Headline: IDF building suppressive fire posts along the Syria border

After numerous instances of fire spillover from Syria, the most recent of which ended with the death of a 13-year-old boy, the IDF is building "assault stations" in the Golan Heights - suppressive fire posts along the border with Syria that would offer quick response to any an attack against Israel. The suppressive fire posts, named by the IDF "Defensive Canopy," will be built in the 210th Territorial Division, that was recently established to secure the border with Syria. Similar posts have already been built along the Gaza border to coordinate between different military elements in case of an attack against IDF troops. The coordination between the division, the Air Force and others elements, allows for a relatively quick response to suppress the attackers. The attack stations are manned whenever necessary in accordance with situation and threat assessments. They will be built under the supervision of the artillery corps and their objective is to make the new division run more efficiently. The new unit stationed at the posts will be commanded by an artillery officer. June 24, 2014

Headline: Iron Dome intercepts two rockets fired from Gaza at southern Israel Headline: Israel responds to rocket fire with Gaza airstrike

Air force jets late on Tuesday struck targets in the Gaza Strip following missile fire on southern Israel. Earlier, two rockets were launched from Gaza at Hof Ashkelon Regional Council. Two were intercepted by an Iron Dome anti-rocket defense battery. A third rocket fell at Sdot Negev Regional Council, damaging a building. Following the barrage, the Israel Defense Forces said that it will "not tolerate attempts to harm Israeli citizens or IDF soldiers, and will act against anyone who operates terror against Israel." The IDF has responded to every incident of rocket fire from the Gaza Strip since the beginning of Operation Brother's Keeper in the West Bank 12 days ago. More than 20 targets in Gaza were bombed by the Air force. Security forces estimate that the Islamic Jihad, and not Hamas, is responsible for some of the launches in the past week and a half, while others were probably carried out by organizations that do not accept Hamas' rule in the Strip. Headline: Gaza rockets aim at Kurdish oil route via Israel. More security for Ashkelon and Eilat depots

The Trans-Israel Pipeline from Ashkelon to Eilat is the real target of the increased Grad rocket fire on Ashkelon and nearby coastal areas, military sources tell debkafile. Its momentum has guickened since the launch this month of a transit route for oil exports from the Kurdish Regional Government (KRG) in northern Iraq via Turkey and Israel. Islamic Jihad and other Salafist militants in Gaza are in cahoots with the AI Qaeda affiliated Ansar Bayt al-Magdis operating out of Sinai. All are potential sources of the rocket fire and certainly have an eye on civilian targets, but the sources say the uptick of the last few days is a clear attempt to take out the new Kurdish export route. (see attached Special Map) Islamic Jihad and AI Qaeda in Sinai are strange bedfellows - their backers, Iran and ISIS, are at loggerheads in Iraq. But they share an interest in preventing Israel from using its small oil ports, Ashkelon and Eilat, to become a major conduit for Kurdish oil. Through its geography and infrastructure, Israel has guickly become a key element in the war in Irag and its future. Iran wants to put a stop to oil sales out of the northern Iragi oilfields near Kirkuk, while ISIS considers Iragi oil to be an important war spoil and strategic asset, likewise the oilfields in eastern Syria. ISIS is already using captured Syrian oilfields as a major source of income, bringing in some \$1 billion per year. With control of Irag's oilfields, refineries, and pipelines, the AI Qaeda-affiliated group could easily double or triple its annual oil income. Israel's role puts a damper on these plans. Both Tehran, which has its own designs on Kirkuk, and ISIS, were amazed to discover the Turkish Prime Minister Recep Tayyip Erdogan had signed onto a combined Kurdish-Turkish-Israeli concern for the new Kurdish export route. No time was lost for this transaction after the Kurdish peshmerga moved into Kirkuk as Iragi troops fled the oncoming ISIS fighters.

Headline: Netanyahu Calls out Hamas's 'War on Israel'

Prime Minister Binyamin Netanyahu responded to Hamas leader Khaled Meshaal's blessing toward the abductors of three yeshiva students Tuesday, calling the terror organization out on the difference between its face to the international community and its statements to the Arab world. "Last night we heard Khaled Meshaal, the leader of Hamas, praise and defend the brutal kidnapping of the three innocent Israeli teenagers who were making their way home from school," Netanyahu said. "Meshaal once again made clear that Hamas remains committed to its war against Israel and its war against every Israeli citizen, and coincidently, against every Jew around the world." The Prime Minister expressed his appreciation for Palestinian Authority (PA) Chairman Mahmoud Abbas's condemnation of the abduction, but clarified that he will be tested in actions, not words. "How can President Abbas make an alliance with these terrorists who extoll kidnapping?" he asked. "I appreciate what President Abbas said a few days ago in Saudi Arabia, rejecting the kidnapping. I think these were important words." "Now, if he really means what he said about the kidnapping, and if he is truly committed to peace and to fighting terrorism, then logic and common sense mandate that he break his pact with Hamas. This is the only way that we can move forward." "I think this is something that is shared by many in Europe who understand that the quest for peace and stability and tranquility means that we have to fight the forces of terror, intolerance and darkness," he added. "There can be no alliance with the kidnappers of children." Earlier this week, Meshaal denied all knowledge of the abduction, and gave the kidnappers his "blessing" in an interview to Al-Jazeera. Headline: Suicide car bomber wounds 19 in south Beirut

A suicide bomber blew up his car in southern Beirut on Monday night near an army checkpoint, killing himself and wounding several people watching the soccer World Cup in a nearby cafe. The bombing came just three days after a failed attempt to kill one of the top security officials in Lebanon, which has suffered a wave of sectarian violence linked to the civil war in neighbouring Syria. Monday's explosion, shortly before midnight (2100 GMT), killed the bomber and wounded 19 people, Lebanon's civil defence force said. An emergency worker at the nearby Sahel hospital said it treated 11 lightly wounded people. Reuters television footage from the scene showed the blackened wreckage of a car, surrounded by damaged vehicles. Windows in nearby buildings were shattered by the blast, which occurred in a mainly Shi'ite Muslim district of southern Beirut inhabited by supporters of the Shi'ite group Amal, an ally of the militant movement Hezbollah. Hezbollah has been fighting alongside President Bashar al-Assad's forces in Syria against the mainly Sunni Muslim rebels, who have also been supported by Lebanese Sunnis.


Headline: At least 5 injured after explosions hit Cairo subway stations, court building

Five small explosions that went off in subway stations and outside a court building in Cairo during Wednesday morning's rush hour wounded at least five people, state media and officials say. The explosions were the first attacks since the election of Egyptian President Abdel-Fattah el-Sissi, the country's former army chief. Three of the blasts, caused by homemade explosive devices, went off in separate subway stations in central and northern Cairo, Interior Ministry spokesman Hani Abdel-Latif said. In one of the subway attacks, one of the injured was a man who carried the explosive in his backpack, Abdel-Latif said. In another, the bomb was hidden in a garbage can. Hours later, two additional bombs exploded outside a courthouse in the upscale Heliopolis district of Cairo, state media reported, according to The Wall Street Journal. One of the bombs had been planted under a car outside the courthouse, Interior Ministry spokesman Hani Abdel-Latif said. June 24, 2014

A car bomb exploded Tuesday in the central Syrian city of Homs, killing one person and wounding at least 14 in the latest blast to hit the city in recent weeks, Syrian media and an activist group said. State news agency SANA said the car bomb exploded near a candy shop in the pro-government neighborhood of Wadi Dahab, killing one person and wounding 23. The Britain-based Syrian Observatory for Human Rights also reported the blast came from a car bomb in Wadi Dahab, saying it killed one woman and wounded 14. June 24, 2014



Headline: Al-Qaeda merges with ISIL at Syria-Iraq town

Al-Qaeda's Syrian branch issued a loyalty pledge on Wednesday to the Islamic State of Iraq and the Levant at a tinderbox town on the Iraqi border, a monitor said. The merger is significant as it opens the way for ISIL to take control of both sides of the border at Albu Kamal in Syria and Al-Qaim in Iraq, according to the Syrian Observatory for Human Rights. ISIL — which aspires to create an Islamic state that straddles Iraq and Syria — has spearheaded an lightning jihadist offensive that has captured swathes of territory north and west of Baghdad this month. After months of clashes between the two sides, Al-Qaeda's official Syrian arm the Al-Nusra Front "pledged loyalty to ISIL" in Albu Kamal, said Observatory director Rami Abdel Rahman. "The pledge comes amid advances by ISIL in Deir Ezzor province" in eastern Syria on the Iraqi border, Abdel Rahman told AFP. An ISIL jihadist confirmed the reports on Twitter, and posted a photograph showing an Egyptian Al-Nusra Front commander shaking hands with a ISIL leader of Chechen origin. June 25, 2014

The first of 130 U.S. troops have arrived in Baghdad, according to the Pentagon. Press Secretary Rear Adm. John Kirby said that the first 40 were already in Iraq, assigned to the Office of Security Cooperation. The Special Operations troops were "re-missioned" and began working today as the first two assessment teams. Another 90 military personnel arrived in Baghdad today to begin setting up the Baghdad Joint Operations Center. These troops were deployed from around the Central Command area of operations, and include Special Operations troops, intelligence analysts, logisticians, IT support, etc. — from all the U.S. armed services, not just the Army. Approximately 50 more troops will deploy to Iraq in the next few days and will form the next four assessment teams, officials said. Kirby also said that the U.S. is now flying between 30 to 35 ISR (Intelligence,


Surveillance and Reconnaissance) flights per day around Iraq. Meanwhile, Iraqi air strikes killed at least 38 people on Tuesday as security forces held off attacks on a strategic town and an oil refinery, officials and witnesses said. In the town of Baiji, north of Baghdad, morning air strikes killed at least 19 people and wounded at least 17, officials said, while further raids in the evening killed six more. The officials said the dead and wounded were civilians, and it was unclear if there were any casualties among the militants who were the target of the strikes. State television said 19 "terrorists" were killed in the earlier set of Baiji raids.


Headline: Russian President Putin 'scraps Ukraine military move'

Russia's president has asked parliament to revoke the right of military intervention in Ukraine, where rebels have been fighting government troops. Vladimir Putin's move was aimed at "normalising the situation" in the conflict-torn eastern regions of Ukraine, his press-secretary said. The parliament authorised Mr Putin to use force in Ukraine on 1 March. Ukraine said Mr Putin's latest move was a "first practical step" towards settling the crisis in the east. In a statement, Ukrainian President Petro Poroshenko stressed that this came after Mr Putin had officially supported Kiev's peace plan, which involved a ceasefire. Since March, Moscow has annexed Ukraine's southern Crimea peninsula. This was achieved with the help of troops without insignia. Despite initial denials, Mr Putin later admitted that they were Russian armed forces. However, Moscow denies accusations by Kiev that Russian troops are helping and arming the separatists in Ukraine's eastern Donetsk and Luhansk regions.

Headline: Could 2014 Become the Warmest Year on Record?

Even though the year is only halfway over, a series of warm months — including the warmest May on record, announced Monday — paired with a brewing El Niño,have set one question circulating: Could 2014 take over the title of the warmest year on record? It's possible, experts say, but the No. 1 ranking is far from guaranteed, as the effects of an El Niño — an event that can raise global temperatures — on temperature may not fully emerge until the winter. "I agree that 2014 could well be the warmest on record, and/or 2015, depending on how things play out," said Kevin Trenberth, a climate scientist with the National Center for Atmospheric Research in Boulder, Colo. For 351 months in a row, or more than 29 years, global temperatures have been warmer than average. May 2014 was the 351st month in that uninterrupted series. The record-setting May came in with an average temperature 1.33°F above the 20th century average for the month (58.6°F), according to figures released by the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration. Data from the Japanese Meteorological Agency and preliminary data from NASA (which doesn't include records from China) also ranked May in the top spot. The ranking follows on the heels of an April that was ranked the warmest on record by NOAA and second warmest by NASA

Headline: Floods displace 200,000 people in Paraguay

Officials in Paraguay say floods caused by heavy rains have forced some 200,000 people across the country to leave their homes. The country's emergency service said Monday that an estimated 70,000 of the people who have escaped the rising waters are from the capital, Asuncion. Paraguay has seen heavy rainfall in recent weeks, which has caused the Paraguay and Parana rivers to overflow their banks. The flooding has affected the departments of Neembucu, Alto Parana, Presidente Hayes and Alto Paraguay, as well as the municipalities of Ayolas and Asuncion. Rescue workers have set up some 60 government camps to shelter displaced families and have distributed clothes and foods among those affected by the floods. Headline: Over 90 more abducted in northeast Nigeria

Extremists have abducted 60 more girls and women and 31 boys in weekend attacks on villages in northeast Nigeria, witnesses said Tuesday, another sign of the Nigerian military's failure to curb an

Islamic uprising. Some married women were taken along with their children who range in age from three to 15, said witnesses. A local official confirmed the abductions but security forces denied them. Nigeria's government and military have been widely criticized for their slow response to the abductions of more than 200 schoolgirls kidnapped April 15. There was no way to safely and independently confirm the report from Kummabza, 150 kilometers (95 miles) from Maiduguri, capital of Borno state and headquarters of a military state of emergency that has failed to curtail near-daily attacks by Boko Haram fighters. Kummabza resident Aji Khalil said Tuesday the abductions took place Saturday in an attack in which four villagers were killed. Khalil is a member of one of the vigilante groups that have had some success in repelling Boko Haram attacks with primitive weapons. A senior councilor from the village's Damboa local government told The Associated Press that abductions had occurred but insisted on anonymity because he was not authorized to give information to reporters. He said elderly survivors of the attack had walked some 25 kilometers (15 miles) to the relative safety of other villages. The new kidnappings show that international efforts to coordinate security along Nigeria's border with Cameroon have stalled, said Jacob Zenn, author of a book about Boko Haram. Sightings of groups of girls assumed to be among those kidnapped in April have come in from the neighboring countries of Chad, Niger and Cameroon, he said. Boko Haram's kidnapping experts appear to have set up headquarters in Cameroon, he said. "This latest kidnapping highlights the continued need for the Nigerian military, its neighbors and the international community to prevent Boko Haram from taking advantage of the border region," Zenn, an analyst for the Jamestown Foundation, said in a telephone interview.

Headline: Further fighting in Central African Republic kills over 50


More than 50 people have been killed in two days of clashes in Central African Republic, witnesses and officials said on Tuesday, with foreign troops struggling to stop recurrent violence between Muslim and Christian communities. Witnesses in Bambari, 380 km (236 miles) northwest of the capital Bangui, said an initial attack early on Monday by mainly Christian militia on its outskirts led to waves of reprisals by Muslim youths and fighting inside the town. Bambari sits on a sectarian fault line now cleaving the country, where over a year of violence has killed thousands, forced a million from their homes and led to most Muslims fleeing into northern zones closer to Chad and Sudan. The violence in the landlocked ex-French colony dates to the takeover last year of Bangui by the mostly Muslim Seleka rebel group, whose time in power was marked by a string of rights abuses, leading to the creation of the Christian militia. Seleka stepped down earlier this year under intense international pressure but a weak interim government has failed to stamp its authority on the country, which is rich in gold and diamonds but seen little but violence and political instability. Ibrahim Alawad, a witness in Bambari, said he had counted at least 22 bodies in the village of Liwa, about 7 km from Bambari, after the initial attack by Christian militia known as "anti-Balaka".

"Some had been cut to pieces, some had their hearts cut out. I saw about five children and six women." Citing reports from other witnesses, he added: "After that the youth of the Muslim area went there. They killed about 10 anti-Balaka."
