Do you remember these words?

“For the Lord Himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds...” — *1 Thessalonians 4:16-17*

And Jesus said:

“Two men will be in the field; one will be taken and the other left. Two women will be grinding at the mill; one will be taken and the other left.” — *Matthew 24:40–41*

**You are that one who was left.
But you don't have to stay lost.
You can still cry out to Jesus right now, wherever you are. He will hear you — even in the middle of the chaos.**

My Final Words to You

**Please, listen to me.
Don't take the mark of the beast, no matter how desperate things get. Don't believe the lies that this world will feed you. You're going to see deception like never before. Stay strong. Hold on to your faith. Read the Bible — if you can find one, keep it close.**

I prayed for you before this day came, and I'm praying that these words will be the spark that leads you to salvation. I may be gone, but what I wanted most was for you to know Jesus Christ and to join me one day in heaven.

**So fall on your knees and pray. Confess your sins. Ask Jesus to save you.
Do it now — while there's still a moment of mercy left.**

“Seek the Lord while He may be found; call upon Him while He is near.” — *Isaiah 55:6*

You're living in the days I warned you about. But even now, there's still a door open — and His name is Jesus.

After the Rapture: What You Must Do Now

This message is to help you survive it — not just physically, but spiritually.

If you're reading this, then the unthinkable has already happened — and you've been left behind. The world is in chaos. You've seen the fear, the confusion, and the desperate search for answers. But even in this darkness, there is still hope. God's mercy hasn't vanished — it's just harder to find. The time you're living in now is the *Tribulation*, the seven-year period that Jesus warned about. It will be the most terrifying, deceptive, and painful time the earth has ever known.

1. Understand What Just Happened

You need to be absolutely clear: The Rapture wasn't aliens, radiation, or some “mass disappearance event.” It was Jesus Christ taking His true believers out of the world before judgment falls.

2. Repent and Cry Out to Jesus

Pray something like this (in your own words):

“Lord Jesus, I believe You are who You said You are. I know I missed You when You came, but I don't want to be lost forever. Please forgive me. Wash me clean by Your blood. Give me the strength to follow You, no matter what it costs. I belong to You now.”

If you mean those words, God will hear you. He will forgive you. You can still be saved — but you must hold tightly to your faith through what's coming next.

3. Expect Persecution

Soon, a powerful world leader will rise up, claiming to have all the answers. He will speak of peace, unity, and hope. He will seem compassionate and wise. That man is the Antichrist. He will seek to behead anyone who does not take his mark.

He will gain control over governments, religions, and economies. As I said, eventually, he will demand that everyone take a *mark*— on their right hand or forehead — to buy or sell anything.

Do not take that mark. Once you do, you've sealed your fate. There will be no turning back. No forgiveness.

“He causes all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and slave, to receive a mark on their right hand or on their foreheads.” — *Revelation 13:16*

4. Find a Bible and Hide It

If you can find a Bible, guard it like your life depends on it — because it does. Read it daily. Start in the book of Matthew, then read Revelation. Everything you see happening will make sense when you read it in God’s Word.

There will be false teachers, fake “religious leaders,” and twisted messages trying to deceive you. The Bible is your only source of truth now.

5. Prepare for your Hardship they are coming!

You will face a world unlike anything you’ve known. Food shortages. Violence. Lawlessness. Global control. People betraying one another just to survive.

But don’t let fear control you. Trust that God will provide for those who call on His name. Connect with others who have also turned to Christ after the Rapture. You’ll need each other for encouragement and survival.

**“He that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved.”
— *Matthew 24:13***

6. Stay Faithful — Even Unto Death

The Tribulation will not last forever — it will end with the return of Jesus Christ to earth in glory. If you die for your faith, you will wake up in His presence, safe for eternity.

“Be faithful unto death, and I will give you a crown of life.” — Revelation 2:10

Do not fear death. Fear eternal separation from God instead.

7. Remember Why You’re Still Here

God didn’t leave you behind to destroy you — He’s giving you one final chance to surrender your life to Him. He still loves you. He still wants you in His Kingdom.

If you cling to Jesus, you will make it. You will see Him again. What saddens me is you who are left behind have to take the hard road in order to be saved.

Final Words of Hope

The world you knew is gone, but this isn’t the end of your story.

It’s the beginning of your final opportunity to choose — Christ or the world, truth or deception, life or death.

**Choose Jesus.
Hold fast to your faith.**

And no matter how dark it gets, remember — this is not the end for those who belong to Him.

When Jesus returns again — this time to reign — I pray I'll see you standing among those who overcame, your faith unbroken, your soul redeemed.

“Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in Me.” — *John 14:1*

**Don't give up.
He's coming again — and this time, you'll be ready.**

A Survival Guide for the Tribulation

Written for those left behind after the Rapture of the Church

If you're reading this, the world you once knew has vanished. The Rapture has happened, millions have disappeared, and the world has fallen into chaos. I know you're afraid, confused, and searching for hope. But I need you to understand — this is not the end of everything. It's the beginning of the most difficult seven years in human history — the Great Tribulation.

The Bible warned about this time, and now you are living it. What you do from this moment forward will determine your eternal destiny.

1. Do Not Take the Mark of the Beast

This is the single most important warning I can give you.

He will introduce a system requiring everyone to receive a mark on their right hand or forehead — without it, you will not be able to buy, sell, or trade.

Soon, a global leader — the Antichrist — will rise to power. He will promise peace and stability in the midst of global panic. At first, people will worship him as a savior. But then he will demand absolute loyalty.

“He causes all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and slave, to receive a mark on their right hand or on their foreheads, and that no man might buy or sell, save he that had the mark.” — *Revelation 13:16–17*

This mark will likely be connected to digital identification or currency — something that looks convenient, even compassionate. But it will bind you to the Antichrist and seal your eternal fate.

If you take it, you will be forever separated from God. If you refuse it, you will suffer — possibly even die — but your soul will be saved.

“If any man worship the beast and his image, and receive his mark... he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone.” — *Revelation 14:9–10*

Refuse the mark, no matter the cost.

2. Prepare to Live Without the System

Once you refuse the mark, you'll be cut off from society. You won't be able to buy food, medicine, or fuel. The government will track and persecute those who resist.

You'll need to find other believers — people who also realized the truth after the Rapture. Small groups of faithful Christians will gather in secret to pray, worship, and survive together.

If possible:

- Move away from large cities — they'll be the first places under total control.**
- Find safe locations — rural areas, forests, farms, or underground shelters.**
- Store food, water, and supplies — trade quietly with others who refuse the mark.**
- Keep a Bible hidden and safe. It will be your lifeline to truth and strength.**

You will be living like the early Christians — persecuted, hunted, but faithful to the end.

3. Expect Great Deception

During these years, deception will flood the earth like never before.

The Antichrist will perform miracles, signs, and wonders — calling down fire, healing the sick, even raising the dead. He

will use these things to convince people he is divine. But it's all a lie — a counterfeit power fueled by Satan himself.

“Even him, whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders.” — *2 Thessalonians 2:9*

**Do not believe the false miracles.
Do not follow the false prophet who will serve as the
Antichrist's spiritual spokesman.
Do not worship the image of the beast that they will set up in
the temple of Jerusalem.**

Stay faithful to the Word of God — it's the only truth you can trust.

4. Find Strength in the Scriptures

There will be times you feel completely alone, hungry, or hopeless. But remember — millions of others across the world will be suffering for the same reason: they refused to bow to evil.

When fear takes hold, cling to the promises in the Bible:

“God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.” — *Psalms* 46:1

“He that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved.” — *Matthew* 24:13

“Be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life.” — *Revelation 2:10*

Your courage will not be forgotten. Heaven will honor every tear, every trial, every act of faith.

5. Expect Global Disasters and Judgments

During the Tribulation, God's wrath will fall upon the earth through a series of catastrophic judgments — described in Revelation as the Seals, Trumpets, and Bowls.

These include:

- War on a global scale.**
- Famine and economic collapse.**
- Massive earthquakes and cosmic disturbances.**
- Waters turning to blood and deadly plagues.**
- Demonic torment released upon mankind.**

The world will cry out for death, but death will flee from them (Revelation 9:6).

But even as these things happen, God will still be calling people to repentance. Don't curse Him — run to Him.

6. Look for God's Witnesses

God will not leave the world without hope. During the Tribulation, He will send 144,000 Jewish evangelists — sealed by God to preach the truth — and two mighty witnesses in Jerusalem who will perform miracles and call the world to repentance.

When you hear their message, believe it. They are sent by God to lead you and others to salvation during this dark hour.

7. Hold on to the Hope of Christ's Return

This nightmare will not last forever. At the end of the seven years, the heavens will open, and Jesus Christ will return — not as a lamb, but as the Lion of Judah. He will destroy the Antichrist, crush the armies that rise against Israel, and set up His Kingdom on Earth.

“And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and He that sat upon him was called Faithful and True... and on His vesture and on His thigh a name written, KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS.” — *Revelation 19:11, 16*

If you endure faithfully to that day — even if it costs you your life — you will reign with Him forever.

8. My Final Words to You

I wish you weren't here to read this. I wish you had gone up with us in the Rapture. But now that you're here, I'm pleading with you — do not let Satan take your soul. I repeat, you take his mark he takes your soul and you will never escape hell.

You can't change the past, but you can choose your eternal future.

Hold on. Stand firm. Trust Jesus.

Your suffering will be temporary. Your reward will be eternal.

“He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death, or sorrow, or crying, or pain. All these things are gone forever.” — *Revelation 21:4*

The world may call you foolish, but heaven will call you faithful.
