Arabia have attended the funeral of two activists who were killed by regime forces in the country's Eastern Province. The funerals were held in the town of Awamiyah and the Qatif region on Wednesday. The mourners slammed the regime's deadly crackdown on the country's uprising and chanted slogans against the ruling Al Saud family. On June 23, Saudi police opened fire at and seriously injured Morsi Ali Ibrahim al-Rabah when trying to arrest him over allegations of involvement in anti-regime protests. Rabah, who was on a list of 23 activists wanted in connection with protests in Awamiyah, died of his injuries in hospital. He was the 18th victim of the Saudi crackdown on the protesters in Qatif since 2011.

Headline: Morsi tries to calm protesters after two killed and scores wounded in clashes Headline: Egypt factions clash in Alexandria

Egyptian President Mohammed Morsi late Wednesday offered opponents a say in amending a controversial new constitution and a forum to seek "national reconciliation", as he sought to avert a violent showdown in the streets after two people were killed and scores wounded over the course of the night. In a televised address lasting more than two and a half hours, the Islamist head of state blamed loyalists of fallen dictator Hosni Mubarak for the "paralysis" that has marked his first year in office but also offered an olive branch to opponents that also seemed to address demands from the army. He said he was inviting party leaders to meet on Thursday to choose a chairman for an all-party committee that would prepare amendments to the constitution. It was pushed through a referendum late last year with Islamist support, but many in the opposition say the document is flawed and biased against them. Morsi also said he was forming a committee of leading public figures, including Muslim and Christian clerics, to promote "national reconciliation". Meanwhile, Supporters and opponents of Egypt's Mohammed Morsi clashed in the second city of Alexandria, throwing rocks and firing shotguns early on Thursday as the Islamist president made a keynote speech in Cairo. A Reuters reporter saw dozens of youths approach a rally of Morsi's supporters in the Mediterranean port and the two sides then fought. There was no immediate information on casualties.

# Headline: UN inspectors in Turkey to investigate Syria chemical weapons use

UN-appointed inspectors, blocked from entering Syria, are in Turkey to gather information about possible use of chemical weapons in the civil war, officials said on Thursday. Members of the team assembled by UN Secretary-General Ban Ki-moon had been on standby in Cyprus since April, unable to enter Syria as Western governments accused President Bashar Assad's forces of chemical weapons attacks. They were sent to Turkey this week and its head, Swedish scientist Ake Sellstrom, was meeting Turkish Foreign Minister Ahmet Davutoglu on Thursday, a senior Turkish official told Reuters. The Syrian government and rebels fighting it have accused each other of using lethal chemical agents, including sarin gas, in the two-year-old conflict.

# Headline: In liberated Al-Ragga: a second revolution

A counter-revolution has started in the Syrian province of Al-Raqqa, following its liberation from the Assad regime's control. Everything in Al-Raqqa points to this fact: graffiti on walls across the city depict the unease over militant groups, and black flags have replaced independence flags as slogans from the revolution are now being pitted against the al-Nusra Front and the Ahrar Ash-Sham. This is what life is like in the liberated city. Ahmad, who shouts slogans during protests in Al-Raqqa, told us that scores of masked armed men in black clothing entered the city on March 4, 2013, chanting "Our leader forever, our Prophet Mohammad" and calling for one to exclaim "Allah is great." He went on to say: "Back then, we felt happy for a few moments when regime troops and security forces fled the city, but this happiness soon vanished when we had to look for the independence flag among the liberators. We went to the Della roundabout and chanted 'No Sunnis, no Alawites, but one Syria with national unity. We did not realize back then that those who liberated our city would occupy it.'

#### Headline: Iran's supreme leader: Nuclear solution 'easy' if West is serious

Iran's supreme leader said a solution to the nuclear impasse with the West would be "easy" if the United States and its allies are serious about seeking a deal, Iranian media reported Thursday. The remarks by Ayatollah Ali Khamenei are his first on the nuclear issue since the presidential election earlier this month of Hasan Rohani, who supports direct talks with Washington. It suggests Khamenei also could endorse bolder diplomacy by Iran if talks resume with world powers. Several newspapers, including the hard-line Jomhouri Eslami, quoted Khamenei as saying, "the solution to Iran's nuclear case is an easy and smooth job" if Western powers want to strike a deal. "The opposition front against Iran does not want the nuclear issue to be solved," Khamenei told a group of judiciary officials Wednesday. Khamenei, who has final say on all state matters, singled out the U.S. for what he called "new excuses" to block possible headway on negotiations over Tehran's nuclear program.

# Headline: Small anti-government protests rumble on in Turkish capital

Hundreds of protesters took to the streets in a residential area of the Turkish capital overnight, setting up barricades and lighting small bonfires. Weeks of often violent anti-government protests have mostly died out in Istanbul and the centre of the capital Ankara, but daily demonstrations by a small

core have continued in its recently developed working-class Dikmen district. The protesters, numbering no more than a thousand, blocked Dikmen's main road with makeshift barricades and started small fires late on Wednesday, some chanting anti-government slogans. Riot police and water cannon trucks initially kept their distance but moved in to disperse the protesters in the early hours, footage from anti-government channel Halk TV showed. The images showed police firing at least two rounds of teargas and detaining at least one protester.

A Russian newspaper has reported that Russia has pulled out all of its military personnel from its naval base in Syria. The base at Tartus is a minor facility, used mainly to service Russian navy ships in the Mediterranean, but it is Russia's only naval outpost outside the former Soviet Union. The number of personnel stationed there is unknown. Vedomosti, a respected business newspaper, reported the evacuation on Wednesday, citing an interview with Deputy Foreign Minister Mikhail Bogdanov published in the Al Hayat newspaper and its own unnamed source in the Defense Ministry. The Defense Ministry has not commented, and the report could not be independently confirmed. June 26, 2013

Headline: Tensions high in Libya as capital hit by fighting
Headline: Death toll from Libyan clashes rises to five, 97 wounded

Tension was palpable in the Libyan capital on Thursday, a day after deadly fighting broke out between groups of ex-rebels, highlighting the country's continuing insecurity nearly two years after dictator Moamer Kadhafi fell. Much of Libya's recent unrest has centerd on the eastern city of Benghazi, the cradle of the 2011 uprising against Kadhafi, where attacks blamed on Islamists have targeted both the authorities and Western interests. But it now seems to be spreading to Tripoli, where brigades of ex-rebels remain entrenched despite government efforts to disarm them and impose its authority. Since the fall of Kadhafi's regime, militia groups, mostly ex-rebels, have managed border controls, prisons, strategic facilities in the country and vital institutions. June 27, 2013

# Headline: Europe strikes deal to push cost of bank failure on investors

The European Union agreed on Thursday to force investors and wealthy savers to share the costs of future bank failures, moving closer to drawing a line under years of taxpayer-funded bailouts that have prompted public outrage. After seven hours of late-night talks, finance ministers from the bloc's 27 countries emerged with a blueprint to close or salvage banks in trouble. The plan stipulates that shareholders, bondholders and depositors with more than 100,000 euros (\$132,000) should share the burden of saving a bank. The deal is a boost for EU leaders, who meet later on Thursday in Brussels, and can show that they are finally getting to grips with the financial crisis that began in mid-2007 with the near collapse of Germany's IKB.

# Headline: Moody's downgrades Jordan credit rating two notches to B1

Moody's Investors Service on Wednesday downgraded Jordan's sovereign foreign currency government bond rating by two notches to B1 from Ba2 citing a deterioration in the Middle East nation's fiscal metrics and rising government debt. The outlook on the credit is stable, Moody's said in a statement. "The first driver of today's rating is the dramatic deterioration in Jordan's public finances since 2009, due to a combination of lower economic growth and external shocks," Moody's said in a statement. Jordan's general government debt levels as a percentage of gross domestic product are rising and expected to climb in the coming years. The firm expects the debt-to-GDP ratio to hit 84 percent this year and reach close to 90 percent of GDP in 2014.

South Korea's president arrived in Beijing on Thursday for summit talks to be dominated by Pyongyang's nuclear programme, seeking to push China to do more to bring its wayward ally North Korea to heel. "South Korean President Park Gyen-Hye arrived in Beijing to start a four-day visit to China," the state broadcaster CCTV said on an official news micro blog account. She arrived late morning, it said. Park - who will meet her counterpart Xi Jinping on Thursday - has said that her priority will be to "harden" China-South Korea co-operation on pressing for denuclearisation of the North. Washington and Seoul have made it clear they will never accept the idea of North Korea as a nuclear state, and insist Pyongyang must show a tangible commitment to abandoning its nuclear weapons if it wants substantive talks.



# Headline: War games near California: Are the US and Japan sending a message to China?

A series of unprecedented joint drills, code-named Dawn Blitz, began earlier this month between the United States and Japan off the coast of California with a specific aim: a joint amphibious assault on the island after it has been seized by a small, but heavily armed, invading force. San Clemente Island, located about 75 miles northwest of San Diego, is acting as a surrogate for the disputed island chain known as the Senkaku Islands in Japan and the Diaoyu in China. Japanese officials insist publicly that the drills are not targeting a third country, adding that the island's identity is purely hypothetical. The exercise has added to tensions thousands of miles away in waters near the Senkaku Islands, a group of islands in the East China Sea that the Japanese government bought from their private owners last year, triggering violent protests in China and sending Sino-Japanese ties to their lowest point in years.

# Headline: Justice: No youth programs with God

A Louisiana lawman is livid over the federal government's decision to cut off funds for two programs to help troubled young people, all, he says, because he refused to sign a pledge to bar prayer or any mention of God at their meetings. Julian Whittington, the sheriff of Bossier Parish, La., told Fox News the Department of Justice Office of Civil Rights defunded \$30,000 for their Young Marines chapter as well as a youth diversion program. # Headline: Drought conditions persist across much of Colorado

June is living up to its history as one of the driest months in the Colorado high country, with very little precipitation in the state's key river basins. According to the June drought update from the Colorado Water Conservation Board, the Yampa and White River basins in the northwestern part of the state, as well as the South Platte and Gunnison River basins have received zero percent of their average June precipitation. As of the June 18, the US Drought Monitor is showing that 100 percent of Colorado continues to experience some level of drought classification. Farther south, the Rio Grande Basin and the rivers in the southwestern corner of the state have only seen about 14 to 14 percent of their average June precipitation to-date. All the basins, with the exception of the South Platte, were also below average in May. Scattered storms brought some moisture relief to the southeastern plains which have been faced with exceptional drought conditions for two years. But soils are so dry in this region that some fields have become hydrophobic.

Headline: Hawaiian Telescope Discovers Ten Thousandth Near-Earth Object

NASA said the 10,000th near-Earth object (NEO) has been discovered using the Pan-STARRS-1 telescope in Hawaii. Astronomers spotted asteroid 2013 MZ5 on the night of June 18, marking a significant milestone for the NEO search. The space agency said 90 percent of all NEOs discovered were first detected by NASA-supported surveys. "But there are at least 10 times that many more to be found before we can be assured we will have found any and all that could impact and do significant harm to the citizens of Earth," said Lindley Johnson, program executive for NASA's Near-Earth Object Observations Program at NASA Headquarters, Washington.In order to be classified as an NEO, a comet or asteroid must approach Earth at an orbital distance to within about 28 million miles. They range in size from as small as a few feet to as large as 25 miles for the largest NEO. Asteroid 2013 MZ5 is about 1,000 feet across and will never be close enough to Earth to be considered potentially hazardous.

# Headline: Brazilian police teargas protesters in Belo Horizonte

Brazilian police have clashed with protesters outside a stadium hosting a football match in the southeastern state of Minas Gerais. The incident broke out in the city of Belo Horizonte on Wednesday when thousands of demonstrators were confronted by police firing teargas on them. Protesters responded by picking up teargas canisters and threw them back at the police as well as pelting them with rocks. The violence erupted just hundreds of meters away from the Mineiro stadium, where Brazil's football team was playing against Uruguay in a semifinal match of a warm-up tournament for the 2014 World Cup. Earlier in the day, about 50,000 protesters thronged a central plaza in Belo Horizonte.

# Headline: Massive student protest rally in Chile capital turns violent

More than 100,000 students have taken part in a nationwide protest rally in Chilean capital of Santiago against government educational reforms as the event turned violent by clashes between some protesters and police. The violence during the Wednesday protest march began when groups of hooded protesters reportedly hurled Molotov cocktails at a police station and blocked rush-hour traffic along some major roadways, according to an AP report. Riot police then responded to the violence using water cannons and tear gas. This is while the Chilean Interior and Security Minister Andres Chadwick slammed the protest violence as "coordinated acts" by "criminals and extremists." "They are not students, they are criminals and extremists," said Chadwick in a press conference. "They've acted in a coordinated and planned way to provoke these acts of violence." While police authorities have not disclosed the number of arrests made during the daylong demonstration, they announced that at least three of their officers were injured in the violence.

But opposition groups say Besigye wanted to show solidarity with striking business owners in Kampala. The business owners closed their shops Tuesday to protest against a new government tax increase on imported goods.

# Headline: Portuguese wage major strike against austerity measures

Public service workers in Portugal have engaged in a general strike to protest government austerity measures that have led to the nation's worst economic slump since the 1970's. The Thursday protest effort, which was called by Portuguese trade unions, began peacefully although it brought the nation's public transport system to a halt, prompting anger and despair among those who decided to go to work but still blamed government policies for record unemployment levels. Previous protest efforts and strikes against the harsh terms of Portugal's 78 billion euro (\$100 billion) bailout by the European Union and IMF in 2011 have mostly been non-violent, unlike the protest events in Greece and more recently in Brazil and Turkey. This is while the unions are hoping that the fourth general strike in two years will prompt the government to boost economic growth and ease the austerity measures, including the sharpest tax hikes in living memory this year.
