



Headline: Saudi Arabia: Muslim Authority Threatens War Over Temple Mount

Saudi Arabia's highest religious council, the Majlis al-Ifta' al-A'ala, has threatened a "religious war" over any attempts to implement equal prayer rights for Jews on Jerusalem's Temple Mount. The Temple Mount is Judaism's holiest site, the site of two Jewish Temples and where some Jewish traditions state the world began. It is also the site of the large "Al Aqsa" Islamic complex, which is built on top of the ruins of the Jewish Temples. The site itself is administered by the Waqf Islamic trust. In measures Jewish activists decry as discriminatory, only Muslims may pray or carry out any other religious rituals on the Mount. Jews who attempt to pray are regularly arrested. Just yesterday the Mount was closed to Jews after a Jewish group sang songs in honor of the festival of Hanukkah, in response to harassment by Muslim extremists at the site. The council condemned what it said were "Israeli attempts to split the Al Aqsa Mosque" by implementing alternate prayer arrangements for Jewish and Muslim worshippers, as well as by establishing a fixed area for Jewish worship.

Headline: Netanyahu meets with pope in Vatican

Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu met Monday morning with Pope Francis at the Vatican and presented the pontiff with a copy of his late father's book about the Spanish Inquisition. The encounter was the prime minister's first with the current pope, who has already met at the Vatican with Palestinian Authority President Mahmoud Abbas in October and with Israeli President Shimon Peres in April. Netanyahu met with the previous pope, Benedict XVI, in 2009, and with pope John Paul II in 1997. Citing an anonymous official Israeli source, CNN reported last week that the pope was scheduled to make his first visit to Israel in May. The Vatican has not confirmed that report. Six government ministers joined Netanyahu on the trip and were set to meet with Italian ministers. The pope and the prime minister reportedly discussed negotiations between Israel and the Palestinians and security threats Jerusalem faces in the region from Iran and elsewhere, as well as recent European legislation banning circumcision and kosher slaughter, said Murray Watson, a Christian-Jewish relations expert.

Headline: Israel admitted into advisory body to UN

The U.S. and other Western countries say they have admitted Israel into an informal group in Geneva that will provide it with some influence before the U.N. top human rights body. U.S. Ambassador Samantha Power says Israel's entry into the Geneva-based section of the Western European and Others Group will help the country "shape policy and determine leadership posts" at the U.N.'s Human Rights Council. The group and others like it have no formal standing with the 47-nation council, in which the U.S. is a member but Israel is not, but acts in an advisory capacity.

The American Jewish Committee's executive director, David Harris, said the decision "ends the shameful anomaly whereby Israel was the only U.N. member state not fully integrated in the world body's regional grouping system."

Headline: Protests rage over Bedouin resettlement plans in Israel

Large protests over a plan to resettle nomadic Bedouin Arabs in Israel's southern Negev desert caused injuries Saturday and led to some arrests as well as condemnation from Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu. Protests focused on a bill that would move thousands of Bedouins into government-recognised villages. Opponents charge the plan would confiscate Bedouin land and affect their nomadic way of life, but Israel says the moves are necessary to provide basic services that many Bedouins lack and would benefit their community while preserving their traditions.

Over a thousand people protested in a Negev village in southern Israel Saturday. The demonstration turned violent when some protesters threw rocks and fire bombs at police and burned tires. Police, some on horseback, responded with water cannon, tear gas and stun grenades, police spokesman Micky Rosenfeld said. Hundreds more took to the streets at protests held in Jerusalem, Haifa and elsewhere. Police made more than 40 arrests and 15 officers were injured, Rosenfeld said.

Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu issued a statement condemning the violence. "We will treat offenders to the fullest extent of the law and will not tolerate such disturbances. We have – and will have – no tolerance for those who break the law, Netanyahu said. "Attempts by a loud and violent minority to deny a better future to a large and broad population are grave. We will continue to advance the law for a better future for all residents of the Negev," he said.

Headline: Hundreds of Gazans protest at sea over Israeli naval blockade

Hundreds of Palestinian youth activists sailed from the shores of the Gaza Strip on Monday to protest at Israel's restrictions on fishing in the seas off the Islamist-ruled enclave. Palestinian fishermen say they cannot meet demand in Gaza due to Israel's naval blockade on the territory and limit of six nautical miles (11 km) in which they can take out their boats off shore. Israel eased the blockade somewhat in 2010 after an Israeli commando raid on a ship in an activist flotilla bent on reaching Gaza left nine Turks dead and raised an international uproar, but Palestinians say the gestures were not enough. On Monday, Gaza's Coalition Intifada group said about 200 youths boarded fishing boats heading out of Gaza City toward the fishing zone boundary, before returning to shore. Organizers said some boats crossed the six-mile maritime limit. "We have sent a message of solidarity with the fishermen and a message to the world that they must act to end the Gaza blockade," said Shorouq Mahmoud, the group's spokeswoman.

Headline: Israeli army fires into Syria after gunmen shoot at IDF soldiers on Golan Heights

The Israeli army fired into Syria on Monday after its troops were shot at on the Golan Heights, the military said. "Gunfire was opened from Syria toward IDF soldiers in the central Golan Heights. The force retaliated toward the threat and a hit was confirmed," a military statement said. There were no Israeli casualties in the incident. An Israeli military source said that the brief exchange of fire happened near the Quneitra border crossing and that the Israeli troops said they were fired on by a Syrian soldier. The army was still checking whether its troops were the target of the gunfire, the source said. Hours earlier, a Syrian mortar shell landed in the Druze village of Majdal Shams on the Golan, near Israel's security fence. No casualties were reported.

Headline: PA: Cancel Building Tenders Or Talks Over

The Palestinian Authority (PA) is threatening once again to pull out of the peace talks with Israel over its plans to build in Judea and Samaria. *Channel 2 News* reported on Sunday that the PA is accusing Israel of not having really cancelled tenders that were issued several weeks ago for 20,000 new homes in Judea, Samaria and Jerusalem. Prime Minister Binyamin Netanyahu reprimanded Housing and Construction Minister Uri Ariel over the construction and cancelled it, but the PA is now claiming, according to *Channel 2*, that the announcement of the tenders appeared as "active" on the Housing Ministry's website until at least this past Thursday. This, the PA is claiming, is a violation of a guarantee by the United States, which had promised the PA that these tenders were null and void. The report said that PA officials have recently turned directly to Secretary of State John Kerry and told him that unless the tenders are canceled, the negotiations will end immediately.

Headline: Tripoli death toll rises to 12 as clashes persist

Headline: Lebanon puts Tripoli under Army control: Mikati

Fighting in Tripoli between supporters and opponents of Syria's Assad regime raged Saturday night and carried on Sunday as the death toll reached twelve with dozens more wounded. Some of the wounded from the Saturday-Sunday overnight fighting died Sunday. They were identified as Mahmoud al-Mohammad, a Syrian national who died from his wounds after being hit by sniper gunfire at the Malloulah roundabout and Ali Mahmoud Al-Ahmad, in addition to Mahmoud Hussein, who died of a heart attack while fleeing sniper gunfire in the Zahereyah area. A soldier identified as Abdullah Ajaj also died from his wounds after being hit by sniper fire while passing near the fighting area. An additional two people were killed Sunday as a result of the fighting, security sources told The Daily Star. One of the shells targeted a center for the army in Bab al-Tabbaneh Sunday wounding a man identified as Abu Hasan Al-Jundi who later died from his wounds. Over 49 people, including 12 soldiers and policemen, were wounded in the fighting. Army units conducted raids in Tripoli overnight, arrested 8 militants and confiscated their light weapons and ammunitions, a statement from the military said Sunday. Meanwhile, Lebanon decided Monday to put the northern city of Tripoli under the command of the military for a period of six months in a bid to end repeated clashes there linked to the war raging in Syria.

Saudi Arabia

Headline: Iran says seeks stronger cooperation with Saudi Arabia

Iran said on Sunday it wanted stronger cooperation with U.S. ally Saudi Arabia, as it seeks to ease concerns among Gulf Arab neighbors about a potential resurgence in its influence following a nuclear deal with world powers. Iranian Foreign Minister Javad Zarif, on a tour of Gulf Arab states, said after talks in Kuwait that no date had been set for an expected visit to Sunni Muslim power Saudi Arabia, Shi'ite Iran's main regional rival. But he suggested the nuclear deal reached in Geneva on November

24 should not be seen as a threat. "This agreement cannot be at the expense of any country in the region," Zarif, speaking through an interpreter, told reporters at a news conference after discussions with his Kuwaiti counterpart, Sheikh Sabah al-Hamad al-Sabah. Asked about reports he also planned to visit Riyadh, Zarif said: "We look at Saudi Arabia as an important and influential regional country and we are working to strengthen cooperation with it for the benefit of the region."

Headline: Egypt police fire tear gas to disperse protesters in Alexandria

Headline: Egypt's Muslim Brotherhood Opposes New Constitution

Riot police in Egypt's second largest city of Alexandria have fired tear gas at a large crowd of protesters demanding the abolition of a new law that restricts demonstrations. The police fired tear gas at protesters and chased with them in vehicles and on foot on Monday. The mass rally comes despite warnings from authorities of a firm response to any unauthorized protests. The law has sparked a new wave of protests by supporters of ousted president, Mohammad Morsi, who accuse the military-backed government of giving the police and military a free hand to commit rights violations. The angry protesters demand the abolition of the law that imposes fines and jail terms on violators. They say the law aims to silence dissent ahead of a nationwide referendum on the amended constitution expected in January. Meanwhile, Egypt's Muslim Brotherhood has rejected the country's new constitution, nearly half a year since the ouster of Brotherhood-backed Islamist president Mohammed Morsi.

Headline: Protesters gather outside Qatar's embassy in Cairo

Scores of protesters gathered on Saturday in front of Qatar's Cairo embassy on Saturday, calling for the cutting of diplomatic ties with the Gulf state. The demonstrators chanted anti-Qatar slogans in protest over what they called Doha's support to the Muslim Brotherhood and its hostile stance over the ouster of Islamist President Mohammad Mursi. During the protest - which had been approved by the Interior ministry - demonstrators burned and shredded Qatar's flag, and held up photos of Egypt's army chief Gen. Abdel Fattah al-Sisi. Egyptian media quoted sources saying that the protesters got the license to gather for three hours, confirming that security forces had a heavy presence around the embassy.

This is not the first time Egyptians who support the interim pro-military government have demonstrated against the Gulf state.

Headline: 50 killed in air strikes on Syria's Al Bab — NGO

A two-day wave of regime air strikes on a north Syrian town has killed 50 people, a monitor said Sunday, while in Damascus a mortar round struck the French school without causing injuries. On the political front, Syria's deputy foreign minister insisted that no solution to Syria's conflict proposed at a January 22 peace conference in Geneva would be implemented without President Bashar Al Assad's approval. The Syrian Observatory for Human Rights said that helicopters on Sunday dropped explosive-laden barrels on the rebel-held town of Al Bab in northern Syria's Aleppo province, killing at least 24 people, including two women and four children. Their deaths in a market area of Al Bab came a day after similar aerial bombardments on the same town that killed at least 26 others. State news agency SANA, reporting on the conflict in the town, said "Syrian army units destroyed the headquarters of an Islamic [rebel] tribunal in Al Bab in a special operation", without giving further details. Large swathes of Aleppo province have been under rebel control for more than a year, and have suffered frequent aerial attacks by the regime. Meanwhile in Damascus, children escaped a mortar attack on the French school, officials said. "A mortar shell landed on the chimney of a classroom around 9:00am (0700 GMT). No one was hurt but the windows shattered and the walls cracked," school receptionist Bashir Oneiz told AFP.

Headline: Syria Asks for International Aid to Destroy Chemical Weapons

Syria has reportedly appealed for international aid in order to destroy its chemical weapons arsenal safely and correctly, according to the *New Zealand Herald*. Syrian deputy foreign minister Faisal Mekdad stated to reporters Monday that Syria needs armored vehicles and other equipment to move the chemicals for destruction, and warned that if such equipment was not provided, "it will be difficult if not impossible for Syria" to destroy the weapons. Mekdad's statements followed a meeting between Syrian ministers and the Organization for the Prohibition of Chemical Weapons (OPCW) Monday, where he decried efforts by "terrorists" to use the weapons, conspicuously omitting any mention of weapons use by Syrian President Bashar Assad. Saturday, US officials announced that they would be destroying the weapons at sea, according to the OPCW's specifications. Norway also offered logistical support and naval equipment for the operation, though it refused to carry out the directive on its own soil. Apparently, the pledges are not sufficient, however, as Syrian officials have expressed concern for the operation's security.

Headline: Syria war crimes evidence implicates Assad: UN


Evidence has been uncovered in Syria that implicates President Bashar al-Assad and members of his inner circle in war crimes and crimes against humanity, a top UN official said Monday. A UN probe into rights violations committed during 33 months of brutal conflict "has produced massive evidence ... (of) very serious crimes, war crimes, crimes against humanity," United Nations human rights chief Navi Pillay said. "The evidence indicates responsibility at the highest level of government, including the head of state." It is the first time evidence by a UN-mandated commission has directly implicated Assad in crimes committed during Syria's civil war, which has killed an estimated 126,000 people, according to new figures released by the Syrian Observatory for Human Rights, a Britain-based monitoring group.

Headline: Rouhani: Iran to start building 2nd nuclear plant in Bushehr

Iranian President Hassan Rouhani said construction will soon start construction on a second nuclear power plant in the country's southwest Bushehr province, Iranian Tasnim news agency reported. "The first nuclear power plant is in operation in Bushehr province, and the construction of the second one will soon kick off ; development of new atomic power plants in the country will start in earnest and there will be nuclear reactors in most parts of Bushehr province," Tasnim quoted him as saying. In reference to the recently-signed deal in Geneva with world powers on the Islamic Republic's disputed nuclear program, Rouhani said the airs in the international arena were less tense. However, the Iranian president stressed that "our enemies and rivals will not give up their hostility and rivalry." Under the Nov. 24 interim accord, Iran agreed to curb its nuclear program in exchange for limited sanctions relief. The agreement - reached after more than four days of negotiations between Iran and the United States, France, Russia, China, Britain and Germany - was designed to buy time for negotiations on a final settlement of the decade-old nuclear dispute. Amid the third round of negotiations between Iran and the P5+1 group of world powers in November, senior Iranian nuclear officials spoke of plans in Tehran to construct two new nuclear power plants in the near future, Iran's semi-official Fars news agency reported.

Headline: Terrorist attacks across Iraq leave 15 people dead

In the deadliest violence on Monday, a family of six, including two men, two women and two children, were killed at their home in al-Nibaie, which lies just north of the Iraqi capital, Baghdad. Meanwhile, attacks in Abu Ghraib, Mosul and Tuz Khormato cities left nine others dead. The assaults come a day after 12 people were killed and 25 others wounded in a bomb explosion in northern Iraq. Also on Friday, a wave of violent attacks left 51 people dead across the Arab country. Carnage has claimed the lives of more than 6,000 people in Iraq so far this year.


Headline: U.S. sends submarine-hunting jets to E. China Sea post

U.S. military authorities dispatched the first of six top-tech submarine-hunting jets to its Okinawa post near the disputed East China Sea, a move sure to ratchet up tensions among China and the United States. The Navy plans to send in a total of six P-8 Poseidon patrol craft, aimed at bolstering the United States' ability to root out submarines in the area, Reuters reported. The deployment was planned months ago, but nonetheless comes as China declared an air defense zone above islands that it's fighting Japan to control. President Obama, in response to the declaration, flew in two B-52 bombers into the so-called off-limits air space — a strong message that the United States would not abide China's terms of designation. But Mr. Obama also said that U.S. businesses would obey China's air zone declaration, and refrain from flying private craft into the zone without Beijing's

permission. The White House said it is proceeding with previously forged plans to deliver six submarine-hunting jets to Kadena Air Base in Okinawa. The first was sent Sunday, with the remaining five to be delivered before the end of this month, a U.S. Navy official told Reuters.

Headline: Strong Earthquake Hits Indonesia; No Casualties

A strong, shallow earthquake rocked parts of eastern Indonesia early Sunday, but there were no immediate reports of damage or injuries. The U.S. Geological Survey said the **6.3**-magnitude quake was centered 343 kilometers (212) miles northwest of Saumlaki, a coastal town in Maluku province, at a depth of 9 kilometers (5.5 miles) beneath the sea. Indonesia's Meteorology, Earthquake and

Geophysics Agency put its preliminary magnitude at 6.7 and said that the quake was unlikely to trigger a tsunami, said Suhardjono, the agency official who like many Indonesians uses a single name.

M5.4 for a shallow quake is damaging level in this area of the world. As the distance to major towns is rather big (also to Rwanda and Burundi), the earthquake may not have been felt so far (no mentions from this otherwise very communicative area). Smaller villages and settlements (Like Bikule and Mukingiti, only a few km from the epicenter are however at risk. The epicenter is also Gorilla nature area (Maiko National Park) and has a number of dormant volcanoes in the area. More to the east are some active volcanoes. This is also a location where rebels are fighting the army, this already for many years and with very cruel atrocities going on (HRW reports).

Headline: North Texas earthquakes trigger dam inspections

Earthquakes keep rocking Azle. Last Tuesday, another earthquake jolted the small town in northwest Tarrant County. And on Friday, yet another one hit nearby. About 20 quakes rattled North Texas in November -- five of them in or near Azle. The minor earthquakes haven't caused significant damage, but residents in Azle are getting nervous and seismologists are trying to get to the bottom of what's going on. Some point to natural gas drilling that's happening in the Barnett Shale, a massive geological formation that covers about 20 North Texas counties. But a geophysicist with the National Earthquake Information Center says more testing is needed to make such a connection.

Headline: France sends 200 new troops to CAR

More than 200 new French troops have arrived in the Central African Republic (CAR) to join an African-led stabilization force in the country. The soldiers along with combat vehicles and logistics equipment reached CAR through neighboring Cameroon on Sunday. The troops joined a 450-strong French force. Paris says it is planning to send around a thousand more troops to the country in the future. The new deployment came after the United Nations Security Council this week voted on a resolution drafted by France to expand the regional African military mission in CAR. Paris is scheduled to host a 'mini-summit' on CAR on Saturday, to be attended by some 40 African leaders, including Central African Prime Minister Nicolas Tiangaye, and UN Secretary-General Ban Ki-moon. French military officials say Antonov 124 cargo planes will take materiel necessary for the French force in CAR within the next few days. The officials said that if needed, the force can also protect French nationals. France is also looking for other European nations to support its mission in its former colony.

Headline: Boko Haram militants attack military base, airport in northern Nigeria

Several people were killed Monday in northeastern Nigeria after suspected Boko Haram terrorists planted hundreds of explosives in the capital of Borno state. The terrorists attacked an air force base in Maiduguri and the city's international airport, and placed more than 300 explosives around the city, the Nigerian newspaper Vanguard reported. A newly constructed trailer park, military check points, and residential and public buildings also were hit in the attacks, which began about 3 a.m.

An official total of the dead and wounded was not yet available, but more than 100 militants were reported killed in military airstrikes. At least 24 people were reported killed and 15 others injured Saturday as members of Boko Haram sneaked weapons and ammunition into Borno state along its border with Chad, the Lagos-based newspaper The Guardian reported. The attacks occurred at the village of Madayi, located on Lake Chad about 160 miles north of Maiduguri, and in the town of Sabon Gari, about 70 miles south of the state capital.

Headline: Clashes at protests in Ukrainian capital Kiev

Headline: 100,000 rally in defiance of Ukraine protest ban

Police beat protesters and journalists outside of the Ukrainian presidential administration building where a group of young men tried to break police lines. Protesters fired flares at police who threw them back and shot stun grenades into the crowd. Riot police started pushing protesters out of the square in front of the presidential administration building and beating those who refused to leave. Broadcaster Euronews said on its Facebook page that police deliberately attacked a Euronews crew covering the clashes. The news organisation said cameraman Roman Kupriyanov was wounded and his camera destroyed. Mass protests drew several hundred thousands out on the streets to protest the government's decision to forego an EU deal and a violent crackdown by police on protesters. The rally, by far the biggest seen in the Ukrainian capital since the Orange Revolution nine years ago, came a day after a police crackdown on protesters that inflamed demonstrators further after President Viktor Yanukovich's policy switch. While the main protest on Kiev's Independence Square was peaceful, groups of roving masked men with sticks broke windows and confronted police at the presidential administration building. Opposition leaders sought to distance themselves from the groups of protesters. The protesters broke windows along Kiev's main street and used a bulldozer to try to break a police blockade around the presidential administration.

Headline: **Protesters launch 'people's coup' in Thailand**

Headline: **Violence rocks Bangkok; PM forced to leave building**

About 30,000 protesters have launched a "people's coup" on Thailand's government.

They have swarmed state agencies in violent clashes, taking control of a state broadcaster and forcing the prime minister to flee a police compound. Meanwhile, protest leader Suthep Thaugsuban has announced a government holiday for 2 December. Protesters gathered at Government House and other key state buildings in a bid to topple the government. Riot police behind concrete barriers and barb wire have been repelling crowds of protesters using water cannon and tear gas.

"In order to continue the people's operation and eliminate Thaksin's regime, the People's Democratic Reform Committee would like to announce that Monday, December 2, is a holiday for the government sector," he said in a statement which was broadcast on the Blue Sky channel which is funded mainly by the opposition Democrat party and its supporters. Apart from government buildings, protesters took over part of a TV station earlier in the day seeking them to air footage of their "people's coup". Network TPBS aired Mr Suthep's announcement on their channel. The protest leader has been holding rallies at government complex which is partially occupied by his supporters.

Headline: **Haitian protesters demand end to President Martelly presidency**

Several thousand people were reported to have marched in the capital, Port-au-Prince, on Friday, calling for Martelly to stand down. The protest numbers were said to have shrunk to around 1,000 by the time participants converged on the US embassy. Demonstrators - who approached the compound from the rear after police blockaded the area with barricades - were repelled by police firing tear gas. UN peacekeeping troops also guarded the building. Protesters voiced dissatisfaction with Martelly's government, which they claim has been propped up by the US. "We ask the ambassador to rid the country of the president that the Americans installed in power," one participant, Jean Max Edouard, told the AFP news agency. Another protester, Jude Saint-Ame, said he was protesting against "occupation." "Haitians must be able to demonstrate where they want, without restriction," he said, denouncing "the stranglehold of America" on Haiti. As well as calling for the president to resign, protesters carried placards demanding Prime Minister Laurent Salvador Lamothe leave office. The demonstrators made appeals for better living standards in the country, which is the poorest in the Americas.
